What about box scores? Some folks like to see the box score from the previous game in Game Notes, while some folks like to peruse all of that season's box scores. Some like to see the box scores from previous meetings between the two teams playing today.

Given all these possibilities, we have decided not to include any box scores in an effort to rid the planet of unnecessary paper waste. Box Scores are located on line

The Aces are without two main pieces from their 2019 playoff team as Liz Cambage (medical exemption) and Kelsey Plum (Achilles surgery) will not join the team in the Wubble this year.

Las Vegas added two key free agents to the roster in the offseason signing five-time All-Star and two-time Olympian Angel McCoughtry, and three-time All-Star Danielle Robinson.

## GETTING DEFENSIVE

By nearly every statistical measure, the Aces defense did a complete 180 from 2018 to 2019, and they have maintained that improvement in the 2020 season.

The Aces finished the 2019 season ranked first in the WNBA in defensive field goal percentage, Defensive Efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions), and defensive rebound percentage, and second in defensive three-point field goal percentage.

In 2020 they rank first in the league defensive three-point field goal percentage, first in defensive rebound percentage, second in defensive efficiency, and third in defensive field goal percentage.

## TURN THE BEAT AROUND

The Las Vegas Aces won seven more games in 2019 than they did in 2018, which was tied for the largest improvement by a team last season.

## IF A THREE FALLS IN THE WOODS ...

Las Vegas led the league in three-point field goal percentage a year ago making 36.7 percent of their shots from beyond the arc, but they took the fewest attempts per game in the league (14.9 per game).

In 2020, Las Vegas is 9th in the league in three-point field goal percentage (33.8), and are averaging just 10.9 attempts per game.

The last time a team averaged fewer than 10 three-point field goal attempts per game was back in 2014 when the Liberty and Sparks averaged 9.9 and 8.3 respectively.

The Aces have made 48 three-pointers on the season as a team. Connecticut has made the second fewest in the league with 82.

## NOT PUSHING FOR INDIVIDUAL AWARDS, WE ARE ALL ABOUT TEAM PRETTY GOOD PLAYER—*A’ja Wilson*

The third-year pro and two-time All-Star is enjoying the best statistical season of her career, and has also captained the Aces to the second best record in the league, the third most efficient offense, and the second most efficient defense.

## DIDN’T PLAY LAST YEAR, BUT IS GOOD THIS YEAR PLAYER—*Angel McCoughtry*

Five-time All-Star Angel McCoughtry has missed two of the last three WNBA seasons, including the 2019 campaign when she injured her knee late in the 2018 season. But you wouldn’t know it from her stat line.

The soon-to-be-34-year-old is averaging career highs in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage. She is also pouring in 15.2 points per game, in just 20.8 minutes of action. Her offensive efficiency rating, assist-to-turnover ratio, defensive rebound percentage, rebound percentage, turnover ratio and effective field goal percentage are all the highest of her career.

ALL GOOD THREES  
MUST COME TO AN END

Las Vegas didn’t make any three pointers in the team’s season-opening loss to Chicago. The last time that happened was on July 24, 2007, when the then-San Antonio Silver Stars went 0-for-7 from long distance at Indiana. The Chicago blanking ended the Aces’ streak of consecutive games with at least one made at 419, which was the third longest streak in WNBA history.

BE ... AGGRESSIVE. B. E. AGGRESSIVE

Las Vegas pounded the ball inside in 2018, reaping the rewards by averaging a 23.6 free throw attempts per game, which was the second highest average in the league. In 2019, the team averaged 21.5 free throws per game which ranked 1st in the league.

In 2020, they are taking 23.4 free throws per game which is the most in the league.

GONE STREAKING

Lindsay Allen

Made 8 of her lat 14 shots from the field over 4 games after going 2 for 11 in her previous 4 games ... Handed out 17 assist with 2 turnovers over her past 5 games ...

Cierra Burdick

Prior to checking in for the Aces on August 5, 2020, last played in the WNBA on September 2, 2017 with the San Antonio Stars ... Scored her first WNBA points since September 2, 2017 when she drained a jumper on August 15 vs. Washington ... Made her last 2 shots from the field over 2 games ...

Dearica Hamby

Over her first three years in the W, made 41.2 percent of her shots from the field and averaged 7.5 points per game, but since the team moved to Las Vegas, she is connecting on 50.9 percent of her shots, and is averaging 9.6 points per game ... Has handed out 14 assists and committed just 2 turnover over the past 5 games ...

Kayla McBride

Didn’t attempt a three-pointer for the first time in her career vs. Connecticut on August 20 ... Went 3 for 10 from the field for 6 points vs. Seattle on August 22 after making 9 of 10 shots for 25 points the game prior vs. Connecticut ... Is 2 of her last 20 from three-point range after making 8 of her previous 16 ...

Angel McCoughtry

At the age of 33, and in her 11th season in the league, is averaging career highs in field goal percentage (.538), three-point field goal percentage (.455) and free throw percentage (.850) ... Went 1 for 4 from the field and scored 4 points vs. Dallas on August 2, but has made 54 of her last 100 shots from the field since (.540) ... Has 12 assists over her last 3 games, after handing out 6 in her previous 4 games ... Has scored in double figures in 6 straight games ... Averaging 13.5 points and 11.0 rebounds over her last 2 games ...

Danielle Robinson

Has 39 assists over her last 9 games after handing out 5 in her first 4 games ... Averaging 6.3 assists over her last 4 games ... Has made 21 of her last 38 shots from the field (.553) over 6 games after going 2 for 8 at New York on August 9 ...

Sugar Rodgers

Is 11 for her last 25 shots from the field, including 9 of 21 from long distance over 6 games ...

Carolyn Swords

Went to the free throw line 8 times in the first 4 games, but has been only 4 times since ... Is averaging a career-high 4.9 rebounds and 18.2 minutes per game ... Has made 4 of her last 5 shots from the field ...

A’ja Wilson

Started the year making 14 of 23 shots from the free throw line (.609), but is 56 of 70 since (.800) ... Averaging 2.38 blocked shots over her last 8 games after blocking just 1 shot in her first 5 ... Has scored in double figures in 21 straight games, including 8 to close out the 2019 season ...

Jackie Young

Only took 2 shots vs. Connecticut after averaging 11 over her previous 6 games ... Is 5 for 19 from the field over her last 3 games, averaging 5.3 points per game, after making 32 of 56 shots in her previous 5 games, and averaging 15.8 points ...Has missed her last 4 three-pointers ...
