QUICK HITS

The Liberty host the expansion Toronto Tempo for the first matchup between these franchises all-time.

This matchup will feature two of the top three teams in 3-point shooting so far this season, with Toronto and New York both averaging more than 10 made 3-pointers per game in 2026. Both teams have also limited opponents in transition so far this season, with the Liberty allowing a league-low 7.1 opponent fast-break points per game, just one spot ahead of Toronto's transition defense (T-2nd, 7.2 opp. fast-break points per game).

New York swept the Phoenix Mercury in a pair of home games last week. **Pauline Astier** led the Liberty on May 29 as she became the third rookie in WNBA history to record at least 12 points, six rebounds and six assists while shooting 75 percent from the field and finishing with two or fewer turnovers, with both previous players to do so going on to win Rookie of the Year.

Marine Johannès set the franchise record for 3-pointers through the first nine games of a season (29). Johannès surpassed **Sabrina Ionescu's** record from 2023, when she went on to set the WNBA single-season record with 128 made threes.

The Liberty used a historic 23-0 run, the longest in franchise history, to defeat the Mercury 84-74 on May 27. New York's defense held Phoenix scoreless over the final six minutes of the third quarter, the longest scoreless stretch by a Liberty opponent to end a quarter since 2016.

With the WNBA debut of **Raquel Carrera** and the Liberty regular-season debut of **Anneli Maley** on Sunday, a WNBA-record 11 international players have suited up for the Liberty so far in 2026.

This offseason, New York added three-time All-Star **Satou Sabally**, re-signed the All-WNBA trio of **Breanna Stewart**, **Jonquel Jones** and **Sabrina Ionescu** to multi-year contracts, and hired four-time NBA Champion Chris DeMarco as the 10th head coach in franchise history.

The 2026 season marks the Liberty's 30th anniversary as one of the WNBA's three remaining original franchises since 1997. New York will celebrate the historic campaign by honoring the special people and moments that have defined the Liberty's journey and launching a "30 Seasons" throwback-inspired logo as a unifying symbol that connects generations of players and fans through a shared past and a collective future.

PAULINE POPS OFF AGAINST PHOENIX

Pauline Astier led the Liberty in their second matchup against the Mercury, posting 16 points, six assists and a career-high six rebounds with a 75 percent field-goal percentage. Astier is the third rookie in WNBA history to record at least 12 points, six rebounds and six assists while shooting 75 percent from the field and finishing with two or fewer turnovers in a single game, and both previous players to do so went on to win Rookie of the Year.

MARINE CAN'T MISS

Marine Johannès set her career high with seven 3-pointers on May 27 against Phoenix, finishing with a team-high 21 points and five assists while shooting 77.8 percent (7-for-9) from long range. Johannès also reached 1,000 career points in the win and passed Vickie Johnson (221) for the eighth-most made 3-pointers in Liberty franchise history. Johannès has connected on a league-best 29 3-pointers so far in 2026, setting a franchise record for 3-pointers through the first nine games of a season. Johannès surpassed Sabrina Ionescu's record from 2023, when she went on to set the WNBA single-season record with 128 made threes.

LIBERTY DEFENSE LOCKS DOWN MERCURY WITH HISTORIC RUN

The Liberty went on a 23-0 run to end the third quarter on May 27 against the Mercury, the longest scoring run in franchise history. New York's defense held Phoenix scoreless over the final six minutes of the third quarter, the longest scoreless stretch by a Liberty opponent to end a quarter since 2016.

JJ DOMINATING ON THE BOARDS

Jonquel Jones recorded her second consecutive double-double on May 27, finishing with 17 points and a season-high 12 rebounds in the win over Phoenix. Jones reached double figures in rebounding while knocking down at least 3 triples for the 17th time in her career, the third-most such games in WNBA history and only trailing Breanna Stewart and Tamika Catchings. Jones also reached 1,000 rebounds with the Liberty on May 27 to become the second-fastest player in franchise history to reach that mark (118 games).

300 GAMES FOR STEWIE

Playing in her 300th career WNBA regular-season contest on May 27, **Breanna Stewart** finished the night with 6,145 career points, the second-most by any player in WNBA history through 300 career games.

