MATCHUP QUICK HITS

This Friday, the New York Liberty will host the Phoenix Mercury for the final time in the 2025 regular season, in a marquee matchup between two of the WNBA's top three teams. New York enters the game ranked second with a 16-6 record, while Phoenix sits in third place at 15-8.

The Liberty are seeking its first win over the Mercury this season, having dropped both previous matchups—home and away—following Jonquel Jones' early exit in the second quarter of their June 19 meeting at Barclays Center.

New York has scored 98 points in each of its last two games, tying the longest streak in the WNBA this season. With another 98-point performance against Phoenix, the Liberty would match the league's all-time record.

Jones made her much-anticipated return on July 22 against Indiana, delivering a strong performance with 18 points (5-for-13 FG, 3-for-7 3PT, 5-for-5 FT) and nine assists. She opened the game by sinking a 22-foot three-pointer for the first field goal of the night.

Breanna Stewart added 17 points, six assists, and four rebounds, while matching her season high with three steals for the sixth time. In doing so, she became just the 45th player in WNBA history to reach 400 career steals. Stewart also surpassed Becky Hammon for 16th on the league's all-time scoring list with a career total of 5,850 points — reaching this mark in record time, in just 283 games.

Isabelle Harrison contributed a season-best 13 points (5-for-6 FG, 3-for-3 FT) in just 17 minutes.

From beyond the arc, Leonie Fiebich (24-46, 52.2%) and Kennedy Burke (38-77, 49.4%) continue to lead the WNBA in 3-point shooting percentage, ranking first and second, respectively, on the league leaderboard.

The Liberty lead the WNBA in points per game (87.4), threes made per game (10.1), 3-point percentage (35.3%), points off turnovers per game (18.3), and steals per game (8.8).

A Recap of New York's Historic 2024 Playoff Run

First Round Sweep

The New York Liberty's playoff path began with a best-of-three series against the Atlanta Dream. The Liberty swept Atlanta via back-toback wins at Barclays Center.

Game 1 was dominated by the Liberty, who were up by as much as 22 points and never relinquished their lead. Sabrina Ionescu and rookie Leonie Fiebich led the team in scoring, each putting up 25 points. Fiebich also became the first ever rookie with 4+ 3PM in a playoff game without a miss. Breanna Stewart put up a 24-11 double-double and got up for three blocks as the team held the Dream to shooting 18.8% from three.

Sweeping the series with a Game 2 win, New York grinded out a 9.1 net rating, with every starter finishing with a positive plus/minus. With a Sabrina Ionescu 36-point night, which tied the franchise's single-game playoff scoring record, and a Jonquel Jones 20-point, 13 rebound double-double, the Liberty fended off Atlanta's attempt to even the series.

Feeling Lucky in Las Vegas

In the 2024 Semifinals against the Las Vegas Aces, New York continued their defense of home court in the post season. With three players scoring in double figures, the Liberty powered past the Aces in Game 1. After a Jonquel Jones made three less than two minutes into the game to the final buzzer, New York held the lead in a wire-to-wire victory.

A Game 2 win featured every starter earning a defensive rating equal to or above 100.0. Sabrina Ionescu led the way with 24 points and nine rebounds.

Playing a second game in Michelob Ultra Arena after a Game 3 loss, the Liberty were determined to end the series with a Game 4 win. On the back of a Breanna Stewart double-double, the Liberty closed out the series with a resounding 14-point win.

A Finals Series for the Ages

New York's second Finals appearance in two years began with hosting the first two games in Barclays Center. After a Game 1 loss in overtime, the Liberty stormed through Game 2 to victory, shooting 45.8% from three and building up a lead by as much as 17 points. In the first two matchups, Jonquel Jones amassed a combined 38 points and 19 rebounds.

Hitting the road for Minnesota, the Liberty battled for a Game 3 win with Breanna Stewart racking up a 30-point double-double. Stewart, Betnijah Laney-Hamilton, Jonquel Jones, Sabrina Ionescu and Nyara Sabally combined for nine blocks, matching the franchise record for most blocks in a playoff game. Sabrina Ionescu called game, sinking a game-winning 28-foot 3-pointer with one second left on the shot clock.

