

Last Meeting: Washington was one of just 5 teams that grabbed a W against the Aces last year. The last time the teams met, however, the Aces earned an 84-75 win on Aug. 31, 2023, behind 26 points and 11 rebounds from A'ja Wilson and 21 points from Chelsea Gray.

NEXT UP

The Aces return home to play Indiana on July 2 at T-Mobile Arena. The first game, played May 25 in Las Vegas, saw A'ja Wilson record her fourth consecutive 20-plus point, 10-plus rebound game of the season to lead the Aces to a 99-80 victory.

Given all these possibilities, with the exception of 2024 games between the two teams playing today, we have decided not to include any box scores because we are lazy in an effort to rid the planet of unnecessary paper waste. The Aces finished among the top 3 teams in the league for shooting percentage over the past 4 seasons, including an all-time league third-best 48.6% last season.

However, the Aces struggled to find the bottom of the net to start the season, making just 41.8% of their attempts and <u>ranked 7th in the league</u> over their first 9 games. However, over their past 6 games, the Aces have improved to netting 48.5% of their shots from the field, and are steadily moving up the season's leaderboard to 3rd overall at 44.3%.

GOOD GAWD!

Chelsea Gray checked into the June 19 game against Seattle with 1:41 to play in the first quarter. It was her first game played since October 15, 2023, when she injured her left foot in Game 3 of the 2023 WNBA Finals.

She handed out her first assist of the 2024 season 20 seconds later on an Alysha Clark triple. That was also the 1,500th assist of Gray's career. She now has 1,506 and is the https://example.com/9th-player-in-WNBA-history-with-at-least-1,500 assists.

Further, Gray (3,684 points, 1,506 assists) became the 7th player in WNBA history with at least 3,500 points and 1,500 assists, and <u>was the third-fastest to accomplish the feat</u>, doing so in 299 games (Sue Bird, 279; Lindsay Whalen, 294).

MINUTE BY MINUTE

Since the franchise moved to Las Vegas, only one Aces player has logged an average of more than 33 minutes per game (Jackie Young, 33:13 mpg, 2022), although it used to happen with some degree of regularity.

In 2024, however, three Aces are logging at least 33 minutes a game: Kelsey Plum (35:54), whose average ranks second in the W, A'ja Wilson (33:49) and Jackie Young (33:35).

RECORD WATCH

A'ja Wilson is on pace to raise the franchise career scoring record ahead of the All-Star/Olympic break. Sophia Young-Malcolm scored an even 4,300 points in her 9 years in San Antonio and Wilson should have that record midway through her 7th season in Las Vegas. It also is one of the few franchise scoring records not yet owned by Wilson. She has the records most games with 15+ points (160), 20+ points (118), 25+ points (50), 30+ points (18), 35+ points (8) and 40+ points (2).

Over the past two seasons, the Aces have been rewriting their home attendance record books, and made WNBA history by becoming the first team in the league to sell out 100% of their home games in a season

- The 8 Las Vegas home games played in 2024 are the top 8 attendance marks ever for the Aces at Michelob ULTRA Arena.
- After seeing attendance averages hit no higher than 5,606 over their first four seasons in Las Vegas, the Aces upped their average to 9,551 fans per game in 2023, and are on pace to surpass that number in 2024 with an average of 10,379 over their first 8 games.
- The Aces sold out of their season-ticket memberships in early March and had 7 full sellouts by the third week in April, breaking the Las Vegas record of 6 regular season sellouts set in 2023.
- The attendance mark of **10,424** against New York on June 15 is the largest crowd ever for an Aces game at Michelob ULTRA Arena.
- The Las Vegas Aces welcomed 10,000 or more fans at 20 home games since arriving in the Valley in 2018—3 of which came in 2022, 9 were in 2023 and 8 (and counting) in 2024.
- They listed a franchise-high 17,406 fans at T-Mobile Arena in their final 2023 regular season game against the Mercury on Sept. 10, eclipsing the previous regular season record of 15,657, set on Aug. 4,1998, when the Utah Starzz played host to the Houston Comets.
- Three nights later, the Aces rewrote their playoff attendance record since arriving in Las Vegas with 12,927 fans at T-Mobile Arena for their first game of the First Round against the Sky. The franchise high for a playoff game is 16,012, set Oct. 3, 2008, when the San Antonio Stars hosted the Detroit Shock in the Finals.

RECORD-SETTING NIGHT

Las Vegas established a new franchise record for points in a quarter with 42 in the second period against Phoenix on June 13 with the help of a WNBA single-quarter record 10 made 3-pointers. They also broke the league mark for most made 3s in a quarter without a miss (10 of 10).

CENTURY MARK

The Aces scored 100 or more points in 7 games in 2021 and 2022, and upped that to a WNBA record-setting 11 times in 2023. The WNBA record for most times reaching the century mark in a season was previously 10, set by the 2010 Phoenix Mercury.

While it's still early in her WNBA coaching career, not only did Becky Hammon lead the Aces to the their first championship during her inaugural season at the helm and follow that up with back-to-back titles in 2023, but she also boasts the highest winning percentage of any coach in WNBA history for those who have coached at least 50 games.

When Jackie Young turned 25 on September 16, 2022, she had 87 regular season wins to her credit—one off the record for most wins prior to turning 25, held by Lynx legend Maya Moore (88).

Mwadi Mabika held the league mark for wins through her 26th birthday until Jackie Young, at 25 years, 329 days, passed Mabika on Aug. 11, 2023, and now owns the record outright with 121.

Looking ahead to Young's 27th birthday this year, <u>Moore owns the</u>
<u>No. 1 slot for wins before turning 27 with 137</u>, and Young will need 8 more victories prior to September 16, 2024, to claim that record outright.

