HELLO, MY NAME IS ...

The Las Vegas Aces <u>signed 6-foot-1 guard Ashley Joens to an</u> <u>emergency hardship contract</u> on July 18. Dallas selected Joens with the 19th pick in the 2023 WNBA Draft. She played 8 games with the Wings before being waived on June 28.

ACES VS SEATTLE: THE BACK STORY

The Aces and Storm have squared off against one another on 2 previous occasions this season with Las Vegas picking up a 105-64 win in the season opener, and a 96-63 victory on June 15. Dating back to the 2022 Playoffs, the Aces have won 5-straight games vs. Seattle. The Storm own an overall 47-45 edge in the history of games between the two clubs, but the Aces are 10-2 over the Storm over their last dozen outings (see pages 14-15 for the series history and 44 for this season's stats and box scores).

PLEASE PASS THE SALT

Since moving to Las Vegas, the Aces have produced the <u>top five</u> <u>seasons for average assists in franchise history</u>, and are on pace to top the season record this year. In fact, before the move the record was 18.9 apg, set by the 2012 Stars squad, with the franchise having never reached the 20 apg mark.

RISING UP THE RANKS

The Aces started their season with a 16-1 record for the No. 3 spot in league history for victories before a 2nd loss on the season. The team's 19-2 record through 21 games is second only to the 20-1 starts by the 1998 Houston Comets and 2016 Los Angeles Sparks. The league record for most wins prior to a team's 3rd loss is 25 by those same 1998 Comets.

DON'T TIPTOE INTO A SHOOTOUT

In scoring 40 points against the Lynx on July 9, Kelsey Plum not only <u>upped the franchise scoring standard</u>, Plum's 77.78 shooting percentage (14-18 FGs, 6-9 3pt FGs) also <u>set the bar for all-time</u> <u>WNBA single-game shooting percentage</u> when scoring 40 or more points, eclipsing the 77.27% shot by Liz Cambage when she set the WNBA single-game scoring mark of 53 points.

DOMINANCE

The Aces are off to a 19-2 start, and by at least one measure, they have had the most dominant 21-game start to a season in WNBA history. The team's +15.4 scoring differential is the highest for a team after 21 games in league history, eclipsing the +14.6 mark set by the 2000 Houston Comets. The next 5 milestones are:

Only <u>7 players have dropped 500 or more dimes in franchise history</u>, and 3 of them are on this year's squad. Chelsea Gray and Jackie Young reached that mark on July 1 and June 29, respectively, and Gray hit the milestone in just 83 games, the fastest to the mark.

GRADE A WINNING

Midway through the 40-game season, the Aces are on pace to record one of the <u>highest winning percentages in</u> <u>league history</u>. The 1998 Houston Comets finished 27-3, a 90% winning percentage, and the Aces, with their 19-2 record, have won 90.5% of their games.

POINT GAWD OR SHOOTING GAWD?

Over her last 46 games, including the 2022 postseason (dating to 7/6/22), the 2022 WNBA Final MVP is averaging 16.5 points and 6.5 assists while connecting on 54.7% from the field, 47% from 3-point range, and 91.9% from the free throw line. The Aces are 37-8 over that span.

Only 4 players in WNBA history have averaged more than 16.0 points and 6.0 assists over a full season. None have come close to shooting as well as Gray has over her last 46 games.

A'ja Wilson needs 1 blocked shot to hit the 300-block milestone, a mark achieved by just 5 players in WNBA history, Brittney Griner (746), Candace Parker (619), Elizabeth Williams (396), Elena Delle Donne (343) and Diana Taurasi (336). She is currently tied at <u>No. 6 among active players</u> and <u>has blocked more shots than anyone else since entering the league in 2018.</u>

With her 6 3-pointers against Minnesota on July 9, Kelsey Plum passed Kayla McBride (323) to move into 2nd in franchise history for made 3s. She now has 328, but has a long way to go to overtake Becky Hammon, who owns the franchise record with 498.

FRANCHISE STEALS

Jackie Young (154) broke into the top 10 for franchise steals just before the All-Star break, and is currently tied with Shannon Johnson in the No. 10 spot. Plum (150) is not far back at No. 13, and both will be moving up the ranks of the top 10 for steals in franchise history this season. Sophia Young-Malcolm's 477 tops the list.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

If you want to know which team historically has the best chance at winning the WNBA Championship, look no further than scoring differential—the difference between a team's points scored and points allowed.

