LIBERTY LAST GAME QUICK HITS

Home in Brooklyn, the New York Liberty (9-9) defeated the Washington Mystics (7-10), 82-79, coming back from a 20-point deficit. The last time any WNBA team came back from down 20+ to win a contest was in 2019. New York won their ninth contest this afternoon, evening their 2021 season record to .500.

Entering Saturday, the Liberty had just one comeback win when trailing by 20+ points in franchise history, also against the Washington Mystics on August 21, 2003.

At the half, New York trailed Washington by 19 points. The Liberty outscored the Mystics 49-28 in the second half to secure the win.

In the final two minutes of the game, **Sabrina Ionescu** found **Reshanda Gray** in consecutive possessions for a 4-0 run to give New York the lead. **Betnijah Laney** sealed the victory by knocking down a pair of free throws within the final two seconds, en route to an 82-79 comeback win.

In a contest that saw seven lead changes and only one tie, New York finished with 16 team assists and their second-lowest turnover total of the season (12). The team also totaled 39 rebounds, outrebounding the Mystics 39-34.

The Liberty tallied 42 points in the paint, their second-highest total of the season, and notched 11 fast break points.

New York finished on 45.3% (29-64) shooting from the field, 40.0% (8-20) from beyond the arc and 84.2% (16-19) at the free throw line.

For the first time since May 23 at Chicago, five Liberty players scored in double figures in tonight's game (Laney, Jones, Ionescu, Onyenwere, Gray).

Betnijah Laney led all Liberty scorers with 19 points on 50.0% (7-14) from the field, 3 assists, and 3 rebounds. On Saturday, Betnijah scored in double figures for the 17th time through her first 18 games in Seafoam and is currently the only player in the league to average 19.0+ points and 5.0+ assists per game.

Jazmine Jones tied her season-high of 17 points on 44.4% (4-9) from the field, 66.7% (2-3) from deep, 100% from the line (7-7) and 5 rebounds.

Sabrina lonescu recorded 15 points, 5 assists and 5 rebounds. While on a minute restriction, Sabrina has still scored at least 6 points and grabbed 5 boards in five of her last six games.

Two-time WNBA Rookie of the Month, **Michaela Onyenwere**, totaled 11 points on 44.4% (4-9) from the field and 75.0% (3-4) from the line; her fourth consecutive game in double figure scoring.

In her first game back with New York, **Reshanda Gray** posted 11 points on 55.6% (5-6) shooting from the field and 6 rebounds, including a 6-point fourth quarter that helped complete New York's 20-point comeback.

Sami Whitcomb tied her career-high of 9 rebounds to go along with 6 points.

LIBERTY VS. WINGS QUICK HITS

Monday's game will mark the Liberty's 71st all-time regular season matchup against the Dallas Wings franchise.

New York and Dallas both enter the matchup with 9-9 records through the first 18 games, and will battle to surpass the .500 mark on the season.

The Liberty are coming off an 82-79 win on July 3, coming back from a 20-point deficit against the Washington Mystics. The last time any WNBA team came back from down 20+ to win a contest was in 2019. Prior to Saturday, the Liberty had just one comeback win when trailing by 20+ points in franchise history (also against the Washington Mystics on August 21, 2003).

For the first time since May 23 at Chicago, five Liberty players scored in double figures in Saturday's game (Laney, Jones, Ionescu, Onyenwere, Gray).

Betnijah Laney led all Liberty scorers with 19 points on 50.0% (7-14) from the field, 3 assists, and 3 rebounds. Betnijah scored in double figures for the 17th time through her first 18 games in Seafoam and is currently the only player in the league to average 19.0+ points and 5.0+ assists per game.

Dallas will travel to Brooklyn after defeating the Chicago Sky, 100-91, behind **Marina Mabrey**'s 28-point performance off the bench on July 2.

In their first meeting of the season on May 24, New York outlasted Dallas in an 88-81 win at home in the latter half of a back-to-back.