GLOBAL GAME

With the WNBA debut of **Raquel Carrera** and the Liberty regular-season debut of **Anneli Maley** on May 24, a WNBA-record 11 international players have suited up for the Liberty so far in 2026.

SABALLY SIGHTING

Three-time WNBA All-Star **Satou Sabally** made her Liberty debut on May 21 after signing a multi-year contract with New York this offseason. Sabally earned 2023 All-WNBA First Team honors and was named the 2023 Most Improved Player after averaging a career-high 18.6 points, 8.1 rebounds and 1.8 steals per game and dishing out 4.4 assists per contest to join Candace Parker as the only players in league history to record such a stat line in a season. With the addition of Sabally alongside **Breanna Stewart** and **Jonquel Jones**, the Liberty become the first team in WNBA history with three players listed at 6-4 or taller who all have been named to an All-WNBA First Team. Sabally finished with a team-high 20 points against the Wings in her second game with the Liberty on May 24.





CLUTCH-TIME LEO

Since the start of the 2024 season, Leonie Fiebich leads the WNBA with an 83.3 percent (15-for-18) field-goal percentage on attempts with under five minutes remaining in the fourth quarter or overtime with a scoring margin within 5 points, which is nearly 20 percentage points above second place, per Genius Sports (min. 10 attempts).

Fiebich has also scored a league-high 2.1 points per shot on clutch field goal attempts, with no other qualified player scoring even 1.5 points per clutch shot in that span.

LIBERTY OFFENSE CONTINUES HISTORIC START

New York dished out 32 assists on May 14 at Portland, tied for the third-highest single-game assists total in franchise history, and became the first team in franchise history to shoot over 50 percent from the field through the first four games of a season (50.9 percent). The Liberty also scored 61 points in the second half at Portland to become the second team in WNBA history to begin a season with a 50-point half in each of the first four games.

The 2026 Liberty became the first team in WNBA history to average at least 100 points per contest through the first four games of a season, and the first to open a season with four consecutive games of at least 95 points. The Liberty set WNBA records for eFG% (59.3%) and true shooting percentage (62.4%) through the first five games of a season.

STEWART WINS EASTERN CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Breanna Stewart was named Eastern Conference Player of the Week for her performance from May 8 to May 17. This marks the 19th weekly honor of Stewart's career and her ninth with the Liberty, which ranks third in franchise history. She is the first player in WNBA history to win at least nine Player of the Week awards in both conferences.

Stewart led the Liberty to a 3-1 record in their first week, posting averages of 23.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 2.8 assists, 1.3 steals and a conference-high 2.0 blocks in 33.3 minutes per game, while shooting 47.0 percent (31-for-66) from the field and 93.3 percent (28-for-30) from the free-throw line. The two-time MVP scored 110 points across the first four games of the season, her highest combined scoring total through four games since her 2023 MVP campaign. Stewart is the first Eastern Conference player in WNBA history to begin a season with averages of at least 20 points, nine rebounds and two blocks per contest through four games.

HISTORIC THREES FOR HAN

Han Xu made her 25th career 3-pointer on May 24 against Dallas to become the first player listed at 6-8 or taller in WNBA history to reach 25 career 3-pointers made.

BEK OFF THE BENCH

Rebekah Gardner scored her 500th career point on May 14, becoming the second player in WNBA history to reach that mark on shooting splits of at least 50/40/80 percent. Gardner put up 14 points, five rebounds and five assists to become the first Liberty reserve to record such a stat line since 2019 (Johannès). Her 72.8 percent true shooting percentage is on pace to tie for the sixth-highest in WNBA single-season history (min. 30 field-goal attempts).

LOCKDOWN LINEUP

The Liberty held opponents to just 85.2 points per 100 possessions in 122 regular-season minutes with Ionescu, Fiebich, Laney-Hamilton, Stewart and Jones sharing the court in 2024, marking the second-best defensive rating by any lineup with over 100 minutes played in a single season since 2020.





