QUICK HITS

The Liberty host the Sun to open the 2026 regular season after defeating Connecticut 79-67 in the team's final preseason matchup.

Last season, the Liberty defeated Connecticut 100-52 on June 1, 2025 to set the franchise record for margin of victory at +48. New York tied the WNBA's all-time single-game record for 3-pointers made with 19 triples in the win.

Sabrina Ionescu averaged 22.0 points, 6.8 rebounds and 5.8 assists per game in four matchups with Connecticut last season while shooting 55.6 percent from the field, her highest field-goal percentage against any opponent in 2025.

Ionescu scored 36 points against the Sun on Aug. 3, marking the highest-scoring performance by a Liberty player against Connecticut in franchise history.

Jonquel Jones has averaged 8.8 rebounds per game in 12 career matchups against the Sun, which ranks sixth in WNBA history among Connecticut opponents with at least 10 games played.

Jones played the first six seasons of her career with Connecticut, where she became the first player in WNBA history to win MVP, Sixth Player of the Year and Most Improved Player.

This offseason, New York added three-time All-Star **Satou Sabally**, re-signed the All-WNBA trio of **Breanna Stewart**, Jones and Ionescu to multi-year contracts, and hired four-time NBA Champion **Chris DeMarco** as the 10th head coach in franchise history.

The 2026 season marks the Liberty's 30th anniversary as one of the WNBA's three remaining original franchises since 1997. New York will celebrate the historic campaign by honoring the special people and moments that have defined the Liberty's journey and launching a "30 Seasons" throwback-inspired logo as a unifying symbol that connects generations of players and fans through a shared past and a collective future.

THE BIG THREE IS BACK

Breanna Stewart, **Jonquel Jones** and **Sabrina Ionescu** look to build on an unprecedented run of success over the past three seasons after becoming the first group of three teammates in Liberty franchise history to earn All-WNBA Team honors in the same season in 2024. In 1,733 regular season minutes with Ionescu, Jones and Stewart on the court together since 2023, the Liberty recorded a +16.8 net rating, and New York posted a 70-16 record (81.4 percent) in games with all three stars in the starting lineup, the best winning percentage by any trio with at least 50 starts together since at least 2002.

Stewart, a two-time WNBA MVP, makes her return to WNBA action after a historic offseason in which she won championships in Unrivaled and EuroLeague while being named 2026 Unrivaled Championship MVP. She set the Liberty single-game scoring record with 45 points against the Fever on May 21, 2023.

Ionescu begins the season as the Liberty's all-time leader in three-pointers made with 460 and the fastest player in WNBA history to reach 400 made threes. In 2025, she became the third player in league history to average at least 18.0 points, 5.5 assists and 4.5 rebounds in a season, joining Candace Parker and Caitlin Clark.

Jones enters 2026 as the only player in WNBA history to win MVP, Sixth Player of the Year and Most Improved Player over the course of her career. During her Liberty tenure, New York went 34-0 in regular-season games when Jones recorded a double-double.

SABALLY SIGHTING

The Liberty signed three-time WNBA All-Star **Satou Sabally** to a multi-year contract this offseason. Sabally earned 2023 All-WNBA First Team honors and was named the 2023 Most Improved Player after averaging a career-high 18.6 points, 8.1 rebounds and 1.8 steals per game and dishing out 4.4 assists per contest to join Candace Parker as the only players in league history to record such a stat line in a season.

With the addition of Sabally alongside **Breanna Stewart** and **Jonquel Jones**, the Liberty become the first team in WNBA history with three players listed at 6-4 or taller who all have been named to an All-WNBA First Team.

FAMILIAR FACES

A few familiar faces will make their returns to New York in the 2026 preseason, highlighted by two-time All-Defensive Team selection **Betnijah Laney-Hamilton**. Laney-Hamilton, who led the WNBA in average plus-minus (+9.7) in the 2024 regular season, played her first WNBA game since Game 5 of the 2024 WNBA Finals on April 25 after missing the 2025 WNBA season due to a knee injury.

Rebecca Allen and **Han Xu** both rejoined the Liberty this offseason after beginning their WNBA careers in New York. Allen, who ranks ninth all-time in franchise history in blocks (110), spent seven seasons with the Liberty (2015-19 and 2021-22) before playing the past three years with Connecticut, Phoenix and Chicago. Han was drafted by the Liberty in 2019 and played for New York in the 2019, 2022 and 2023 WNBA seasons.

LOCKDOWN LINEUP

The Liberty held opponents to just 85.2 points per 100 possessions in 122 regular-season minutes with Ionescu, Fiebich, Laney-Hamilton, Stewart and Jones sharing the court in 2024, marking the second-best defensive rating by any lineup with over 100 minutes played in a single season since 2020.





HISTORIC HEIGHT

The team's average height of 74.2 inches would be the tallest in WNBA history if maintained for the full season, and the 2026 Liberty are on pace to become the first team with an average height above 6-2.

