LIBERTY RETURN TO THE GARDEN TO HOST WINLESS SPARKS

In the midst of a stretch where five of six games will come on the road, the Liberty return to Madison Square Garden to host the Los Angeles Sparks on Sunday afternoon. Los Angeles is the only team in the WNBA that has yet to record a win this season, but the Sparks have had a couple of close calls during its East Coast road swing, falling at Washington, 84-80, and first-place Connecticut, 80-76 in overtime on Friday night.

A SPOON FULL OF SUGAR

Sugar Rodgers started the second-consecutive game of her three-year WNBA career on Friday and led all scorers with 12 points in the loss to Tulsa. On June 21 at Atlanta, she started her first-ever game and did it with a bang, scoring 17 points, including two 3-pointers, while shooting 4-for-8 from the field. The Friday matchup at Tulsa was her fourth-consecutive game in double figures. She is averaging 12.5 ppg in the last four games, and 8.5 on the season.

Bill Laimbeer, a WNBA Coach of the Year and three-time WNBA Champion, enters his third season as head coach of the New York Liberty.

Laimbeer previously spent eight seasons from 2002-09 as general manager and head coach of the Detroit Shock (now Tulsa Shock), where he earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors in his first full season as head coach (2003). He took over a team that finished 9-23 in the previous year and led them to a league-best 25 wins the following season. The 16-win improvement was the largest in WNBA history. Laimbeer led the Shock to a 137-93 (.596) overall record, including six-straight playoff appearances as the squad won the WNBA Championship in 2003, 2006 and 2008.

As general manager of the Shock, Laimbeer made several key moves during his tenure that were integral in Detroit capturing three WNBA Championships, which still stand as second most in league history. In his first full season, Laimbeer drafted former All-Star and 2003 Rookie of the Year Cheryl Ford. He also acquired the Finals MVP that year Ruth Riley in the WNBA dispersal draft.

Prior to returning to the WNBA, Laimbeer spent two seasons as an assistant in the NBA with the Minnesota Timberwolves (2009-2011).

A 14-year NBA veteran, Laimbeer was a four-time All-Star for the Detroit Pistons. As a member of the famed "Bad Boys," Laimbeer totaled 13,790 points and 10,400 rebounds in his career, becoming just the 19th player in NBA history to eclipse 10,000 in both categories. A key member of back-to-back NBA Championships in 1989 and 1990, he had his jersey No. 40 retired by the franchise in 1995. Laimbeer played college ball at Notre Dame from 1975-79, graduating with a degree in economics in 1979.

Laimbeer and his wife Chris are parents to their son Eric and daughter Keri.

- 14-year NBA veteran and four-time All-Star
- Won back-to-back NBA Championships in 1989 and 1990 with the Detroit Pistons
- Had his #40 retired by the Detroit Pistons in 1995.
- Played collegiately at Notre Dame from 1975-79.

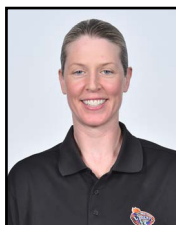

ALL-STAR VOTING UNDERWAY

Voting for the 2015 WNBA All-Star Game is underway and now fans have the ability to vote for any WNBA player for a chance to send them to the All-Star Game at Mohegan Sun Arena on July 25. There are four ways to vote and fans can pick up to 10 players each day with each method. Tag a player on Facebook or Twitter using the [#wnbaballot](#) hashtag, or vote on each individual player page on WNBA.com or the WNBA mobile app. Voting runs through July 9, and the starters will be announced on July 14.

CARRY ON CAROLYN

Carolyn Swords has quietly made integral contributions for the Liberty off the bench this season and after another solid performance at Tulsa on June 26, leads the league with a .600 field goal percentage. On June 21 at Atlanta, she scored a season high 12 points for the second time, leading all scorers with 10 in the first half. She also played a season high 27 minutes at Atlanta, 10 more than her highest minute total prior. She has scored in double figures three out of the Liberty's eight games. Swords' presence is also being felt on the defensive end, she swatted a career-best five shots at Atlanta, and ranks sixth the league, averaging 1.5 blocks per game.

PROTECTING THE BASKETBALL

New York committed a season-high 26 turnovers in the loss at Tulsa on June 26, which led directly to 18 Shock points the other direction. The Liberty rank 11th in the league, averaging 18.5 turnovers per game, and have seen all four losses come when it lost the turnover battle, posting a 2-4 record in those games.

