- The Sparks rank third in the league in terms of scoring offense, averaging 85.7 points per game. The Mystics have not had the same success on offense, ranking 8th in the league with 81.5 points per game.
- Washington does hold a distinct advantage on the boards, bringing in 34.1 rebounds per game, compared to 30.6 by the Sparks.

Los Angeles and Chicago are set to face off for the third and final time of the 2016 regular season on July 13. Each of their previous clashes this season have been high-scoring affairs, with the Sparks winning both games behind an average of 95.5 points per game in the two contests. The Sky currently find themselves at 7-10, good for 4th place in the Eastern Conference. Chicago ranks fifth in the league with 84.3 points per game, however it ranks fifth-worst in scoring defense, allowing 84.3 points per game. Both teams shoot the ball at an incredibly high rate, with the Sparks leading the WNBA with a 49.1% clip on the year, with the Sky ranking third with a 46.1% mark. Chicago does hold an edge in the battle of the boards, with the Sky ranking 3rd in the league with 35.9 rebounds, while Los Angeles sits at 11th with an average of 30.6.

SPARK PLUGS

NNEKA EARNS PLAYER OF THE MONTH HONORS

Sparks forward **Nneka Ogwumike** earned Western Conference Player of the Month honors for her performance in the month of June. **Ogwumike** averaged 19.7 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.8 assists in leading the Sparks through a 10-1 month. She shot a blistering 73.3% from the floor, improving her league-leading field goal percentage to 70.1% on the year. The award was Ogwumike's first Player of the Month honor in her five-year career, and was the first Sparks player to win since Candace Parker in August of 2015.

ACROSS THE BOARD

With the victory over Indiana on Wednesday, Los Angeles became the first team in the league to defeat all 11 other teams at least once in 2016. The Sparks currently are 7-1 against its Western Conference foes, while boasting a perfect 10-0 record against its opponents from the East. No other team in WNBA history has ever defeated every other team in the league after just 18 games.

NEW YEAR, NEW TEAM

Last year, Los Angeles began with a 4-14 record to open the season, averaging just 71.4 points per game while giving up 76.7 points per game. The Sparks have completely bucked that trend in 2016, currently sitting with a league-best 17-1 record largely due to the league's best scoring defense (73.3 ppg allowed) and the WNBA's third-best offense (85.7 ppg). Los Angeles only shot 31.8% from three-point range through 18 games last year, but currently knocks down a league-high 39.1% of its shots from beyond the arc. The Sparks have started the same lineup in all 16 games this year, after utilizing 10 in 18 games a year ago.

WELCOME TO THE BLOCK PARTY

Los Angeles ranks 7th in the WNBA with 3.9 blocks per game, but the Sparks have seemingly turned up its interior presence with 22 blocks over the past three games. **Nneka Ogwumike** has been the biggest factor in the recent success down-low, recording 10 blocks in the past three victories, including a career-best 5 against the Atlanta Dream on June 30. The Sparks had not had more than five blocks as a team in any game before June 30, but have surpassed that total in each of the past two games.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING

While 2016 is a year to celebrate with the 24th Summer Olympics and the WNBA's 20th season, it also marks a season without a WNBA All-Star game. For Sparks forward **Nneka Ogwumike** – this is the second time in her career she has put together an All-Star caliber start to the season, with no All-Star game. The first time was her rookie season (2012), when Ogwumike eventually went on to win Rookie of the Year. This season, she is setting WNBA records, career-highs and making her mark in league history through 18 games and making a case for MVP. Not only is she curently leading the WNBA with a 70.1% clip from the field, she also has an opportunity to break the league record of a 66.8 shooting percentage by Tamika Raymond in 2003.

HISTORICAL START

With the Sparks 94-88 victory over Indiana on Wednesday, Los Angeles tied the 1998 Houston Comets with a 17-1 record to open the season. Houston went on to start 20-1 before finishing with a 27-3 record and winning the WNBA Championship. The Sparks have a chance to break the Comets record on 7/17 against Atlanta with four more wins. Los Angeles' best franchise record in a season was 28-4 in 2000, when the Sparks won a WNBA Championship. Of the three teams in WNBA history to start a season 12-1 or better, two have won the WNBA Finals (1998 Comets, 2002 Sparks) while the 2012 Lynx lost in the Finals.

LEAVE IT TO THE STARTERS

While the Sparks have been one of the league's most balanced teams all year, Los Angeles has also been rewarded with some fantastic performances from its starters. Its past three games against Atlanta, New York and Indiana have been no different, with the Sparks starting five scoring 80 of the team's 84 points against the Dream, 68 of 77 points against the Liberty and 76 of 94 points against the Fever. Los Angeles has started the same lineup in all 18 games, en route to a league-best 17-1 record. For the season, the Sparks starters average 67.4 points per game and shoot a combined 51.3% from the field.

