•The Sparks continue their winning streak of 6 consecutive wins, now (10-3) and 1-0 against the Connecticut Sun this season

 Sparks closed the first quarter leading the Sun by 10 points, 27-17, after a 16-6 run and shooting 63.2%.

 Nneka Ogwumike started the Sparks off strong scoring the first 9 points for the Sparks. Ogwumike shot 6-6 from the floor to led all scorers with 13 points in the first quarter.

•Alana Beard continued her strong defensive play with one steal at 1:39 mark in the first quarter and is tied with Jia Perkins on the WNBA all-time leaders list with 609.

Ogwumike would finish the 1st half leading all scorers with 17 points shooting a perfect 8-8 from the floor, and led the Sparks with 5 rebounds.

•For the third game in a row the Sparks started the 3rd quarter off strong with a 16-5 run. During this run the Sparks earned their largest lead of the night at 19 points.

•Third time this season that all Sparks starters reach double figures in points and the second time resulting in a Sparks win.

Ogwumike would finish the night leading all scorers with 21 points, led the team with 9 rebounds, 2 assists, and 2 steals. This continues her double figure point streak to 13 games on the season, and reached 20+ points in 9 of the 13 games this season.

 Chelsea Gray led the Sparks by tying a career high and setting a season high 37 minutes. Gray would also would finish with the game high 5 assists.

Jantel Lavender led both benches in scoring with 8 points and tied a season high with 5 rebounds.

•Candace Parker had the game and season high 5 blocks and scored 14 points reaching double figures for the 11th game this season.

-Sparks 2017 1st round pick, Sydney Wiese, made her first free-throw opportunity of her career.

Sparks dominated the Sun in the paint scoring 34 points (17/25) compared to Sun's 26 points (13/39).

•The Sparks finished the night shooting 32-64 (50%) from the field and the Suns connected 28-77 (36.4%) from the floor.
•Sparks tied a season high 7 blocks versus Connecticut.

-Chelsea Gray set a career high in points with 25 on May 27 in the first meeting of the season.

#### LAST GAME RECAP:

-Tiffany Hayes scored a season-high 24 points, including a critical free throw with 12 seconds to play, and the Atlanta Dream handed the defending champion Los Angeles Sparks their second straight loss, 75-73 on Saturday night.

-After Hayes made one of two from the line, Atlanta (3-1) led 75-71. Chelsea Gray was fouled on a 3-point attempt with 6.8 seconds remaining and after making her first two attempts, missed the third on purpose. However, Hayes grabbed the rebound and released the ball down court as time ran out.

-Layshia Clarendon was the only starter not in double figures for Atlanta. She had nine points and had 12 assists.

-Gray led Los Angeles (2-2) with a career-high 25 points, 16 in the fourth quarter. Nneka Ogwumike added 15 points.

The Sparks led 32-29 at the half but Atlanta opened the second half with an 11-1 run and led 51-44 after three quarters. Los Angeles had an 11-2 run opening the fourth quarter when the teams combined for 53 points. Clarendon's free throw had the Dream up by five with 25.8 seconds left before Candace Parker's offensive rebound and basket with 13.1 seconds left made it 74-71.

#### Candace Parker Named Player of the Week 6/18

Candace Parker was named the Western Conference Player of the Week ending 6/18/17.

Parker earned Player of the Week honors for the 19th time in her 10-year career. Behind the 6-4 forward/center, the Sparks went 3-0 for the week and improved to 8-3 overall, the second-best record in the WNBA. Among West players, the two-time WNBA MVP was seventh in scoring (18.0 ppg) and rebounding (6.3 rpg). She also tied for second in blocks (2.0 bpg) and for third in assists (5.0 apg). Parker was eighth in three-point shooting (.417, 5-of-12) and made 13 of her 14 attempts from the free throw line (.929).

On June 13, the former University of Tennessee standout tallied 17 points, seven rebounds and five assists as the Sparks defeated the Dallas Wings 97-87 in Los Angeles. Two days later, Parker contributed 20 points, four rebounds, four assists and two blocks to help guide the host Sparks past the San Antonio Stars 80-75. Parker closed the week with 17 points, eight rebounds, six assists and three blocks as Los Angeles beat the Phoenix Mercury 90-59 on June 18 in a game that also saw Phoenix guard Diana Taurasi become the WNBA's career scoring leader.

