The Aces finished the 2019 season ranked first in the WNBA in defensive field goal percentage, Defensive Efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions), and defensive rebound percentage, and second in defensive three-point field goal percentage.

In 2020 they rank second in the league defensive three-point field goal percentage, first in defensive rebound percentage, second in defensive efficiency, and second in defensive field goal percentage.

TURN THE BEAT AROUND

The Las Vegas Aces won seven more games in 2019 than they did in 2018, which was tied for the largest improvement by a team last season.

In 2020, they are taking 23.6 free throws per game which is the most in the league.

DIDN'T PLAY LAST YEAR, BUT IS A GOOD THIS YEAR PLAYER-Angel McCoughtry

Five-time All-Star Angel McCoughtry has missed two of the last three WNBA seasons, including the 2019 campaign when she injured her knee late in the 2018 season. But you wouldn't know it from her stat line.

The soon-to-be-34-year-old is averaging career highs in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage. She is also pouring in 14.3 points per game, in just 20.5 minutes of action. Her offensive efficiency rating, assist-to-turnover ratio, defensive rebound percentage, rebound percentage, turnover ratio and effective field goal percentage are all the highest of her career.

ALL GOOD THREES MUST COME TO AN END

Las Vegas didn't make any three pointers in the team's season-opening loss to Chicago. The last time that happened was on July 24, 2007, when the then-San Antonio Silver Stars went 0-for-7 from long distance at Indiana. The Chicago blanking ended the Aces' streak of consecutive games with at least one made at 419, which was the third longest streak in WNBA history.

ALL RIGHT NOW

In 2018, A'ja Wilson ranked first in the league in free throw attempts per game with 7.5, and she did so again in 2019 averaging 5.5 trips to the charity stripe.

In 2020, she is taking 7.1 free throw attempts per game—tops in the league. Teammate Angel Mc-Coughtry holds the WNBA record for free throw attempts per game in a season at 8.7 set in 2011.

GONE STREAKING

Handed out 23 assist with 3 turnovers over her past 8 games ... Made 1 of her last 8 shots from the field after making 8 of her previous 14 ...

Cierra Burdick

Prior to checking in for the Aces on August 5, 2020, last played in the W on September 2, 2017 with the San Antonio Stars ...

Dearica Hamby

Over her first three years in the W, made 41.2 percent of her shots from the field and averaged 7.5 points per game, but since the team moved to Las Vegas, she is connecting on 51.3 percent of her shots, and is averaging 9.9 points per game ... Has handed out 21 assists and committed just 9 turnover over the past 8 games, but was 0/3 vs. Phoenix in Sept. 1 ...

Kayla McBride

Didn't attempt a three-pointer for the first time in her career vs. Connecticut on August 20 ... Is 3 of her last 29 from three-point range (.103) after making 8 of her previous 16 ...

Angel McCoughtry

At the age of 33, and in her 11th season in the league, is averaging career highs in field goal percentage (.524), three-point field goal percentage (.417) and free throw percentage (.863) ... Was making 57.1 percent of her shots through her first 10 games, but is connecting on 44.3 percent since

Danielle Robinson

Has made 1 of her last 5 shots over 2 games after making 24 of her previous 42 ... Has 23 assists and 5 turnovers in her last 5 games ...

Sugar Rodgers

Is 17 of 43 from long distance (.395) over her last 9 games after starting the year by making 26.7 percent from beyond the arc....

Carolyn Swords

Went to the free throw line 8 times in the first 4 games, but has been only 4 times since ... Is averaging a career-high 4.8 rebounds and 17.5 minutes per game ...

A'ja Wilson

Started the year making 14 of 23 shots from the free throw line (.609), but is 77 of 91 since (.846) ... Averaging 2.36 blocked shots per game over her last 11 games after blocking just 1 shot in her first 5 ... Has scored in double figures in 24 straight games, including 8 to close out the 2019 season ... Was making 50.0 percent of her shots through 7 games, but is making 43.3 percent since ...

Jackie Young

Went 8 for 15 from the field vs. Phoenix on September 1 after making 29.7 percent of her shots from the field over her previous 5 games ...

Aces Offense

Through the first six games of the season, the Aces were making 40.7 percent of their three-pointers, but since then they are connecting on just 29.7 percent ... Las Vegas was making 49.0 percent of its field goal attempts through 10 games, but is making just 44.1 percent of its shots since ...

Aces Defense

The Aces held opponents to 28.7 percent shooting from long distance in the first 10 games, but are allowing them to connect on 34.7 percent since.

Dearica Hamby is making a strong case already for a second straight WNBA 6th Woman of the Year Award.

Established in 2007, two players have won the award multiple times, Allie Quigley (2014, '15) and DeWanna Bonner (2009, '10, '11).

Hamby's teammate, Sugar Rodgers, won the award while playing for Bill Laimbeer in New York in 2017, and Plenette Pierson won the award playing for Laimbeer in Detroit 2007.

IF A THREE FALLS IN THE WOODS ...

Las Vegas led the league in three-point field goal percentage in 2019 making 36.7 percent of their shots from beyond the arc, but they took the fewest attempts in the league (14.9 per game).

In 2020, Las Vegas is 9th in the league in threepoint field goal percentage (33.1), and are averaging just 11.1 attempts per game.

The last time a team averaged fewer than 10 three-point field goal attempts per game was back in 2014 when the Liberty and Sparks averaged 9.9 and 8.3 respectively.

The Aces have made 59 three-pointers on the season as a team. Connecticut has made the second fewest in the league with 102.