STEW YORK CITY

Breanna Stewart put up 31 points, 10 rebounds and three blocks in the team's season opener against Connecticut on May 8 for her 16th career 30-point double-double, and her first since Sept. 15, 2024. Stewart became the second-fastest player in WNBA history to score 6,000 career points, doing so in her 293rd game. Stewart put up another strong performance on May 10 at Washington, becoming the first player in franchise history and just the seventh in WNBA history to begin a season with back-to-back games of at least 20 points and four stocks. She also made her 150th career 3-pointer in a Liberty uniform to become the first player in franchise history with at least 150 3-pointers and 150 blocks with New York while passing Crystal Robinson (2,301 points) for sixth on the franchise scoring list.

Stewart recorded her 2,500th career rebound to become the first player in WNBA history to reach 6,000 points and 2,500 rebounds in fewer than 300 games, doing so in her 295th career game.

PAULINE ON THE SCENE

Rookie guard **Pauline Astier** made her WNBA debut against Connecticut on May 8 before breaking out on May 10 against Washington with 18 points, seven assists, five rebounds and two steals on 60 percent shooting from the field to join Candace Parker and Paige Bueckers as the only rookies in WNBA history to post such a stat line.

Astier put up a career-high 24 points on 71.4 percent (10-for-14) shooting from the field and 66.7 percent (2-for-3) shooting from the field May 13 at Portland. Astier joined Candace Parker, Sabrina Ionescu, Andrea Stinson and Caitlin Clark as the only rookies in WNBA history to average 15 points, 4 rebounds and 4 assists through their first three career games, and was the only one to do so while shooting over 50 percent from the field (64.3%). Astier recorded her second consecutive 20-point performance on May 14 as she became the first Liberty rookie to score 60 points in any three-game span since 1997 (Sophia Witherspoon) and joined Aliyah Boston as the only rookies in the past 20 seasons to score 60 points while shooting over 60 percent from the field through four career games.

Astier became the first rookie in WNBA history to shoot 60 percent from the field on more than 40 attempts through five career games. She totaled 74 points through her first five games, only trailing Kia Nurse (81 points) for the most by a Liberty rookie through five career games in franchise history.

OFFENSE IN MID-SEASON FORM

New York's 106 points on May 8 against Connecticut set a franchise record for highest-scoring season opener and is the most points in a season opener by any team since 2023, while ranking as the sixth-highest scoring game in franchise history. The Liberty erupted for 36 points in the first quarter, more than the team scored in any single quarter during the 2025 season and New York's highest-scoring first quarter since 2023. The Liberty's 66 points before halftime also marked the team's highest-scoring first half since 2023.

PEAKING PLAYMAKER

Sabrina Ionescu has recorded an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.0 or better with a true shooting percentage above 50% in each of the last four seasons entering 2026. Ionescu is the third player in WNBA history to record such a statline in four consecutive seasons, and only Ionescu, Sue Bird, Chelsea Gray, Skylar Diggins, Epiphanny Prince and Lindsay Whalen have recorded four such seasons in their career.





SHARPSHOOTING START

Marine Johannès opened 2026 on a historic shooting stretch. Her 11 made 3-pointers across her first two games set a Liberty franchise record, and she became just the second player in WNBA history to begin a season with consecutive games of five or more made 3-pointers.

The French guard continued her hot start with 18 points on May 12 at Portland, breaking the franchise record for made 3-pointers through the first three games of a season and setting her career highs for 3-pointers made (14) and steals (7) in any three-game span. Johannès also dished out a career-high 11 assists on May 14 while grabbing a pair of steals to join Teresa Weatherspoon as the only Liberty players in franchise history to begin a season with four consecutive multi-steal games.

THE BIG THREE IS BACK

Breanna Stewart, **Jonquel Jones** and **Sabrina Ionescu** look to build on an unprecedented run of success over the past three seasons after becoming the first group of three teammates in Liberty franchise history to earn All-WNBA Team honors in the same season in 2024. In 1,733 regular season minutes with Ionescu, Jones and Stewart on the court together since 2023, the Liberty recorded a +16.8 net rating, and New York posted a 70-17 record (80.5 percent) in games with all three stars in the starting lineup, the best winning percentage by any trio with at least 50 starts together since at least 2002.