A close Game 4 loss despite 21 points from Jones set the stage for the Game 5 face-off in Brooklyn with the series tied at 2-2. Leading the team, Jones scored 17 points and Stewart put up 3 blocks. Nyara Sabally and Leonie Fiebich combined for 26 points, including a key 5 points in overtime that guaranteed the New York Liberty their first WNBA title in franchise history and the city's first basketball title in over 50 years. Jonquel Jones was awarded the 2024 Finals Most Valuable Player award after tallying 89 points, 38 rebounds, 11 assists and 4 blocks in the series.

All Eyes on the Liberty

A New York Liberty attendance record was set when over 18,000 fans gathered in the arena to watch the Liberty bring New York its first professional basketball championship since 1973.

The Finals series averaged 1.6 million viewers, garnering the highest rating in 25 years. This mark was a 115% increase from the 2023 WNBA Finals. Games 3, 4 and 5 were the most watched WNBA Finals games that aired on cable. Viewership for Game 5 peaked at 3.3 million, with its television rating doubling the previous record for a Game 5 Finals matchup.

Canyon of Heroes History

Thousands upon thousands of fans showered the 2024 WNBA Champions with ticker tape and support as the New York Liberty's championship parade made its way down the renowned Canyon of Heroes. The Liberty joined New York sports history as they took the famous same path taken by winners of World Cups, Stanley Cups, Super Bowls and World Series titles.

A massive crowd of seafoam gathered for the first parade celebrating a NY professional sports team since the New York Giants' Super Bowl in 2012. The parade was followed by a ceremony at City Hall with the New York Liberty receiving the key to New York City.

On May 16, the Liberty had a permanent plaque installed and unveiled at 250 Broadway Street, commemorating their spot among this city's all-time legendary championship winning teams.



Reflecting the New York Liberty's commitment to excellence and honoring Brooklyn were at the forefront of the design process for renowned bespoke diamond jewelry creator, Jason of Beverly Hills and Brooklyn-based designers, Dynasty and Soull Ogun of L'Enchanteur. The championship celebrates one of the WNBA's original franchises winning their first-ever title, New York City's first professional basketball championship since 1973 and serves as a tribute to the spirit, core values and city that the franchise represents.





More than six carats of white diamonds reflect the six years of Joe and Clara Wu Tsai's ownership of the Liberty. Eleven black diamonds represent the team's 2024 playoff wins, while 32 points of black diamonds honor the Liberty's franchise-record tying 32 regular season wins as they became the first WNBA team to win 30+ games in back-to-back seasons. The single diamond in the trophy represents the New York Liberty's first WNBA title.



An image of a budding leaf breaking through a crack in the concrete pays homage to 'The Concrete Jungle' that the Liberty calls home while symbolizing the beginning of the Liberty's championship chapter. The 28 points of Paraiba in the leaf symbolize the team's 28 seasons in the WNBA. Each player's name and jersey number complete the shank's design.



The top of the championship ring unscrews to reveal a recreation of the New York Liberty court with the team's record in each playoff series in their title run. Underneath the ring's top are a pair of earrings, providing players with everyday jewelry to remind them of their historic win.

 - New York has outscored its opponents by 7.95 points per game, 0 second only to Minnesota's 10.24 ppg advantage. The team's total margin of victory is the second-best mark in Liberty history through 22 games.

 - Sabrina Ionescu claimed her second WNBA STARRY® 3-Point Contest title which is the second highest score in event history, behind only her record-s Allie Quigley (four titles) as the only players to win the contest multiple tim career win in the Kia WNBA Skills Challenge, marking just the second time a New York Liberty player has won the event. With both victories, New York joins Atlanta as the only franchises to sweep the 3-Point Contest and Skills Challenge in the same year.

