The New York Liberty will host the Seattle Storm for the first time this season on Sunday afternoon at Barclays Center.

New York aims to extend its four-game home winning streak against Seattle, a run that began with an 80-76 victory on July 8, 2023. This marks the Liberty's second-longest home win streak in the all-time series, trailing only a six-game stretch from Aug. 9, 2011, to July 6, 2016.

The teams last met on June 22 in Seattle without Sabrina Ionescu, Leonie Fiebich, and Jonquel Jones. Despite an 89-79 loss, **Breanna Stewart** led the Liberty with 18 points (6-for-14 FG, 6-for-7 FT) and nine rebounds. It was the 25th time she led the team in both categories, including playoff games, tying her with Tari Phillips for the second-most such performances in franchise history.

In addition to **Stewart** and **Sabrina lonescu** being named starters for the 2025 AT&T WNBA All-Star Game, Liberty head coach **Sandy Brondello** will lead Team Collier in the contest. Brondello earned the honor as New York holds the league's second-best winning percentage (.706).

Brondello reached a milestone on July 3, tying Bill Laimbeer for the second-most regular-season wins in franchise history (92) following an 89-79 victory over the Los Angeles Sparks. She achieved the mark in just 133 games, giving her a .692 winning percentage, the highest of any Liberty head coach. Eight more wins would bring her total to 100, matching Richie Adubato.

Two Liberty players rank among the WNBA's top four in 3-point shooting percentage. **Kennedy Burke** leads the league at 50.8% (33-for-65), while **Leonie Fiebich** ranks fourth at 46.4% (13-for-28), among qualified players.

On Sunday, Natasha Cloud has a chance to reach two career milestones: 300 made 3-pointers and eighth place on the WNBA's list of alltime assists leaders. She will achieve both with one 3-pointer and two assists to surpass Candace Parker (1,634 assists) and move into the No. 8 spot.

A Recap of New York's Historic 2024 Playoff Run

First Round Sweep

The New York Liberty's playoff path began with a best-of-three series against the Atlanta Dream. The Liberty swept Atlanta via back-toback wins at Barclays Center.

Game 1 was dominated by the Liberty, who were up by as much as 22 points and never relinquished their lead. Sabrina Ionescu and rookie Leonie Fiebich led the team in scoring, each putting up 25 points. Fiebich also became the first ever rookie with 4+ 3PM in a playoff game without a miss. Breanna Stewart put up a 24-11 double-double and got up for three blocks as the team held the Dream to shooting 18.8% from three.

Sweeping the series with a Game 2 win, New York grinded out a 9.1 net rating, with every starter finishing with a positive plus/minus. With a Sabrina Ionescu 36-point night, which tied the franchise's single-game playoff scoring record, and a Jonquel Jones 20-point, 13 rebound double-double, the Liberty fended off Atlanta's attempt to even the series.

Feeling Lucky in Las Vegas

In the 2024 Semifinals against the Las Vegas Aces, New York continued their defense of home court in the post season. With three players scoring in double figures, the Liberty powered past the Aces in Game 1. After a Jonquel Jones made three less than two minutes into the game to the final buzzer, New York held the lead in a wire-to-wire victory.

A Game 2 win featured every starter earning a defensive rating equal to or above 100.0. Sabrina Ionescu led the way with 24 points and nine rebounds.

Playing a second game in Michelob Ultra Arena after a Game 3 loss, the Liberty were determined to end the series with a Game 4 win. On the back of a Breanna Stewart double-double, the Liberty closed out the series with a resounding 14-point win.

A Finals Series for the Ages

New York's second Finals appearance in two years began with hosting the first two games in Barclays Center. After a Game 1 loss in overtime, the Liberty stormed through Game 2 to victory, shooting 45.8% from three and building up a lead by as much as 17 points. In the first two matchups, Jonquel Jones amassed a combined 38 points and 19 rebounds.

Hitting the road for Minnesota, the Liberty battled for a Game 3 win with Breanna Stewart racking up a 30-point double-double. Stewart, Betnijah Laney-Hamilton, Jonquel Jones, Sabrina Ionescu and Nyara Sabally combined for nine blocks, matching the franchise record for most blocks in a playoff game. Sabrina Ionescu called game, sinking a game-winning 28-foot 3-pointer with one second left on the shot clock.