DEFENDING THE PERIMETER

The Liberty continue to lead the WNBA, limiting opponents to 35.8 percent shooting from the field, however, this comes in spite of the fact that New York ranks 10th in the league in defensive 3-point field goal percentage. The Shock became the third team this season to hit 10 shots from beyond-the-arc against New York, and teams are shooting 35.8 percent from long-distance against the Liberty, tied for 10th in the league. Tulsa shot 41.7 percent (10-of-24) from three, but were just 28.9 percent inside the 3-point line.

LIVING UP TO HER REPUTATION

Rookie Kiah Stokes came into the league known as an outstanding shot blocker, and early in her pro career she is living up to that reputation. She had a season high four blocks at Tulsa on June 26. She has now recorded at least one block in six out of eight games this season. She blocked two shots against Phoenix on 6/11, swatted three shots in the game vs. Indiana on 6/9, recorded two blocks at Washington 6/6 and three in her rookie debut vs. Atlanta on 6/5. She is fourth in the WNBA with 1.9 blocks per game, and third in the league with 15 overall. With Stokes holding down the interior, New York ranks second in the league, averaging 5.75 blocks per game.

TINA CHARLES RECORDS 100TH-CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE

With 13 points and 12 rebounds in the win at Atlanta on June 21, Tina Charles recorded the 100th-regular season double-double of her career. Charles ranks second all-time in the WNBA in career double-doubles, trailing just Lisa Leslie (157), and leads all active players. She has three double-doubles so far this season.

TINA CHARLES DONATING HALF OF 2015 WNBA SALARY TO HOPEY'S HEART FOUNDATION

Liberty center Tina Charles announced she will donate half of her 2015 salary to the Hopey's Heart Foundation. She's dedicated to placing a minimum of 100 automatic external defibrillators (AED) throughout the United States each year. Nearly 390,000 out-of-hospital sudden cardiac arrests (SCA) occur annually. Having an automatic external defibrillators (AED) close by can mean the difference between life and death for a victim of SCA. Hopey's Heart Foundation is committed to improving the health of student and amateur athletes by providing health education, CPR training and lifesaving AEDs in schools, community and recreational centers. To date, Hopey's Heart has placed 142 AED's.

BOYD LEADS THE WAY

Rookie point guard Brittany Boyd came off the bench to lead the Liberty with 18 points in its win at Atlanta on June 21. That is significant because Boyd is the first rookie to lead New York in scoring since Kelsey Bone in 2013, and the first Liberty rookie to lead both teams offensively in a win since Becky Hammon in a 72-55 victory over Cleveland on Aug. 19, 1999.

LIBERTY LIMITING FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE

- In the 71-62 loss to Tulsa on Friday, the Liberty held the Shock to its lowest field goal percentage this season at .339, on 21-of-62 shooting from the field.
- In its 73-64 win at Atlanta on June 21, the Liberty held the Dream to just 29.7 percent shooting, on 19-for-64 from the field.
- The Liberty had not held an opponent to under 30-percent on the road since June 1, 2007, when it held Minnesota to .274 (20-for-73) from the field in a 70-60 victory.
- The last time a WNBA team held a home team that low was June 7, 2014, when Phoenix forced San Antonio into shooting .278 (25-for-90) in a double-OT victory.
- That was the second time the Liberty held a team under 30-percent this season, holding the Mercury to just 29.2 percent shooting from the field in its 68-57 win over Phoenix on June 11.
- Phoenix posted the lowest field goal percentage for a Liberty foe since 2012, when again it was the Mercury, shooting just 17-of-69 (.246).
- New York's team record for lowest opponent field goal percentage is .241, set on July 8, 1999, when it beat the Cleveland Rockers 84-49 at The Garden.
- The Liberty rank first in the WNBA in opponent shooting percentage, limiting foes to just 36.0 percent from the field.

ROOKIE REBECCA ALLEN TO MISS REMAINDER OF 2015 SEASON

The New York Liberty have been short handed to start the season due to Epiphanny Prince's commitment to compete in the EuroBasket Women 2015 Tournament during the month of June, but that lineup became a little thinner when it was announced that dynamic rookie forward Rebecca Allen will miss the remainder of the 2015 season in order to surgically repair a left-knee injury. That absence leaves the Liberty with 10 active players on the roster until Prince returns next month.

