Los Angeles and Atlanta are set to face-off for the second time in 2016 on Sunday. The Sparks won their first meeting, emerging victorious by a single-digit margin over the Dream on June 30th by a score of 84 to 75. The Dream currently sit at 11-10, good for 2nd place in the Eastern Conference. Atlanta has struggled to shoot the ball this season, ranking 10th in the league with a 40.9% clip from the floor, compared to a 50.0% shooting mark by the Sparks. The Dream are also the league's worst three-point shooting team, knocking down just 26.5% of its shots from beyond the arc. The Sparks, on the other hand, lead the WNBA with a 39.2% three-point shooting mark. Atlanta enters play as the 2nd-leading rebounding team in the league with an average of 36.7 boards per game, while Los Angeles brings in 30.9 rebounds per game, ranking 10th in the league.

SPARK PLUGS

COMFORTABLE ON THE ROAD

After sweeping a six-game homestand, the Sparks began its current five-game road trip with a 77-67 victory over Chicago on Wednesday, improving to 8-0 on the road this season. LA's undefeated road mark has tied the 2016 Minnesota Lynx for the best road record to start a season. The Sparks will have an opportunity to set a WNBA record with a victory over Connecticut today, which would make them 9-0 on the road this season, the most road wins without a loss in league history. The 1998 Houston Comets hold the best road record over the course of an entire season, going 13-2 on the road, good for an .867 winning percentage on the year.

UNSTOPPABLE FROM THE FLOOR

Nneka Ogumike's 2016 campaign has featured several impressive performances, including her historic 12-for-12 game against the Dallas Wings on June 11th, where she set a WNBA record for most made shot attempts without a miss. She has also recorded three other halves of perfect shooting, in the first half of games against the Chicago Sky on 6/14 (6-for-6) and 7/13 (6-for-6), as well as the second half against Atlanta on 6/30 (7-for-7). Ogumike has finished within two missed shots from recording three perfect games this season, but has still recorded three separate perfect halves in 2016, a WNBA record for a player who has taken at least six shot attempts in a each of the perfect halves.

SOME ASSISTANCE REQUIRED

The Sparks assisted on 24 consecutive field goals against the Chicago Sky on Wednesday, its longest such streak of the season. Los Angeles finished the game with 28 assists, only two behind its season-high of 30 against the New York Liberty on June 7th. L.A. currently leads the WNBA with an average of 21.6 assists per game, a mark that would break the franchise-record of 18.8 set in 2013.

COAST-TO-COAST SUCCESS

With the victory over Chicago on Wednesday, Los Angeles improved to 12-0 against Eastern Conference opponents this season. The Sparks are currently the only WNBA team to be undefeated against an entire conference, with its lone loss coming to Western Conference foe, Minnesota. Los Angeles has outscored its opponents from the East by an 87.5-to-69.6 margin this season, after going just 4-8 against Eastern Conference opponents in 2015.

NNEKA EARNS PLAYER OF THE MONTH HONORS

Sparks forward **Nneka Ogumike** earned Western Conference Player of the Month honors for her performance in the month of June. **Ogumike** averaged 19.7 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.8 assists in leading the Sparks through a 10-1 month. She shot a blistering 73.3% from the floor, improving her league-leading field goal percentage to 70.1% on the year. The award was Ogumike's first Player of the Month honor in her five-year career, and was the first Sparks player to win since Candace Parker in August of 2015.

HISTORY IN THE MAKING

While 2016 is a year to celebrate with the 24th Summer Olympics and the WNBA's 20th season, it also marks a season without a WNBA All-Star game. For Sparks forward **Nneka Ogumike** – this is the second time in her career she has put together an All-Star caliber start to the season, with no All-Star game. The first time was her rookie season (2012), when Ogumike eventually went on to win Rookie of the Year. This season, she is setting WNBA records and making a case for MVP. Not only is she currently leading the WNBA with a 71.2% clip from the field, she also has an opportunity to break the league record of a 66.8% mark by Tamika Raymond in 2003.

HISTORICAL START

With the Sparks 77-67 victory over Chicago on Wednesday, Los Angeles tied the 1998 Houston Comets with an 19-1 record to start the season. Houston went on to open 20-1 before finishing with a 27-3 record and winning the WNBA Championship. The Sparks have a chance to break the Comets record on 7/17 against Atlanta with two more wins. Los Angeles' best franchise record in a season was 28-4 in 2000, when the Sparks won a WNBA Championship. Of the three teams in WNBA history to start a season 12-1 or better, two have won the WNBA Finals (1998 Comets, 2002 Sparks) while the 2012 Lynx lost in the Finals.

NNEKA'S RECENT DOMINANCE

Since 6/7 against New York, Ogumike has shot 113-for-150 from the field, good for an incredible 75.3% mark. No player with at least an average of at least eight shot attempts per game has ever shot that well over a 13-game stretch, as proof of her dominance. On 6/30 against the Atlanta Dream, Ogumike recorded a career-high 37 points on 13-of-14 shooting from the floor, including 24 points in the second half to seal the victory. She currently has a team-high 9 double-doubles on the season.