A close Game 4 loss despite 21 points from Jones set the stage for the Game 5 face-off in Brooklyn with the series tied at 2-2. Leading the team, Jones scored 17 points and Stewart put up 3 blocks. Nyara Sabally and Leonie Fiebich combined for 26 points, including a key 5 points in overtime that guaranteed the New York Liberty their first WNBA title in franchise history and the city's first basketball title in over 50 years. Jonquel Jones was awarded the 2024 Finals Most Valuable Player award after tallying 89 points, 38 rebounds, 11 assists and 4 blocks in the series.

All Eyes on the Liberty

A New York Liberty attendance record was set when over 18,000 fans gathered in the arena to watch the Liberty bring New York its first professional basketball championship since 1973.

The Finals series averaged 1.6 million viewers, garnering the highest rating in 25 years. This mark was a 115% increase from the 2023 WNBA Finals. Games 3, 4 and 5 were the most watched WNBA Finals games that aired on cable. Viewership for Game 5 peaked at 3.3 million, with its television rating doubling the previous record for a Game 5 Finals matchup.

Canyon of Heroes History

Thousands upon thousands of fans showered the 2024 WNBA Champions with ticker tape and support as the New York Liberty's championship parade made its way down the renowned Canyon of Heroes. The Liberty joined New York sports history as they took the famous same path taken by winners of World Cups, Stanley Cups, Super Bowls and World Series titles.

A massive crowd of seafoam gathered for the first parade celebrating a NY professional sports team since the New York Giants' Super Bowl in 2012. The parade was followed by a ceremony at City Hall with the New York Liberty receiving the key to New York City.

On May 16, the Liberty had a permanent plaque installed and unveiled at 250 Broadway Street, commemorating their spot among this city's all-time legendary championship winning teams.



Reflecting the New York Liberty's commitment to excellence and honoring Brooklyn were at the forefront of the design process for renowned bespoke diamond jewelry creator, Jason of Beverly Hills and Brooklyn-based designers, Dynasty and Soull Ogun of L'Enchanteur. The championship celebrates one of the WNBA's original franchises winning their first-ever title, New York City's first professional basketball championship since 1973 and serves as a tribute to the spirit, core values and city that the franchise represents.





More than six carats of white diamonds reflect the six years of Joe and Clara Wu Tsai's ownership of the Liberty. Eleven black diamonds represent the team's 2024 playoff wins, while 32 points of black diamonds honor the Liberty's franchise-record tying 32 regular season wins as they became the first WNBA team to win 30+ games in back-to-back seasons. The single diamond in the trophy represents the New York Liberty's first WNBA title.



An image of a budding leaf breaking through a crack in the concrete pays homage to 'The Concrete Jungle' that the Liberty calls home while symbolizing the beginning of the Liberty's championship chapter. The 28 points of Paraiba in the leaf symbolize the team's 28 seasons in the WNBA. Each player's name and jersey number complete the shank's design.



The top of the championship ring unscrews to reveal a recreation of the New York Liberty court with the team's record in each playoff series in their title run. Underneath the ring's top are a pair of earrings, providing players with everyday jewelry to remind them of their historic win.

- **TOP OF THE CHARTS**: The Liberty leads the WNBA in various categories this season, including points per game (87.6), pace (97.76), and true shooting percentage (58.2%).
 - New York has outscored its opponents by 7.82 points per game, second only to Minnesota's 11.53 ppg advantage. The team's total margin of victory is the second-best mark in Liberty history to start a season.
 - See the chart for a look at the best total point differential through the first 17 games in franchise history.
 - With Sabrina Ionescu and Breanna Stewart named starters for the 2025 AT&T WNBA All-Star Game, this marks the 15th season in which multiple New York Liberty players have earned All-Star honors. Only the Connecticut Sun, with 16 such seasons, have achieved this more often in WNBA history. This season, the Indiana Fever were the only other team with more than one player named to the pool of All-Star starters (Aliyah Boston, Caitlin Clark).

RUNNING IT UP

- New York has won seven of its 17 contests by double figures, including four wins of at least 20 points.
 - The Liberty lead the league in 20+ point wins, with the Valkyries, Fever and Lynx tied for second with three such wins.

