LIBERTY VS. MERCURY QUICK HITS

Friday's contest will mark the Liberty's 55th all-time regular season matchup against the Phoenix Mercury. The matchup will also be New York's third and final contest of 2021 against the Mercury. With an all-time head-to-head record of 28-27 (.509), New York holds a slight advantage in their all-time regular-season series against Phoenix.

The Liberty and the Mercury last played on Wednesday in the opener of New York's two-game, home-and-home set on Crystal Robinson's Ring of Honor induction night. In the matchup, the Liberty concluded with four double-digit scorers: **Betnijah Laney** (20), **DiDi Richards** (14), **Rebecca Allen** (12), and **Sabrina Ionescu** (10).

With her 20-point, eight-rebound, five-assist night, 2021 WNBA All-Star **Betnijah Laney** scored 20+ points for the 13th time this season and tied with Rebecca Allen for the team high in rebounds.

2021 All-Rookie Team candidate **DiDi Richards** led the Liberty bench's scoring reaching career-highs of 14 points on 62.5% (5-8) from the field and 80% (4-5) from deep over 25 minutes of play. After missing her only three-point attempt at Baylor, Richards has attempted 15 triples in her rookie campaign and is so far connecting on a 53.3% clip (8-15).

For Phoenix, four players scored in double figures, three of which scored 20+ points: **Skylar Diggins-Smith** (27), **Brittney Griner** (26), **Diana Taurasi** (21), and **Brianna Turner** (10).

Going into Friday's rubber match to their three-game regular-season series, New York is the league's best three-point shooting team. Their 271 Three-Pointers Made leads the WNBA and is nearly 40 more than the second-ranked Storm (234). Plus, they lead the league in Three-Point Attempts (28.3) and Three-Pointers Made (10.4) per game and are top-3 in Three-Point Percentage (36.8), too.

Phoenix continues to lead the league in Blocks Per Game (5.6). They are top-2 in Rebounds Per Game (37.1) and top-5 in Field Goal Percentage (44.4) and Assists Per Game (19.5).

Former Liberty guard, **Kia Nurse**, will play her third career game against New York. Nurse was a 2018 No. 10 overall selection of the Liberty, where she spent three seasons and averaged 11.5 points per game across 89 total contests, 59 of which she started.

Additionally, both **Kia Vaughn** (2009-12, 2017-18) and **Megan Walker** (2020) also spent time in Seafoam before moving to the Valley.

DIDI FOR ALL-ROOKIE TEAM

DiDi Richards' breakout second half has her in prime position for WNBA All-Rookie Team honors. Last game, Richards totaled career highs of 14 points on 4-5 (80.0%) from beyond the arc against the Mercury.

Currently second in the WNBA in field goal percentage (44.7%), assists (21), steals (14), and blocks (5) by a rookie, DiDi has been New York's spark off the bench through her first 25 WNBA games. With the Liberty, DiDi has also knocked down 8 of 15 three-pointers at 53.3% (team-best and No. 1 amongst rookies) despite attempting just one three in four seasons at Baylor.

SAMI WHITCOMB MEDICAL UPDATE

Liberty shooting guard, **Sami Whitcomb**, injured her left ankle at the 2:12 mark in the fourth quarter of Sunday's game against the Los Angeles Sparks. Whitcomb underwent an MRI and clinical exam at Hospital for Special Surgery on Monday, August 23 which revealed the diagnosis of an ankle sprain.

The Liberty's medical staff determined Sami will be unavailable for 10-14 days. Further updates will be provided as appropriate.

Whitcomb, the WNBA's leading three-point shooter and a 2021 Most Improved Player Award candidate, is compiling a career-best season. She is averaging 12.8 points on 48.5% (112-231) shooting from the field, 44.2% (69-156) from three, 5.6 rebounds and 3.0 assists through her first 25 games with the Liberty.

"IF YOU DON'T KNOW B BY NOW..."

Potential MVP Candidate and first-time WNBA All-Star, **Betnijah Laney**, has combined for 466 points on 46.2% shooting for New York in the first 26 games of the season. Laney currently ranks third in the league in field goals made (178), ninth in points per game (17.9), and has eclipsed double-figure scoring in 23 of the first 26 contests. Similarly, Betnijah finished her 2020 WNBA Most Improved Player Award season totaling 13 of the last 14 games in double figures for the Dream.