Stewart, a two-time WNBA MVP, makes her return to WNBA action after a historic offseason in which she won championships in Unrivaled and EuroLeague while being named 2026 Unrivaled Championship MVP. She set the Liberty single-game scoring record with 45 points against the Fever on May 21, 2023.

Ionescu begins the season as the Liberty's all-time leader in three-pointers made with 460 and the fastest player in WNBA history to reach 400 made threes. In 2025, she became the third player in league history to average at least 18.0 points, 5.5 assists and 4.5 rebounds in a season, joining Candace Parker and Caitlin Clark.

Jones enters 2026 as the only player in WNBA history to win MVP, Sixth Player of the Year and Most Improved Player over the course of her career. During her Liberty tenure, New York has gone 35-1 in regular-season games when Jones recorded a double-double.

DANGEROUS FROM DEEP

Three of the 11 WNBA players who shot at least 40% on catch-and-shoot 3-pointers over the last two seasons (2024-25) are members of the 2026 Liberty. **Leonie Fiebich** led the league at 44.8% on catch-and-shoot threes, while **Satou Sabally** (5th, 42.0%) and **Jonquel Jones** (10th, 40.1%) also ranked in the top-10 according to Genius Sports tracking data.

Marine Johannès ranked second in pull-up 3-point accuracy (35.7%) among players with at least 100 attempts in 2025 after finishing with the second-most total 3-pointers made (14) at the 2024 Paris Olympics. Johannès, who entered the season as the Liberty's all-time leader in 3-pointers made off the bench (153), is one of three players in Liberty franchise history to average at least 2.0 made 3-pointers off the bench in a single season (min. 10 games), which she achieved in 2022 to join **Rebecca Allen** (2021) and Ring of Honor member **Crystal Robinson** (1999).





The 2026 season marks the 30th anniversary of the Liberty as one of the WNBA's three remaining original franchises. The organization is bringing the historic campaign to life by celebrating the trailblazers, moments, and community that have defined the organization since 1997.

Throughout the season, the Liberty are celebrating the franchise's legacy with commemorative merchandise, in-arena giveaways, community events, theme nights, and original storytelling that highlight the special people and moments that have defined the Liberty's journey. New York will honor the legendary Liberty players who made significant contributions to the Liberty's tradition of excellence and played pivotal roles in some of the most memorable moments and seasons in the franchise's 30-year history.

Anchored by a "30 Seasons" throwback-inspired logo, the campaign's visual identity blends the franchise's earliest influences with a modernized aesthetic. The bold "30" symbolizes three decades of continuity and strength, incorporating the original orange torch from the Liberty's original Lady Liberty primary logo, representing both the origins of the franchise and the energy that continues to drive it forward. Angular crown details, accented with the team's original blue colorway, pay homage to the Liberty's foundational era and trailblazing spirit since 1997. A star set on the finger of the torch-bearing fist stands as a symbol of the Liberty's 2024 WNBA Championship, capturing a defining moment in franchise history. Completed with a contemporary color palette and dimensional accents, the logo blends retro inspiration with modern design, capturing the movement of the city and the momentum of the team today.

The "30 Seasons" mark appears across merchandise, in-arena branding, digital platforms, and storytelling moments, serving as a unifying symbol that connects generations of players and fans through a shared past and a collective future.





The New York Liberty unveiled the design for their Nike WNBA "Court Origins" Edition uniform on April 24, 2026, a modern reinterpretation of the franchise's original 1997 look. The unveil date marks the 30th anniversary of the WNBA's founding announcement on April 24, 1996.

The uniform is part of the WNBA's first-ever league-wide retro uniform program, commemorating 30 seasons of the WNBA. The "Court Origins" Edition reinterprets each participating team's inaugural 1997 design within a modern silhouette, connecting the league's early identity to its continued growth. The Liberty are one of the WNBA's three remaining original franchises since 1997, along with the Phoenix Mercury and Los Angeles Sparks.