In the WNBA's first 26 years, the team that led the league in scoring differential during the regular season won the championship 19 times. The five teams that had a positive double-digit scoring differential all won the title.

ACES IN THE COMMUNITY

\$16,500 AND COUNTING EARNED FOR NAMI SO. NEVADA

For each Commissioner's Cup win this season, teams earn \$2K to donate to a chairty of their choice and \$500 for each loss. The Aces are playing for NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness) Southern Nevada, and have earned \$16,500 for the organization through 9 CC games (standings page 5). The Aces' game against Phoenix marks their their final Commissioner's Cup contest, and they are hoping to up the contribution to NAMI Southern Nevada to \$18,500.

NAMI is the nation's largest grassroots mental health organization dedicated to building better lives for the millions of Americans affected by mental illness, and relies on gifts and contributions to support its important work throughout Southern Nevada.

FLYING ACES

The Aces continue making an impact in the community in a variety of ways. On June 9, BUCKET\$ and Aces staff members visited Nellis Air Force Base where they met with troops, toured the fitness facility and flightline, and passed out Aces gear and tickets for the July 5 "Heroes of the House" Aces game as a way of saying thank you for all they do.

WARNING: EVEN MORE OFFENSIVE

No team in the history of the league has finished the season with a final offensive rating in the teens. In 2019 the Washington Mystics came close with an all-time W record 112.9 offensive rating.

From 1997-2015, it was rare for teams to even round out the year in triple digits. From then, there was a sudden jump and, aside from 2019 when only 3 teams closed the year in triple figures, the majority teams from 2016-2022 finished with a 100+ offensive rating.

It is quite possible that the Aces, <u>currently boasting a 114.7 OER</u>, will not only finish with an offensive rating over 100, but they could set a new high-water mark in the process.

HIGH ROLLERS

The Aces scored 90+ points in each of their first 5 games in 2023, becoming the only team in league history to accomplish that feat. In fact, <u>no other team has scored 90+ in each of the first three games of the season</u>.

Las Vegas also scored 90+ points in 6-straight games dating back to 2022, which is the 2nd longest such streak in W history (Phoenix, 2010, 7 straight). Indiana ended the Aces run by holding them to 84 points on June 4. The Aces have now scored 90+ points in 16 of 21 games this season, including 4 with 100+ points, and are averaging a league-high 94.0 ppg.

IF A T(H)REE FALLS IN THE WOODS ...

Although the Aces have been one of the best 3-point shooting teams over the past 5 years, it wasn't always a big part of their arsenal. In 2022, the Aces utilized the 3-pointer to a much greater degree, and are slightly trailing the use of 3s in 2022 so far this season.

In 2019, Washington Mystics guard/forward Elena Delle Donne became the first, and to date only, member of the WNBA's 50-40-90 club by finishing a season with a field goal percentage of 50% or higher, a 3-point field goal percentage of 40% or higher, and a free throw percentage of 90% or higher while qualifying for league leadership in each category.

Halfway through the season, Chelsea Gray is shooting 51.8% from the field, 45.5% from 3-point range, and 95.2% from the charity stripe in looking for a membership into the exclusive club.

Jackie Young, who is making 57.3% of her field goal attempts, 48.5 from beyond the arc and 79.7% from the line, is closing in on the 50-40-80 club.

BE YOUNG, BE DOPE, BE PROUD

One year after Kelsey Plum took a run at the franchise record for scoring average in a season, A'ja Wilson is pushing to take each of the top 3 spots and Plum and Jackie Young are also making a run for the top 5. The only coaches with an equal or higher winning percentage in league history are Ryan Weisenberg and Karleen Thompson, who combined to go 11-3 (.786) as the co-head coaches of the Los Angeles Sparks in 2004. The duo replaced Michael Cooper who resigned midway through the season to become the head coach of the Denver Nuggets.

SLIDE OVER COACH

Entering 2022, Becky Hammon owned 5 of the top 6 slots on the Aces franchise leader board for made 3s in a season. Kelsey Plum topped that mark in the 26th game of the year last season.

