Las Vegas added two key free agents to the roster in the offseason signing five-time All-Star and two-time Olympian Angel McCoughtry, and three-time All-Star Danielle Robinson

GETTING DEFENSIVE

By nearly every statistical measure, the Aces defense did a complete 180 from 2018 to 2019, and they have maintained that improvement in the 2020 season.

The Aces finished the 2019 season ranked first in the WNBA in defensive field goal percentage, Defensive Efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions), and defensive rebound percentage, and second in defensive three-point field goal percentage.

In 2020 they rank first in the league defensive three-point field goal percentage, second in defensive rebound percentage, and fourth in defensive field goal percentage and defensive efficiency.

TURN THE BEAT AROUND

The Las Vegas Aces won seven more games in 2019 than they did in 2018, which was tied for the largest improvement by a team last season.

The Aces 8-3 start to the season is tied with the 2002 team for the best 11-game start in the 24-year history of the franchise.

IF A THREE FALLS IN THE WOODS ...

Las Vegas led the league in three-point field goal percentage a year ago making 36.7 percent of their shots from beyond the arc, but they took the fewest attempts per game in the league (14.9 per game).

In 2020, Las Vegas is 5th in the league in threepoint field goal percentage (35.0), but are averaging just 10.9 attempts per game.

The last time a team averaged fewer than 10 three-point field goal attempts per game was back in 2014 when the Liberty and Sparks averaged 9.9 and 8.3 respectively.

The Aces have made 42 three-pointers on the season as a team.



AWARDS WATCH

MOST VALUABLE PLAYER—A'ja Wilson

A'ja Wilson's name is being mentioned early and often in MVP discussions this year, and with good reason. The third-year pro and two-time All-Star is enjoying the best statistical season of her career, and has also captained the Aces to the second best record in the league, the third most efficient offense, and the fourth most efficient defense.

ASSOCIATED PRESS COMEBACK PLAYER OF THE YEAR—Angel McCoughtry

Five-time All-Star Angel McCoughtry has missed two of the last three WNBA seasons, including the 2019 campaign when she injured her knee late in the 2018 season. But you wouldn't know it from her stat line.

The soon-to-be-34-year-old is averaging career highs in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage. She is also pouring in 15.5 points per game, in just 20.8 minutes of action. Her offensive efficiency rating, assist-to-turnover ratio, defensive rebound percentage, rebound percentage, turnover ratio and effective field goal percentage are all the highest of her career.

ALL GOOD THREES MUST COME TO AN END

Las Vegas didn't make any three pointers in the team's season-opening loss to Chicago. The last time that happened was on July 24, 2007, when the then-San Antonio Silver Stars went 0-for-7 from long distance at Indiana. The Chicago blanking ended the Aces' streak of consecutive games with at least one made at 419, which was the third longest streak in WNBA history.

BE ... AGGRESSIVE. B. E. AGGRESSIVE

Las Vegas pounded the ball inside in 2018, reaping the rewards by averaging a 23.6 free throw attempts per game, which was the second highest average in the league. In 2019, the team averaged 21.5 free throws per game which ranked 1st in the league.

In 2020, they are taking 22.9 free throws per game which is the most in the league.

GONE STREAKING

Lindsay Allen

Made 6 of her last 8 shots over 2 games for 14 points after going 2 for 11 from the field over her previous 5 games for 6 points ... Handed out 13 assist with no turnovers over her past 3 games ...

Cierra Burdick

Prior to checking in for the Aces on August 5, 2020, last played in the WNBA on September 2, 2017 with the San Antonio Stars ... Scored her first WNBA points since September 2, 2017 when she drained a jumper on August 15 vs. Washington ...

Dearica Hamby

Over her first three years in the W, made 41.2 percent of her shots from the field and averaged 7.5 points per game, but since the team moved to Las Vegas, she is connecting on 51.1 percent of her shots, and is averaging 9.5 points per game ... Made 9 of her last 16 shots from the field after making 6 of her previous 15 (.400) ... Has handed out 10 assists and committed just 1 turnover over the past 3 games ...

Kayla McBride

Went 5 for 16 from the field at Chi ago on August 18 after making 13 of her previous 24 shots from the field ... Is 2 of her last 16 from three-point range after making 8 of her previous 16 ...

Angel McCoughtry

At the age of 33, and in her 11th season in the league, is averaging career highs in field goal percentage (.558), three-point field goal percentage (.421) and free throw percentage (.853) ... Went 1 for 4 from the field and scored 4 points vs. Dallas on August 2, but has made 44 of her last 77 shots from the field since (.571) ...

Danielle Robinson

Has 23 assists over her last 7 games after handing out 5 in her first 4 games ... Went 6 for 7 from the free throw line at Washington on August 5, but is a combined 9 of 11 in her other 10 games ... Has made 13 of her last 22 shots from the field after going 2 for 8 at New York on August 9 ...

Sugar Rodgers

Went 0 for 3 from the field, all from three-point range, at Chicago on August 18 after making 8 of her previous 15 overall, and 6 of 11 from long distance ...

Carolyn Swords

Went to the free throw line 8 times in the first 4 games, but has been only 2 times since ... Began the season making 9 of 14 shots from the field, but is 5 for 14 since ...Is averaging a career-high 5.3 rebounds per game ...

A'ja Wilson

Started the year making 14 of 23 shots from the free throw line (.609), but is 42 of 51 since (.824) ... Has 17 blocks in the last 6 games after blocking just 1 in the first 5 games of the season ... Made 7 of her last 25 shots from the field after going 10 for 16 vs. Minnesota on August 13 ...

Jackie Young

Went 1 for 10 from the field for 5 points at Chicago on August 18 after making 32 of her previous 56 shots from the field (.571) for an average of 15.8 points over 5 games ... Has gone to the line 21 times over her past 5 games after taking 11 shots from the free throw line during her first 6 games ...

Established prior to the 2007 season, two players in league history have won the award multiple times, Allie Quigley (2014, 2015) and DeWanna Bonner (2009, 2010, 2011).

Hamby's teammate, Sugar Rodgers, won the award while playing for Bill Laimbeer in New York in 2017, and Plenette Pierson won the award playing for Laimbeer in Detroit 2007.

ALL RIGHT NOW

In 2018, A'ja Wilson ranked first in the league in free throw attempts per game with 7.5, and she did so again in 2019 averaging 5.5 trips to the charity stripe.

In 2020, she is taking 6.7 free throw attempts per game—tops in the league. Teammate Angel Mc-Coughtry holds the WNBA record for free throw attempts per game in a season at 8.7 set in 2011.

THIS TABLE IS RESERVED

Dearica Hamby and Jackie Young are both averaging double figures in scoring despite not having started a game this season. Only seven players in WNBA history have done that, and no set of teammates has accomplished the feat.