WNBA Pride month will feature four nationally televised games on ESPN2, tipping off coverage when the Washington Mystics visit the Dallas Wings on June 6 (8 p.m. ET). The celebration continues with the Los Angeles Sparks hosting the Dallas Wings on June 13 (10 p.m. ET), followed by a June 23 showdown in Minnesota between the Mystics and the Minnesota Lynx (8 p.m. ET). To close out ESPN2's WNBA Pride telecasts, the Connecticut Sun will host the Seattle Storm on June 29 (8 p.m. ET).

In celebration of LGBTQ Pride Month, the league announced a collaboration with GLSEN and Fanatics in which fans can choose from an exclusive line of Fanatics-designed Pride T-shirts featuring WNBA or NBA team logos. A portion of the proceeds will benefit GLSEN, a longtime WNBA partner. The league will also donate \$10,000 to help support GLSEN's efforts to create safer and more inclusive school environments for all students.

Throughout June, teams will offer special ticket packages and in-arena experiences for Pride-themed games. In addition, there will be community outreach and activation with local pride groups, festivals and parades. Team activities will be showcased on WNBA and NBA Cares social media channels with the hashtag #wn-bapride. Additional information on team events and celebrations can be found at WNBA.com/pride.

For the second year in a row, the WNBA, NBA and NBA Development League will march together and have a float in the New York City Pride March on June 25.

#### **HEAD COACH BRIAN AGLER**

On Jan. 5, 2015, Agler became the 12th head coach in Los Angeles Sparks history, bringing with him over 30 years of head-coaching experience, including 11 in the WNBA. In his first season with LA, Agler led the Sparks to a league-best 15th postseason appearance. Just one year later he led them to a 26-8 regular season mark and the 2016 WNBA championship, the third league title in the franchise's history.

Along the way, three Sparks players earned major WNBA awards in 2016 -- Nneka Ogwumike (league MVP); Candace (Finals MVP); and Jantel Lavender (Sixth Woman of the Year). The 2016 championship, when coupled with the one captured by his Seattle Storm in 2010, made Agler the first head coach in WNBA history to guide two different franchises to a title.

The all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball history in the U.S. with 296 regular-season victories, Agler enters the 2017 campaign with 224 wins as a WNBA head coach and 72 from his tenure in the ABL. On June 6, 2017, when the Sparks faced the Chicago Sky at the Staples Center, Head Coach Brian Agler notched his 300th regular season career win as a head coach.

Immediately prior to joining the Sparks, Agler spent seven seasons (2008-14) at the helm of the Storm, guiding Seattle to the playoffs in each of his first six campaigns and compiling an overall regular-season record of 136-102 (.571) during his tenure there. In 2010, when Agler was recognized as the WNBA Coach of the Year, his Storm – led by league MVP Lauren Jackson and All-Star Sue Bird – captured the franchise's second WNBA title with an impressive regular 28-6 season record and a 7-0 run through the postseason.

Agler first joined the WNBA as Head Coach and GM of the expansion Minnesota Lynx from 1999-2002, where he compiled a 42-54 (.438) record. Following that, Agler was an assistant with the Phoenix Mercury in 2004 before spending 2005-07 as an assistant with the San Antonio Stars.

Agler's move to the WNBA's Lynx in 1999 followed three seasons as head coach of the ABL's Columbus Quest from 1996-1999, when his teams compiled a 72-18 regular-season record and a 10-4 mark in the postseason. Agler led the Quest to back-to-back ABL championships in 1997 and 1998 and was the ABL Coach of the Year for the 1996-97 campaign.

Agler spent 15 seasons coaching in the collegiate ranks, including 13 seasons as a head coach. He posted an impressive collegiate record of 248-135 (.648 winning percentage). From 1993-96 he served as the head women's basketball coach at Kansas State. In 1998, Agler took over as the head women's coach at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. In five seasons at UMKC, Agler was 85-54 and took the Kangaroos from a 9-16 record in 1988-89 to four straight winning seasons. Under his direction, UMKC led the NCAA in scoring defense three straight seasons (1990-93). In 1991, UMKC set an NCAA record, allowing just 51.8 points per game.

As the head women's basketball coach at Northeast Oklahoma A&M Junior College from 1984-88, Agler compiled a 124-42 record. In 1985-86, NEO A&M ranked second nationally at 30-2.

Agler attended Wittenberg University (Springfield, Oh.), where he starred on the basketball team, leading the Tigers to their only NCAA Division III basketball championship in basketball as a freshman. He started all 112 games during his career, leaving the school as the all-time assist leader (481). Agler was the MVP of the Ohio Athletic Conference and first-team All-America as a senior. In 1995, he was inducted into the Wittenberg Hall of Honor.
