When Los Angeles and Indiana face-off on Wednesday, it will be the first of three meetings between these cross-country foes in 2016. Indiana currently has a 7-9 record, sitting in fourth place in the Eastern Conference. The Sparks hold an advantage on the offensive end, ranking third in the WNBA with 85.8 points per game, while the Fever sit at 11th in the WNBA with 79.5 points per game. Indiana also struggles to knock down the three-point shot, making just 28.3% of its shots beyond the arc, while Los Angeles excels with the deep ball, hitting 38.9% of its three-pointers. The Fever are the best free-throw shooting team in the league, hitting 84.1% of its shot attempts from the charity stripe.

SPARK PLUGS

GETTING IT DONE THE HARD WAY

The Sparks 15-1 record is the best in the WNBA, but it hasn't always come easy. In LA's last three games the team trailed its opponents at halftime before staging second-half comebacks and emerging victorious in all three contests. In those games, Los Angeles has averaged 35.7 points in the first half, while allowing 42.7 first-half points. The Sparks have been able to turn the tide in the second half of those contests, scoring an average of 49.3 points over the final 20 minutes, while giving up just 34.7 points in the second half.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING

While 2016 is a year to celebrate with the 24th Summer Olympics and the WNBA's 20th season, it also marks a season without a WNBA All-Star game. For Sparks forward **Nneka Ogwumike** – this is the second time in her career she has put together an All-Star caliber start to the season, with no All-Star game. The first time was her rookie season (2012), when Ogwumike eventually went on to win Rookie of the Year. This season, she is setting WNBA records, career-highs and making her mark in league history through 16 games and making a case for MVP. Not only is she curently leading the WNBA with a 70.4% clip from the field, she also has an opportunity to break the league record of a 66.8 shooting percentage by Tamika Raymond in 2003.

NNEKA'S RECENT DOMINANCE

Nneka Ogwumike is arguably off to her best career start, largely due to her recent play. Since 6/7 against New York, Ogwumike has shot 74-for-97 from the field, good for an incredible 76.3% mark. No player with at least an average of at least eight shot attempts per game has ever shot that well over a nine-game stretch, as proof of her dominance. In her most recent game against the Atlanta Dream, Ogwumike recorded a career-high 37 points on 13-of-14 shooting from the floor, including 24 points in the second half to seal the victory. She also recorded her 7th double-double of the season, the most of any Sparks player.

HISTORICAL START

With the Sparks 84-75 victory on Thursday, Los Angeles equaled the 1998 Houston Comets with a 15-1 record to open the season. Houston went on to start the season 20-1 before finishing with a 27-3 record. The Sparks have a chance to break the Comets record on 7/17 against Atlanta. Los Angeles' best franchise-record over the course of a season was 28-4 in 2000, when the Sparks went on to a WNBA Championship.

DOMINANCE DOWN-LOW

Although the Sparks have been one of the league's best outside-shooting teams in 2016, they have not had any difficulty scoring in the paint over the past two games. Los Angeles is averaging 54.0 points in the paint in its recent victories over Dallas and Atlanta, helping to make up for just a combined 7 made three-pointers in those games. After trailing in the category in 9 of its first 15 games, the Sparks newfound emphasis on utilizing the paint has paid huge dividends over the past two games.

LEAVE IT TO THE STARTERS

While the Sparks have been one of the league's most balanced teams all season, Los Angeles has also been rewarded with some fantastic performances from its starting five. Thursday's game against Atlanta was no different, with the Sparks starting five scoring 80 of the team's 84 points in the victory. Los Angeles has utilized the same starting lineup in all 16 of its games, which has paid huge dividends with their league-best 15-1 record. For the season, the Sparks starters are averaging 66.3 points per game, while shooting a combined 50.7% from the field.

COMEBACK FOR THE AGES

After falling behind by 22 points to the Dallas Wings on Tuesday night, the Sparks tied the franchises largest comeback victory in 20 years with a strong performance to close out the win. After trailing 58-36 with 7:41 in the third quarter, the Sparks closed out the game on a 53-26 run to pull out the 89-84 victory at STAPLES Center. Los Angeles was led by an inspired **Candace Parker**, who scored 25 of her 31 points in the second half. The Sparks shot 55.6% in the second half to pull off one of the team's most impressive victories of the season.

STEPPING UP HER GAME

The Sparks have had several different contributors en route to a 15-1 start to the season, and guard **Essence Carson** has been one of the team's keys in 2016, especially of late. The veteran guard has scored in double-figures in eight of her last ten games, after not reaching that mark in the first six games of the season. For the year, **Carson** is averaging 9.1 points per game, her highest mark since the 2013 season with the New York Liberty. She also ranks fourth in the WNBA with a 46.4% mark from three-point range, the highest of her career.