MICHAELA ONYENWERE LEADING ROOKIE OF THE YEAR RACE

Liberty rookie, **Michaela Onyenwere**, was named the Kia WNBA Rookie of the Month for May and June. The No. 6 overall selection is leading all rookies in points per game (9.0), minutes per game (22.8), total field goals made (77), three pointers made (31), and blocks (9), while also sitting at No. 2 in total rebounds (70). Through her first 26 WNBA games, she is shooting 39.5% from the field, 32.0% from beyond the arc and 84.2% at the free throw line.

Earlier this season, Michaela became the first Liberty rookie to garner consecutive Rookie of the Month honors in franchise history since the award was instituted in 2010.



NEW LOOK LIBERTY

Through the first three games in 2021, the Liberty surpassed their 2020 win total (2-20). New York (11-15) is currently in third place in the Eastern Conference, and vying for a playoff spot as they're currently the No. 7 overall seed.

SEAFOAM SHARPSHOOTERS

The New York Liberty sit atop the WNBA across in nearly all three-point shooting categories. The Liberty rank No. 1 in total three-pointers made (271), triples per game (10.4-), attempts (736), and percentage of points from three (39.3%). New York also ranks No. 3 in effective field goal percentage (50.7%) and No. 5 in true shooting percentage (54.4%).

Also, **Sami Whitcomb** is currently first in the WNBA in three-point field goals made on the season (69).

SOMEONE SAY MVB?

Through the first 26 games of the 2021 season, **Betnijah Laney** is making an MVP case in her first year with the Liberty. Last season, Laney garnered the 2020 WNBA Most Improved Player Award with Atlanta after averaging 17.2 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 4.0 assists per contest, while shooting 48.1% from the field and 40.5% from beyond the arc.

To date, no WNBA player has garnered both the Most Improved Player and Most Valuable Player awards throughout their career. In the NBA, **Giannis Antetokounmpo** was the first recipient of the award to later become an MVP.

THREE-POINT HISTORY

On Sunday, August 22, the Liberty set the franchise record for most three-pointers made in a game with 16 (45.7%; 16-35). Last month on July 5, the Liberty broke the franchise record for three pointers made in a contest, connecting on 15-31 (43.8%).

FIRST TIME OLYMPIAN

Rebecca Allen represented Australia in the 2020 Tokyo Summer Olympics for the first time in her career. This season, Allen is averaging career-highs of 9.6 points, 1.6 steals, 1.2 blocks and 22.3 minutes through her first 19 games of 2021.

IN THIER OWN LANE(Y)

Betnijah Laney's basketball pedigree is well-documented, as her mother, Yolanda Laney, was an All-American guard at Cheney State for Coach C. Vivian Stringer. She led the team to two Final Fours, including a national championship appearance in 1982.



ASHLEY BATTLE RE-JOINS LIBERTY

On June 18, the Liberty announced that former player **Ashley Battle** has been named color analyst on YES Network, the official regional TV partner of the New York Liberty.

Former Liberty forward and defensive specialist (2006-2009), Battle will call game action alongside play-by-play announcer Chris Shearn.

JESS SIMS NAMED LIBERTY IN-ARENA CO-HOST

As part of the team's 25th anniversary season, the New York Liberty have named **Jess Sims** the official In-Arena Co-Host. The New York-based educator, fitness professional and Peloton Instructor will join co-host Jason Negron during select Liberty home games at Brooklyn's Barclays Center.

To begin the 2021 season, the New York Liberty have already garnered six awards, including:

SEASON 25: #OwnTheCrown

The New York Liberty are one of the WNBA's three remaining original franchises, joined by the Los Angeles Sparks and Phoenix Mercury. This season, the Liberty and WNBA are both celebrating their historic 25-Year Anniversary. To celebrate the team's monumental milestone, the Liberty will be using #OwnTheCrown throughout the 2021:

"The campaign pays homage to women who continue to break barriers like the women of the Liberty have done for the last 25 years. From on-and off-court legends, #Own-TheCrown will celebrate the journey of women who are vital to not only the history of the organization, but the overall empowerment of women, and the diverse culture of New York City." - Shana Stephenson, Liberty Vice President of Marketing

TRIPLE DOUBLE HISTORY

On May 18 against the Minnesota Lynx, **Sabrina Ionescu** posted the first triple-double in Liberty history with 26 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists. Ionescu recorded the 10th triple-double in the league's 25-year history (9th in regular season). She is the youngest player in WNBA history to ever do so, and just the ninth player all-time to accomplish the feat.



