REVOLUTION NUMBER 9

The Lynx, who are an even 9-9 on the season, have been surging as of late. Following an 0-6 start, the Lynx have since gone 9-3, and are on a 5-game winning streak. They played 5 of their first 7 games against teams that currently boast records of .500 or above. The Lynx' current winning streak consists of 2 wins each against Phoenix (3-14) and Seattle (4-13) and 1 over Indiana (5-13)

Statistically, Minnesota had the second worst defense (108.0 DER) in the league during their winless start, and the 8th best offense (97.1). Over the past 5 games, however, they are averaging 111.5 points per 100 possessions, while giving up a much more manageable 100.7.

One of the keys to the turnaround has been the play of 5-year veteran Napheesa Collier. During the team's start, she was posting All-Star caliber-numbers of 18.8 points per game and 5.3 rebounds. During the team's current streak, however, she is averaging MVP-esque numbers of 24.8 points and 9.4 boards.

Kayla McBride missed 2 of the team's first 6 games, and made only 34.7 percent of her field goals and 30.8 percent of her 3-pointers to open the season. Over the last 5 games, she is making 42.6 percent of her shots, including 44.1 percent from distance.

Las Vegas upended Minnesota in the first meeting between the teams this year, 94-73, at Michelob ULTRA Arena. The Aces' defense held Minnesota to 36.6 percent shooting from the field, while Jackie Young (23 points) and Aja Wilson (21) led 5 Aces in double figures.

The teams squared off again in Las Vegas on June 18, with the Aces winning 93-62. Las Vegas outscored Minnesota 20-7 in the 3rd quarter to put the game out of reach. Young scored a gamehigh 24 points, while Plum dropped 4 3-pointers and finished with 21 points. Napheesa Collier scored 18, and was the lone member of the Lynx in double figures.



WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

If you want to know which team historically has the best chance at winning the WNBA Championship, look no further than scoring differential-the difference between a team's points scored and points allowed.

In the WNBA's first 26 years, the team that led the league in scoring differential during the regular season won the championship 19 times. The five teams that had a positive double-digit scoring differential all won the title.

Aces Defense—With a league-leading 14.2 scoring differential, the Aces have allowed opponents just 78.4 ppg (2nd lowest in the league) and 41.8% shooting from the field (2nd) and 33.4 rpg (3rd) and have sent opponents to the line a league-low of 15.3 times a game.

#### TOP OF THE PECKING OERDER

Seven teams in WNBA history have boasted both the best offense and defense in the same season as measured by <u>Offensive (OER)</u> and <u>Defensive Efficiency Ratings</u> (DER)—points scored and allowed per 100 possessions. Twelve games into the 2023 season, the Aces have their sights set on becoming the 8th, currently ranking first for both OER and DER. Six of those teams ended up winning the title *.

#### WARNING: EVEN MORE OFFENSIVE

Not one single team in the history of the league has finished the season with a final offensive rating in the teens. In 2019 the Washington Mystics came close with an all-time W record 112.9 offensive rating.

From 1997-2015, it was rare for teams to even round out the year in triple digits. From then, there was a sudden jump and, aside from 2019 when only 3 teams closed the year in triple figures, the majority teams from 2016-2022 finished with a 100+ offensive rating.

It is quite possible that the Aces, <u>currently boasting a 112.7 OER</u>, will not only finish with an offensive rating over 100, but they could set a new high-water mark in the process.

#### **MILESTONE WATCH: DEFENSIVE BOARDS**

Candace Parker has 2,846 defensive rebounds in her career and needs 29 to overtake Sylvia Fowles (2,874) an become the <u>all-time</u> <u>WNBA career leader for defensive boards</u>.

### ACES IN THE COMMUNITY

For each Commissioner's Cup win this season, teams earn \$2K to donate to a chairty of their choice and \$500 for each loss. The Aces are playing for NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness) Southern Nevada, and have earned \$14,500 for the organization through 8 CC games (standings page 13). The Aces' next 2 games also mark their their final Commissioner's Cup contests, and they are hoping to up the contribution to NAMI Southern Nevada to \$18,500.

