- •The Sparks remain perfect at home with a 5-0 record on the season.
- Sparks now are on a current win streak of 8 versus the Stars, and home winning streak of 5. The Sparks lead the franchise series 47-30.
- Sparks defense limited the Stars to just 26 in the first half, a new season opponent low. The Stars 11 points in the first and 15 in the second quarter were the second lowest allowed by the Sparks in each quarter this season.
- The Sparks tied a season high lead at any time for a second straight game leading by 22 at 3:08 in the second quarter.
- The Stars started the third quarter with a 20-4 run before Jantel Lavender responded with three straight jump shots, then Chelsea Gray would finish the quarter with a buzzer beater driving bank jump shot.
- Essence Carson tied her season high with 2 steals in the first quarter. She would finish the night with 2 rebounds, 1 assist, and score 2 points.
- Jantel Lavender lead the Sparks bench with 17 minutes, shooting 3-5 from the field, 2-3 from the free throw line, grabbed 4 boards, had 1 assist, 1 block, and scored 8 points.
- Alana Beard would lead the Sparks in minutes recording a season high 37 minutes, shooting 3-4 from the field, collecting 5 rebounds, dishing out 3 assists. 1 steal. and scored 6 points.
- Candace Parker would lead the Sparks offense with 20 points shooting 7-15 from the field, 6-7 from the free throw line, recovered 4 rebounds, 4 assists, 1 steal, and 2 blocks in 34 minutes.
- Sparks guard Chelsea Gray continued her offensive surge recording 19 points, shooting 5-9 from the field, 1-1 from 3-point range, a career high 8-9 from the free throw line, 2 rebounds, 3 assists, and 1 steal in 33 minutes.
- Nneka Ogwumike led the game with 9 boards, 16 points shooting 5-12 from the field, 6-7 free throw line, dishing out 2 assists, and 1 block in 30 minutes of play.

San Antonio Stars Notes:

- •The Stars held the Sparks to only 12 points in the third quarter, tying the least amount of points San Antonio has allowed an opponent in a single quarter this season. They also held the Mercury to 12 points during the fourth quarter on May 19.
- Los Angeles' 34 second-half points ties the fewest points scored in a half by an opponent this season. Previously, Phoenix (May 19) and Chicago (June 10) also scored 34 points in a half.
- Isabelle Harrison scored the first 20-plus points game of her career with 22 points. Harrison scored 16 points in the second half, which ties her previous career-high scored against Phoenix on May 19 and Connecticut on June 3. She also registered a career-high 4 assists. She previously notched 3 at Minnesota on May 28.
- Moriah Jefferson scored 19 of her 24 total points in the second half to set a new season high. She previously scored 18 points versus Chicago on June 10.
- Kayla McBride grabbed a season-high 7 rebounds. She previously recorded 6 rebounds in 3 games this season. She also recorded a season-high 5 assists. She previously tallied 4 assists at Minnesota on May 28.

-The Sparks were able to hang on in Phoenix to edge out the first win of the season series.

-Phoenix's Diana Taurasi continues her climb up the WNBA All-time scoring leader boards.

-The Sparks defense will need to limit Griner (WNBA's leading PPG player) and Taurasi to ensure a Sparks win.

LAST GAME RE-CAP:

 Sparks trailed by 9 points to start the game, but rebounded and finished the 1st quarter leading 19-18.

• Alana Beard's 600th career steal lead to her 1,662st field goal made at 3:40 in the 2nd quarter. Beard would finish the night with 35:26 minutes, shooting 4-6 from the field, prefect from distance 1-1 (her first 3FG this season), 3-4 from the line, recovered 2 boards, dished out 3 assists, picked up 2 steals, and a block for 12 points

 2nd time this season all Sparks starters reached double digit points in a game (other time was at Indiana on 5/24). Chelsea Gray had a strong performance playing a season high 35:45 minutes, shooting 8-13 from the field, 1-4 from

behind the arch, 7-10 from the free-throw line (season and career high), scoring a team high 24 points, collecting 3 rebounds, tied a career and season high 8 assists, a steal and a block.