Betnijah Laney led all scorers with a game-high 26 points on 60.0% (9-15) shooting from the field.

The Wings' offense is led by their Notre Dame alumnae. **Arike Ogunbowale** has team-high 23.0 points per game in her third season with Dallas, while **Marina Mabrey** is averaging 14.8 points.

Since 1998, the Wings franchise (previously Detroit and Tulsa) hold the head-to-head regular season series lead, as the Liberty have an overall record of 33-37 (.471) against Dallas.

Liberty legend and Ring of Honor Member, **Vickie Johnson**, is in her first season as the Head Coach of the Dallas Wings. Johnson, who was an integral part of the Liberty from 1997-2005, holds the franchise record for most games played (282), minutes played (8,950), and ranks second in multiple categories including, but not limited to, points scored (3,248), rebounds (1,077) and assists (787).

The Liberty lost both games in their season series with the Wings in 2020. **Sabrina lonescu** posted her career-high scoring performance against Dallas on August 29 when she dropped 33 points, which is New York's single-game scoring record against the Wings franchise.

In last year's season series, WNBA All-Rookie Team member **Jazmine Jones** averaged 14.5 points through the pair of games against the Wings, while Neah Odom totaled an average of 10.0 points per game.

For Dallas, **Arike Ogunbowale** averaged a series-best 23.0 points against New York over the two games.

"IF YOU DON'T KNOW B BY NOW..."

On Wednesday, the WNBA announced the roster selections for the 2021 AT&T WNBA All Star Game, and New York's Betnijah Laney was among eight first-time All Stars selected.

MVP Candidate and first-time WNBA All-Star, **Betnijah Laney**, has combined for 354 points for New York in the first 18 games of the season. She is shooting 50.0% from the field and 32.3% from beyond the arc. Laney currently ranks fifth in the league in points per game with 19.7, and has eclipsed double-figure scoring in 17 of the first 18 contests. Similarly, Betnijah finished her 2020 WNBA Most Improved Player Award season totaling 13 of the last 14 games in double figures for the Dream.

WE GOT THE JAZ

On Saturday against the Mystics, **Jazmine Jones** led the Liberty to the their second 20+ point comeback win in franchise history. Jones tied her season-high of 17 points on 44.4% (4-9) from the field, 66.7% (2-3) from deep, 100% from the line (7-7) and 5 rebounds.

GUESS WHO'S BACK

Following the waiver of center Kiah Stokes, the New York Liberty re-signed forward **Reshanda Gray**, who played six games with New York earlier this season. In her first game back with the Liberty, Gray posted 11 points on 55.6% (5-6) shooting from the field and 6 rebounds, including a 6-point fourth quarter that helped complete New York's 20-point comeback win.

SAMIII FOR MIP

Veteran sharpshooter and valued leader, **Sami Whitcomb**, is compiling a career-year in her first campaign with New York. Whitcomb is currently averaging career-highs of 11.9 points, 5.4 rebounds and 2.8 assists per game. Sami's career-highs do not stop there, as she is shooting personal bests of 49.3% from the field and 44.8% from deep, as well as logging 28.6 minutes per game and a career-high 18 starts. She is currently first in the WNBA in three-point field goals made on the season (47).

On June 26, Whitcomb led all scorers with a career-high 30 points on 58.3% (7-12) from distance, 6 rebounds, 5 assists and 3 steals. She tallied a game-high 22 first-half points, tying her previously held career high. Whitcomb's seven three-pointers (also a career-high) tied the Liberty's all-time single-game record, making her just the sixth player in team history to do so.

MICHAELA ONYENWERE LEADING ROOKIE OF THE YEAR RACE

Liberty rookie, **Michaela Onyenwere**, was named the Kia WNBA Rookie of the Month for May and June. The No. 6 overall selection is leading all rookies in points per game (10.3), minutes per game (24.0), total field goals made (63) and three pointers made (25), while also sitting at No. 2 in total rebounds (52). Through her first 18 WNBA games, she is shooting 39.4% from the field, 32.1% from beyond the arc and 82.9% at the free throw line.