Offensive Rebound Percentages have been declining for years now as teams have relied more and more on the 3-pointer shot as a weapon.

From 1997-2003, no team grabbed fewer than 30 percent of available offensive rebounds.

From 2004-09, 7 teams grabbed fewer than 30 percent.

In 2022, 7 teams finished below 30 percent, including the Aces, whose percentage was the fourth lowest in WNBA history.

This season, 9 teams are below 30 percent, and the 2023 Aces and Mystics are both threatening to break into the low 5 in the category at the end of the season.

Las Vegas' bench averaged a league-record 35.0 points per game in 2020. Only 7 other teams in WNBA history have averaged more than 30 points per game from their reserves. Two years later, in the Aces' championship season, the bench averaged 12.9 points—12th in the league. This year, Las Vegas' reserves are averaging 13.2 points per game (2nd fewest in the league), with the Dallas Wings "leading" the way with 11.7 per game.

You've heard of the double-double, but probably not the double-nickel. That's because the feat of <u>blocking 5 shots and picking up 5 steals</u> in the same game has only been done twice in WNBA history.

Candace Parker was the first to pull it off blocking 6 shots and recording 5 steals as a member of the Los Angeles Sparks in a double overtime game against Indiana on May 29, 2008. Natasha Howard accomplished it while playing for the Seattle Storm in a regulation game against the New York Liberty on August 6, 2018.

AGE IS ONLY A NUMBER

When Candace Parker suited up for the Aces in the team's season opener she became the 6th-oldest player in franchise history to see action in a regular season game.

HEAD COACH BECKY HAMMON



Las Vegas Aces President Nikki Fargas announced on December 31, 2021 that the team hired San Antonio Spurs assistant, and 6-time WNBA All-Star Becky Hammon as the team's head coach. Hammon rewarded the Aces less than nine months later with the fanchise's first WNBA Championship.

The seeds for Hammon's hiring were originally sewn when the Aces retired her jersey on September 13, 2021. That ceremony served as the culmination of the franchise's 25th anniversary alumni initiative, which saw the Aces embrace their Utah and San Antonio roots, and celebrate the players who helped build the franchise and the league from the ground up. Las Vegas owner Mark Davis spent time with Hammon and her family that week, and walked away understandably impressed.

Hammon played 16 seasons in the WNBA, including her final eight in San Antonio, where she led the franchise to its first finals appearance in 2008.

On August 5, 2014, Spurs head coach Gregg Popovich hired Hammon as a full-time assistant making her the first woman in NBA history to hold that position.

Since that time, Hammon has continued to accumulate coaching 'firsts' in the NBA. On July 3, 2015, she became the first woman to serve as head coach in the NBA's Summer League where she led the Spurs to the league title.

Less than a year later, Hammon became the first woman to be part of an All-Star coaching staff, and on December 30, 2020, following Popovich's ejection in San Antonio's game against Los Angeles, Hammon took over on the bench, becoming the first woman acting head coach in the history of the NBA.

A member of the league's 15th, 20th and 25th anniversary teams, Hammon went undrafted in 1999 following her All-American career at Colorado State. She signed with New York as a free agent that same year, helping the team to WNBA Finals appearances in three of her first four years in the Big Apple.

The Rapid City, SD native earned her first All-Star nod in 2003, and represented New York on the Eastern Conference squad in 2005 and 2006 as well.



Following the 2006 season, New York traded Hammon to San Antonio. In her first year in silver and black, she posted what were then career highs in scoring (18.8 ppg), and assists (5.0) while earning another trip to the WNBA All-Star Game. As a team, the Silver Stars made their first appearance in the postseason since 2002, falling to Phoenix in the Western Conference Finals.

In 2008, Hammon led San Antonio to its first trip to the WNBA Finals where they fell to Detroit. The Silver Stars made the playoffs in each of her seven full seasons with the team, and Hammon once again was named to the All-Star team in 2009 and 2011.

She retired as the franchise leader in assists per game (5.1) and scoring average (15.6), and the WNBA leader in career free throw percentage (89.7).

Hammon, who will be inducted into the Naismith Memorial Hall of Fame this year, was inducted into the Colorado Sports Hall of Fame in 2015 and the San Antonio Sports Hall of Fame in 2018.