NAMI is the nation's largest grassroots mental health organization dedicated to building better lives for the millions of Americans affected by mental illness, and relies on gifts and contributions to support its important work throughout Southern Nevada.

#### **FLYING ACES**

The Aces continue making an impact in the community in a variety of ways. #### HIGH ROLLERS

The Aces scored 90+ points in each of their first 5 games in 2023, becoming the only team in league history to accomplish that feat. In fact, no other team has scored 90+ in each of the first three games of the season.

Las Vegas also scored 90+ points in 6-straight games dating back to 2022, which is the 2nd longest such streak in W history (Phoenix, 2010, 7 straight). Indiana ended the Aces run by holding them to 84 points on June 4. The Aces have now scored 90+ points in 13 games this season, and are averaging a league-high 92.6 ppg.

#### NUMBER IX, NUMBER IX, NUMBER IX

After a successful inaugural event in 2022, which celebrated the 50th anniversary of the passage of Title IX, <u>this year's The IX</u> <u>Awards</u> again recognized outstanding people who have been instrumental in the fight for equality in sports and beyond.

Held June 13 at Allegiant Stadium, The IXs honored Wyomia Tyus with the Legacy Award, Jackie Joyner-Kersee with the Icon Award, Jessica Mendoza with the Game Changer Award, Elaine Wynn with the Impact Award and Annick Haczkiewicz with the Next Gen Award.

Emceed by Chris Spencer, the IXs features performances by Judith Hill and Broadway in the Hill, and concluded with a 30-minute fireside chat with Tyus.

Highlights from the 2022 The IXs celebration included a fireside chat with Billie Jean King, who was recognized with the Legacy Award, and members of the 1996 U.S. Olympic Women's Basketball Team, who collectively earned the Game Changer Award.

#### 50-40-90 TABLE FOR 3?

In 2019, Washington Mystics guard/forward Elena Delle Donne became the first, and to date only, member of the WNBA's 50-40-90 club by finishing a season with a field goal percentage of 50% or higher, a 3-point field goal percentage of 40% or higher, and a free throw percentage of 90% or higher while qualifying for league leadership in each category.

Chelsea Gray and Jackie Young are both knocking on the door of the 50-40-90 club. Gray is currently shooting 50.5% from the field, 45.3% from 3-point range, and 97.1% from the charity stripe, and would join the exclusive club if the season ended today. Young currently sits at 57.3 FG%, 48.2 3pt FG% and 82.4 FT%, which would put her on the outside looking in at 50-40-80.

#### (RE)BOUNDING ALONG

A'ja Wilson currently sits in the No. 3 spot for rebounds in franchise history. With 1,404 boards, Wilson needs 126 to draw even with No. 2 Margo Dydek (1,530). If she keeps the same pace (9.2 rpg.) she has had through the first 18 games of the season, Wilson will sit alone at No. 2 later this year.

The Aces hold <u>the top 2 marks for most defensive rebounds in a</u> regulation game in WNBA history, with 44 at Seattle on May 20, 2023, and 43 at Los Angeles on July 1, 2022. The Mercury grabbed 47 defensive rebounds against the Stars on June 7, 2014, but that was a double-overtime game.



#### **МST3K**

A'ja Wilson reached the 3,000 career point mark against the Sun on June 8 (<u>watch it here</u>). At 26 years, 303 days, she became the <u>fifth youngest player to score 3,000 points in her career</u> (Lauren Jackson, 25 years, 27 days).

Wilson also reached the 3,000-points pinnacle in her 157th game, which is the 7th fewest games needed to reach the mark (Elena Delle Donne, 148).

The Aces made 58.5% (38-65) of their field goals against the Sky, June 11, which is <u>the best shooting percentage in a game by any</u> <u>team this season</u>. It also marked the 2nd-best percentage for the Aces since the team moved to Las Vegas (59.72%, 43-72 FGs vs. Atlanta, July 4, 2021).