BROOKLYN VETS

The New York Liberty highlighted the WNBA's off-season transactions with the additions of veterans **Betnijah Laney**, **Natasha Howard** and **Sami Whitcomb**. They have each fought hard to overcome adversity and earn their spots as 3 of 144, and now begin the next chapter of their WNBA careers with the Liberty. Each player brings unique experience, high-level character, and championship pedigree to this New York Liberty roster.

THE FLASH IN NY

On February 8, the Liberty made a blockbuster trade to bring three-time WNBA Champion, **Natasha Howard** to New York from the Seattle Storm in exchange for the 2021 No. 1 overall draft pick.

The WNBA's 2019 Defensive Player of the Year, Natasha Howard (29) is a 6-2 forward who is entering her eighth WNBA season. Howard was drafted by the Indiana Fever in 2014 where she spent two seasons, followed by two years with the Minnesota Lynx. Howard won her first WNBA Championship (2017) alongside Liberty Head Coach Walt Hopkins in Minnesota. During her three-year tenure with the Seattle Storm, Howard secured two additional WNBA Championships (2018, 2020).

In Seattle's 2020 Championship season, Howard averaged 9.5 points and 7.1 rebounds per game while shooting 53.0% from the field during the regular season.

SAMI IN SEAFOAM

Fifth-year WNBA veteran, **Sami Whitcomb**, joined the Liberty after spending the past four seasons with the Seattle Storm.

Whitcomb (32), a 5-10 guard, came to New York after helping the Storm to two WNBA titles. In Seattle's 2020 championship season, Whitcomb averaged 8.1 points, 2.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game while shooting 38.1% from three, 44.3% from the field and 100% at the free throw line (22-22). The Ventura, Calif. native and Australia citizen signed as a free agent with the Storm in 2017 after competing professionally overseas for several seasons, most notably in Australia's WNBL.

BEC'S BACK

Sami Whitcomb will not be the only Australian sharpshooter bringing their talents to Brooklyn, as the Liberty have re-signed veteran forward **Rebecca Allen**. Allen, 28, re-joins the Liberty as the team's longest-tenured member (along with Kiah Stokes) after five seasons with New York. Rebecca, whose most recent season with the Liberty was in 2019, averaged a career-high 7.2 points per game on a team-best 42.6% shooting from three-point territory.



SOPHOMORE SZN

Just as New York was historically rookie-heavy in 2020, the team will be returning five sophomores to their roster this season: **Sabrina Ionescu, Jazmine Jones, Leaonna Odom, Kylee Shook**, and **Jocelyn Willoughby** (out for season).

2021 WNBA DRAFT

The New York Liberty enjoyed a successful 2021 WNBA Draft, as the front office was able to procure two first-round talents in **Michaela Onyenwere** and **DiDi Richards**.

Onyenwere, the Liberty's No. 6 overall pick, is a 6-0 forward. The Aurora, Colo. native averaged 19.1 points and 7.2 rebounds while shooting 42.1% in her senior campaign, leading UCLA to a Sweet Sixteen appearance. Michaela, a four-year letter winner with the Bruins, finished her collegiate career as the fourth overall leading scorer in program history (1,888 points).

Richards, New York's No. 17 overall selection, is a 6-2 guard/forward. DiDi averaged 6.3 points and 6.3 assists per game in the 2020-21 season while shooting 42.9% from the field, leading Baylor to a 28-3 finish and Final Four appearance. The Cypress, Texas native, known for her elite defensive ability, garnered the 2020 Naismith and WBCA Defensive Player of The Year Awards.

PLAYER TO COACH

On April 26, 2021, the Liberty announced the hiring of **Jacki Gemelos** as an assistant coach. Gemelos, 32, begins her first season as a WNBA coach after several seasons of service in the league. Jacki was a point guard for the Chicago Sky in 2015, and split time between the Connecticut Sun and Washington Mystics in 2020. Additionally, she has played six seasons overseas, and was a member of Greece's National Women's Basketball Team.

YES, PLEASE.

The Liberty's regional TV partner since 2019, will televise a record 19 New York Liberty games this season All of YES' 19 Liberty telecasts will also be streamed live on the YES App.