Rooted in the Liberty's inaugural visual identity, the uniform features a nostalgic color-blocked design, blending the team's signature seafoam green, black, and white with orange piping and blue trim. Centered on the chest is the original Liberty logo, featuring the Statue of Liberty's torch rendered in the franchise's founding colors and typography. The torch, the team's first symbol, was chosen to represent New York, freedom, and a purpose that extends beyond the court.

The WNBA's inaugural logo is also integrated throughout the design, appearing in red, white, and blue across the jersey hem, back, and shorts. Displayed as a patch, the logo features a silhouetted female basketball player and marks the launch of a groundbreaking platform for women's basketball. The jersey features a commemorative patch celebrating the WNBA's 30th season.

The Nike New York Liberty "Court Origins" Edition uniform debuted at Barclays Center on May 8, 2026 and will be worn during select games throughout the season.





AFRICAN AMERICAN POLICY FORUM

AFRICAN AMERICAN POLICY FORUM

The New York Liberty's charity of choice for the 2026 WNBA Commissioner's Cup is the **African American Policy Forum (AAPF)**. The AAPF is an "innovative think tank that connects academics, activists and policymakers to promote efforts to dismantle structural inequality." The forum is dedicated to the advancement of human rights across the world, with a goal of using different ideas and perspectives to move society closer to a racial justice that embraces intersectionality.

Many of the AAPF's initiatives are centered around the inequalities that Black women suffer, such as the #SayHerName campaign, an initiative that focuses on promoting justice for Black women wrongfully killed by law enforcement. The Liberty had direct involvement with the #SayHerName campaign, as well as the WNBA's 2020 dedication to Breonna Taylor, a movement that the AAPF led.

The WNBA worked in partnership with the AAPF back in 2020 to shed light on the policy issues contributing to police brutality and racial violence and connected with the families of female victims to elevate their stories. Several members from the AAPF have worked with the WNBA before, such as co-founder, executive director and social justice pioneer Kimberlé Crenshaw, who advised the WNBA's Social Justice Council.

Both The AAPF and the Liberty have spent decades promoting visibility, justice, and leadership for Black women. The partnership between the two reflects a shared history of advocacy and lasting influence, as well as a continued commitment to meaningful change as both organizations mark 30 years of impact.





PLENETTE PIERSON



Plenette Pierson came to the Liberty in 2010 after starting the season with the Tulsa Shock and went on to spend four more seasons in New York (2011-2014) after finishing the 2010 season.

Across her 149 games as a forward on the Liberty, Pierson averaged 10.6 points and 4.7 rebounds and recorded one of the best seasons of her career in 2011, where she averaged a career-high 12.9 points per game, along with 2.1 stocks, 5.2 rebounds and a 47.8% field goal percentage.

Pierson has etched her name into the Liberty franchise books in many different categories — the forward ranks 7th in field goal percentage (44.9%), 10th in double-doubles (8), 12th in games with 15 or more points (37) and rebounds (696), 13th in blocks (85) and 11th in three categories: points (1573), points per game (10.6) and field goals made (609).

After retiring from the W in 2017, Pierson went on to serve as an assistant coach at both the collegiate and professional levels, including spending three seasons with the Minnesota Lynx where she helped the team make playoffs during all her seasons on the coaching staff. She now acts as the Assistant Women's Basketball Coach at Prairie View A&M University.





Brooklyn Basketball opened the 18,600 sq. ft. Brooklyn Basketball Training Center in September of 2025 and since then, the initiative has continued to grow and expand their reach across New York.

This marks the third year of the partnership between Brooklyn Basketball and the NYC Department of Education on an innovative program that gives elementary and middle school students access to free, in-school basketball clinics. This year alone, the program has reached over 23,000 youth across 170 schools and is on track to exceed 35,000 students by the end of 2026. In addition to schools, Brooklyn Basketball has partnered with organizations like the YMCA and Boys & Girls Clubs to bring community-based clinics to neighborhoods across Brooklyn, making the game more accessible.