PERFECT PERFORMANCE

New York shot a perfect 100 percent (22-for-22) from the free-throw line in the team's final preseason game at Connecticut on May 3, which would be the most free throws made in franchise history without a miss if accomplished in a regular season or postseason game.

HAN'S HOMECOMING

Playing in her first WNBA game since 2023, **Han Xu** scored a game-high 20 points in the Liberty's preseason game against Indiana on April 25 for her second career 20-point performance in the WNBA.

PEAKING PLAYMAKER

Sabrina Ionescu has recorded an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.0 or better with a true shooting percentage above 50% in each of the last four seasons. Ionescu is the third player in WNBA history to record such a statline in four consecutive seasons, and only Ionescu, Sue Bird, Chelsea Gray, Skylar Diggins, Epiphanny Prince and Lindsay Whalen have recorded four such seasons in their career.

GLOBAL GAME

The Liberty's training camp roster included players from eight different countries, marking the most diverse training camp roster in franchise history. New York's international group includes Olympic medalists, EuroLeague standouts and domestic league award winners from Australia, the Bahamas, China, France, Germany, Spain, and USA.

Pauline Astier and **Marine Fauthoux** join **Marine Johannès** to add to New York's French National Team pipeline. Astier was named 2026 FIBA Europe SuperCup MVP and ranked fifth in assists and seventh in steals during the 2025-26 EuroLeague season with USK Praha, while Fauthoux is a two-time Olympic medalist with France and was named 2022 EuroLeague Women Young Player of the Year.

DANGEROUS FROM DEEP

Three of the 11 WNBA players who shot at least 40% on catch-and-shoot 3-pointers over the last two seasons will be on the Liberty this season. **Leonie Fiebich** led the league at 44.8% on catch-and-shoot threes, while **Satou Sabally** (5th, 42.0%) and **Jonquel Jones** (10th, 40.1%) also ranked in the top-10 according to Genius Sports tracking data.

Marine Johannès ranked second in pull-up 3-point accuracy (35.7%) among players with at least 100 attempts in 2025 after finishing with the second-most total 3-pointers made (14) at the 2024 Paris Olympics. Johannès, who enters the season as the Liberty's all-time franchise leader in 3-pointers made off the bench (153), is one of three players in Liberty franchise history to average at least 2.0 made 3-pointers off the bench in a single season (min. 10 games), which she achieved in 2022 to join **Rebecca Allen** (2021) and Ring of Honor member **Crystal Robinson** (1999).

Throughout the season, the Liberty will celebrate the franchise's legacy with commemorative merchandise, in-arena giveaways, community events, theme nights, and original storytelling that highlight the special people and moments that have defined the Liberty's journey. New York will honor the legendary Liberty players who made significant contributions to the Liberty's tradition of excellence and played pivotal roles in some of the most memorable moments and seasons in the franchise's 30-year history.

Anchored by a "30 Seasons" throwback-inspired logo, the campaign's visual identity blends the franchise's earliest influences with a modernized aesthetic. The bold "30" symbolizes three decades of continuity and strength, incorporating the original orange torch from the Liberty's original Lady Liberty primary logo, representing both the origins of the franchise and the energy that continues to drive it forward. Angular crown details, accented with the team's original blue colorway, pay homage to the Liberty's foundational era and trailblazing spirit since 1997. A star set on the finger of the torch-bearing fist stands as a symbol of the Liberty's 2024 WNBA Championship, capturing a defining moment in franchise history. Completed with a contemporary color palette and dimensional accents, the logo blends retro inspiration with modern design, capturing the movement of the city and the momentum of the team today.

The "30 Seasons" mark will appear across merchandise, in-arena branding, digital platforms, and storytelling moments, serving as a unifying symbol that connects generations of players and fans through a shared past and a collective future.





The New York Liberty unveiled the design for their Nike WNBA "Court Origins" Edition uniform on April 24, 2026, a modern reinterpretation of the franchise's original 1997 look. The unveil date marks the 30th anniversary of the WNBA's founding announcement on April 24, 1996.

The uniform is part of the WNBA's first-ever league-wide retro uniform program, commemorating 30 seasons of the WNBA. The "Court Origins" Edition reinterprets each participating team's inaugural 1997 design within a modern silhouette, connecting the league's early identity to its continued growth. The Liberty are one of the WNBA's three remaining original franchises since 1997, along with the Phoenix Mercury and Los Angeles Sparks.

Rooted in the Liberty's inaugural visual identity, the uniform features a nostalgic color-blocked design, blending the team's signature seafoam green, black, and white with orange piping and blue trim. Centered on the chest is the original Liberty logo, featuring the Statue of Liberty's torch rendered in the franchise's founding colors and typography. The torch, the team's first symbol, was chosen to represent New York, freedom, and a purpose that extends beyond the court.