SHARP-SHOOTER

Two-time WNBA All-Star **Kristi Toliver** has had one of her best all-around seasons in 2016, averaging 14.3 points per game, the second-highest scoring output of her career (17.5 in 2012). **Toliver** has improved her scoring largely due to some stellar shooting from three-point range, where she ranks third in the WNBA with a 46.1% mark from beyond the arc. Her 45 made three-pointers are only three behind league leader Sugar Rodgers, who has 16 more attempts from long-range. **Toliver** has also scored in double-figures in 14 of the team's 16 games, including a season-high 25 points against Minnesota on 6/24. The 5-7 guard also has 61 assists compared to only 16 turnovers, good for a 3.8-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio that ranks 1st in the WNBA.

HIGH PERCENTAGE SHOOTERS

The Sparks currently sit atop the league's best offenses with a WNBA-best 48.9% field goal percentage on the year. Los Angeles has shot 50.0% or better in 8 of 16 games, averaging 93.4 points per game in those contests, and winning each of the eight games by an average of 19.0 points per game. The Sparks have six of the top-40 shooters in the WNBA, including all five of its starters.

SPARK PLUGS

IRON WOMAN

Forward **Jantel Lavender**, has now played in 154 consecutive regular season games for the Sparks. **Lavender** is currently tied for the most consecutively-played games in franchise history with Delisha Milton-Jones. When she checks in to today's game for the Sparks, **Lavender** will become the franchise record-holder for most consecutive games played, showing how she has been a symbol of consistency in Los Angeles in recent years. She was the only player to see action in all 34 games of the 2015 season for Los Angeles, and looks poised to accomplish the feat as well this year.

THREE-POINT LINE DOMINANCE

Very rarely in sports is there a team that completely dominates one aspect of the game as well as the Sparks control the three-point line. The Sparks are currently shooting 38.9% from beyond the arc, a mark that currently leads the league. Led by sharpshooters **Kristi Toliver** (48.4/3rd) and **Essence Carson** (46.4/4th) who rank in the top-10 of qualified shooters (at least one made three-pointer per game). Overall, 9 of the 12 Sparks players have made a three-pointer on the season. However, Los Angeles is also the league's best team in terms of defending the three-point line, allowing opponents to shoot just 26.7% from deep.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Not only are the Sparks one of the top offensive teams in the league, they also lead the WNBA with just 72.8 points per game allowed,

almost five points better than the nearest competition. One explanation of the dominant defensive effort is their 9.2 steals per game, the most in the league. Los Angeles also defends 3-pointers at an extremely strong rate, allowing opponents to knock down just .267% of shots from deep. Minnesota is the only other team to rank in the top-5 in both offensive and defensive scoring.

ATOP THE LEADERBOARD

Nneka Ogwumike currently sits at 8th in points per game with her mark of 17.1, while teammate Candace Parker isn't far behind with 16.3 points per game, 10th in the league. Kristi **Toliver** also finds herself in the top 15, sitting at 15th in the league with 14.7 points per game. Los Angeles is the only team with three top-15 scorers in the league, showing the Sparks emphasis on offensive balance. Ogwumike (68.3%/1st), Jantel Lavender (50.4%/13th), Kristi Toliver (46.8/22nd) and Alana Beard (46.7%/23rd) also rank in the top-25 of the WNBA, shooting some of the highest percentages in the league. In regards to the three-point shot, Toliver (48.9%/3rd) and Essence Carson (44.4%/4th) each sit in the top-10 from behind the arc. Not only are Parker and Toliver scoring at a high level, but the two Sparks' veterans are sharing the ball as well, both ranking in the top-20 of assists with 4.6 and 3.5 assists, respectively. While the Sparks are statistically one of the lowest-rebounding teams in the WNBA, **Ogwumike** currently brings in 8.5 boards per contest, good for 5th in the league.

HEAD COACH BRIAN AGLER (2nd Season)

On January 5, 2015, Brian Agler joined the Los Angeles Sparks as the 12th head coach in franchise history, bringing with him over 30 years of head-coaching experience, including 11 in the WNBA.

In his first season with LA and 12th in the WNBA, Agler led the Sparks to a league-best 15th postseason appearance, finishing 4th in the Western Conference standings (14-20). The all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball history, Agler enters the 2016 season two wins shy of 200 career WNBA (198) regular season wins to go along with his 78 wins in the ABL.

Agler came to the Sparks from Seattle, where he led the Storm to six consecutive playoff appearances (2008-2013) in seven years. He compiled a 136-102 (.571) record during his time in the Pacific Northwest, including his 212th career (WNBA and ABL) victory in 2012. The win on June 1 against the Tulsa Shock moved him past Van Chancellor (211), former coach of the Houston Comets, to become the all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball.