RUNNING IT UP

- New York has won nine of its 22 contests by double figures, including five wins of at least 20 points.
 - The Liberty lead the league in 20+ point wins, with Lynx in second with four such wins.
 - See the chart for a look at the Liberty seasons with the most 20+ point wins.
- **FROM DISTANCE**: See the chart for a look at the most 3-pointers made by New York through its first 22 games of a season.
 - 0 The Liberty have made the second-most triples through 22 games in team history.
- **IUMPING AHEAD EARLY:** Out of 22 games, 11 of New York's first halves have ended with a tie or a Liberty lead this season. They have held double-digit leads at the break eight times and have led by 20 or more after the second quarter three times.
 - The Liberty had three halftime leads of at least 20 points three times *last regular season*. 0
- **CARE FOR THE ROCK**: New York ranks fourth in the WNBA in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.58).
 - The Liberty boast the second-highest assists per game mark (21.8) while turning the ball over just 13.6 times 0 per contest (fourth-lowest average in the league this season).
- LIBS ON DEFENSE: The Liberty's opponents average a -8.0 plus/minus, with only Minnesota's -10.2 +/- ahead of them.
 - New York has held its opponents to the third-lowest success rate from the field (41.2%, 29.0-for-70.5), close 0 behind Minnesota's 41.2% (27.6-for-67.0) and Golden State's 40.1% (26.5-for-66.2) opponent field goal percentage.
 - The team's 97.4 defensive rating is second in the WNBA this season following Minnesota's 94.5 defensive 0 rating.
 - Liberty opponents average just 9.0 fast break points per game, second to only the Mystics allowing 8.3 fast 0 break points per game.
- **CHECK IN, BALL OUT:** New York has one of the most impactful collection of reserve players in the WNBA. The Liberty's bench performance leads the league in field goal percentage (47.1%), 3-point percentage (39.8%), fast break points (4.1), and steals per game (3.0). They are in a close second-place in three made per game (3.3, PHX in first with 3.5) and average plus/minus (+1.7, MIN in first with +1.9).
 - New York's reserves have combined for 30+ points and 10+ rebounds six times in 2025 and lead the WNBA in such games. See the chart for teams with 30-10 bench performances
 - Shining on both ends of the court, the Liberty's bench has tallied the second-best net 0 rating in the league (3.2) with only Minnesota's 3.9 rating ahead of them.
 - The New York bench holds opponents to a -1.7 plus/minus rating with only 0 Minnesota's -1.9 rating allowed ranked above them.



Player Notes

- **<u>II DBL-DBLS</u>**: In her first performance after a nine-game injury absence on July 22, **Jonguel Jones** recorded 18 points (5-for-13 FG, 3-for-7 3FG, 5-for-5 FT) and nine rebounds in 22 minutes of play.
 - Since joining New York ahead of the 2023 season, Jones has tallied 28 double-doubles in the regular season, which is tied with Seattle's Nneka Ogwumike for seventh-most in the league over that span.
 - New York is a perfect 28-0 in regular season games where Jones notches a double-double.
 - She joins Vickie Johnson (4-0) and Kelsey Bone (2-0) as the only Liberty players who posted multiple doubledoubles with the team and an undefeated record.

SOPHMORE SZN: On June 16, Leonie Fiebich made her 40th career start (including the postseason). Following that victory, her win total reached 34 wins, the most of any WNBA player in her first 40 starts.