- **FROM DISTANCE**: See the chart for a look at the most 3-pointers made by a WNBA team through its first 17 games of a season.
 - The Liberty have made the fourth-most triples through 17 games in team history.
- <u>JUMPING AHEAD EARLY</u>: Out of 17 games, 10 of New York's first halves have ended with a tie or a Liberty lead this season. They have held double-digit leads at the break seven times and have led by 20 or more after the second quarter three times.
 - The Liberty had three halftime leads of at least 20 points three times *last regular season*.
- **CARE FOR THE ROCK**: New York ranks fourth in the WNBA in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.53).
 - The Liberty boast the third-highest assists per game mark (21.3) while turning the ball over just 13.9 times per contest (fourth-lowest average in the league this season).
 - Through 17 games, New York has averaged 8.9 steals per game, second to only Phoenix's 8.9 steals per game in 18 games.
- LIBS ON DEFENSE: The Liberty's opponents average a -7.8 plus/minus, second to only Minnesota's -11.5.
 - New York has held its opponents to a third-lowest success rate from the field (41.4%, 29.4-for-70.9), close behind Golden State's 39.3% and Minnesota's 40.1% opponent field goal percentage.
 - The team's 97.8 defensive rating through the first 17 games is the franchise's fourth-best mark since 2015 and is third in the WNBA this season following Minnesota's 93.7 and Golden State's 96.8 defensive ratings.
 - Liberty opponents average just 14.5 points off turnovers per game, second to only the Dream allowing 12.9 points off turnovers per game.

• Her back-to-back 20-point performances on 6/29 and 7/3 match her longest streak of consecutive 20-point games, previously set on 7/23 and 7/26/2023.

Player Notes

- **<u>II DBL-DBLS</u>**: **Jonquel Jones** recorded 10 points (4-of-10 FG, 2-of-4 3FG) and 10 rebounds in 25:29 minutes against Atlanta on 6/17, marking her sixth double-double this season.
 - She and Las Vegas' A'ja Wilson are tied for the third-most double-doubles in the league this season. Only Chicago's Angel Reese (10), Atlanta's Brionna Jones (8), Indiana's Aliyah Boston and Phoenix's Alyssa Thomas (7 each) have totaled more.
 - Since joining New York ahead of the 2023 season, Jones has tallied 28 double-doubles in the regular season, which is seventh-most in the league over that span.
 - New York is a perfect 28-0 in regular season games where Jones notches a double-double.
 - She joins Vickie Johnson (4-0) and Kelsey Bone (2-0) as the only Liberty players who posted multiple doubledoubles with the team and an undefeated record.

- KB FROM THREE: Through 17 games this season, Kennedy Burke has shot 33-of-65 from beyond the arc for a league-leading 50.8% 3-point success rate. *See the chart for a* STAT % RANK look at where KB's shooting marks rank among qualified players this season 3FG % 50.8 1st
 - Burke has shot a league-best 50.0% (27-of-54) on above the break 3-pointers this season (min. 40 such 3FGA). She was 14-of-52 (26.9%) on those attempts all last season.
- **SOPHMORE SZN:** Just six games into her second season, **Leonie Fiebich** has set a career-high in blocks (3) and matched her career-high in rebounds (9).
 - Fiebich's 3-point percentage (46.4%, 13-for-28) currently ranks fourth among qualified players. In her five-game FIBA Women's EuroBasket tournament run representing Germany, she shot 45.2% (14-for-31) from beyond the arc, the third highest success rate of players who attempted more than 25 threes.
 - Her 50.0% (9-18) success rate for above the break threes is tied for first in the league (min. 10 such 3FGA) with teammate Kennedy Burke, Golden State's Cecilia Zandalasini (8-for-16) and Dallas' IJ Quinerly (5-for-10).
- **ON CLOUD NINE:** Natasha Cloud opened her Liberty career on 5/17 vs. the Las Vegas Aces and became the first WNBA player to record at least 22 points, six rebounds, and nine assists in a franchise debut.
 - o This season, she has ascended up the WNBA's ranks of all-time assists leaders and with her next assist she will tie Candance Parker (1,634) for eighth on the leaderboard.
 - Of players with at least 10 games under their belt this season, Cloud has the best assist/turnover ratio in the league (3.17) and the second-highest rate of assists per game (6.5). Phoenix's Alyssa Thomas (ast/tov: third, 3.05; apg: first, 9.4) is the only other player ranked in the top five for both those categories.
 - Cloud has tallied at least 20 points and five assists three times thus far in 2025. She is on track to surpass her current record of five such games in a season. See the chart for Cloud's history of 20point, five assist games.