On Friday, Michaela became the first Liberty rookie to garner consecutive Rookie of the Month honors in franchise history since the award was instituted in 2010.



SOMEONE SAY MVB?

Through the first 18 games of the 2021 season, **Betnijah Laney** is making an MVP case in her first year with the Liberty. Last season, Laney garnered the 2020 WNBA Most Improved Player Award with Atlanta after averaging 17.2 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 4.0 assists per contest, while shooting 48.1% from the field and 40.5% from beyond the arc.

To date, no WNBA player has garnered both the Most Improved Player and Most Valuable Player awards throughout their career. In the NBA, **Giannis Antetokounmpo** was the first recipient of the award to later become an MVP.

IN THIER OWN LANE(Y)

Betnijah Laney's basketball pedigree is well-documented, as her mother, Yolanda Laney, was an All-American guard at Cheney State for Coach C. Vivian Stringer. She led the team to two Final Fours, including a national championship appearance in 1982.

NEW LOOK LIBERTY

Through the first three games in 2021, the Liberty surpassed their 2020 win total (2-20). New York (9-9) is currently in third place in the Eastern Conference.

SEAFOAM SHARPSHOOTERS

The New York Liberty sit atop the WNBA across in nearly all three-point shooting categories. The Liberty rank No. 1 in total three-pointers made (182), triples per game (10.1), attempts (507), percentage of points from three (37.9%). New York also ranks No. 2 in effective field goal percentage (50.5%) and No. 4 in true shooting percentage (54.5%).

Sami Whitcomb is currently first in the WNBA in three-point field goals made on the season (47).

FIRST TIME OLYMPIAN

Rebecca Allen will be representing Australia in the 2020 Tokyo Summer Olympics for the first time in her career. This season, Allen is averaging career-highs of 8.9 points, 1.6 steals and 22.1 minutes through her first 14 games of 2021.

ASHLEY BATTLE RE-JOINS LIBERTY

On June 18, the Liberty announced that former player **Ashley Battle** has been named color analyst on YES Network, the official regional TV partner of the New York Liberty.

Former Liberty forward and defensive specialist (2006-2009), Battle will call game action alongside play-by-play announcer Chris Shearn.



DON'T FORGET DIDI

DiDi Richards currently leads the WNBA in steals by a rookie (9). Richards has been New York's defensive spark and source of instant energy through her first 17 WNBA games.

AWARDS SZN IN BK

To begin the 2021 season, the New York Liberty have already garnered six awards, including:

NATASHA HOWARD OUT 4-6 WEEKS

New York Liberty forward/center, **Natasha Howard**, injured her left knee in the fourth quarter against the Dallas Wings on May 24. Howard underwent an MRI and clinical exam at Hospital for Special Surgery on Tuesday, May 25 which revealed the diagnosis of a medial collateral ligament (MCL) sprain. The Liberty's medical staff determined Natasha will be unavailable for 4-6 weeks.

TRIPLE DOUBLE HISTORY

On May 18, **Sabrina Ionescu** posted the first triple-double in Liberty history with 26 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists. Ionescu recorded the 10th triple-double in the league's 25-year history (9th in regular season). She is the youngest player in WNBA history to ever do so, and just the ninth player all-time to accomplish the feat.

SEASON 25: #OwnTheCrown

The New York Liberty are one of the WNBA's three remaining original franchises, joined by the Los Angeles Sparks and Phoenix Mercury. This season, the Liberty and WNBA are both celebrating their historic 25-Year Anniversary. To celebrate the team's monumental milestone, the Liberty will be using #OwnTheCrown throughout the 2021:

JESS SIMS NAMED LIBERTY IN-ARENA CO-HOST

As part of the team's 25th anniversary season, the New York Liberty have named **Jess Sims** the official In-Arena Co-Host. The New York-based educator, fitness professional and Peloton Instructor will join co-host Jason Negron during select Liberty home games at Brooklyn's Barclays Center.