- Fiebich is shooting a league-leading 52.2% (24-for-46) from three, among qualified players. In her five-game FIBA Women's EuroBasket tournament run representing Germany, she shot 45.2% (14-for-31) from beyond the arc, the third highest success rate of players who attempted more than 25 threes. See the chart for how Fiebich's shooting ranks compared to her WNBA peers.
- Her 54.3% (19-for-35) success rate for above the break threes is the best of the WNBA (min. 30 such 3FGA).
- **KB FROM THREE**: Thus far in 2025, **Kennedy Burke** shot 38-of-77 (49.4%) from beyond the arc for the league's second-best 3-point success rate.
 - Burke has shot a league-best 48.4% (31-of-64) on above the break 3-pointers this season (min. 60 such 3FGA). She was 14-of-52 (26.9%) on those attempts all last season.
- **ON CLOUD NINE:** Natasha Cloud opened her Liberty career on 5/17 vs. the Las Vegas Aces and became the first WNBA player to record at least 22 points, six rebounds, and nine assists in her debut with a new franchise. Upon the conclusion of the first week of play, Cloud represented the Eastern Conference when she won her first-ever WNBA Player of the Week award.
 - This season, she has ascended the WNBA's ranks of all-time assists leaders and is currently sitting in eighth place with 1,645 dimes apiece.
 - Of players with at least 20 games under their belt this season, Cloud has the best assist/turnover ratio in the league (3.08) and the second-highest rate of assists per game (6.0). She is the only player ranked in the top five for both categories.
 - Cloud has tallied at least 20 points and five assists three times thus far in 2025. She is on track to surpass her current record of five such games in a season. See the chart for Cloud's history of 20point, five assist games.
 - Her back-to-back 20-point performances on 6/29 and 7/3 match her longest streak of consecutive 20-point games, previously set on 7/23 and 7/26/2023.

- **SA-THREE-NA:** On 6/5 against Washington, **Sabrina Ionescu** hit two 3-pointers to become the Libertv's all-time leading 3-point scorer with 429, surpassing Crystal Robinson's 400 3-point field goals. Her career total currently stands at 432 made 3-point shots.
 - With 53 made threes on the season thus far, Sabrina Ionescu has hit the fifth-most shots from deep in the league.
 - Of the players who have attempted at least 150 3-pointers, Ionescu leads the WNBA with a 31.7% success rate on 161 attempts.
 - The 5/29 contest against the Washington Mystics featured Ionescu hitting five 3-pointers in the first 0 half, matching her career high.
 - For the first time in her career, Ionescu has scored at least 30 points in consecutive games (6/14: 34 0 pts, 6/17: 34 pts). She is only the second Liberty player to do this after Breanna Stewart (8/28-30/2024) and the first WNBA player to do so since Atlanta's Rhyne Howard's three game streak in 2024 (9/3-8/2024). She joins Diana Taurasi (2006), Liz Cambage (2018) and Kahleah Copper (2024) as the only WNBA players to reach 34 points in back-to-back games.
 - In the three-game stretch from 7/3 to 7/8, Ionescu recorded at least 20 points, five rebounds and five assists in each game. This is the longest such streak in Liberty history and marks the secondlongest in WNBA history, one game shy of Caitlin Clark's four-game run from 7/17 - 8/24/2023.
 - Ionescu earned the WNBA's Eastern Conference Player of the Week award for July 3 July 13. This is the ninth time she has received this distinction.
 - On June 18, Ionescu won her second WNBA 3-Point Contest. Only Allie Quigley's four titles ranks above her.
- STEW YORK CITY: With 431 points on the season, Breanna Stewart is the league's fifth-leading total scorer. Her 494 efficiency rating gives her the same rank among qualified players.
 - Her 88 assists dished out through 22 games is the strongest start of her career.
 - Stewart is the only player averaging at least 19.0 points, 0 6.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists, and 1.0 blocks per game.
 - Since 2020, Stewart is the only WNBA player to hold a top 0 four WAR rating each season.
 - Over three games (6/14–19), Breanna Stewart scored at least 23 points in each contest. This 0 matches her longest such streak since joining the Liberty.
 - The longest such streak in Liberty history is four games, a mark achieved by Sabrina Ionescu (6/1-7/2022) and Tina Charles (5/29-6/7/2018, and 6/14-22/2016).