- <u>SA-THREE-NA</u>: On 6/5 against Washington, Sabrina Ionescu hit two 3-pointers to become the Liberty's all-time leading 3-point scorer with 401, surpassing Crystal Robinson's 400 3-point field goals. Her career total currently stands at 420 made 3-point shots.
 - With 41 made threes on the season thus far, Sabrina Ionescu has hit the third-most shots from deep in the league.
 - Of the four players who have attempted at least 120 3-pointers, Ionescu leads the WNBA with a 32.8% success rate on 125 attempts.
 - The 5/29 contest against the Washington Mystics featured Ionescu hitting five 3-pointers in the first half, matching her career high.
 - For the first time in her career, Ionescu has scored at least 30 points in consecutive games (6/14: 34 pts, 6/17: 34 pts). She is only the second Liberty player to do this after Breanna Stewart (8/28-30/2024) and the first WNBA player to do so since Atlanta's Rhyne Howard's three game streak in 2024 (9/3-8/2024). She joins Diana Taurasi (2006), Liz Cambage (2018) and Kahleah Copper (2024) as the only WNBA players to reach 34 points in back-to-back games.
 - In Ionescu's first WNBA game in her native Bay Area, on 6/25 vs. Golden State, she went 8-for-8 on free throws. That marked her eighth game with a perfect free throw shooting record on at least eight attempts, the most such games in franchise history.

STEW YORK CITY:

With 349 points on the season, Breanna Stewart is the league's leading total scorer. Her 50% (118-236) field goal percentage through 17 games is second only to her 53.7% (137-255) FG% en route to her first MVP Award and WNBA

Championship in 2018.

 Stewart is one of only three players averaging at least 20.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 1.0 blocks per game.

- Over three games (6/14–19), Breanna Stewart scored at least 23 points in each contest. This matches her longest such streak since joining the Liberty.
 - The longest such streak in Liberty history is four games, a mark achieved by Sabrina Ionescu (6/1–7/2022) and Tina Charles (5/29–6/7/2018, and 6/14–22/2016).

<u>YEAR THREE SCORING SPREE</u>

- Breanna Stewart (21.8 ppg) and Sabrina Ionescu (19.1 ppg) were among the WNBA's top ten leaders in scoring for the month of June, ranking second and sixth, respectively. New York was the only team with multiple players in the top five.
 Stewart and Ionescu have scored at least 20 points each in the same game

Similarly, on 6/5 against Washington, Breanna Stewart passed Essence Carson to move into the No. 9 spot on New York's all-time scoring list after surpassing 131 points on the season.

- Jonquel Jones ascended to No. 20 on the WNBA's all-time leader in rebounds. After nine appearances in 2025, her career count totals 2,405 rebounds. With 40 more boards, she'll pass Yolanda Griffin for the No. 19 ranking. Jones is currently 21st on the WNBA's leaderboard for all-time offensive rebounds (707). With three more offensive boards, she'll leap over Tammy Sutton-Browne, Michelle Snow (tied at 19th with 708) and Lauren Jackson (18th with 709) for the No. 18 spot.
- With her 34-point performance in the 6/14 contest against Indiana, Ionescu reached the 2,500 milestone in 153 games. This makes her the third fastest Liberty player to achieve this feat, after Cappie Pondexter (130) and Tina Charles (133).
- This season, Breanna Stewart has reached 5,768 career points. She achieved the 5,500 point milestone in 266 games, which ties Diana Taurasi for the league's record for fastest to this mark. Stewart is the league's 11th leading defensive rebounder with 1,997 in her career. She surpassed Diana Taurasi's total of 1,970.
- **Stewart** and **Jones** have climbed the ranks of the Liberty's all-time leaders in blocks. Stewart's 131 blocks as a Liberty player ranks sixth behind Shameka Christon (133), and Jones' 110 swats is the ninth most, tied with Rebecca Allen and three shy of Janel McCarville (113).
- On 6/19 against the Phoenix Mercury, Breanna Stewart racked up 35 points for the first time this season. It marked the 12th 35-plus-point game of her regular-season career, tying her with Las Vegas' A'ja Wilson for second-most in WNBA history. The duo trails only Diana Taurasi, who holds the all-time record with 14 such games.
 - Seven of Stewart's 35-point outings have come since she joined the Liberty in 2023. She is the only player in franchise history to record multiple 35-point games.
- **Stewart's** 10 rebound performance on 6/25 against the Valkyries brought her Liberty rebound total to 776, moving her past Jonquel Jones (772) to seventh on New York's all-time leaderboard.

