What about box scores? Some folks like to see the box score from the previous game in Game Notes, while some folks like to peruse all of that season's box scores. Some like to see the box scores from previous meetings between the two teams playing today.

The Aces are without two main pieces from their 2019 playoff team as Liz Cambage (medical exemption) and Kelsey Plum (Achilles surgery) will not join the team in the Wubble this year.

WELCOME ADDITIONS

Las Vegas added two key free agents to the roster in the offseason signing five-time All-Star and two-time Olympian Angel McCoughtry, and three-time All-Star Danielle Robinson.

GONE STREAKING

Lindsay Allen

Began the season making 11 of 21 shots over her first 3 games, and averaged 8.7 points per game, but since has gone 2 for 7 from the field over her last 3 games, while averaging 2.0 points ... Has made 2 of her last 4 three-pointers after beginning her career by going 1 for 30 ...

Cierra Burdick

Prior to checking in for the Aces on August 5, 2020, last played in the WNBA on September 2, 2017 with the San Antonio Stars ...

Dearica Hamby

Over her first three years in the W, made 41.2 percent of her shots from the field and averaged 7.5 points per game, but since the team moved to Las Vegas, she is connecting on 51.2 percent of her shots, and is averaging 9.5 points per game ... Has at least 21 made three-pointer in 3 straight games ... Took 26 shots over her first 2 games, but 31 in the next 5 games ...

Megan Huff

Saw her first action for the Aces at New York on August 9 ...

Kayla McBride

Is 2 for her last 13 from the field over 2 games after making 16 of her previous 32 shots ... Scored 7 points over her last 2 games after averaging 13.8 points over her previous 4 games ... Went 0 for 4 from three-point range at New York on August 9, after making 8 of her previous 16 shots ... Has made 18 consecutive free throws, which is the longest active streak in the league ...

Angel McCoughtry

At the age of 33, and in her 11th season in the league, is averaging career highs in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage ... Went 1 for 4 from the field and scored 4 points vs. Dallas on August 2, but has made 15 of her last 29 shots from the field since then ...

Danielle Robinson

Went 2 for 8 from the field at New York on August 9 after making 12 of her previous 21 shots ... Has 8 assists over her last 3 games after handing out 5 in her first 4 games ...

Sugar Rodgers

Went 5 of 9 from the field, including 4 of 8 from three-point range, at Phoenix on July 31 (16 points) but is 2 for 13 and 0 for 7 in her other 6 games (5 points) ...

Carolyn Swords

Made 1 of her last 6 shots from the field after starting the season by making 9 of 14 shots ... Went to the free throw line 8 times in the first 4 games, but has not been to the line since ...

A'ja Wilson

Is 27 of her last 45 from the field (.600) after starting the year making 43.5 percent of her shots ... Started the year making 14 of 23 shots from the free throw line (.609), but is 28 of 33 since (.848) ... Has 5 blocks in the last 2 games after blocking just 1 in the first 5 games of the season ...

Jackie Young

Has 7 assists in her last 2 games after handing out 8 in the first 5 games of the year ... Has made 13 of her last 25 shots from the field over 2 games after starting the year making 9 of 23 in 5 games ...

GETTING DEFENSIVE

The Aces finished the 2019 season ranked first in the WNBA in defensive field goal percentage (.399), adjusted defensive field goal percentage (.448), Defensive Efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions, 95.0), and defensive rebound percentage (78.2%).

WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

By nearly every statistical measure, the Aces defense did a complete 180 from 2018 to 2019.

TURN THE BEAT AROUND

The Las Vegas Aces won seven more games in 2019 than they did in 2018, which was tied for the largest improvement by a team last season.

TURNING BACK THE CLOCK TO 1978

The Aces are averaging just 9.7 three-point field goal attempts per game this season.

The last time a team averaged fewer than 10 three-point field goal attempts per game was back in 2014 when the Liberty and Sparks averaged 9.9 and 8.3 respectively.

IF A THREE FALLS IN THE WOODS ...

Las Vegas led the league in three-point field goal percentage a year ago making 36.7 percent of their shots from beyond the arc, but they took the fewest attempts per game in the league (14.9 per game).

In 2020, Las Vegas is 5th in the league in threepoint field goal percentage (36.8), but are averaging just 9.7 attempts per game.

The Aces have made 25 three-pointers on the season as a team. Kelsey Mitchell has made 21 by herself.

ALL GOOD THREES MUST COME TO AN END

Las Vegas didn't make any three pointers in the team's season-opening loss to Chicago. The last time that happened was on July 24, 2007, when the then-San Antonio Silver Stars went 0-for-7 from long distance at Indiana. The Chicago blanking ended the Aces' streak of consecutive games with at least one made at 419, which was the third longest streak in WNBA history.



TWELFTH WOMAN OF THE YEAR

Dearica Hamby is making a strong case already for a second straight WNBA 6th Woman of the Year Award.

Established prior to the 2007 season, two players in league history have won the award multiple times, Allie Quigley (2014, 2015) and DeWanna Bonner (2009, 2010, 2011).

Hamby's teammate, Sugar Rodgers, won the award while playing for Bill Laimbeer in New York in 2017, and Plenette Pierson won the award playing for Laimbeer in Detroit 2007.

ALL ABOUT THAT PACE

Las Vegas is playing at the second fastest pace in the league this year, averaging 84.3 possessions per game. The Aces were the second "fastest" team in the league a year ago at 82.3 possessions per game, and 1st in 2018 at 82.4.

CHASING DOGMA

Las Vegas held opposing defenses to just 39.9 percent shooting from the field in 2019, and took a run at the WNBA record for the lowest percentage in history.

This season Aces opponents are connecting on 43.8 percent of their field goal attempts.

OUICK OFF THE BLOCK

The Aces 5-2 start to the season is second only to the 2011 San Antonio team's 6-1 record through seven games as the best start in franchise history.

BID EUCHRE

When the Aces allow an opponent to shoot 50.0 percent or better from the field during the regular season, they are 0-13 since moving to Vegas, including 0-1 in 2020.

BE ... AGGRESSIVE. B. E. AGGRESSIVE

Las Vegas pounded the ball inside in 2018, reaping the rewards by averaging a 23.6 free throw attempts per game, which was the second highest average in the league. In 2019, the team averaged 21.5 free throws per game which ranked 1st in the league.

In 2020, they are taking 24.3 free throws per game which is the second most in the league.

SHOOTING IS THE NAME OF THE GAME

When the Aces shoot = or better from the field than the opposition during the regular season over the last 2-plus years, they are 35-6. When they are out-shot, they are 5-28.

STRAIGHT SHOOTER

Kayla McBride has made 18 consecutive free throws, which is the longest active streak in the league.

DAZZLING DEBUT

Angel McCoughtry became just the fifth player in WNBA history to score 25 or more points in her debut with a new team when she poured in 25 against Chicago on July 26 of this year.

THREE IS A CROWD

The Aces have made more three pointers than their opponents in a game just 11 times in the regular season since moving to Las Vegas. They are 10-1 in those games, including an 8-0 record in 2019, and a 1-0 mark in 2020.

GOOD COMPANY

Bill Laimbeer has coached 12 full seasons in the W, and 8 times his teams have won at least 21 games, including in 2019.