YEAR THREE SCORING SPREE

- Among the WNBA's leading scorers are Breanna Stewart (fourth, 19.6 ppg) and Sabrina Ionescu (eighth, 18.4 ppg). New York is the only team to have multiple players earn a top 10 ranking.
- Stewart and Ionescu have scored at least 20 points each in the same game three times this season. 0 The pair is on pace to record the most such games this season in their YEAR G
 - three years as teammates. Their current total of 14 is the most for any pair of teammates in Liberty history.
 - *See the chart for the number of Stewart, Ionescu 20+ points games in* each year of their partnership.
- So far in 2025, Breanna Stewart has logged 10 20-point games, and Sabrina Ionescu has nine such 0 performances. The high-scoring duo each tallied 16 such games during the 2024 regular season en route to a WNBA championship - and they're on pace to match or surpass that mark this year.

Career Milestones

- Sabrina Ionescu scored her first 31 points of the 2025 season by 5/24 against Indiana, surpassing Becky Hammon to become the Liberty's fourth all-time leading scorer. Similarly, on 6/5 against Washington, Breanna Stewart passed Tari Phillips to move into the No. 8 spot on New York's alltime scoring list after surpassing 131 points on the season.

- Natasha Cloud's first assist on 7/13 vs. Atlanta lifted her career total past Candace Parker (1,634). She sits in the No. 8 spot on the WNBA's all-time assist leaderboard

with 1,645 career dimes. In the June 16 matchup versus the Indiana Fever, Cloud recorded her 1,00th career rebound.

- With her first field goal attempt on July 6 vs. the Seattle Storm, Natasha Cloud hit her 300th career 3-pointer. She is only the 67th player in WNBA history to reach this milestone.
- Jonquel Jones has ascended on the WNBA's all-time leader in rebounds. After ten appearances in 2025, her career count totals 2,414 rebounds for the No. 22 spot. Jones is currently 18th on the WNBA's leaderboard for all-time offensive rebounds (709), tied with Lauren Jackson and Elizabeth Williams.
- With her 34-point performance in the 6/14 contest against Indiana, Ionescu reached the 2,500 milestone in 153 games. This makes her the third fastest Liberty player to achieve this feat, after Cappie Pondexter (130) and Tina Charles (133).
- This season, Breanna Stewart has reached 5,850 career points. She achieved the 5,500 point milestone in 266 games, which ties Diana Taurasi for the league's record for fastest to this mark. Stewart is the league's 11th leading defensive rebounder with 2,023 in her career. She surpassed Diana Taurasi's total of 1,970.
- **Stewart** and **Jones** have climbed the ranks of the Liberty's all-time leaders in blocks. Stewart's 142 blocks as a Liberty player ranks fifth behind Elena Baranova (147), and Jones' 112 swats is the eighth-most and one shy of Janel McCarville (113).
- On 6/19 against the Phoenix Mercury, Breanna Stewart racked up 35 points for the first time this season. It marked the 12th 35-plus-point game of her regular-season career, the third most in WNBA history. Las Vegas' A'ja Wilson holds second place with 13 and Diana Taurasi holds the all-time record with 14 such games.
 - Seven of Stewart's 35-point outings have come since she joined the Liberty in 2023. She is the only player in franchise history to record multiple 35-point games.
- Kennedy Burke had a career night against the Aces on 7/8 with a personal record of six steals and her first made triple bringing her career total to 100. Adding 10 points to the performance made Burke only the eighth player in Liberty history to log as many points and steals in the same game and the first to do so since Courtney Vandersloot's 9/3/2023 outing vs. Chicago.
- The 7/22 contest against the Indiana Fever gave **Sandy Brondello** her 96th win as the Liberty's head coach. She is now four victories away from 100 in her New York career and tying Richie Adubato for most regular season wins in franchise history.



Team Milestones

- The New York Liberty are off to the third-best start through 22 games in franchise's 29-year history (16-6), following only 2023's 17-5 start and 2024's 18-4 starting record. The Liberty are just the ninth team in WNBA history to begin a season 9-0.

 New York defeated Connecticut, 100-52, on 6/1 at Barclays Center. This 48point win marked the largest margin of victory in Liberty history, surpassing a 43-point win (88-45) over Washington on August 13, 1998. It is also the second-largest win in

league history, behind Minnesota's 111-52 victory over Indiana on August 18, 2017.

