The 2017 season has eyes to be one of the most exciting seasons yet, as the Los Angeles Sparks acquire top prospects such as Sydney Wiese in the draft, while also obtaining bignames Odyssey Sims and Tiffany Jackson-Jones through trades this offseason. Although these strong additions to the already-stacked 2016 WNBA Champion roster will offer some incredible basketball, this is also the season for three teams to frivolously fight for their fourth title.

Although the Phoenix Mercury barely clinched the playoffs last season with a final record of 16-18, they are not a team to trifle with. Brittney Griner, three-time All-Star, signed a long-term contract during the offseason, ensuring that she'll be a rock in Phoenix. This will bring Phoenix some muchneeded stability and drive as she and Taurasi return from Russia, and this momentum will propel them into the 2017 season. It certainly won't be anything short of interesting watching these two veterans lead their team, and there's no doubt

they'll become a strong contender for the fourth trophy.

With a better record than the Sparks last season (28-6), the Minnesota Lynx are pawing at the opportunity to dig a grave for the Sparks this year. The Sparks can count on the Lynx forcing them to sweat over every single point. With four Olympian-athletes' ambitions strongly-embedded in the Lynx game-winning mindset, training camp showcased some incredible improvements. Minnesota shifted to transforming their shooting game during training camp, and an adjustment to Brunson's arc is already a promising edge to their offense. The Lynx are starving for a victory and redemption this season, and it's clear that a fourth trophy is the only thing that will satisfy this ravenous team.

Meanwhile, the Los Angeles Sparks are welcoming straight, raw talent to their championship roster.

With the starting five already being a force to reckon with, the Sparks acquired Odyssey Sims and Tiffany Jackson-Jones during the offseason. Sims averaged 16.7 PPG while being awarded Rookie of the Month (twice) and being named to the WNBA All-Rookie Team in her first year. She averaged 21.3 PPG in the Turkish league during the offseason and will join the Sparks on the court with sure intensity. Jackson-Jones was the #5 pick in the 2007 draft and continued to bring power to her team in Israel with 16.7 PPG and 8.2RPG this offseason once her final year with the Tulsa Shock came to a close. Los Angeles also looks forward to showcase draft picks Sydney Wiese (11th pick, point guard) and Saicha Grand-Allen (35th pick, center). These additions to the Los Angeles champions will bring new power and grit to the court as they combat Phoenix and Minnesota.

There's a lot to say about what's in store for the 2017 season, but "sensational" and "edge-of-your-seat anticipation" are a few of them, as we watch the race to be the first active WNBA team with four championship trophies.