BROOKLYN VETS

The New York Liberty highlighted the WNBA's off-season transactions with the additions of veterans **Betnijah Laney**, **Natasha Howard** and **Sami Whitcomb**. They have each fought hard to overcome adversity and earn their spots as 3 of 144, and now begin the next chapter of their WNBA careers with the Liberty. Each player brings unique experience, high-level character, and championship pedigree to this New York Liberty roster.

THE FLASH IN NY

On February 8, the Liberty made a blockbuster trade to bring three-time WNBA Champion, **Natasha Howard** to New York from the Seattle Storm in exchange for the 2021 No. 1 overall draft pick.

The WNBA's 2019 Defensive Player of the Year, Natasha Howard (29) is a 6-2 forward who is entering her eighth WNBA season. Howard was drafted by the Indiana Fever in 2014 where she spent two seasons, followed by two years with the Minnesota Lynx. Howard won her first WNBA Championship (2017) alongside Liberty Head Coach Walt Hopkins in Minnesota. During her three-year tenure with the Seattle Storm, Howard secured two additional WNBA Championships (2018, 2020).

In Seattle's 2020 Championship season, Howard averaged 9.5 points and 7.1 rebounds per game while shooting 53.0% from the field during the regular season.

SAMI IN SEAFOAM

Fifth-year WNBA veteran, **Sami Whitcomb**, joined the Liberty after spending the past four seasons with the Seattle Storm.

Whitcomb (32), a 5-10 guard, came to New York after helping the Storm to two WNBA titles. In Seattle's 2020 championship season, Whitcomb averaged 8.1 points, 2.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game while shooting 38.1% from three, 44.3% from the field and 100% at the free throw line (22-22). The Ventura, Calif. native and Australia citizen signed as a free agent with the Storm in 2017 after competing professionally overseas for several seasons, most notably in Australia's WNBL.

BEC'S BACK

Sami Whitcomb will not be the only Australian sharpshooter bringing their talents to Brooklyn, as the Liberty have re-signed veteran forward **Rebecca Allen**. Allen, 28, re-joins the Liberty as the team's longest-tenured member (along with Kiah Stokes) after five seasons with New York. Rebecca, whose most recent season with the Liberty was in 2019, averaged a career-high 7.2 points per game on a team-best 42.6% shooting from three-point territory.



SOPHOMORE SZN

Just as New York was historically rookie-heavy in 2020, the team will be returning five sophomores to their roster this season: **Sabrina Ionescu, Jazmine Jones, Leaonna Odom, Kylee Shook**, and **Jocelyn Willoughby** (out for season).

2021 WNBA DRAFT

The New York Liberty enjoyed a successful 2021 WNBA Draft, as the front office was able to procure two first-round talents in **Michaela Onyenwere** and **DiDi Richards**.

Onyenwere, the Liberty's No. 6 overall pick, is a 6-0 forward. The Aurora, Colo. native averaged 19.1 points and 7.2 rebounds while shooting 42.1% in her senior campaign, leading UCLA to a Sweet Sixteen appearance. Michaela, a four-year letter winner with the Bruins, finished her collegiate career as the fourth overall leading scorer in program history (1,888 points).

Richards, New York's No. 17 overall selection, is a 6-2 guard/forward. DiDi averaged 6.3 points and 6.3 assists per game in the 2020-21 season while shooting 42.9% from the field, leading Baylor to a 28-3 finish and Final Four appearance. The Cypress, Texas native, known for her elite defensive ability, garnered the 2020 Naismith and WBCA Defensive Player of The Year Awards.