The Aces are netting 49.8% of their shots from the field and hitting an even deadlier 56.2% of their 2-point shots this year. Not only do those numbers lead the league, they would also bypass the 2020 Sky for the all-time WNBA season records in both categories, should they keep up the pace through the end of the year.

In 2022, 7 teams finished below 30 percent, including the Aces, whose percentage was the fourth lowest in WNBA history. The 2023 Aces and Mystics are both threatening to break into the top 5 at the end of the season.

#### LOW ON RESERVES

Las Vegas' bench averaged a league record 35.0 points per game in 2020. Only 7 other teams in WNBA history have averaged more than 30 points per game from their reserves.

Two years later, in the Aces' championship season, the bench averaged 12.9 points—12th in the league. <u>This year, Las Vegas'</u> reserves are averaging 12.8 points per game (2nd fewest in the league), with the Dallas Wings "leading" the way with 11.2 per game.

#### **DOUBLE NICKLE**

You've heard of the double-double, but probably not the doublenickel. That's because the feat of <u>blocking 5 shots and picking up</u> <u>5 steals</u> in the same game has only been done twice in WNBA history.

Candace Parker was the first to pull it off blocking 6 shots and recording 5 steals as a member of the Los Angeles Sparks in a double overtime game against Indiana on May 29, 2008. Natasha Howard accomplished it while playing for the Seattle Storm in a regulation game against the New York Liberty on August 6, 2018.

## HEAD COACH BECKY HAMMON



Las Vegas Aces President Nikki Fargas announced on December 31, 2021 that the team hired San Antonio Spurs assistant, and 6-time WNBA All-Star Becky Hammon as the team's head coach. Hammon rewarded the Aces less than nine months later with the fanchise's first WNBA Championship.

The seeds for Hammon's hiring were originally sewn when the Aces retired her jersey on September 13, 2021. That ceremony served as the culmination of the franchise's 25th anniversary alumni initiative, which saw the Aces embrace their Utah and San Antonio roots, and celebrate the players who helped build the franchise and the league from the ground up. Las Vegas owner Mark Davis spent time with Hammon and her family that week, and walked away understandably impressed.

Hammon played 16 seasons in the WNBA, including her final eight in San Antonio, where she led the franchise to its first finals appearance in 2008.

On August 5, 2014, Spurs head coach Gregg Popovich hired Hammon as a full-time assistant making her the first woman in NBA history to hold that position.

Since that time, Hammon has continued to accumulate coaching 'firsts' in the NBA. On July 3, 2015, she became the first woman to serve as head coach in the NBA's Summer League where she led the Spurs to the league title.

Less than a year later, Hammon became the first woman to be part of an All-Star coaching staff, and on December 30, 2020, following Popovich's ejection in San Antonio's game against Los Angeles, Hammon took over on the bench, becoming the first woman acting head coach in the history of the NBA.

A member of the league's 15th, 20th and 25th anniversary teams, Hammon went undrafted in 1999 following her All-American career at Colorado State. She signed with New York as a free agent that same year, helping the team to WNBA Finals appearances in three of her first four years in the Big Apple.

The Rapid City, SD native earned her first All-Star nod in 2003, and represented New York on the Eastern Conference squad in 2005 and 2006 as well.



Following the 2006 season, New York traded Hammon to San Antonio. In her first year in silver and black, she posted what were then career highs in scoring (18.8 ppg), and assists (5.0) while earning another trip to the WNBA All-Star Game. As a team, the Silver Stars made their first appearance in the postseason since 2002, falling to Phoenix in the Western Conference Finals.

In 2008, Hammon led San Antonio to its first trip to the WNBA Finals where they fell to Detroit. The Silver Stars made the playoffs in each of her seven full seasons with the team, and Hammon once again was named to the All-Star team in 2009 and 2011.

She retired as the franchise leader in assists per game (5.1) and scoring average (15.6), and the WNBA leader in career free throw percentage (89.7).

Hammon, who will be inducted into the Naismith Memorial Hall of Fame this year, was inducted into the Colorado Sports Hall of Fame in 2015 and the San Antonio Sports Hall of Fame in 2018.
