



LIBERTY VS. MERCURY QUICK HITS

Thursday's contest will mark the Liberty's third all-time postseason meeting against the Phoenix Mercury. The First-Round matchup will also mark New York's first playoff game since the 2017 season. With an all-time head-to-head postseason record of 1-1, and 28-28 in the regular season, New York and Phoenix are tied in both of their all-time series.

In the original franchises' first-ever playoff matchup on August 28, 1997, New York came out on top in the Valley by a score of 59-41. The Liberty were led by rookie **Rebecca Lobo**'s 16-point, nine-rebound performance and **Kym Hampton**'s double-double of 14 points and 14 rebounds.

Twenty seasons later, the Mercury evened the head-to-head playoff series with a 101-94 win over the Liberty in New York City. **Diana Taurasi** led the way for Phoenix with 30 points, followed by Brittney Griner's 22-point, 15-rebound double-double.

The Liberty and the Mercury last played on Friday, August 27 in Brooklyn, where Phoenix solidified the 2021 regular season series victory with an 80-64 win.

On Wednesday, August 25, the Mercury edged the Liberty at home 106-79.

The Liberty opened the season series with an 85-83 road victory at Footprint Center.

In the regular season series against the Mercury, the Liberty were led by 2021 WNBA All-Star, **Betnijah Laney**, who averaged 19.0 points, 7.0 assists and 5.7 rebounds per game.

The Mercury offense was paced by the combination of **Brittney Griner**, **Skylar Diggins-Smith** and **Diana Taurasi**, who averaged 27.5, 26.3 and 20.0 points against the Liberty, respectively. Griner also grabbed a series-high 11.5 rebounds per game.

Although New York has seven players making their playoff debuts, **Natasha Howard** and **Sami Whitcomb** bring robust postseason experience to the Liberty's rotation. Both players have reached postseason play in every season of their careers and have secured five combined WNBA Championships.

Former Liberty guard, **Kia Nurse**, will also make her playoff debut against New York. Nurse was a 2018 No. 10 overall selection of the Liberty, where she spent three seasons and averaged 11.5 points per game across 89 total contests, 59 of which she started.

Additionally, both **Kia Vaughn** (2009-12, 2017-18) and **Megan Walker** (2020) also spent time in Seafoam before moving to the Valley.



2021 PLAYOFF STORYLINES

BACK IN THE DANCE

The New York Liberty finished last season with only two wins and are now set to make their first postseason appearance since 2017. The team's 1,474-day playoff drought will come to an end on Thursday night in Phoenix when New York makes its 16th all-time appearance in the WNBA Playoffs.

NATASHA AND SAMI'S PLAYOFF STREAK

The Liberty's playoff berth continues **Natasha Howard** and **Sami Whitcomb**'s combined career playoff streak. Both players have reached postseason play in every season of their careers and have secured five combined WNBA Championships.

POSTSEASON RUBBER MATCH BETWEEN ORIGINAL FRANCHISES

Thursday's game will mark the third all-time postseason meeting between the Liberty and Mercury, both of whom are original WNBA franchises. The head-to-head series is split at one win apiece. New York won the first matchup in the Valley on August 28, 1997, 59-41, and twenty seasons later, Phoenix evened the series with a 101-94 road victory in New York City on September 24, 2016.

ANNIVERSARY SEASON MEETINGS

Five seasons since their last postseason matchup, and during both teams' 25th Anniversary seasons, the Liberty and Mercury will have the opportunity to take the lead in their postseason series.

The previous two matchups (2016, 1997) were played during the 20th Anniversary and Inaugural seasons of the WNBA.







LIBERTY IN THE VALLEY

Dating back to July 18, 2015, the New York Liberty are 5-3 (.625) in games played in Phoenix including an 85-83 win earlier this season. Over that span, New York has averaged 79.3 points per game, 6.9 points more than the all-time franchise average of 72.4. This season, the Mercury have a record of 7-9 at home compared to a 12-4 record while on the road.

PLAYOFF ROOKIES

The New York Liberty will feature seven players making their WNBA Playoff debuts on Thursday. Phoenix's **Kia Nurse** and **Megan Walker**, both former Liberty players, will also make their first-ever WNBA postseason appearances.



"IF YOU DON'T KNOW B BY NOW..."

First-time WNBA All-Star, **Betnijah Laney**, combined for 536 points on 45.1% shooting for New York through 32 games of the regular season. Laney ranks seventh in the league in field goals made (203), eighth in assists per game (5.2), tenth in points per game (16.8), and has eclipsed double figure scoring in 27 of 32 contests.