NNEKA'S RECENT DOMINANCE

Since 6/7 against New York, Ogwumike has shot 93-for-125 from the field, good for an incredible 74.4% mark. No player with at least an average of at least eight shot attempts per game has ever shot that well over an eleven-game stretch, as proof of her dominance. On 6/30 against the Atlanta Dream, Ogwumike recorded a career-high 37 points on 13-of-14 shooting from the floor, including 24 points in the second half to seal the victory. She currently has a team-high 9 double-doubles on the season.

SHARP-SHOOTER

Two-time WNBA All-Star **Kristi Toliver** has had one of her best all-around seasons in 2016, averaging 14.4 points per game, the second-highest scoring output of her career (17.5 in 2012). **Toliver** has improved her scoring largely due to some stellar shooting from three-point range, where she ranks fourth in the WNBA with a 46.7% mark from beyond the arc. Her 49 made three-pointers are only eight behind league leader Sugar Rodgers, who has 26 more attempts from long-range. **Toliver** has also scored in double-figures in 16 of the team's 18 games, including a season-high 25 points against Minnesota on 6/24. The 5-7 guard also has 70 assists compared to only 21 turnovers, good for a 3.3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio that ranks 1st in the WNBA.

HIGH PERCENTAGE SHOOTERS

The Sparks currently sit atop the league's best offenses with a WNBA-best 49.4% field goal percentage on the year. Los Angeles has shot 50.0% or better in 10 of 18 games, averaging 91.8 points per game in those contests, and winning each of the nine games by an average of 25.8 points per game.

SPARK PLUGS

STEPPING UP HER GAME

The Sparks have had several different contributors in their 17-1 start to the season, and guard **Essence Carson** has been one of the team's keys in 2016, especially of late. The veteran guard has scored in double-figures in eight of her last 12 games, after not reaching that mark in the first six games this year. For the year, **Carson** is averaging 8.9 points per game, her highest mark since 2013 with the New York Liberty. She also ranks 3rd in the WNBA with a 46.9% mark from three-point range, the highest of her career.

THREE-POINT LINE DOMINANCE

Very rarely in sports is there a team that completely dominates one aspect of the game as well as the Sparks control the three-point line. The Sparks are currently shooting 39.1% from beyond the arc, a mark that leads the league. Led by sharpshooters **Essence Carson** (46.9/3rd) and **Kristi Toliver** (46.7/4th) who rank in the top-5 of qualified shooters (at least one made three-pointer per game). Overall, 9 of the 12 Sparks players have made a three-pointer on the season. However, Los Angeles is also the league's best team in terms of defending the three-point line, allowing opponents to shoot just 28.1% from deep. New York is the only other team in the league to rank in the top-3 in both categories.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Not only are the Sparks one of the top offensive teams in the league, they also lead the WNBA with just 73.3 points per game allowed,

almost four points better than the nearest competition. One explanation of the dominant defensive effort is their 9.1 steals per game, the most in the league. Los Angeles also defends 3-pointers at an extremely strong rate, allowing opponents to knock down just 26.8% of shots from deep. Minnesota is the only other team to rank in the top-5 in both offensive and defensive scoring.

ATOP THE LEADERBOARD

Nneka Ogwumike currently sits at 6th in points per game with her mark of 18.9, while teammate Candace Parker isn't far behind with 16.4 points per game, 9th in the league. Kristi **Toliver** also finds herself in the top 20, sitting at 17th in the league with 14.4 points per game. Los Angeles is the only team with three top-20 scorers in the league, showing the Sparks emphasis on offensive balance. Ogwumike (70.1%/1st), Jantel Lavender (50.0%/13th), Alana Beard (48.0%/19th) and Carson (47.2%/20th) also rank in the top-20 of the WNBA, shooting some of the highest percentages in the league. In regards to the threepoint shot, Carson (46.9%/3rd) and Toliver (46.7%/4th) each sit in the top-5 from beyond the arc. Not only are Parker and Toliver scoring at a high level, but the two Sparks'veterans are sharing the ball as well, both ranking in the top-20 of assists with 4.6 and 3.9 assists, respectively. While the Sparks are statistically one of the lowest-rebounding teams in the WNBA, **Ogwumike** currently brings in 8.4 boards per contest, good for 4th in the league in that category.

HEAD COACH BRIAN AGLER (2nd Season)

On January 5, 2015, Brian Agler joined the Los Angeles Sparks as the 12th head coach in franchise history, bringing with him over 30 years of head-coaching experience, including 11 in the WNBA.

In his first season with LA and 12th in the WNBA, Agler led the Sparks to a league-best 15th postseason appearance, finishing 4th in the Western Conference standings (14-20). The all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball history, Agler enters the 2016 season two wins shy of 200 career WNBA (198) regular season wins to go along with his 78 wins in the ABL.

Agler came to the Sparks from Seattle, where he led the Storm to six consecutive playoff appearances (2008-2013) in seven years. He compiled a 136-102 (.571) record during his time in the Pacific Northwest, including his 212th career (WNBA and ABL) victory in 2012. The win on June 1 against the Tulsa Shock moved him past Van Chancellor (211), former coach of the Houston Comets, to become the all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball.