#### **PARIS BOUND (USA VERSION)**

On June 11 it was announced that Chelsea Gray, Kelsey Plum, A'ja Wilson and Jackie Young would become two-time Olympians later this summer. USA Basketball named the four Aces All-Stars and WNBA champions as members of the USA National Team that will represent our country at the 2024 Olympics in Paris. Gray and Wilson previously earned Olympic gold in Tokyo playing the traditional five-on-five version of the game, while Plum and Young were part of the team that claimed the first Olympic 3x3 gold medal ever awarded.



#### PARIS BOUND (AZERBAIJAN VERSION)

Tiffany Hayes became a naturalized Azerbaijani citizen in 2015 in order to play 3x3 hoops for the small nation at the 2015 European Games. Fast forward to 2024. Hayes recently led Azerbaijan to a berth into the 3x3 Olympic tournament, claiming gold at the first 2024 FIBA 3x3 Universality Tournament held April 12-14 in Hong Kong. Hayes was named MVP after averaging a team-high 6.5 ppg (5th best in the tournament). Sidelined by injury in her team's lone loss of the tournament, Hayes returned to tally 8 points and 11 rebounds in the semifinal and 6 points and 3 assists in the final.

#### R-E, R-E-B, R-E-B-O-U-N-D, RE-BOUND

Since 2019, the Aces recorded <u>4 of the 5 highest defensive rebounds</u> per game averages in WNBA history.

Further, the Aces hold the top 2 marks for <u>most defensive rebounds in a regulation game in WNBA history</u>, with 44 at Seattle on May 20, 2023, and 43 at Los Angeles on July 1, 2022. Phoenix had 47 defensive boards against San Antonio on June 7, 2014, but in a double overtime contest.

A'ja Wilson (22.8), Kelsey Plum (18.7), Jackie Young (17.6) and Chelsea Gray (15.3) finished last year as the first four teammates in WNBA history to average 15 or more points per game in the same season.

#### **SHOOTING OFF FIREWORKS**

The Aces led the W in 2023 with 92.8 ppg, 4.8 bpg, 48.6% shooting from the field, 54.9% from 2-point, 84% from the line, a +12.6 scoring differential, a WNBA-record for offensive efficiency rating at 113.0, 97.7 defensive efficiency rating, 15.3 net rating and 1.85 assist-to-turnover ratio, and a league-low 11.8 turnovers a game. They missed out on leading in all 4 shooting percentage categories after dropping to 37.2% from 3-point range, just behind NY's 37.4%.

#### **WNBA1K**

On Sept. 26, 2023, against Dallas in the WNBA Semifinals, A'ja Wilson became the first player in league history to score 1,000 points in a single year when combining regular season and postseason points.

#### **HEAD COACH BECKY HAMMON**



Las Vegas Aces President Nikki Fargas announced on December 31, 2021, that the team hired San Antonio Spurs assistant and 6-time WNBA All-Star Becky Hammon as the team's head coach.

Hammon rewarded the Aces less than nine months later with the fanchise's first WNBA Championship.

She repeated that feat in her second season, helping the Aces become the first team to claim back-to-back WNBA titles in more than 20 years.

In her first two years with the Aces, Las Vegas tallied a 60-16 (.789) mark

in the regular season, 16-3 (.842) in playoff games and also captured the 2022 Commissioner's Cup crown.

The seeds for Hammon's hiring were originally sewn when the Aces retired her jersey on September 13, 2021. That ceremony served as the culmination of the franchise's 25th anniversary alumni initiative, which saw the Aces embrace their Utah and San Antonio roots, and celebrate the players who helped build the franchise and the league from the ground up. Las Vegas owner Mark Davis spent time with Hammon and her family that week, and walked away understandably impressed.

Hammon played 16 seasons in the WNBA, including her final eight in San Antonio, where she led the franchise to its first finals appearance in 2008.

On August 5, 2014, Spurs head coach Gregg Popovich hired Hammon as a full-time assistant making her the first woman in NBA history to hold that position.

Since that time, Hammon continued to accumulate coaching 'firsts' in the NBA. On July 3, 2015, she became the first woman to serve as head coach in the NBA's Summer League where she led the Spurs to the league title.

Less than a year later, Hammon became the first woman to be part of an All-Star coaching staff, and on December 30, 2020, following Popovich's ejection in San Antonio's game against Los Angeles, Hammon took over on the bench, becoming the first woman acting head coach in the history of the NBA.

A member of the league's 15th, 20th and 25th anniversary teams, Hammon went undrafted in 1999 following her All-American career at Colorado State. She signed with New York as a free agent that same year, helping the team to WNBA Finals appearances in three of her first four years in the Big Apple.



The Rapid City, South Dakota native earned her first All-Star nod in 2003, and represented New York on the Eastern Conference squad in 2005 and 2006 as well.

Following the 2006 season, New York traded Hammon to San Antonio. In her first year in silver and black, she posted what were then career highs in scoring (18.8 ppg), and assists (5.0) while earning another trip to the WNBA All-Star Game. As a team, the Silver Stars made their first appearance in the postseason since 2002, falling to Phoenix in the Western Conference Finals.

In 2008, Hammon led San Antonio to its first trip to the WNBA Finals where they fell to Detroit. The Silver Stars made the playoffs in each of her seven full seasons with the team, and Hammon once again was named to the All-Star team in 2009 and 2011.

She retired as the franchise leader in assists per game (5.1) and scoring average (15.6), and the WNBA leader in career free throw percentage (89.7).

Hammon, who was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Hall of Fame on Aug. 12, 2023, was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in 2022, the Colorado Sports Hall of Fame in 2015 and the San Antonio Sports Hall of Fame in 2018.