Betnijah finished the regular season as just the fourth player in WNBA history to finish the regular season averaging 16.7+ points, 5+ assists and 4+ rebounds, joining Cappie Pondexter (2009), Diana Taurasi (2013), and Candace Parker (2015).

TASH TIME

Liberty center, **Natasha Howard**, was named the Eastern Conference Player of the Week for games played from Monday, September 13, through Sunday, September 19 where she averaged 24.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, and 2.5 steals per game against Connecticut and Washington; including a 24-point, team-high 10-rebound double-double on 84.6% (11-13) shooting in New York's must-win game against Washington. The honor was Howard's fourth of her career, and first since July 22, 2019.

After returning to the Liberty frontcourt from injury, Howard posted averages of 16.5 points, 7.4 rebounds, and 1.6 assists per game through the 11-game second half.

SAB'S SECOND HALF

2020 No. 1 overall selection, **Sabrina Ionescu**, averaged 14.8 points, 6.2 assists, and 5.7 rebounds per game in the second half of her first full-season WNBA campaign. Over the 11-game span, lonescu reached double figure scoring in each contest which was highlighted by her 22-point performance in the Liberty's crucial win over the Mystics on September 17.

MICHAELA ONYENWERE LEADING ROOKIE OF THE YEAR RACE

Liberty rookie, **Michaela Onyenwere**, was named the Kia WNBA Rookie of the Month for May, June, August, and September; the first rookie in team history to do so. The sixth overall selection in the 2021 WNBA Draft led all rookies through the regular season in points per game (8.6), minutes per game (22.5), total field goals made (91), three pointers made (37), games played (32), and starts (29), while also sitting at No. 2 in total rebounds (94). Michaela shot 39.9% from the field, 32.7% from beyond the arc and 83.6% at the free throw line in her first WNBA campaign.



SAMI WHITCOMB'S MOST IMPROVED PLAYER CAMPAIGN

Sami Whitcomb, one of the WNBA's top three-point shooters and a 2021 Most Improved Player Award candidate, compiled a career-best season with New York. She averaged career highs of 11.7 points on 47.3% shooting from the field, 42.5%, 5.0 rebounds and 2.7 assists through her first 30 games with the Liberty. Sami finished No. 2 in the league in three-point field goals made with 76.

On September 17, Whitcomb scored her 1000th point and became the 230th player in WNBA history to do so.

BEC ALLEN'S DEFENSIVE PRESENCE

Liberty sharpshooter, Bec Allen, not only got it done on the offensive end with career-highs of 9.2 points, 1.1 assists, but she was also a defensive anchor for New York during the regular season. The team's leader in both steals (40) and blocks (31), Allen ranks fourth in steals per game (1.6) and first in blocks per game (1.3) leaguewide amongst guards. Her 2.8 stocks per game ranks third overall in the WNBA behind only Slyvia Fowles and Breanna Stewart.

DIDI FOR ALL-ROOKIE TEAM

DiDi Richards led all rookies during the regular season in three-point field goal percentage, shooting 45.5% (10-22) from distance despite attempting only one three in four seasons at Baylor. Additionally, Richards ranks second in games played (31), field goal percentage (42.1%), and steals (17), as well as third in assists (25) and blocks (5).

THREE-POINT HISTORY

Last game, the Liberty made WNBA history. New York's 321 three-point field goals made on the season ranks the most all-time, which was previously held by the 2019 WNBA Champion Washington Mystics (316).

On August 22, the Liberty set the franchise record for most three-pointers made in a game with 16 (45.7%; 16-35). Previously, on July 5, the Liberty broke the franchise record for three pointers made in a contest, connecting on 15-31 (43.8%).



NEW LOOK LIBERTY

Through the first three games in 2021, the Liberty surpassed their 2020 win total (2-20). New York, who finsihed the regular season 12-20, secured its first-ever postseason berth in over four years.

SEAFOAM SHARPSHOOTERS

The New York Liberty finished the regular season atop the WNBA across in nearly all three-point shooting categories. The Liberty rank No. 1 in total three-pointers made (321), triples per game (10.0), attempts (887), and percentage of points from three (38.4%). New York also ranks No. 3 in three-point field goal percentage (36.2%), and **Sami Whitcomb** finished No. 2 in the WNBA in three-point field goals made on the season (76).

IN THIER OWN LANE(Y)

Betnijah Laney's basketball pedigree is well-documented, as her mother, Yolanda Laney, was an All-American guard at Cheney State for Coach C. Vivian Stringer. She led the team to two Final Fours, including a national championship appearance in 1982

TRIPLE DOUBLE HISTORY

On May 18 against the Minnesota Lynx, **Sabrina Ionescu** posted the first triple-double in Liberty history with 26 points, 10 rebounds and 12 assists. Ionescu recorded the 10th triple-double in the league's 25-year history (9th in regular season). She is the youngest player in WNBA history to ever do so, and just the ninth player all-time to accomplish the feat.