New York drilled 19 3-pointers on 5/22 at Chicago, setting a new single-game WNBA record,

before matching that total on 6/1 against Connecticut.

In the 7/13 79-72 win over the Atlanta Dream, New York completed the team's largest comeback of the season. After facing a 19-point deficit in the second quarter, the Liberty scored 48 points in the second half, matching the squad's second-highest 2025 scoring total in the last two quarters.



CHAMPIONSHIP DNA

Following their first-ever championship, the New York Liberty's 2025 roster will return players who accounted for 73.2% of the team's total minutes during the playoff run.

The two most frequently used lineups in that championship push posted plus-minus ratings of +3.9 and +9.0, respectively, and have returned all but one player for the start of the new season.

The Liberty also maintained a dominant home-court presence throughout the postseason, finishing with a 6–1 record at Barclays Center.

THE HOTTEST TICKET IN TOWN

The New York Liberty's rise to the top of the WNBA has been matched by a surge in fan support at Barclays Center. From 2023 to 2024, home game attendance increased by more than 63%, with the 2024 season averaging over 12,500 fans per game - one of the highest marks in the league.

That momentum carried into the postseason, where the Liberty earned the distinction of playing back-to-back WNBA Finals series at Barclays Center. In the 2023 Finals against the Las Vegas Aces, games in Brooklyn drew an average of 16,997 fans. The following year, as the Liberty battled the Minnesota Lynx en route to their first championship, that number climbed even higher - an average of 17,956 fans packed the arena for the 2024 Finals.

The crescendo came on October 20, 2024, when a franchise-record crowd of 18,090 filled Barclays Center to witness history. In a thrilling Game 5, the Liberty clinched their first-ever WNBA Championship, capping off a season defined by excellence on the court and unprecedented support in the stands.

THE WIZARD'S RETURN

While **Marine Johannès'** creative passing often defies measurement, her shooting ability is welldocumented. Her career 3-point percentage of 38.8% ranks ninth among active WNBA players with at least 50 made threes.

Johannès was a strong contender for the 2023 Sixth Player of the Year award, making impactful contributions off the bench and as a starter. In games she started, she averaged 10.6 points, including a team-high 18-point performance against the Atlanta Dream.

In 2024, national team duties called Johannès back to France, where she helped lead her country to a silver medal in the Olympic Games. She scored 24 points in a key win over Germany, propelling France into the final matchup against Team USA.



CLOUDY DAYS ARE HERE

The recent WNBA offseason brought a flurry of roster moves, including the high-profile addition of **Natasha Cloud** to the New York Liberty.

In 26 of her 38 starts last season, Cloud recorded at least 10 assists—eight of those performances resulting in double-doubles.

Her 2024 campaign was filled with standout achievements, including a career-high 31-point game. She finished the season ranked in the top four in assists, top 10 in minutes played, and earned a spot on the WNBA All-Defensive Second Team.

IZZY SZN

The Liberty continued to bolster their roster in the offseason with the addition of forward **Isabelle Harrison**, who is coming off a career-best defensive season with the Chicago Sky.

Harrison posted a defensive rating of 104.8 while averaging 16.3 minutes per game. She also recorded her best assist-to-turnover ratio in six years (0.69). One of her standout performances came at Barclays Center, where she grabbed a career-high 11 defensive rebounds against the Liberty.

BEK IS BACK

Acquired by the New York Liberty in 2024, **Rebekah Gardner** is set to make her debut in seafoam this season.

Gardner made an immediate impact in her 2022 WNBA debut, earning All-Rookie Team honors and finishing with a top-eight field goal percentage of 54.2%. During her two seasons with the Chicago Sky, she posted offensive ratings of 101.4 in 2022 and 94.2 in 2023.