CHAMPIONSHIP DNA

After bringing home the franchise's first championship, the New York Liberty's 2025 roster will include players responsible for 73.2% of the minutes in the team's playoff run.

The two lineups most used in the championship pursuit posted plus/minus ratings of +3.9 and +9.0 and will return all but one player for the start of the season.

The Liberty maintained home court dominance throughout their journey to securing a championship, posting a 6-1 record at Barclays Center.

THE HOTTEST TICKET IN TOWN

Attendance at Barclays Center for New York Liberty games surged over 63% from 2023 to the 2024. Last season, home games attendance averaged over 12,500.

The Liberty earned the honor of playing back-to-back WNBA Finals series in Barclays Center. In the 2023 Finals matchup against the Las Vegas Aces, games in Brooklyn, NY drew an average of 16,997 fans. During the 2024 series, on their path to besting the Minnesota Lynx, an average of 17,956 Liberty fans filled the arena.

On October 20, 2024, a Liberty franchise attendance record at Barclays Center was set when 18,090 fans packed the arena to watch the New York Liberty win Game 5 and clinch their first ever WNBA Championship.

THE WIZARD'S RETURN

While **Marine Johannès'** creative passing and acrobatics at the rim cannot be quantified or captured on a stat sheet, her shooting ability certainly can. Her career 3-point percentage ranks her amongst the top 7 active WNBA players (minimum 20 3PM).

Marine was in contention for the 2023 Sixth Player of the Year award, but her outings as a starter were impactful. She averaged 10.6 points in those starting appearances, including leading the team in scoring with 18 points against the Atlanta Dream.

National team commitments called Johannès back to France during the 2024 season. In an Olympic tournament run that resulted in a silver medal, she put up 24 points versus Germany to advance to the penultimate matchup against Team USA.

CLOUDY DAYS ARE HERE

The WNBA saw a whirlwind of movement during the offseason, including the addition of **Natasha Cloud** to the New York Liberty.

In 26 of her 38 starts last season, she accumulated at least 10 assists. Eight of those outings resulted in a double-double.

Cloud's 2024 campaign was laden with achievements, including a career-high scoring performance with 31 points, finishing top 4 in assists, top 10 in minutes played and a nomination to the league's All-Defensive 2nd Team.



IZZY SZN

The Liberty's offseason moves continued with the acquisition of forward **Isabelle Harrison** who is coming off a career best defensive performance with the Chicago Sky.

Harrison saw her defensive rating jump to 104.8 while she averaged 16.3 minutes per game. She posted her best assist-to-turnover ratio in six years (0.69). Her career-high of 11 defensive rebounds came against the New York Liberty in Barclays last season

BEK IS BACK

Acquired by the New York Liberty in 2024, **Rebekah Gardner** will make her first appearance in seafoam this season. In her 2022 debut, Gardner made the WNBA's All-Rookie Team and put up a top 8 field goal percentage of 54.2%. In her two seasons with the Chicago Sky, she posted offensive ratings of 101.4 (2022) and 94.2 (2023).

SABRINA/STEWART SCORING SPREE

A championship season saw **Sabrina Ionescu** and **Breanna Stewart** climb the ranks of the Liberty's franchise scoring records, with both firmly established in the top ten.

After Stewart's 2024 scoring performance, she now sits atop the Liberty's scoring average leaders (21.7). In 16 of her 38 appearances in the 2024 regular season, she tallied at least 20 points.

Sixteen was a lucky number for this pair, as Ionescu also racked up 20+ point performances in as many games. Her 2024 season ranks her in the league's top 3 3-pointers performances, only being outdone by Diana Taurasi in 2006....and herself in 2023.