PLAYER TO COACH

On April 26, 2021, the Liberty announced the hiring of **Jacki Gemelos** as an assistant coach. Gemelos, 32, begins her first season as a WNBA coach after several seasons of service in the league. Jacki was a point guard for the Chicago Sky in 2015, and split time between the Connecticut Sun and Washington Mystics in 2020. Additionally, she has played six seasons overseas, and was a member of Greece's National Women's Basketball Team.

YES, PLEASE.

The Liberty's regional TV partner since 2019, will televise a record 19 New York Liberty games this season All of YES' 19 Liberty telecasts will also be streamed live on the YES App.

DIDI'S PERSERVERANCE

In October 2020, New York Liberty rookie, **DiDi Richards**, suffered a collision during practice at Baylor that left her temporarily paralyzed. Just 38 days later, Richards returned to the hardwood where she was able to lead the Lady Bears to an NCAA Final Four finish. In the same season, DiDi ranked second in the nation in total assists (189) while averaging 6.3 points and 6.3 assists during her senior campaign.

WITHOUT WILLOUGHBY

New York Liberty guard/forward **Jocelyn Willoughby** suffered a tear of her left Achilles' tendon during the team's scrimmage on May 3 at Connecticut. Willoughby underwent a successful surgical repair on May 5 at Hospital for Special Surgery (HSS). She will miss the 2021 season.



MADDIE PASSED THE TORCH TO ELLIE

As part of the 25th anniversary season, the New York Liberty announced a new mascot, Ellie the Elephant. Ellie, named after Ellis Island, is replacing Maddie, the team's mascot for the last 24 years.

Back story: Before the grand opening of the Brooklyn Bridge in 1883, there was speculation on the structural integrity of the bridge. To display its strength and safety, showman P.T. Barnum marched 21 elephants across the bridge. The PR stunt was a massive success, paving the way for one of New York's most iconic landmarks. Read more about Ellie here.

2021 NIKE JERSEYS

The new WNBA uniform system from Nike feature three game uniform editions for each of the 12 teams in the league, bringing stories from their cities and communities to life through the muse of female archetypes in storytelling and film: the WNBA Nike Heroine Edition, the WNBA Nike Explorer Edition and the WNBA Nike Rebel Edition.

Rebel Edition (Seafoam): Inspired by the striking colors of the city's iconic monument and all that it represents, the uniform features "Equality" across the chest, framed by copper and black taping.

Explorer Edition (Black): The uniform's speckled details represent the urban pavement while jagged, graphic details embody the toughness and eccentricity that defines true New Yorkers.

LIBS ABROAD

The New York Liberty's roster enjoyed a highly successful 2020-21 WNBA Off-Season competing overseas. **Bec Allen**, who played for Valencia Basket in Spain, helped lead the Orange to their first-ever EuroCup Championship win in club history. **Kiah Stokes** (Fenerbache) took home the gold in the Turkish League championships, and **Nastasha Howard** secured the Serie A1 Finals Championship with Reyer Venezia in Italy.


READ WHAT YOU SOW



The 2021 WNBA season is Walt Hopkins' second season as the New York Liberty's head coach.

He specializes in: relationship building; providing nuanced individual skill development at every position, improving footwork and shot mechanics, creating and maintaining positive team culture via specific framing and communication strategies, and cultivating positive mindsets in players and coaches.

Prior to joining the Lynx staff, Hopkins served as Academic Coach at the University of California, Berkeley (2014-2016). He also served as the assistant women's basketball coach at Utah Valley University (2013-2014) and Director of Basketball Operations and Player Development Coach for the Tulsa Shock (2013).

Originally from Sparks, Nevada, Hopkins received his bachelor's degree at the University of Nevada-Reno. He also holds master's degrees from Harvard and UC Berkeley, where his studies focused primarily on applying findings from Social, Developmental and Educational Psychology to coaching settings.

- In Seattle's 2020 championship season, Whitcomb averaged 8.1 points, 2.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game while shooting 38.1% from three, 44.3% from the field and 100% at the free throw line (22-22).
