Sugar Rodgers (2014-18), Carolyn Swords (2015-16) and Lindsay Allen (2017) all played for the Liberty. Layshia Clarendon played with Angel McCoughtry in Atlanta from 2016-17, and with Cierraa Burdick in 2016.





#### WUBBLE, WUBBLE, TOIL & TROUBLE

The Aces are without two main pieces from their 2019 playoff team as Liz Cambage (medical exemption) and Kelsey Plum (Achilles surgery) will not join the team in the Wubble this year.

#### WELCOME ADDITIONS

Las Vegas added two key free agents to the roster in the offseason signing five-time All-Star and two-time Olympian Angel McCoughtry, and three-time All-Star Danielle Robinson.

#### WAFTER DARK

With all game being played in Florida this season, west coast teams are "hosting" many games after the traditional 7 pm tip time to accommodate local broadcasts. In all, 13 of the Aces 22 games this year tip at 8 pm or later

#### **GONE STREAKING**

#### Lindsay Allen

Began the season making 11 of 21 shots over her first 3 games, and averaged 8.7 points per game, but since has gone 0 for 3 from the field over her last 2 games, without scoring ... Has made 2 of her last 3 three-pointers after beginning her career by going 1 for 30 ...

#### Cierra Burdick

Prior to checking in for the Aces on August 5, 2020, last played in the WNBA on September 2, 2017 with the San Antonio Stars ...

#### **Dearica Hamby**

Over her first three years in the W, made 41.2 percent of her shots from the field and averaged 7.5 points per game, but since the team moved to Las Vegas, she is connecting on 50.9 percent of her shots, and is averaging 9.5 points per game ... Averaging 3.0 assists over her last 3 games, after starting the season by averaging 1.3 assists in 3 games ...

#### Megan Huff

#### Kayla McBride

Went 1 for 6 from the field vs. the Sparks after making 16 of her prior 32 shots ... Scored 5 points vs. the Sparks after averaging 13.8 points over her previous 4 games ... Missed her first 2 shots from long distance this season, but is 8 for 16 since (.500) ... Has made 18 consecutive free throws, which is the 3rd longest active streak in the league ...

#### **Angel McCoughtry**

At the age of 33, and in her 11th season in the league, is averaging career highs in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage ... Went 1 for 4 from the field and scored 4 points vs. Dallas on August 2, but has made 12 of her last 22 shots from the field, and is averaging 18.5 points per game over her last 2 contests ...

#### **Danielle Robinson**

Made 12 of her last 21 shots from the field after starting the year making 7 of 19 ... Has 6 assists over her last 2 games after handing out 5 in her first 4 games ...

#### **Sugar Rodgers**

Went 5 of 9 from the field, including 4 of 8 from three-point range, at Phoenix on July 31 but is 2 for 11 and 0 for 6 in her other 5 games ...

#### **Carolyn Swords**

Made 1 of 4 shot from the field vs. Los Angeles on August 7 after starting the season by making 9 of 14 shots ... Has at least 4 rebounds in every game this season ...

#### A'ja Wilson

Is 17 of her last 28 from the field (.607) after starting the year making 43.5 percent of her shots ... Started the year making 14 of 23 shots from the free throw line (.609), but is 17 of 21 since (.810) ... Has at least 8 rebounds in every game this season ...

#### **Jackie Young**

Averaged 6 assists over her last 7 regular season games to close out 2019, but has 12 in the first 6 games of 2020 ... Went 7 for 12 from the field vs. Los Angeles on August 7, but us 9 for 23 in her other 5 games ... Had nearly a 3-1 assist-to-turnover ratio last season, but is under 1-1 this year ...

#### **GETTING DEFENSIVE**

The Aces finished the 2019 season ranked first in the WNBA in defensive field goal percentage (.399), adjusted defensive field goal percentage (.448), Defensive Efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions, 96.8), and defensive rebound percentage (78.2%).

#### WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

By nearly every statistical measure, the Aces defense did a complete 180 from 2018 to 2019.

#### TURN THE BEAT AROUND

The Las Vegas Aces won seven more games in 2019 than they did in 2018, which was tied for the largest improvement by a team last season.

#### **TURNING BACK THE CLOCK TO 1978**

The Aces are averaging just 10.0 three-point field goal attempts per game this season.

The last time a team averaged fewer than 10 three-point field goal attempts per game was back in 2014 when the Liberty and Sparks averaged 9.9 and 8.3 respectively.

#### IF A THREE FALLS IN THE WOODS ...

Las Vegas led the league in three-point field goal percentage a year ago making 36.7 percent of their shots from beyond the arc, but they took the fewest attempts per game in the league (14.9 per game).

In 2020, Las Vegas is 3rd in the league in three-point field goal percentage (37.5), but are averaging just 10.6 attempts per game.

The Aces have made 24 three-pointers on the season as a team. Ariel Atkins (Waashington) and Kelsey Mitchell (Indiana) have made 17 each by themselves.

#### ALL GOOD THREES MUST COME TO AN END

Las Vegas didn't make any three pointers in the team's season-opening loss to Chicago. The last time that happened was on July 24, 2007, when the then-San Antonio Silver Stars went 0-for-7 from long distance at Indiana. The Chicago blanking ended the Aces' streak of consecutive games with at least one made at 419, which was the third longest streak in WNBA history.

#### TWELFTH WOMAN OF THE YEAR

Dearica Hamby is making a strong case already for a second straight WNBA 6th Woman of the Year Award.

Established prior to the 2007 season, two players in league history have won the award multiple times, Allie Quigley (2014, 2015) and DeWanna Bonner (2009, 2010, 2011).

Hamby's teammate, Sugar Rodgers, won the award while playing for Bill Laimbeer in New York in 2017, and Plenette Pierson won the award playing for Laimbeer in Detroit 2007.

#### ALL ABOUT THAT PACE

Las Vegas is playing at the fastest pace in the league this year, averaging 85.3 possessions per game. The Aces were the second "fastest" team in the league a year ago at 82.3 possessions per game, and 1st in 2018 at 82.4.

#### CHASING DOGMA

Las Vegas held opposing defenses to just 39.9 percent shooting from the field in 2019, and took a run at the WNBA record for the lowest percentage in history.

This season Aces opponents are connecting on 43.8 percent of their field goal attempts.

#### **BID EUCHRE**

When the Aces allow an opponent to shoot 50.0 percent or better from the field during the regular season, they are 0-13 since moving to Vegas, including 0-1 in 2020.

#### BE ... AGGRESSIVE. B. E. AGGRESSIVE

Las Vegas pounded the ball inside in 2018, reaping the rewards by averaging a 23.6 free throw attempts per game, which was the second highest average in the league. In 2019, the team averaged 21.5 free throws per game which ranked 1st in the league.

In 2020, they are taking 24.3 free throws per game which is the second most in the league.

#### SHOOTING IS THE NAME OF THE GAME

When the Aces shoot = or better from the field than the opposition during the regular season over the last 2-plus years, they are 34-6. When they are out-shot, they are 5-28.

#### STRAIGHT SHOOTER

Kayla McBride has made 18 consecutive free throws, which is the fourth longest active streak in the league.