SABRINA/STEWART SCORING SPREE

During the Liberty's championship season, **Sabrina Ionescu** and **Breanna Stewart** continued their ascent in the franchise's all-time scoring ranks, with both now firmly established in the top ten.

Following her stellar 2024 campaign, Stewart now leads the Liberty all-time in career scoring average at 21.3 points per game. She scored 20 or more points in 16 of her 38 regular-season appearances. Ionescu, meanwhile, rounds out the top five in franchise history with a career scoring average of 16.6 points per game.

Sixteen proved to be a shared milestone, as Ionescu also recorded 16 games with 20+ points. Her 2024 season ranks among the top three single-season three-point shooting performances in WNBA history—surpassed only by Diana Taurasi in 2006 and her own record-setting total in 2023.



BLOCK PARTY IN BROOKLYN

2024 Finals MVP **Jonquel Jones** and **Breanna Stewart** formed a dominant defensive duo, both ranking in the top six in total blocks across the league—Jones with 50 and Stewart with 48. Each averaged 1.3 blocks per game, earning spots on the Liberty's all-time playoff blocks leaderboard with 7 and 19, respectively.

Jones led the team in total blocks and finished among the league's top four in the category, showcasing her elite rim protection throughout the season.

Stewart, meanwhile, set franchise records for blocks in both a regular-season game (6) and a playoff game (4), the latter coming in Game 3 of the 2024 WNBA Finals.

PHENOMENAL FIEBICH

Leonie Fiebich enters the 2025 WNBA season fresh off a championship run with Valencia Basket Club in Spain's LF Endesa.

Her rookie campaign with the New York Liberty was equally impressive. Fiebich earned a spot on the 2024 WNBA All-Rookie Team and played a key role in the Liberty's title-winning season. She finished second in voting for the 2024 Sixth Player of the Year Award—the highest placement by a rookie since 2009.

Among the 26 first-year players in 2024, only five appeared in all 40 regular-season games. Fiebich was one of them, and she led that group in scoring efficiency, topping the charts in field goal percentage (47.8%), effective field goal percentage (62.4%), and true shooting percentage (62.4%).

Her 3-point shooting was historic. Fiebich's 43.3% from beyond the arc and her +279 single-season plus/minus both rank second all-time among WNBA rookies. Her career 3-point percentage of 44.1% leads all active players with at least 50 made threes.

Fiebich's postseason performance further cemented her place in the record books. She scored 128 points during her first playoff run—the second-most ever by a WNBA rookie. Over 11 games, she knocked down 25 three-pointers, becoming the third-fastest player in league history to reach that mark in the postseason. In Game 1 of the WNBA Finals, she hit five threes, becoming the first rookie to do so in a Finals game.

Sandy Brondello led the Phoenix Mercury for eight years (2014-2021), the franchise's longest head coaching tenure, and made the playoffs each year, including a fruitful run to the WNBA Championship in 2014. The 2014 season also brought her the WNBA Coach of the Year Award, both the franchise's and her first time winning the award. In her eight years, Brondello totaled 150 victories in the regular season and 24 in the postseason, both records for the franchise. In the 2024 Olympics, Brondello coached Phoenix guard Sami Whitcomb for the Australian Opals. Whitcomb played for the New York Liberty from 2021 to 2022. Isabelle Harrison was selected by the Phoenix Mercury in the 2015 WNBA Draft with the 12th overall pick and remained with the team through the 2016 season. The Phoenix Mercury drafted Stephanie Talbot with the 33rd overall pick in the 2014 WNBA Draft. In 2017, she made her WNBA debut with the team and remained with them through the 2018 season. Natasha Cloud played for the Mercury in 2024. Mercury forward Satou Sabally, sister of Nyara Sabally, has many ties with Liberty players. She shared the court at the University of Oregon with New York's Sabally (2019-2020) and Sabrina Ionescu (2017-2020). Phoenix's Sabally teamed up with Ionescu and Natasha Cloud in the 2025 Unrivaled season for Phantom Basketball Club. The Sabally sisters and Leonie Fiebich represented Germany in the 2024 Olympics. Sabally and Izzy Harrison played for the Dallas Wings for two years (2020-22). The University of Maryland's 2010-11 women's basketball program featured Cloud and Mercury forward Alyssa Thomas. Cloud was also teammates with Phoenix guard/forward Kahleah Copper on the 2016 Washington Mystics. Copper was part of the 2021 Chicago Sky squad that Olaf Lange helped lead to a WNBA Championship. Thomas teamed up with Jonquel Jones as part of the Connecticut Sun organization from 2016 to 2022. Thomas was a member of 2025 Unrivaled's Laces Basketball Club, coached by Andrew Wade.