SEASON 25: #OwnTheCrown

The New York Liberty are one of the WNBA's three remaining original franchises, joined by the Los Angeles Sparks and Phoenix Mercury. This season, the Liberty and WNBA are both celebrating their historic 25-Year Anniversary. To celebrate the team's monumental milestone, the Liberty will be using #OwnTheCrown throughout the 2021:

2021 WNBA DRAFT

The New York Liberty enjoyed a successful 2021 WNBA Draft, as the front office was able to procure two first-round talents in **Michaela Onyenwere** and **DiDi Richards**.

Onyenwere, the Liberty's No. 6 overall pick, is a 6-0 forward. The Aurora, Colo. native averaged 19.1 points and 7.2 rebounds while shooting 42.1% in her senior campaign, leading UCLA to a Sweet Sixteen appearance. Michaela, a four-year letter winner with the Bruins, finished her collegiate career as the fourth overall leading scorer in program history (1,888 points).

Richards, New York's No. 17 overall selection, is a 6-2 guard/forward. DiDi averaged 6.3 points and 6.3 assists per game in the 2020-21 season while shooting 42.9% from the field, leading Baylor to a 28-3 finish and Final Four appearance. The Cypress, Texas native, known for her elite defensive ability, garnered the 2020 Naismith and WBCA Defensive Player of The Year Awards.



BROOKLYN VETS

The New York Liberty highlighted the WNBA's off-season transactions with the additions of veterans **Betnijah Laney**, **Natasha Howard** and **Sami Whitcomb**. They have each fought hard to overcome adversity and earn their spots as 3 of 144, and have begun the next chapter of their WNBA careers with the Liberty. Each player brings unique experience, high-level character, and championship pedigree to this New York Liberty roster.

DIDI'S PERSERVERANCE

In October 2020, New York Liberty rookie, **DiDi Richards**, suffered a collision during practice at Baylor that left her temporarily paralyzed. Just 38 days later, Richards returned to the hardwood where she was able to lead the Lady Bears to an NCAA Final Four finish. In the same season, DiDi ranked second in the nation in total assists (189) while averaging 6.3 points and 6.3 assists during her senior campaign.

PLAYER TO COACH

On April 26, 2021, the Liberty announced the hiring of **Jacki Gemelos** as an assistant coach. Gemelos, 32, begins her first season as a WNBA coach after several seasons of service in the league. Jacki was a point guard for the Chicago Sky in 2015, and split time between the Connecticut Sun and Washington Mystics in 2020. Additionally, she has played six seasons overseas, and was a member of Greece's National Women's Basketball Team.

2021 NIKE JERSEYS

The new WNBA uniform system from Nike feature three game uniform editions for each of the 12 teams in the league, bringing stories from their cities and communities to life through the muse of female archetypes in storytelling and film: the WNBA Nike Heroine Edition, the WNBA Nike Explorer Edition and the WNBA Nike Rebel Edition.

Rebel Edition (Seafoam): Inspired by the striking colors of the city's iconic monument and all that it represents, the uniform features "Equality" across the chest, framed by copper and black taping.

Explorer Edition (Black): The uniform's speckled details represent the urban pavement while jagged, graphic details embody the toughness and eccentricity that defines true New Yorkers.



The 2021 WNBA season is Walt Hopkins' second season as the New York Liberty's head coach.

On June 2, 2021, Hopkins was named the WNBA Coach of the Month for May. The honor is the first of Hopkins' career, after leading New York to one of its best starts in over a decade.

Prior to joining the Liberty, Hopkins served as an assistant coach for the Minnesota Lynx since 2017, where he helped accumulate a 63-39 record, three consecutive trips to the WNBA Playoffs and one WNBA Championship.

Hopkins has over a decade of experience as a basketball coach at the professional, collegiate, and high school levels. He specializes in: relationship building; providing nuanced individual skill development at every position, improving footwork and shot mechanics, creating and maintaining positive team culture via specific framing and communication strategies, and cultivating positive mindsets in players and coaches.

Prior to joining the Lynx staff, Hopkins served as Academic Coach at the University of California, Berkeley (2014-2016). He also served as the assistant women's basketball coach at Utah Valley University (2013-2014) and Director of Basketball Operations and Player Development Coach for the Tulsa Shock (2013).

Originally from Sparks, Nevada, Hopkins received his bachelor's degree at the University of Nevada-Reno. He also holds master's degrees from Harvard and UC Berkeley, where his studies focused primarily on applying findings from Social, Developmental and Educational Psychology to coaching settings.