ROAD WARRIORS

After starting the season with five of its first six games at home, the Liberty will hit the road and play five of its next six games away from Madison Square Garden. The Liberty started the season 3-0 at home before suffering their first home loss to the Mystics on 6/14. New York also began the season 3-1 for the first time since 2007.

BOOST OFF THE BENCH BOYD OH BOYD

After starting four-straight games, rookie point guard Brittany Boyd came off the bench in New York's 73-64 win at Atlanta on June 21, and provided the Liberty with a big spark, scoring a career-best 18 points. New York's bench scoring has proven to be an asset all season long, no matter who is called upon to enter as a reserve, with the Liberty averaging 26.8 bench points per game.

JUST KEEP SWIN-ING

In her 14th season in the WNBA, Swin is climbing up the record charts. She needs just five more games to pass Tully Bevilaqua for 8th all time games played (426), and 20 more points to pass Sheryl Swoopes for 14th all time in scoring (4,875).

SHARP SHOOTER

Essence Carson saw her string of double-digit scoring efforts end at three-straight games against Indiana on June 21, but she is proving to be one of the most effective 3-point shooters in the league so far this season. Carson leads New York with five 3-pointers and is shooting 42.9 percent from 3-point range, which ranks 8th in the league. She added a trey on 1-of-2 shooting from behind the arc against Tulsa on Friday.

LIBERTY OFFSEASON HIGHLIGHTED IN ANNUAL GM SURVEY

The WNBA released its annual general manager survey before the start of the season and the Liberty factored into a pair of categories. According to the executives polled, rookie center Kiah Stokes was tabbed as the sleeper rookie most likely to be a success, receiving 25% of the votes. After a busy offseason, New York grabbed 25% of the votes as the team with the best offseason moves, finishing only behind Seattle in that category.

PRESEASON NOTABLES

- After sitting out the first preseason game, Tina Charles returned to average 15.5 ppg in two preseason appearances, which led the WNBA. She also shot a blistering 70.0 percent from the field, ranking fourth in the league.
- Kiah Stokes enjoyed a strong start to her pro career, averaging 9.0 rpg, the fourth-best rate during the preseason. She also averaged 26.4 minutes of action per game, ranking eighth in the league.
- Rookie Rebecca Allen scored in double figures in all three games, and averaged 10.3 ppg during the preseason.
- Sugar Rodgers had seven steals in three appearances, 2.3 per game, ranking sixth in the WNBA.
- The Liberty will look to tighten up 3-point shooting and protecting the basketball. New York was outscored 63-21 from beyond the arc during the preseason and turned the ball over 15 times more (56-41) than its opponents.

ROOKIES SHINE IN PRESEASON DEBUT

The Liberty saw a pair of first year players shine in the 2015 preseason opener against Chicago on Friday. Rookie center Kiah Stokes turned in a double-double, playing a team-high 25 minutes to finish with 11 points and 11 rebounds. Wing Rebecca Allen out of Australia finished with 10 points, knocking down both of her 3-point attempts. First round draft pick Brittany Boyd started at the point and finished with seven points and a pair of assists in her professional debut.

ISIAH THOMAS NAMED TEAM PRESIDENT

Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer Isiah Thomas was named the President of the New York Liberty on May 5; he will oversee basketball and business operations for the franchise. Thomas played a critical role in the Liberty's busy offseason, which featured a number of trades and free agent signings, resulting in a new look team that features a blend of veteran leaders and exciting young talent heading into 2015. Additionally, Thomas created the Director of Player Development position now held by Liberty legend Teresa Weatherspoon, the first such position for any franchise in the WNBA. Thomas played 13 seasons for the Detroit Pistons, winning back-to-back NBA titles with Liberty head coach Bill Laimbeer in 1989-90. He has held NBA front office positions with the Toronto Raptors, Indiana Pacers and New York Knicks, spent three years as the head men's basketball coach at Florida International University, and currently works as an analyst for NBA TV.

PRINCE TO MISS START OF THE SEASON

Due to pre-existing international obligations, guard Epiphanny Prince, a Queens, N.Y., native acquired via trade from the Chicago Sky, will compete for the Russian national team at the EuroBasket Women 2015 Tournament in Hungary from June 11-28. Prince plays internationally for Dynamo Kursk of Russia. She has held dual citizenship since 2010 and was a member of the Russian national team for the 2013 European Championship. She will depart on Friday, May 22, and rejoin the Liberty at the conclusion of the EuroBasket Women 2015 tournament and compete in the WNBA for the remainder of the season.