Sandy Brondello

Head Coach – 2 Time WNBA Champion (2014, 2024)



Veteran WNBA coach, player, and former Australian Olympian Sandy Brondello was named the ninth head coach in Liberty franchise history in January 2022. Brondello joined New York after an eight-year head coaching tenure with the Phoenix Mercury where she led the team to a playoff appearance in each of her eight seasons. A two-time WNBA Champion head coach, Brondello holds an overall regular season record of 244-164 (.598) over her 12 combined seasons at the helm of the New York Liberty, Phoenix Mercury and San Antonio Silver Stars - making her the sixth-winningest coach in WNBA history.

Additionally, Brondello has compiled a 39-30 postseason record throughout her head coaching career, ranking her as the second-winningest coach in league postseason history. In 2014, Sandy was named the WNBA Coach of the Year after she led Phoenix to a WNBA regular season-record 29 wins and capped the season with a WNBA Championship. In 2023, Brondello led the Liberty to the Commissioner's Cup Championship and first WNBA Finals appearance since 2002. Brondello made history in 2024 after leading the New York Liberty to its first WNBA Championship in franchise history and

the city's first professional basketball championship since 1973.

A 20-year veteran of the WNBA coaching ranks, Brondello has been affiliated with the league for 25 of its 28 seasons, including her time as a player. A proven winner internationally and in the WNBA, her 20 total years as an assistant coach and head coach have featured 17 playoff appearances, highlighted by a perfect 12-for-12 in postseason berths as a head coach.

In those 12 postseasons, Sandy led her teams to nine Semifinals round berths (formerly conference finals) and four WNBA Finals appearances in 2014, 2021, 2023, 2024 - including two titles. Prior to her time with the Mercury, Brondello served as lead assistant coach for the Los Angeles Sparks (2011-13) under 2012 WNBA Coach of the Year Carol Ross. Brondello led the San Antonio Silver Stars to a 2010 playoff berth in her debut season at the helm following five seasons on the Silver Stars bench as an assistant under Dan Hughes (2005-09), the fifth-winningest coach in league history.

A 2010 inductee into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame, Brondello was named the 11th head coach for the Australian Women's National Basketball team on April 17, 2017. Brondello led the Australian National Team to a Bronze medal in the Paris Olympics Games, and most recently, re-signed with the Opals for the 2028 Los Angeles Summer Olympics. In addition to her work internationally with the Australian Women's National Basketball team, Brondello previously served as an assistant coach with UMMC Ekaterinburg in Russia from 2012-2017.

Brondello finished a stellar 17-year professional playing career with a five-year run in the WNBA in which she played for Detroit (1998-99), Miami (2001-02) and Seattle (2003), and was named a 1999 WNBA All-Star. She began her career with the Women's National Basketball League (WNBL) in Australia (1986-96) and was named the league MVP in 1995. The 5-7 guard was a 10-time German Cup champion while playing with BTV Wuppertal (1992-2002), a three-time European Cup All-Star selection (1994, 1996, 1997), and the 1996 European Cup MVP when she led her team to the title.

An 18-year member of the Australian National Team, Brondello is a four-time Olympian, a two-time silver medalist (2000, 2004) and was named the 1992 Australian International Player of the Year.

Brondello is married to Liberty assistant coach, Olaf Lange, and the couple have two children, Brody and Javda.
