#### **LUCKY NO. 8**

On June 7 Chelsea Gray became the <u>8th player in WNBA history</u> to tally at least 4,000 points, 1,000 rebounds and 1,500 assists. She was the second-fastest (332 games) and second-youngest (32 years, 242 days) to ever reach the milestone. Lindsay Whalen holds both No. 1 slots after achieving the mark in her 328th game at 31 years and 114 days.

#### 2 CUBED x 5 TO THE 4TH

Before leaving the game on June 11 with a head injury, A'ja Wilson had amassed 4,949 career points. When she returns to the court, she will need just 51 more to become 28th player in WNBA history to score 5,000 or more points.

However, Wilson, who has played in 235 games and will be 28 years and 316 days on June 20, 2025, could reach the goal in the fewest games played and could be the second youngest to achieve the feat.

Kayla McBride is also on the verge of 5,000 points (4,943), but has played in 342 games and has been in the league four years more than Wilson.

Breanna Stewart, who scored her 5,000th career point in **242 games**, is currently the fastest to the mark and is one of only two players in league history to score her 5,000th point in fewer than 250 games.

Lauren Jackson (**28 years**, **96 days**) and Diana Taurasi (29 years, 34 days) hold the top two youngest spots.

## 30/10 IN 2025 & BEYOND

Only <u>three 30/10 double-doubles</u> have been recorded in 2025. A'ja Wilson has posted two of those three. Napheesa Collier has the other one.

With 18 (and counting) Wilson also has recorded the <u>most double-doubles with 30+ points in league history</u>. Tina Charles and Breanna Stewart have 15 apiece.

## **NEXT WOMAN UP**

Today could be the fourth game without A'ja Wilson in the lineup due to a head injury suffered on June 11.

To underscore the importance of having the 3-time M'VP on the floor, Wilson is not only the Aces leader in most statistical categories this year, <a href="mailto:she only player in league history to average 20+ points">she is the only player in league history to average 20+ points</a>, 9+ rebounds, 4+ assists, 2+ steals and 2+ blocks per game in a season.

Veterans Chelsea Gray, Jewell Loyd, Kiah Stokes and Jackie Young, however, have stepped up in Wilson's absence.

## **PAY TO PLAY**

Over her WNBA career, A'ja Wilson has missed out on a trip to the free throw line just 5 times. The first came in her 145th game on Aug. 4, 2022; in 2023 she experienced a void in free throw attempts on June 18 and Aug. 24; in 2024 her lone non-free throw attempted game was on July 4 and her 5th career game not stepping to the line was on June 1, 2025.

## THE QUICKENING CONTINUES

Only 5 players in league history have compiled <u>5,000 points</u>, <u>2,000 rebounds</u>, <u>500 assists</u>, <u>400 blocked shots and 200 steals</u>. Lisa Leslie and Candace Parker hold the league record for fastest to hit those marks, having done so in 287 games. Parker was the youngest to achieve that milestone, at 32 years and 108 days.

A'ja Wilson is on the verge of shattering those records to become the youngest and fastest to the milestone.

After dishing out 5 assists versus Washington on May 23, 2025, Wilson became the 6th player in WNBA history to have at least 4,500 points, 2,000 rebounds, 500 assists, 400 blocked shots and 200 steals. Not only that, but she did so in 230 games, 28 games faster than the previous fastest, Lisa Leslie (258 games), and at 28 years and 288 days, was the youngest on the list to reach the milestone (Candace Parker, 31 years, 127 days).

## A'JA DOUBLES THE MONTHS

Wilson became the first player in WNBA history to average at least 25 points and 10 rebounds in two consecutive months, after doing so in May and June 2024. She then upped the streak to 5, through September of 2024.

While she didn't make it 6 in a row, Wilson still holds the high-water mark for most consecutive months with 20+ points and 10+ rebounds with 6 from May 2024 through May 2025.

## **SCORING DIP**

The Aces have topped the league's scoring charts every year from 2020-2024, including averaging 92.8 points in 2023, the second-highest scoring output in league history. In fact, the past five seasons are the top five scoring years in franchise history, which should come as no surprise with A'ja Wilson finishing among the top six in the league each of those years -- including a league-record 26.9 ppg in 2024.

However, the Aces scoring this year has dipped to the lowest since arriving in Las Vegas.