In 2010 the Storm captured the league's championship title, its second, with an impressive regular season record of 28-6 and an undefeated playoff record of 7-0. Additionally, Coach Agler was recognized as the WNBA's Coach of the Year. Prior to joining the Storm in 2008, Agler was the head coach and general manager of the expansion team Minnesota Lynx from 1999-2002, where he compiled a 42-54 (.438) record. Before being named the first coach of the expansion Lynx, Agler served as the head coach of the Columbus Quest of the ABL from 1996-1999, compiling an 82-22 record. He led the Quest to back-to-back ABL championships in 1997 and 1998 and was named the ABL Coach of the Year for the 1996-97 season.

Agler completed his third season as an assistant coach for the San Antonio Silver Stars in 2007. Prior to joining San Antonio, he served as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Mercury in 2004 and helped guide the team to a 17-17 record after the Mercury finished with an 8-26 record in 2003.

Agler spent 15 seasons coaching among the collegiate ranks, including 13 seasons as a head coach. He posted an impressive collegiate record of 248-135 (.648 winning percentage). From 1993-96 he served as the head women's basketball coach at Kansas State. In 1998, Agler took over as the head women's coach at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. In five seasons at UMKC, Agler was 85-54 and took the Kangaroos from a 9-16 record in 1988-89 to four straight winning seasons with 17 or more victories.

As the head women's basketball coach at Northeast Oklahoma A&M Junior College from 1984-88, Agler compiled a 124-42 record (.747 winning percentage). In 1985-86, NEO A&M was ranked second nationally and posted a 30-2 record.

Agler attended Wittenberg University in Springfield, Ohio, where he starred on the basketball team for four seasons. He led the Tigers to their only NCAA Division III Championship in basketball as a freshman. He started all 112 games during his college career, leaving the school as the all-time assist leader (481). Agler helped lead his team to a 91-21 record during his four years with the Tigers, and was named most valuable player in the Ohio Athletic Conference and first-team All-America as a senior. In 1995, he was inducted into the Wittenberg Hall of Honor.

ASSISTANT COACH AMBER STOCKS (2nd Season)

Amber Stocks joined the Los Angeles Sparks coaching staff on April 14, 2015, bringing with her 13 years of coaching experience both in the WNBA and at the collegiate level.

A veteran women's collegiate basketball coach and analyst, Stocks joins Los Angeles for her first coaching stint in the WNBA. Most recently she served the past year as a men's and women's basketball analyst for ESPN3 and Big East Digital Network. Prior to moving to the television side, she was the program director and head coach of the Tucson HEAT Basketball Association in Arizona (2009-2013).

Stocks served as an assistant women's basketball coach at Xavier University from 2002-2009. During her years with Xavier, she helped put together six 20-win seasons and six national postseason appearances, including four NCAA Tournaments. Prior to joining Xavier in 2002, Stocks spent two seasons as women's director of basketball operations for the University of Tennessee, working closely with then Lady Vols head coach Pat Summitt on the daily operations of the program. She was part of the staff that helped lead Tennessee to two regular season SEC Championships and advanced to the 2002 Final Four.

Stocks is also a certified strength and conditioning coach, overseeing strength and conditioning at the University of Notre Dame (1999-2000) and serving on the staff for the University of Cincinnati and Xavier (1998 – 1999) during her undergraduate careers.

She attended the University of Cincinnati where she was a four-time Bearcat Scholar honoree, three-time Defensive Player Award recipient and helped lead the Bearcats to a Conference USA Championship. She graduated from UC in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in health promotion and education.

ASSISTANT COACH TONYA EDWARDS (1st Season)

Tonya Edwards enters her first season as an assistant coach with the Sparks, bringing 18 years of coaching experience to her first coaching stint in the WNBA.

Edwards is reunited with head coach Brian Agler whom she played for in both the ABL (Columbus Quest) and the WNBA (Minnesota Lynx). Drafted in 1999 by Agler, then head coach of the Lynx, she was named a WNBA All-Star as a rookie, and went on to play five seasons in the league with Minnesota, Phoenix, and Charlotte before finishing her playing career overseas

Most recently, Edwards served as the head coach of Alcorn State University (2008-15), where she led the Lady Braves to the SWAC Championship game in 2012 and was named 2010-11 SWAC Coach of the Year. Prior to Alcorn State, Edwards served as an assistant coach at the University of Detroit-Mercy (2006-08), the Chicago Blaze (2005) of the National Women's Basketball League and two seasons at Mott Community College (1990-92).

Her coaching career began at her alma mater, Northwestern Community High School, where she earned a 78-23 record in four seasons (1991-94), winning a state title in 1993 while subsequently being named the Michigan High School Coach of the Year.

Edwards attended the University of Tennessee (1986-1990), where she won two national championships with the Lady Vols (1987, 1989) and was named most valuable player in the 1987 NCAA Tournament. She finished her career with 1,309 points and was inducted into the UT Hall of Fame in 2006.