The WNBA's inaugural logo is also integrated throughout the design, appearing in red, white, and blue across the jersey hem, back, and shorts. Displayed as a patch, the logo features a silhouetted female basketball player and marks the launch of a groundbreaking platform for women's basketball. The jersey features a commemorative patch celebrating the WNBA's 30th season.

The Nike New York Liberty "Court Origins" Edition uniform will debut at Barclays Center on May 8, 2026, when the Liberty host the Connecticut Sun for their 2026 regular season home opener, and will be worn during select games throughout the season. The uniform will be available for retail purchase in late May.





The New York Liberty's Friday match against the Connecticut Sun is the opening game of the team's, and the league's, historic 30th season. To celebrate, the Liberty and Barclays Center are welcoming fans back for the monumental game with a variety of activations and giveaways to set the stage for the rest of the season.

The night starts with the unveiling of the 2026 custom court, inspired by the franchise's original 1997 design and featuring iconic callbacks to the past, like 90s-style hardwood and the iconic Lady Liberty mark. Liberty legend Kym Hampton, who scored the league's first-ever basket during the 1997 inaugural season, will be performing the National Anthem. This will make way for the debut of the team's official 2026 opening video, a clip that encapsulates the trailblazers, unforgettable moments, and community that have shaped the Liberty since their first season.

During halftime, Liberty mascot Ellie the Elephant will perform alongside the Lil Torches, Torch Patrol and Timeless Torches, in tribute to an artist that holds an important spot in Liberty and WNBA history.

All guests will walk away with a rally towel inspired by the team's Nike WNBA "Court Origins" Edition uniform and giveaways from Liberty partner essie, as well as new access to several unveilings across Barclays Center. Liberty fans will now be able to find new merchandise celebrating the Liberty's legacy at the 30 Seasons Shop in Section 9, as well as new Nike, Round21, Playa Society and more merchandise at the Official Team Store.

The franchise will honor three decades of impact on the game and culture of New York City as the start of a season-long celebration connecting the Liberty's legacy to the future of basketball in New York.





KYM HAMPTON



In honor of the first game of the organization's 30th season, tonight's Liberty Legend of the Game is Kym Hampton.

Hampton was the fourth pick in the 1997 WNBA Elite Draft and scored the WNBA's first-ever basket in the league's inaugural match, where the Liberty faced the Los Angeles Sparks. Hampton spent her entire career (1997-99) with New York, averaging 9.3 points, 5.8 rebounds and 1.0 assists across three years. The Liberty legend became the first player in franchise history to reach 500 rebounds and was the starting center for the Eastern Conference in the 1999 WNBA All-Star Game.

Hampton was named to the Liberty's Ring of Honor in 2011 and continues to be a part of the organization's growth and success, featuring alongside head coach Chris Dimarco in a Shake Shack commercial announcing the Liberty's special "Liberty Cake Shake."

Connecticut forward **Kennedy Burke** spent two seasons (2024-2025) with the Liberty and won a WNBA championship with New York in 2024. Burke was also teammates with Liberty guard **Derin Erdoğan** for Turkey at the 2026 Women's Basketball World Cup Qualifiers. Liberty guard/forward **Rebecca Allen** played the 2023 WNBA season with Connecticut, where she was teammates with Sun center **Olivia Nelson-Ododa**. Liberty center **Jonquel Jones** spent the first six seasons of her WNBA career (2016-2022) with Connecticut. Liberty player development coach **Kristen Mann** served as manager of basketball development with the Sun prior to joining New York. CHRIS DEMARCO

NEW YORK LIBERTY HEAD COACH
1ST SEASON WITH NEW YORK | 1ST SEASON IN WNBA

Four-time NBA Champion Chris DeMarco was named the 10th head coach in New York Liberty franchise history on December 3, 2025. DeMarco arrives in Brooklyn following 14 seasons with the Golden State Warriors, where he won NBA titles in 2015, 2017, 2018, and 2022. He joined Golden State under Mark Jackson in 2012 and was retained by Steve Kerr, working across player development, assistant coaching, and defensive roles during the Warriors' championship era.

In Golden State, DeMarco played a pivotal role on Steve Kerr's coaching staff, largely focusing on the team's individual skill development and systems, that ultimately culminated in one of the most successful dynasties in modern basketball history. During DeMarco's tenure, Golden State's defense held opponents to the league's second-lowest shot quality over the past 10 seasons (49.9% qSQ), per Second Spectrum. The Warriors also led the league in net rating three times during that span and won an NBA single-season record 73 games in the 2015-16 season.

In addition to his NBA success, DeMarco has served as head coach of the Bahamas Men's National Team since 2019. Under his leadership, the team achieved its most significant victory in program history, defeating host Argentina in the 2024 Olympic Pre-Qualifying Tournament final. He has also been a featured coach at Basketball Without Borders (BWB) Americas, mentoring top international prospects and advancing the game globally.

The 2026 campaign is DeMarco's first as a WNBA head coach after beginning his professional career with the Warriors in video and scouting before advancing to Director of Player Development and ultimately serving as an assistant coach.