SHARP-SHOOTER

Two-time WNBA All-Star **Kristi Toliver** has had one of her best all-around seasons in 2016, averaging 14.1 points per game, the second-highest scoring output of her career (17.5 in 2012). **Toliver** has improved her scoring largely due to some stellar shooting from three-point range, where she ranks third in the WNBA with a 46.1% mark from beyond the arc. Her 53 made three-pointers are only 13 behind league leader Sugar Rodgers, who has 34 more attempts from long-range. **Toliver** has also scored in double-figures in 17 of the team's 20 games, including a season-high 25 points against Minnesota on 6/24. The 5-7 guard has knocked down at least one three-pointer in every game this year.

HIGH PERCENTAGE SHOOTERS

The Sparks currently sit atop the league's best offenses with a WNBA-best 50.0% field goal percentage on the year. Los Angeles has shot 50.0% or better in 12 of 20 games, averaging 90.6 points per game in those contests, and winning each of the nine games by an average of 24.5 points per game.

SPARK PLUGS

LEAVE IT TO THE STARTERS

While the Sparks have been one of the league's most balanced teams all year, Los Angeles has also been rewarded with some fantastic performances from its starters. Its past five games against Atlanta, New York, Indiana, Washington and Chicago have been no different, with the Sparks starting five scoring 80 of the team's 84 points against the Dream, 68 of 77 points against the Liberty, 76 of 94 points against the Fever, 72 of 93 points against the Mystics and 59 of 77 points against the Sky. Los Angeles has started the same lineup in all 20 games, en route to a league-best 19-1 record.

THREE-POINT LINE DOMINANCE

Very rarely in sports is there a team that completely dominates one aspect of the game as well as the Sparks control the three-point line. The Sparks are currently shooting 39.2% from beyond the arc, a mark that leads the league. Led by sharpshooters **Kristi Toliver** (46.1/3rd) and **Essence Carson** (45.9/4th) who rank in the top-five of qualified shooters. Overall, 9 of the 12 Sparks players have made a three-pointer on the season. However, Los Angeles is also the league's best team in terms of defending the three-point line, allowing opponents to shoot just 29.1% from deep. New York is the only other team in the league to rank in the top-3 in both categories.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Not only are the Sparks one of the top offensive teams in the league, they also lead the WNBA with just 73.5 points per game allowed,

almost three points better than the nearest competition. One explanation of the dominant defensive effort is their 8.8 steals per game, the second-most in the league. Los Angeles also defends 3-pointers at an extremely strong rate, allowing opponents to knock down just 29.1% of shots from deep. Minnesota is the only other team to rank in the top-5 in both offensive and defensive scoring.

ATOP THE LEADERBOARD

Nneka Ogumike currently sits at 7th in points per game with her mark of 19.1, while teammate **Candace Parker** isn't far behind with 16.7 points per game, 9th in the league. **Kristi Toliver** also finds herself in the top 20, sitting at 19th in the league with 14.1 points per game. Los Angeles is the only team with three top-20 scorers in the league, showing the Sparks emphasis on offensive balance. **Ogumike** (71.2%/1st), **Jantel Lavender** (53.2%/14th), **Alana Beard** (48.5%/17th) and **Essence Carson** (47.1%/24th) also rank in the top-25 of the WNBA, shooting some of the highest percentages in the league. In regards to the three-point shot, **Toliver** (46.1%/3rd) and **Carson** (45.9%/4th) each sit in the top-five from beyond the arc. Not only are **Parker** and **Toliver** scoring at a high level, but the two Sparks' veterans are sharing the ball as well, both ranking in the top-15 of assists with 5.0 and 3.9 assists, respectively. While the Sparks are one of the lowest-rebounding teams in the WNBA, **Ogumike** currently brings in 8.5 boards per contest, good for 5th in the league.

HEAD COACH BRIAN AGLER (2nd Season)

On January 5, 2015, Brian Agler joined the Los Angeles Sparks as the 12th head coach in franchise history, bringing with him over 30 years of head-coaching experience, including 11 in the WNBA.

In his first season with LA and 12th in the WNBA, Agler led the Sparks to a league-best 15th postseason appearance, finishing 4th in the Western Conference standings (14-20). The all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball history, Agler enters the 2016 season two wins shy of 200 career WNBA (198) regular season wins to go along with his 78 wins in the ABL.

Agler came to the Sparks from Seattle, where he led the Storm to six consecutive playoff appearances (2008-2013) in seven years. He compiled a 136-102 (.571) record during his time in the Pacific Northwest, including his 212th career (WNBA and ABL) victory in 2012. The win on June 1 against the Tulsa Shock moved him past Van Chancellor (211), former coach of the Houston Comets, to become the all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball.