DIDI'S PERSERVERANCE

In October 2020, New York Liberty rookie, **DiDi Richards**, suffered a collision during practice at Baylor that left her temporarily paralyzed. Just 38 days later, Richards returned to the hardwood where she was able to lead the Lady Bears to an NCAA Final Four finish. In the same season, DiDi ranked second in the nation in total assists (189) while averaging 6.3 points and 6.3 assists during her senior campaign.

WITHOUT WILLOUGHBY

New York Liberty guard/forward **Jocelyn Willoughby** suffered a tear of her left Achilles' tendon during the team's scrimmage on May 3 at Connecticut. Willoughby underwent a successful surgical repair on May 5 at Hospital for Special Surgery (HSS). She will miss the 2021 season.



MADDIE PASSED THE TORCH TO ELLIE

As part of the 25th anniversary season, the New York Liberty announced a new mascot, Ellie the Elephant. Ellie, named after Ellis Island, is replacing Maddie, the team's mascot for the last 24 years.

Back story: Before the grand opening of the Brooklyn Bridge in 1883, there was speculation on the structural integrity of the bridge. To display its strength and safety, showman P.T. Barnum marched 21 elephants across the bridge. The PR stunt was a massive success, paving the way for one of New York's most iconic landmarks. Read more about Ellie here.

2021 NIKE JERSEYS

The new WNBA uniform system from Nike feature three game uniform editions for each of the 12 teams in the league, bringing stories from their cities and communities to life through the muse of female archetypes in storytelling and film: the WNBA Nike Heroine Edition, the WNBA Nike Explorer Edition and the WNBA Nike Rebel Edition.

Rebel Edition (Seafoam): Inspired by the striking colors of the city's iconic monument and all that it represents, the uniform features "Equality" across the chest, framed by copper and black taping.

Explorer Edition (Black): The uniform's speckled details represent the urban pavement while jagged, graphic details embody the toughness and eccentricity that defines true New Yorkers.

LIBS ABROAD

The New York Liberty's roster enjoyed a highly successful 2020-21 WNBA Off-Season competing overseas. **Bec Allen**, who played for Valencia Basket in Spain, helped lead the Orange to their first-ever EuroCup Championship win in club history. **Kiah Stokes** (Fenerbache) took home the gold in the Turkish League championships, and **Nastasha Howard** secured the Serie A1 Finals Championship with Reyer Venezia in Italy.

READ WHAT YOU SOW

Before the start of the new year, **Jocelyn Willoughby** announced the launch of her book club, *Read What You Sow*, in partnership with Brooklyn's Cafe con Libros Feminist Book Store. Read What You Sow explored the injustices disproportionately facing Black and Brown people within healthcare, education, and other social systems fundamental to the welfare of all people through the lens of womxn of color.

The club, which was comprised of Liberty fans, advocates, and educators, met bi-weekly for three months where they explored Brit Bennet's *The Vanishing Half*, *Pushout* by Dr. Monique Morris and *You'll Never Believe What Happened to Lacey: Crazy Stories about Racism* by Amber Ruffin and Lacey Lamar. Jocelyn led and moderated each conversation, and in addition, met with the authors of all three books on the Liberty's Instagram Live for one-on-one conversations.



WALT HOPKINS

The 2021 WNBA season is Walt Hopkins' second season as the New York Liberty's head coach.

On June 2, 2021, Hopkins was named the WNBA Coach of the Month for May. The honor is the first of Hopkins' career, after leading New York to one of its best starts in over a decade.

Prior to joining the Liberty, Hopkins served as an assistant coach for the Minnesota Lynx since 2017, where he helped accumulate a 63-39 record, three consecutive trips to the WNBA Playoffs and one WNBA Championship.

Hopkins has over a decade of experience as a basketball coach at the professional, collegiate, and high school levels. He specializes in: relationship building; providing nuanced individual skill development at every position, improving footwork and shot mechanics, creating and maintaining positive team culture via specific framing and communication strategies, and cultivating positive mindsets in players and coaches.

Prior to joining the Lynx staff, Hopkins served as Academic Coach at the University of California, Berkeley (2014-2016). He also served as the assistant women's basketball coach at Utah Valley University (2013-2014) and Director of Basketball Operations and Player Development Coach for the Tulsa Shock (2013).

Originally from Sparks, Nevada, Hopkins received his bachelor's degree at the University of Nevada-Reno. He also holds master's degrees from Harvard and UC Berkeley, where his studies focused primarily on applying findings from Social, Developmental and Educational Psychology to coaching settings.