Kierstan Bell—Was sidelined most of 2024 and averaged 7.2 minutes in 6 regular season games ... has seen action in 8 games this year and after averaging 1.6 ppg and 1.0 rpg and shooting 27.3% from the floor in fewer than 7 minutes a game over her first 5 games, improved to 5.3 ppg and 2.7 rpg and 41.7% from the floor in 12.2 minutes over her last 3 games

<u>Dana Evans</u>—Scored at least 5 points in her first 7 and 8 of 11 games in 2025...dished out 2+ assists in 8 of 11 games this year after doing so in just 5 of her last 10 of 2024...Shot 57.1% (4-7 FGs) from the field on May 17, but has made just 28.3% (17-60 FGs) of her attempts since then (is a 36.2% field goal shooter)...Combined for 1 of 8 from 3-point in her last 4 games after hitting 46.7% (7-15 3pt FGs) in her previous 5.

Through the 2024 season, only 5 players in WNBA history averaged more than 20 points and fewer than 2.0 turnovers over the course of a season. A'ja Wilson has now accomplished the feat 4 times (2018, 2020, 2023 and 2024), which ranks 2nd behind Breanna Stewart (5). Elena Delle Donne and Lauren Jackson are 3rd with 3 such seasons apiece and Tina Charles joined the list in 2016. Wilson's 26.9 points a game in 2024 tops the chart and her 1.26 turnovers per game ranks No. 4.

#### **CAN'T TOUCH THIS**

Entering the 2025 season, there had been 104 different occasions where a player averaged 15 or more shots per game while playing in at least 20 games—the very definition of a team's go-to offensive player.

Of those 104 instances, 65 shot 45% or worse from the field. Only 7 times has a player shot better than 50% from the field. Wilson became the first player to do it twice in her career after first doing so in 2023.

Of those who have previously accomplished this feat, most took fewer than 16 shots. Wilson in 2024 took 19.6 shots per game—more than 2 shots more per game than the next person on the list, Seimone Augustus.

Point Gawd Chelsea Gray, who is known for her magician-like no-look passes, ranks 7th on the WNBA's career assist chart with 1,665 assists. She could surpass No. 6 Becky Hammon (1,708) in the second half of the season.

## **LOW ON RESERVES?**

In the first four years in Las Vegas, in the Bill Laimbeer era, the Aces turned to their bench for points production more than most other teams in the league. And in fact, in 2020 the Aces bench averaged a league-record 35.0 points per game.

Only 7 other teams in WNBA history averaged more than 30 points per game from their reserves.

Two years later, in the Aces first championship season, the bench averaged a league-low 12.9 points. En route to their second championship the 2024 reserves averaged 13.5 points a game, again the fewest in the league. The Aces bench in 2024 scored 15.0 points a game, which was the 4th-fewest in the league and this year's reserves are contributing a league 2nd-lowest 16.2 points.

A'ja Wilson's 2024 usage rating (the percentage of a team's possessions that a player impacts) of 32.16 was the <u>9th highest in league history</u>. None of the 8 players ahead of her had amazingly efficient offensive seasons. Most of the offensive efficiency ratings (OER) and offensive win shares (OWS) listed are above average to good, but there is nothing great about these performances.

## LOOK AT ALL THE PEOPLE HERE TONIGHT

Over the past two seasons, the Aces have been rewriting their home attendance record books, and in 2024 made WNBA history by becoming the first team in the league to sell out 100% of their home games in a season. The Aces sold out their entire season ticket membership inventory for the 2025 season last August—the earliest any team had ever done so.