BLOCK PARTY IN BROOKLYN

2024 Finals MVP **Jonquel Jone**s teamed up with **Breanna Stewart** to both rank in the top 6 number of blocks in 2024, 50 and 48, respectively. Their defensive dominance resulted in both players averaging 1.3 blocks per game and taking their place in the Liberty's top 10 list for blocks in the playoffs (7 and 19, respectively).

Jones' elevated for 50 blocks last season, leading the team and placing herself amongst the top 4 league leaders in the category.

Breanna Stewart set a franchise record for blocks in a regular season game (6) and in a playoff game (4) in Game 3 of the 2024 WNBA Finals.





PHENOMENAL FIEBICH

Leonie Fiebich enters the 2025 WNBA season fresh off winning a championship in Spain's LF Endesa with Valencia Basket Club.

Her rookie season with New York saw her make the 2024 WNBA All-Rookie team as she consistently contributed to the Liberty's championship season. Voting for 2024's Sixth Player of the Year Award ended with Leonie Fiebich finishing in second place, the highest rookie consideration for the award since 2009.

Out of the 26 first year players last season, only five were featured in all 40 regular season games. Leonie was among them and her scoring efficiency stood above the rest. She led that group in field goal percentage (47.8%), effective field goal percentage (62.4%), and true shooting (62.4%).

Her 3-point percentage (43.3%) and single season plus/minus (+279) rank second among the WNBA's all-time debut performances.

Fiebich's postseason performance added her name to the WNBA's rookie record book. She put up 128 points during her first postseason run, second most by a rookie in the WNBA playoffs. In the span of 11 games, Fiebich hit 25 3-pointers, the third fastest player to do so in the WNBA postseason. In Game 1 of the Finals, she hit five shots from beyond the arc, making her the first rookie to sink that many from three in a Finals matchup.

CONNECTIONS

Breanna Stewart was selected first overall by the Seattle Storm in the 2016 WNBA Draft and went on to win Rookie of the Year. She captured two WNBA championships (2018, 2020) and earned her first league MVP award in 2018 while with the Storm.

Stewart remained in Seattle through the 2022 season, during which she was named to the All-WNBA First Team and All-Defensive First Team, selected as an All-Star, finished third in Defensive Player of the Year voting, and was runner-up in MVP voting. Storm head coach Noelle Quinn played alongside Stewart in Seattle from 2016 to 2018. Current Seattle guard Skylar Diggins was coached by Liberty head coach Sandy Brondello during their time with the Phoenix Mercury from 2020 to 2021. Storm forward-center Ezi Magbegor also played under Brondello while representing Australia in the 2024 Olympics. In that same Olympic tournament, Marine Johannès and Seattle forward Gabby Williams competed for the French national team. Williams previously won two NCAA championships with Stewart at the University of Connecticut from 2014 to 2016. Storm forward Katie Lou Samuelson was also part of the 2015–16 UConn championship team. Samuelson has shared locker rooms with several Liberty players throughout her professional career. In the 2020 WNBA season, she played for the Dallas Wings alongside Isabelle Harrison. In 2021, Kennedy Burke played for Seattle with Stewart, Samuelson, and Liberty Director of Player Engagement and Community Relations, Epiphanny Prince. In the inaugural season of Unrivaled, Samuelson teamed up with Sabrina Ionescu and Natasha Cloud for Phantom Basketball Club. Cloud also played with Seattle forward Alysha Clark on the Washington Mystics in 2022. Seattle guard Erica Wheeler was a member of the New York Liberty in 2015. The 2019 Indiana Fever roster featured both Burke, in her rookie season, and Wheeler. Jonquel Jones played with Storm guard Lexie Brown on the Connecticut Sun in 2016.