Brooklyn Basketball also brings schools to the Brooklyn Basketball Training Center for programs during the school day. To date, the training center has hosted over 1,600 students from 24 schools, many of whom do not have their own facilities, for on-site experiences. The center has also hosted after-school programs, weekend training, camps, all-girls programs and other activations, while making space for students to finish homework and address other needs before and after training.

The multi-court youth basketball training facility is the first in the tri-state area to use Shoot 360 technology. Shoot 360, a leader in basketball innovation and skill development, uses advanced ball detection technology that is leveraged by teams across the WNBA and NBA, and now by the training center as well. The technology utilizes interactive features and physical activity to measure participants' skillset and analyzes performance data for suggestions on how participants can improve their game. Empowering youth with this technology aligns directly with Brooklyn Basketball's mission to deliver high-quality, inclusive, and accessible basketball programming.

The Brooklyn Basketball Training Center is right across the street from Barclays Center on Flatbush Avenue, providing the Liberty and the Nets a unique opportunity to impact children, families, schools and programs across New York.

Tempo guard **Kia Nurse** was on the Liberty for three seasons (2018-20). Nurse and Liberty forward **Breanna Stewart** are former University of Connecticut Huskies, playing together during the 2015-16 season. Tempo forward **Nyara Sabally** was on the 2024 Liberty championship squad during three seasons with the New York Liberty (2023-25). Sabally and Liberty forward **Satou Sabally** are sisters and were also teammates at the University of Oregon from 2018-20, where they played alongside Liberty guard **Sabrina Ionescu**. Tempo associate head coach **Olaf Lange** was an assistant coach on the Liberty from 2022 to 2025 and now acts as the head coach of the German national team, where N. Sabally and Liberty guard **Leonie Fiebich** play. Tempo assistant coach **Brian Lankton** was the head video coordinator and player development coach for the Liberty from 2023 to 2025. Tempo forward **Isabelle Harrison** was a part of the Liberty roster for the 2025 season. Nurse and Liberty guard/forward **Rebecca Allen** were teammates on the Chicago Sky during the 2025 season. During their time on the Chicago Sky, Liberty guard **Rebekah Gardner** and Liberty guard **Anneli Maley** were teammates with Harrison and Tempo guard **Marina Mabrey** in 2023, and then Tempo guard **Julie Allemand** in 2022. S. Sabally, Harrison and Mabrey spent three seasons on the Dallas Wings together (2020-22). Allen, Mabrey and Tempo center **Temi Fagbenle** are teammates on Unrivaled's Lunar Owls Basketball Club. Liberty forward **Raquel Carrera** and Tempo forward **Maria Conde** are on the Spanish national team together.

CHRIS DEMARCO

NEW YORK LIBERTY HEAD COACH
1ST SEASON WITH NEW YORK | 1ST SEASON IN WNBA

Four-time NBA Champion Chris DeMarco was named the 10th head coach in New York Liberty franchise history on December 3, 2025. DeMarco arrives in Brooklyn following 14 seasons with the Golden State Warriors, where he won NBA titles in 2015, 2017, 2018, and 2022. He joined Golden State under Mark Jackson in 2012 and was retained by Steve Kerr, working across player development, assistant coaching, and defensive roles during the Warriors' championship era.

In Golden State, DeMarco played a pivotal role on Steve Kerr's coaching staff, largely focusing on the team's individual skill development and systems, that ultimately culminated in one of the most successful dynasties in modern basketball history. During DeMarco's tenure, Golden State's defense held opponents to the league's second-lowest shot quality over the past 10 seasons (49.9% qSQ), per Second Spectrum. The Warriors also led the league in net rating three times during that span and won an NBA single-season record 73 games in the 2015-16 season.

In addition to his NBA success, DeMarco has served as head coach of the Bahamas Men's National Team since 2019. Under his leadership, the team achieved its most significant victory in program history, defeating host Argentina in the 2024 Olympic Pre-Qualifying Tournament final. He has also been a featured coach at Basketball Without Borders (BWB) Americas, mentoring top international prospects and advancing the game globally.

The 2026 campaign is DeMarco's first as a WNBA head coach after beginning his professional career with the Warriors in video and scouting before advancing to Director of Player Development and ultimately serving as an assistant coach.
