

What about box scores? Some folks like to see the box score from the previous game in Game Notes, while some folks like to peruse all of that season's box scores. Some like to see the box scores from previous meetings between the two teams playing today.

Given all these possibilities, we have decided not to include any box scores in an effort to rid the planet of unnecessary paper waste. Box Scores are located on line

Individual Player Profiles

Each player on the roster has at least one page of info in this document.

Included in these are ... Notes from the 2020 season Notes from previous seasons Streaks that paint a statistical picture of the player's most recent efforts. Singe-season and career highs. Career Stats

Additional information is available on each player's online biography, but these should give you what you need to cover the game.

Season Notes

This area is divided into three primary sections.

As the season progresses, the first notes will be super specific to this year's team and players, and should tell the story of the season, essentially answering the question, "Why do the Aces have the record they have?"

The second section contains interesting milestones or tidbits about this year's team or individuals.



By nearly every statistical measure, the Aces defense did a complete 180 from 2018 to 2019, and they have maintained that improvement in the 2020 season.

The Aces finished the 2019 season ranked first in the WNBA in defensive field goal percentage, Defensive Efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions), and defensive rebound percentage, and second in defensive three-point field goal percentage.

In 2020 they rank second in the league defensive three-point field goal percentage, first in defensive rebound percentage, second in defensive efficiency, and second in defensive field goal percentage.

TURN THE BEAT AROUND

The Las Vegas Aces won seven more games in 2019 than they did in 2018, which was tied for the largest improvement by a team last season.

Las Vegas pounded the ball inside in 2018, reaping the rewards by averaging a 23.6 free throw attempts per game, which was the second highest average in the league. In 2019, the team averaged 21.5 free throws per game which ranked 1st in the league.

In 2020, they are taking 23.8 free throws per game which is the most in the league.

DIDN'T PLAY LAST YEAR, BUT IS A GOOD THIS YEAR PLAYER - Angel McCoughtry

Five-time All-Star Angel McCoughtry has missed two of the last three WNBA seasons, including the 2019 campaign when she injured her knee late in the 2018 season. But you wouldn't know it from her stat line.

The soon-to-be-34-year-old is averaging career highs in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage. She is also pouring in 14.7 points per game, in just 20.5 minutes of action. Her offensive efficiency rating, assist-to-turnover ratio, defensive rebound percentage, rebound percentage, turnover ratio and effective field goal percentage are all the highest of her career.

GAME NOTES



ALL GOOD THREES MUST COME TO AN END

Las Vegas didn't make any three pointers in the team's season-opening loss to Chicago. The last time that happened was on July 24, 2007, when the then-San Antonio Silver Stars went 0-for-7 from long distance at Indiana. The Chicago blanking ended the Aces' streak of consecutive games with at least one made at 419, which was the third longest streak in WNBA history.

ALL RIGHT NOW

In 2018, A'ja Wilson ranked first in the league in free throw attempts per game with 7.5, and she did so again in 2019 averaging 5.5 trips to the charity stripe.

In 2020, she is taking 7.4 free throw attempts per game—tops in the league. Teammate Angel Mc-Coughtry holds the WNBA record for free throw attempts per game in a season at 8.7 set in 2011.

GONE STREAKING

Lindsay Allen

Handed out 23 assist with 3 turnovers over her past 7 games ... Made 1 of her last 6 shots from the field after making 8 of her previous 14 ... Went 4 for 4 from the free throw line at Dallas on August 25 after not taking a free throw over her previous 6 games ...

Cierra Burdick

Prior to checking in for the Aces on August 5, 2020, last played in the WNBA on September 2, 2017 with the San Antonio Stars ...

Dearica Hamby

Over her first three years in the W, made 41.2 percent of her shots from the field and averaged 7.5 points per game, but since the team moved to Las Vegas, she is connecting on 51.2 percent of her shots, and is averaging 9.8 points per game ... Has handed out 21 assists and committed just 6 turnover over the past 7 games ...

Kayla McBride

Didn't attempt a three-pointer for the first time in her career vs. Connecticut on August 20 ... Is 2 of her last 25 from three-point range after making 8 of her previous 16 ...

Angel McCoughtry

At the age of 33, and in her 11th season in the league, is averaging career highs in field goal percentage (.535), three-point field goal percentage (.417) and free throw percentage (.857) ... Went 1 for 4 from the field and scored 4 points vs. Dallas on August 2, but has made 61 of her last 114 shots from the field since (.535) ... In 2020, Las Vegas is 9th in the league in threepoint field goal percentage (33.3), and are averaging just 11.2 attempts per game.