Head Coach Sandy Brondello led the then-San Antonio Stars in 2010 after five years as an assistant coach for the franchise. Las Vegas center Kiah Stokes was drafted by the New York Liberty in 2015 and remained a member of the team until 2021, where she played with Sabrina Ionescu. The Liberty's Director of Player Development, Andrew Wade, coached Aces guard Jackie Young and the Laces Basketball Club in Unrivaled this past winter. Breanna Stewart, co-founder of Unrivaled Basketball, shared the court with Las Vegas guard Jewell Lloyd as members of the Mist Basketball Club. Stewart and Stokes won three NCAA championships together while playing for the University of Connecticut, 2012-15. Natasha Cloud and Aces center Megan Gustafson were part of the 2021 Washington Mystics. Kennedy Burke and Stewart also teamed up with Loyd as members of the Seattle Storm for the 2021 season. The 2019 and 2020 Indiana Fever rosters featured Burke and Aces guard Tiffany Mitchell. Marine Johannès, representing France, faced off against a Team USA outfit that included multiple Liberty players, Las Vegas center A'ja Wilson, Young and Loyd in the 2024 Paris Olympics Women's 5x5 Basketball gold medal match. Leonie Fiebich and Nyara Sabally, members of the German National Team, also played against Team USA in the 2024 Olympic Tournament. Isabelle Harrison and Gustafson both suited up for the Dallas Wings for the 2019 and 2020 seasons. Harrison and Aces guard Dana Evans were teammates with the Wings (2021) and the Chicago Sky (2024). The 2023 WNBA season saw Rebekah Gardner and Evans both play for the Chicago Sky.

Sandy Brondello

Head Coach – 2 Time WNBA Champion (2014, 2024)



Veteran WNBA coach, player, and former Australian Olympian Sandy Brondello was named the ninth head coach in Liberty franchise history in January 2022. Brondello joined New York after an eight-year head coaching tenure with the Phoenix Mercury where she led the team to a playoff appearance in each of her eight seasons. A two-time WNBA Champion head coach, Brondello holds an overall regular season record of 244-164 (.598) over her 12 combined seasons at the helm of the New York Liberty, Phoenix Mercury and San Antonio Silver Stars - making her the sixth-winningest coach in WNBA history.

Additionally, Brondello has compiled a 39-30 postseason record throughout her head coaching career, ranking her as the second-winningest coach in league postseason history. In 2014, Sandy was named the WNBA Coach of the Year after she led Phoenix to a WNBA regular season-record 29 wins and capped the season with a WNBA Championship. In 2023, Brondello led the Liberty to the Commissioner's Cup Championship and first WNBA Finals appearance since 2002. Brondello made history in 2024 after leading the New York Liberty to its first WNBA Championship in franchise history and

the city's first professional basketball championship since 1973.

A 20-year veteran of the WNBA coaching ranks, Brondello has been affiliated with the league for 25 of its 28 seasons, including her time as a player. A proven winner internationally and in the WNBA, her 20 total years as an assistant coach and head coach have featured 17 playoff appearances, highlighted by a perfect 12-for-12 in postseason berths as a head coach.

In those 12 postseasons, Sandy led her teams to nine Semifinals round berths (formerly conference finals) and four WNBA Finals appearances in 2014, 2021, 2023, 2024 – including two titles. Prior to her time with the Mercury, Brondello served as lead assistant coach for the Los Angeles Sparks (2011-13) under 2012 WNBA Coach of the Year Carol Ross. Brondello led the San Antonio Silver Stars to a 2010 playoff berth in her debut season at the helm following five seasons on the Silver Stars bench as an assistant under Dan Hughes (2005-09), the fifth-winningest coach in league history.

A 2010 inductee into the Australian Basketball Hall of Fame, Brondello was named the 11th head coach for the Australian Women's National Basketball team on April 17, 2017. Brondello led the Australian National Team to a Bronze medal in the Paris Olympics Games, and most recently, re-signed with the Opals for the 2028 Los Angeles Summer Olympics. In addition to her work internationally with the Australian Women's National Basketball team, Brondello previously served as an assistant coach with UMMC Ekaterinburg in Russia from 2012-2017.

Brondello finished a stellar 17-year professional playing career with a five-year run in the WNBA in which she played for Detroit (1998-99), Miami (2001-02) and Seattle (2003), and was named a 1999 WNBA All-Star. She began her career with the Women's National Basketball League (WNBL) in Australia (1986-96) and was named the league MVP in 1995. The 5-7 guard was a 10-time German Cup champion while playing with BTV Wuppertal (1992-2002), a three-time European Cup All-Star selection (1994, 1996, 1997), and the 1996 European Cup MVP when she led her team to the title.

An 18-year member of the Australian National Team, Brondello is a four-time Olympian, a two-time silver medalist (2000, 2004) and was named the 1992 Australian International Player of the Year.

Brondello is married to Liberty assistant coach, Olaf Lange, and the couple have two children, Brody and Jayda.
