What about box scores? Some folks like to see the box score from the previous game in Game Notes, while some folks like to peruse all of that season's box scores. Some like to see the box scores from previous meetings between the two teams playing today.

Given all these possibilities, we have decided not to include any box scores in an effort to rid the planet of unnecessary paper waste. Box Scores are located on line

Individual Player Profiles

Each player on the roster has at least one page of info in this document.

Included in these are ... Notes from the 2020 season Notes from previous seasons Streaks that paint a statistical picture of the player's most recent efforts. Singe-season and career highs. Career Stats

Additional information is available on each player's online biography, but these should give you what you need to cover the game.

Season Notes

This area is divided into three primary sections.

As the season progresses, the first notes will be super specific to this year's team and players, and should tell the story of the season, essentially answering the question, "Why do the Aces have the record they have?"

The second section contains interesting milestones or tidbits about this year's team or individuals.

The third section includes information from recent seasons that might (in theory) still have relevance to this year's team.

WELCOME ADDITIONS

Las Vegas added two key free agents to the roster in the offseason signing five-time All-Star and two-time Olympian Angel McCoughtry, and three-time All-Star Danielle Robinson.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

By nearly every statistical measure, the Aces defense did a complete 180 from 2018 to 2019, and they have maintained that improvement in the 2020 season.

The Aces finished the 2019 season ranked first in the WNBA in defensive field goal percentage, Defensive Efficiency (points allowed per 100 possessions), and defensive rebound percentage, and second in defensive three-point field goal percentage.

In 2020 they rank first in the league in defensive three-point field goal percentage, second in defensive rebound percentage, second in defensive efficiency, and third in defensive field goal percentage.

TURN THE BEAT AROUND

The Las Vegas Aces won seven more games in 2019 than they did in 2018, which was tied for the largest improvement by a team last season.

BE ... AGGRESSIVE. B. E. AGGRESSIVE

Las Vegas pounded the ball inside in 2018, reaping the rewards by averaging a 23.6 free throw attempts per game, which was the second highest average in the league. In 2019, the team averaged 21.5 free throws per game which ranked 1st in the league.

In 2020, they are taking 22.9 free throws per game which is the most in the league.

PRETTY GOOD PLAYER - A'ja Wilson

DIDN'T PLAY LAST YEAR, BUT IS A GOOD THIS YEAR PLAYER - Angel McCoughtry

Five-time All-Star Angel McCoughtry has missed two of the last three WNBA seasons, including the 2019 campaign when she injured her knee late in the 2018 season. But you wouldn't know it from her stat line.

The soon-to-be-34-year-old (September 10) is averaging career highs in field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage. She is also pouring in 14.1 points per game, in just 20.2 minutes of action. Her offensive efficiency rating, assist-to-turnover ratio, defensive rebound percentage, rebound percentage, turnover ratio and effective field goal percentage are all the highest of her career.

GAME NOTES



ALL GOOD THREES MUST COME TO AN END

Las Vegas didn't make any three pointers in the team's season-opening loss to Chicago. The last time that happened was on July 24, 2007, when the then-San Antonio Silver Stars went 0-for-7 from long distance at Indiana. The Chicago blanking ended the Aces' streak of consecutive games with at least one made at 419, which was the third longest streak in WNBA history.

ALL RIGHT NOW

In 2018, A'ja Wilson ranked first in the league in free throw attempts per game with 7.5, and she did so again in 2019 averaging 5.5 trips to the charity stripe.

In 2020, she is taking 7.2 free throw attempts per game—tops in the league. Teammate Angel Mc-Coughtry holds the WNBA record for free throw attempts per game in a season at 8.7 set in 2011.

GONE STREAKING

Handed out 27 assist with 4 turnovers over her past 8 games ... Made 1 of her last 13 shots from the field after making 8 of her previous 14 ...

Cierra Burdick

Prior to checking in for the Aces on August 5, 2020, last played in the W on September 2, 2017 with the San Antonio Stars ... Missed her last 2 shots from the field over 5 games ...

Dearica Hamby

Over her first three years in the W, made 41.2 percent of her shots from the field and averaged 7.5 points per game, but since the team moved to Las Vegas, she is connecting on 51.6 percent of her shots, and is averaging 10.0 points per game ... Averaging 16.8 points over her last 5 games ... Had her string of 3 straight double-doubles snapped at Connecticut on Sept. 3 ...

Kayla McBride

Didn't attempt a three-pointer for the first time in her career vs. Connecticut on August 20 ... Has made 5 of her last 13 shots from long distance after making 1 of her previous 25 ...

Angel McCoughtry

At the age of 33, and in her 11th season in the league, is averaging career highs in field goal percentage (.518), three-point field goal percentage (.407) and free throw percentage (.857) ... Was making 57.1 percent of her shots through her first 10 games, but is connecting on 45.4 percent since ... Scored 20 or more points in back-to-back games on August 11 and 13, but is averaging 12.7 points since then ...

Danielle Robinson

Has made 1 of her last 7 shots over 4 games after making 24 of her previous 42 ... Has 29 assists and 8 turnovers in her last 7 games ...

Sugar Rodgers

Is 2 of her last 9 from long distance after making 13 of her previous 31 (.319)

Carolyn Swords

Went to the free throw line 8 times in the first 4 games, but has been only 4 times since ... Is averaging a career-high 4.6 rebounds and the second most minutes in her career (17.2) ... Has made 3 of her last 9 shots from the field over 4 games ...

A'ja Wilson

Started the year making 14 of 23 shots from the free throw line (.609), but is 90 of 106 since (.849) ... Averaging 2.38 blocked shots per game over her last 13 games after blocking just 1 shot in her first 5 ... Has scored in double figures in 26 straight games, including 8 to close out the 2019 season ...

Jackie Young

Had made 24 of her last 38 shots from the floor over 3 games (.632) after making 29.7 percent of her shots over her previous 5 ... Averaging 18.7 points over her last 3 games after averaging 6.6 points over her previous 4 games ... Has 24 assists and 6 turnovers in her last 5 games ...

Aces Offense

Through the first six games of the season, the Aces were making 40.7 percent of their three-pointers, but since then they are connecting on just 31.0 percent ... Las Vegas was making 49.0 percent of its field goal attempts through 10 games, but is making 46.1 percent of its shots since ...

Aces Defense

The Aces allowed an opponent to take more free throws than they did for just the second time this season, at Connecticut on Sept. 3 (-17 differential) ... Opponents have made 5 of their last 32 shots from three-point range ...

TWELFTH WOMAN OF THE YEAR

Dearica Hamby is making a strong case already for a second straight WNBA 6th Woman of the Year Award.

Established in 2007, two players have won the award multiple times, Allie Quigley (2014, '15) and DeWanna Bonner (2009, '10, '11).

Hamby's teammate, Sugar Rodgers, won the award while playing for Bill Laimbeer in New York in 2017, and Plenette Pierson won the award playing for Laimbeer in Detroit 2007.

IF A THREE FALLS IN THE WOODS ...

Las Vegas led the league in three-point field goal percentage in 2019 making 36.7 percent of their shots from beyond the arc, but they took the fewest attempts in the league (14.9 per game).

In 2020, Las Vegas is 9th in the league in threepoint field goal percentage (33.7), and are averaging just 11.2 attempts per game.

The last time a team averaged fewer than 10 three-point field goal attempts per game was back in 2014 when the Liberty and Sparks averaged 9.9 and 8.3 respectively.

The Aces have made 68 three-pointers on the season as a team. Connecticut has made the second fewest in the league with 109.

ALL ABOUT THAT PACE