Diana Taurasi had 27 points on 8-of-16 shooting, including 6-of-10 from beyond the arc, to go with three rebounds. With her fourth made field goal, Taurasi passed Tamika Catchings (2,385) for second on the WNBA's all-time field goals made list. Taurasi scored 15+ points for the sixth straight game, her longest streak since May 18-June 7, 2014.

Brittney Griner finished with 21 points on 7-of-14 shooting, nine rebounds and five assists. Griner earned her second-longest career streak of scoring 10+ points, now at 14 regular season games (career-long is 15 games from July 6-Aug. 12, 2014). She has averaged 28.3 points on 57.4 percent shooting, 9.8 rebounds and 3.3 assists in her last four games. Griner set a new season-high with her five assists.

BRIAN AGLER BIOGRAPHY

WNBA Head Coaching Record: 231-200 Los Angeles Sparks Head Coaching Record: 47-31 Seasons in the WNBA: 14th Season Seasons with the Sparks: 3rd Season

HEAD COACH BRIAN AGLER

On Jan. 5, 2015, Agler became the 12th head coach in Los Angeles Sparks history, bringing with him over 30 years of head-coaching experience, including 11 in the WNBA. In his first season with LA, Agler led the Sparks to a league-best 15th postseason appearance. Just one year later he led them to a 26-8 regular season mark and the 2016 WNBA championship, the third league title in the franchise's history.

Along the way, three Sparks players earned major WNBA awards in 2016 -- Nneka Ogwumike (league MVP); Candace (Finals MVP); and Jantel Lavender (Sixth Woman of the Year). The 2016 championship, when coupled with the one captured by his Seattle Storm in 2010, made Agler the first head coach in WNBA history to guide two different franchises to a title.

The all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball history in the U.S. with 296 regular-season victories, Aglerenters the 2017 campaign with 224 wins as a WNBA head coach and 72 from his tenure in the ABL. On June 6, 2017, when the Sparks faced the Chicago Sky at the Staples Center, Head Coach Brian Agler notched his **300th** regular season career win as a head coach.

Immediately prior to joining the Sparks, Agler spent seven seasons (2008-14) at the helm of the Storm, guiding Seattle to the playoffs in each of his first six campaigns and compiling an overall regular-season record of 136-102 (.571) during his tenure there. In 2010, when Agler was recognized as the WNBA Coach of the Year, his Storm – led by league MVP Lauren Jackson and All-Star Sue Bird – captured the franchise's second WNBA title with an impressive regular 28-6 season record and a 7-0 run through the postseason.

Agler first joined the WNBA as Head Coach and GM of the expansion Minnesota Lynx from 1999-2002, where he compiled a 42-54 (.438) record. Following that, Agler was an assistant with the Phoenix Mercury in 2004 before spending 2005-07 as an assistant with the San Antonio Stars.

Agler's move to the WNBA's Lynx in 1999 followed three seasons as head coach of the ABL's Columbus Quest from 1996-1999, when his teams compiled a 72-18 regular-season record and a 10-4 mark in the postseason. Agler led the Quest to back-to-back ABL championships in 1997 and 1998 and was the ABL Coach of the Year for the 1996-97 campaign.

Agler spent 15 seasons coaching in the collegiate ranks, including 13 seasons as a head coach. He posted an impressive collegiate record of 248-135 (.648 winning percentage). From 1993-96 he served as the head women's basketball coach at Kansas State. In 1998, Agler took over as the head women's coach at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. In five seasons at UMKC, Agler was 85-54 and took the Kangaroos from a 9-16 record in 1988-89 to four straight winning seasons. Under his direction, UMKC led the NCAA in scoring defense three straight seasons (1990-93). In 1991, UMKC set an NCAA record, allowing just 51.8 points per game.

As the head women's basketball coach at Northeast Oklahoma A&M Junior College from 1984-88, Agler compiled a 124-42 record. In 1985-86, NEO A&M ranked second nationally at 30-2.

Agler attended Wittenberg University (Springfield, Oh.), where he starred on the basketball team, leading the Tigers to their only NCAA Division III basketball championship in basketball as a freshman. He started all 112 games during his career, leaving the school as the all-time assist leader (481). Agler was the MVP of the Ohio Athletic Conference and first-team All-America as a senior. In 1995, he was inducted into the Wittenberg Hall of Honor.