LIBERTY MAKE A SPLASH IN THE DRAFT

The Liberty made five picks in the 2015 WNBA Draft, including a pair of first rounders, despite entering the day without a first-round pick, which had been sent to Connecticut in 2014 to acquire All-Star center Tina Charles. New York traded Alex Montgomery to San Antonio and selected All-American point guard Brittany Boyd from California. Additionally, the Liberty traded guard Anna Cruz and two picks to the Minnesota Lynx, selecting center Kiah Stokes from the University of Connecticut with the 11th overall pick.

OFFSEASON BLOCKBUSTER

New York and Chicago executed a blockbuster trade during the offseason when the Liberty sent Cappie Pondexter to the Sky in exchange for Brooklyn native Epiphanny Prince. Pondexter played five seasons in New York, and ranks first in franchise history with a scoring average of 18.5 ppg, but had the lowest scoring season of her career, averaging 13.2 ppg in 2014, shooting just 27.7 percent from 3-point range. Prince, entering her sixth season out of Rutgers, averaged a career-best 18.1 ppg in 2012, and 15.0 ppg in each of the last two seasons.

NEW YORK STATE OF MIND

This year's team will have a local feel with three players hailing from the NYC metropolitan area: Tina Charles (Brooklyn — Christ the King), Epiphanny Prince (Queens — Murry Bertram), and Essence Carson (Paterson, N.J. — Paterson Eastside). Additionally, veteran guard Tanisha Wright was born in Brooklyn before moving to Pittsburgh as a child.

FRESH LOOK

This New York Liberty roster will look very different from a year ago. Of the 18 players that reported to camp in 2014, three remain on the active roster heading into 2015 (Tina Charles, Essence Carson, Sugar Rodgers). Carson is the only member of the Liberty that was on the roster when head coach Bill Laimbeer took over prior to the 2013 season.

BILL IS BACK

Head coach Bill Laimbeer returns for his third season with the New York Liberty. Laimbeer has won three WNBA titles (2003, 2006, 2008), all with the Detroit Shock, and was named the WNBA Coach of the Year in 2003 when he led the Shock to the first of three championships.

CONNECTICUT CONNECTION

Including 2015 First Round draft pick Kiah Stokes, the Liberty have a University of Connecticut connection, with three former Huskies on the squad (Tina Charles, Swin Cash), which ties for the most in the league (Seattle, Washington).

WELCOME HOME SPOON!

Liberty legend Teresa "T-Spoon" Weatherspoon rejoins the franchise as its first Director of Player Development. Weatherspoon, who played for the Liberty for seven seasons from 1997-2003, is in the Madison Square Garden Walk of Fame. She was a consultant with the team last season, and was the head coach at her alma mater Louisiana Tech from 2009-13. Weatherspoon is the Liberty's all-time leader in assists (1,306) and steals (453).

VETERAN LEADERSHIP

New York's roster is balanced with young players and veteran leaders who have WNBA titles on their resumes, including a pair of offseason acquisitions in Tanisha Wright and Candice Wiggins.

Swin Cash – The Liberty traded for Swin during the 2014 season and then resigned her this winter. A 13-year veteran, Swin has won three WNBA titles, including two with Bill Laimbeer when she played for the Detroit Shock (2003, 2006). She won her third league championship as a member of the Seattle Storm in 2010. Entering her 14th season in the league, Cash is tied for the second-longest WNBA tenure, trailing just Atlanta's DeLisha Milton-Jones.

Tanisha Wright – Wright played her first 10 WNBA seasons with Seattle, winning a WNBA title in 2010. She has been named to the WNBA All-Defensive team four times and has been exceedingly reliable during her career, as she is the only player in league history to compete in at least 32 games for nine consecutive seasons for the same team.

Candice Wiggins – Wiggins was a member of Minnesota's WNBA Championship team in 2011. She was drafted by the Lynx in 2008 and played there for six seasons before suiting up last year for the Los Angeles Sparks.

HERB WILLIAMS JOINS COACHING STAFF

Longtime NBA coach Herb Williams has joined the New York Liberty staff as an assistant coach. Williams began his coaching career as a New York Knicks assistant in 2003, before serving as the interim head coach in 2004 and 2005. The Columbus, Ohio, native, played collegiately at The Ohio State University from 1977-81, then enjoyed an 18-year playing career before joining the coaching ranks in 2003.