- The Aces have sold out 31 straight home games, dating to Game 1 of the 2023 WNBA Finals.
- On July 2, 2024, there were 20,366 in attendance at T-Mobile Arena, which was the fifth-most attended game in WNBA regular season history and the most since 1999.
- The franchise-high 20,366 fans at T-Mobile Arena against Indiana on July 2 eclipsed the previous regular season record of 17,406, set on Sept. 10, 2023, when the Aces played host to the Mercury.
- Prior to this season, the top 10 attendance marks for Las Vegas Aces games played at Michelob ULTRA Arena came in 2024. However, 4 of the 5 games at MUA in 2025 have jumped into the MUA top 10 list.
- After seeing attendance averages hit no higher than 5,606 over their first four seasons in Las Vegas, the Aces upped their average to 9,551 fans per game in 2023, and surpassed that number in 2024 with an average of 11,283 over their 20 regular season home games.
- The Aces sold out of their 2024 season-ticket memberships in early March and had 7 full sellouts by the third week in April, breaking the Las Vegas record of 6 regular season sellouts set in 2023.
- The Aces sold out of their 2025 season-ticket memberships in August 2024, the earliest any W team had ever done so.
- The attendance mark of 10,431 against Connecticut on Sept. 15 is the largest crowd ever for an Aces game at Michelob ULTRA Arena.
- The Las Vegas Aces have welcomed 10,000 or more fans at 35 home games since arriving in the Valley in 2018—3 of which came in 2022, 9 were in 2023 and 23 in 2024.
- On Sept. 13, 2023, the Aces rewrote their playoff attendance record since arriving in Las Vegas with 12,927 fans at T-Mobile Arena for their first game of the First Round against the Sky. The franchise high for a playoff game is 16,012, set Oct. 3, 2008, when the San Antonio Stars hosted the Detroit Shock in the Finals.
- On Oct 8, 2023, against New York, the Aces welcomed the most fans ever to attend a playoff game in Michelob ULTRA Arena (10,300). That mark has since been eclipsed numerous times.
- The Aces ranked 1st in the W in attendance in 2023 with the help of 6 sold out games and 3rd in 2024 after 20 sellouts. The Aces also sold out 2 playoff games in 2024.

## **HEAD COACH BECKY HAMMON**



Las Vegas Aces President Nikki Fargas announced on December 31, 2021, that the team hired San Antonio Spurs assistant and 6-time WNBA All-Star Becky Hammon as the team's head coach.

Hammon rewarded the Aces less than nine months later with the fanchise's first WNBA Championship.

She repeated that feat in her second season, helping the Aces become the first team to claim back-to-back WNBA titles in more than 20 years.

While the Aces 3-peat bid fell short in Hammon's third season, the injuryhampered team still advanced to the

WNBA Semifinals and finished fourth in league play.

In her first three years with the Aces, Las Vegas tallied a 77-29 (.726) mark in the regular season, 19-6 (.760) in playoff games and also captured the 2022 Commissioner's Cup crown.

The seeds for Hammon's hiring were originally sewn when the Aces retired her jersey on September 13, 2021. That ceremony served as the culmination of the franchise's 25th anniversary alumni initiative, which saw the Aces embrace their Utah and San Antonio roots, and celebrate the players who helped build the franchise and the league from the ground up. Las Vegas owner Mark Davis spent time with Hammon and her family that week, and walked away understandably impressed.

Hammon played 16 seasons in the WNBA, including her final eight in San Antonio, where she led the franchise to its first finals appearance in 2008.

On August 5, 2014, Spurs head coach Gregg Popovich hired Hammon as a full-time assistant making her the first woman in NBA history to hold that position.

Since that time, Hammon continued to accumulate coaching 'firsts' in the NBA. On July 3, 2015, she became the first woman to serve as head coach in the NBA's Summer League where she led the Spurs to the league title.

Less than a year later, Hammon became the first woman to be part of an All-Star coaching staff, and on December 30, 2020, following Popovich's ejection in San Antonio's game against Los Angeles, Hammon took over on the bench, becoming the first woman acting head coach in the history of the NBA.

A member of the league's 15th, 20th and 25th anniversary teams, Hammon went undrafted in 1999 following her All-American career at Colorado State. She signed with New York as a free agent that same year, helping the team to WNBA Finals appearances in three of her first four years in the Big Apple.




The Rapid City, South Dakota native earned her first All-Star nod in 2003, and represented New York on the Eastern Conference squad in 2005 and 2006 as well.

Following the 2006 season, New York traded Hammon to San Antonio. In her first year in silver and black, she posted what were then career highs in scoring (18.8 ppg), and assists (5.0) while earning another trip to the WNBA All-Star Game. As a team, the Silver Stars made their first appearance in the postseason since 2002, falling to Phoenix in the Western Conference Finals.

In 2008, Hammon led San Antonio to its first trip to the WNBA Finals where they fell to Detroit. The Silver Stars made the playoffs in each of her seven full seasons with the team, and Hammon once again was named to the All-Star team in 2009 and 2011.

She retired as the franchise leader in assists per game (5.1) and scoring average (15.6), and the WNBA leader in career free throw percentage (89.7).

Hammon, who was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Hall of Fame on Aug. 12, 2023, was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in 2022, the Colorado Sports Hall of Fame in 2015 and the San Antonio Sports Hall of Fame in 2018.