In 2010 the Storm captured the league's championship title, its second, with an impressive regular season record of 28-6 and an undefeated playoff record of 7-0. Additionally, Coach Agler was recognized as the WNBA's Coach of the Year. Prior to joining the Storm in 2008, Agler was the head coach and general manager of the expansion team Minnesota Lynx from 1999-2002, where he compiled a 42-54 (.438) record. Before being named the first coach of the expansion Lynx, Agler served as the head coach of the Columbus Quest of the ABL from 1996-1999, compiling an 82-22 record. He led the Quest to back-to-back ABL championships in 1997 and 1998 and was named the ABL Coach of the Year for the 1996-97 season.

Agler completed his third season as an assistant coach for the San Antonio Silver Stars in 2007. Prior to joining San Antonio, he served as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Mercury in 2004 and helped guide the team to a 17-17 record after the Mercury finished with an 8-26 record in 2003.

Agler spent 15 seasons coaching among the collegiate ranks, including 13 seasons as a head coach. He posted an impressive collegiate record of 248-135 (.648 winning percentage). From 1993-96 he served as the head women's basketball coach at Kansas State. In 1998, Agler took over as the head women's coach at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. In five seasons at UMKC, Agler was 85-54 and took the Kangaroos from a 9-16 record in 1988-89 to four straight winning seasons with 17 or more victories.

As the head women's basketball coach at Northeast Oklahoma A&M Junior College from 1984-88, Agler compiled a 124-42 record (.747 winning percentage). In 1985-86, NEO A&M was ranked second nationally and posted a 30-2 record.

Agler attended Wittenberg University in Springfield, Ohio, where he starred on the basketball team for four seasons. He led the Tigers to their only NCAA Division III Championship in basketball as a freshman. He started all 112 games during his college career, leaving the school as the all-time assist leader (481). Agler helped lead his team to a 91-21 record during his four years with the Tigers, and was named most valuable player in the Ohio Athletic Conference and first-team All-America as a senior. In 1995, he was inducted into the Wittenberg Hall of Honor.

ASSISTANT COACH AMBER STOCKS (2nd Season)

Amber Stocks joined the Los Angeles Sparks coaching staff on April 14, 2015, bringing with her 13 years of coaching experience both in the WNBA and at the collegiate level.

A veteran women's collegiate basketball coach and analyst, Stocks joins Los Angeles for her first coaching stint in the WNBA. Most recently she served the past year as a men's and women's basketball analyst for ESPN3 and Big East Digital Network. Prior to moving to the television side, she was the program director and head coach of the Tucson HEAT Basketball Association in Arizona (2009-2013).

Stocks served as an assistant women's basketball coach at Xavier University from 2002-2009. During her years with Xavier, she helped put together six 20-win seasons and six national postseason appearances, including four NCAA Tournaments. Prior to joining Xavier in 2002, Stocks spent two seasons as women's director of basketball operations for the University of Tennessee, working closely with then Lady Vols head coach Pat Summitt on the daily operations of the program. She was part of the staff that helped lead Tennessee to two regular season SEC Championships and advanced to the 2002 Final Four.

Stocks is also a certified strength and conditioning coach, overseeing strength and conditioning at the University of Notre Dame (1999-2000) and serving on the staff for the University of Cincinnati and Xavier (1998 – 1999) during her undergraduate careers.

She attended the University of Cincinnati where she was a four-time Bearcat Scholar honoree, three-time Defensive Player Award recipient and helped lead the Bearcats to a Conference USA Championship. She graduated from UC in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in health promotion and education.

ASSISTANT COACH TONYA EDWARDS (1st Season)

Tonya Edwards enters her first season as an assistant coach with the Sparks, bringing 18 years of coaching experience to her first coaching stint in the WNBA.

Edwards is reunited with head coach Brian Agler whom she played for in both the ABL (Columbus Quest) and the WNBA (Minnesota Lynx). Drafted in 1999 by Agler, then head coach of the Lynx, she was named a WNBA All-Star as a rookie, and went on to play five seasons in the league with Minnesota, Phoenix, and Charlotte before finishing her playing career overseas

Most recently, Edwards served as the head coach of Alcorn State University (2008-15), where she led the Lady Braves to the SWAC Championship game in 2012 and was named 2010-11 SWAC Coach of the Year. Prior to Alcorn State, Edwards served as an assistant coach at the University of Detroit-Mercy (2006-08), the Chicago Blaze (2005) of the National Women's Basketball League and two seasons at Mott Community College (1990-92).

Her coaching career began at her alma mater, Northwestern Community High School, where she earned a 78-23 record in four seasons (1991-94), winning a state title in 1993 while subsequently being named the Michigan High School Coach of the Year.

Edwards attended the University of Tennessee (1986-1990), where she won two national championships with the Lady Vols (1987, 1989) and was named most valuable player in the 1987 NCAA Tournament. She finished her career with 1,309 points and was inducted into the UT Hall of Fame in 2006.