In 2010 the Storm captured the league's championship title, its second, with an impressive regular season record of 28-6 and an undefeated playoff record of 7-0. Additionally, Coach Agler was recognized as the WNBA's Coach of the Year. Prior to joining the Storm in 2008, Agler was the head coach and general manager of the expansion team Minnesota Lynx from 1999-2002, where he compiled a 42-54 (.438) record. Before being named the first coach of the expansion Lynx, Agler served as the head coach of the Columbus Quest of the ABL from 1996-1999, compiling an 82-22 record. He led the Quest to back-to-back ABL championships in 1997 and 1998 and was named the ABL Coach of the Year for the 1996-97 season.

Agler completed his third season as an assistant coach for the San Antonio Silver Stars in 2007. Prior to joining San Antonio, he served as an assistant coach with the Phoenix Mercury in 2004 and helped guide the team to a 17-17 record after the Mercury finished with an 8-26 record in 2003.

Agler spent 15 seasons coaching among the collegiate ranks, including 13 seasons as a head coach. He posted an impressive collegiate record of 248-135 (.648 winning percentage). From 1993-96 he served as the head women's basketball coach at Kansas State. In 1998, Agler took over as the head women's coach at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. In five seasons at UMKC, Agler was 85-54 and took the Kangaroos from a 9-16 record in 1988-89 to four straight winning seasons with 17 or more victories.

As the head women's basketball coach at Northeast Oklahoma A&M Junior College from 1984-88, Agler compiled a 124-42 record (.747 winning percentage). In 1985-86, NEO A&M was ranked second nationally and posted a 30-2 record.

Agler attended Wittenberg University in Springfield, Ohio, where he starred on the basketball team for four seasons. He led the Tigers to their only NCAA Division III Championship in basketball as a freshman. He started all 112 games during his college career, leaving the school as the all-time assist leader (481). Agler helped lead his team to a 91-21 record during his four years with the Tigers, and was named most valuable player in the Ohio Athletic Conference and first-team All-America as a senior. In 1995, he was inducted into the Wittenberg Hall of Honor.

ASSISTANT COACH AMBER STOCKS (2nd Season)

Amber Stocks joined the Los Angeles Sparks coaching staff on April 14, 2015, bringing with her 13 years of coaching experience both in the WNBA and at the collegiate level.

A veteran women's collegiate basketball coach and analyst, Stocks joins Los Angeles for her first coaching stint in the WNBA. Most recently she served the past year as a men's and women's basketball analyst for ESPN3 and Big East Digital Network. Prior to moving to the television side, she was the program director and head coach of the Tucson HEAT Basketball Association in Arizona (2009-2013).

Stocks served as an assistant women's basketball coach at Xavier University from 2002-2009. During her years with Xavier, she helped put together six 20-win seasons and six national postseason appearances, including four NCAA Tournaments. Prior to joining Xavier in 2002, Stocks spent two seasons as women's director of basketball operations for the University of Tennessee, working closely with then Lady Vols head coach Pat Summitt on the daily operations of the program. She was part of the staff that helped lead Tennessee to two regular season SEC Championships and advanced to the 2002 Final Four.

Stocks is also a certified strength and conditioning coach, overseeing strength and conditioning at the University of Notre Dame (1999-2000) and serving on the staff for the University of Cincinnati and Xavier (1998 – 1999) during her undergraduate careers.

She attended the University of Cincinnati where she was a four-time Bearcat Scholar honoree, three-time Defensive Player Award recipient and helped lead the Bearcats to a Conference USA Championship. She graduated from UC in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in health promotion and education.

ASSISTANT COACH TONYA EDWARDS (1st Season)

Tonya Edwards enters her first season as an assistant coach with the Sparks, bringing 18 years of coaching experience to her first coaching stint in the WNBA.

Edwards is reunited with head coach Brian Agler whom she played for in both the ABL (Columbus Quest) and the WNBA (Minnesota Lynx). Drafted in 1999 by Agler, then head coach of the Lynx, she was named a WNBA All-Star as a rookie, and went on to play five seasons in the league with Minnesota, Phoenix, and Charlotte before finishing her playing career overseas.

Most recently, Edwards served as the head coach of Alcorn State University (2008-15), where she led the Lady Braves to the SWAC Championship game in 2012 and was named 2010-11 SWAC Coach of the Year. Prior to Alcorn State, Edwards served as an assistant coach at the University of Detroit-Mercy (2006-08), the Chicago Blaze (2005) of the National Women's Basketball League and two seasons at Mott Community College (1990-92).

Her coaching career began at her alma mater, Northwestern Community High School, where she earned a 78-23 record in four seasons (1991-94), winning a state title in 1993 while subsequently being named the Michigan High School Coach of the Year.

Edwards attended the University of Tennessee (1986-1990), where she won two national championships with the Lady Vols (1987, 1989) and was named most valuable player in the 1987 NCAA Tournament. She finished her career with 1,309 points and was inducted into the UT Hall of Fame in 2006.
