#### Sparks Notes:

•Los Angeles Sparks defeat the Chicago Sky 115-106 in double overtime to improve to (21-8) on the season and win the season series (2-1). The game was the fourth dou ble-overtime game in Sparks franchise history and the first double-overtime meeting between the two franchises.

 Four Sparks starters earned double-doubles: Ogwumike (32 points, 10 rebounds); Parker (29 points, 12 rebounds); Gray (20 points, 10 assists); and Sims (15 points, 10 assists). This was the first time a team had four players earn double-doubles in the ame game, in league history.

•The Sparks finished the first quarter trailing by 2, 20-18. Los Angeles connected on 7-19 from the field (36.8%) compared to Chicago's 9-16 (56.3%).

 Nneka Ogwumike led all scorers with 6 points and 1 rebound in the first quarter ·Candace Parker earned her 983rd career assist with a pass to Chelsea Gray at 6:45 passing Nikki Teasley. Parker finished the night with 6 assists to bring her career total to 988. in the second quarter. Parker's assist moved her into sole possession of 22nd all-time

•With Parker's 24 foot 3-pointer at 6:10 in the second quarter, Candace moved into 23rd all-time with her 1689th career field goal made passing Asjha Jones

•Los Angeles finished the second quarter connecting on 8-16 (50%) from the field compared to Chicago's 9-17 (52.9%). •Candace Parker led all scorers with 11 points, 2 rebounds, and 1 assist in the second

•The first half ended with the Sparks trailing the Sky by 2, 40-42. Los Angeles shot 15-35 (42.9%) in the first half compared to Chicago's 18-33 (54.5%).

Candace Parker led all scorers in the first half with 14 points, 4 rebounds, and 1

•Parker (14) and Ogwumike (10) combined for 24 points of the Sparks 40 points in the first half

Sparks Head Coach Brian Agler received his fifth technical foul of the season with 19.4 seconds left in the third quarter. Agler's last technical was at Dallas on August 6.

\*Los Angeles connected 11-22 (50%) from the field, compared to Chicago's 7-18 (38.9%) in the third quarter

 Chelsea Gray tied Allie Quigley for third quarter high scorer. Gray scored 11 points, collected 2 boards, had 2 assists, and was perfect from 3-point range shooting 3-3 om behind the arch

 Through the third quarter, Parker (17), Ogwumike (16), and Gray (16) scored 49 of the Sparks 66 points.

•The Sparks connected on 8-21 (38.1%) from the field in the fourth quarter, and 19-44 (43.2%) in the second half compared to Sky's 9-15 (60%) in the fourth and 16-33 (48.5%) in the second half

·Los Angeles offense was led by Gray (15) and Sims (10) who combined for 25 points, assists, and 4 rebounds in the second half.

 Nneka Ogwumike led all scorers with 9 points in the first overtime, connecting on 4-5 from the floor

Candace Parker led all scorers with 8 points in the second overtime and was perfec

from the floor shooting 3-3.
•Ogwumike led all scorers scoring a season high 32 points, and collected 10 rebounds for her 8th double-double of the season. Nneka set new season highs with 13 field goals (ties career high) and set a new career high playing 47 minutes.

•Parker was the second leading scorer with a new season high 29 points, and game high 12 rebounds for her 9th double-double on the season. Parker set a new season high playing 40 minutes, and tied season highs for field goals and 3-point field goals. Los Angeles finished the game connecting on 45-99 (45.5%) setting new season highs for field goals made/attempted in a game.

• For the second straight game (before overtime), four Sparks' starters had double figures in points at the end of the fourth quarter: Parker (21), Gray (20), Ogwumike (19), and Sims (15).

Odyssey Sims and Chelsea Gray combined for 20 assists and 0 turnovers Alana Beard recorded her 283rd career assist at 3:43 in second overtime to pass Nikki Teasley for 23rd all-time.

Chelsea Gray set a career high playing 48 minutes, career high 4 steals, career high 10 assists, and tied a career high connecting on (4-6) 3-pointers.
 Jantel Lavender led the Sparks bench with 10 points, marking five Sparks' players

with double figures in points.

 Los Angeles set new season highs in the following categories: points in a game (115); field goals made/attempted (45-99); 3-point field goals made (12); offensive rebounds (14); total rebounds (42); and assists (34).

#### Sky Notes:

Courtney Vandersloot continues to play with a hot hand all-the-way-around. She recorded her 10th double-double of the season, all in the last 13 games, including her sixth in a row. The guard finished with 22 points and 12 assists. Twelve of Vandersloot's points came from a 4-for-4 performance from beyond the arc. She is now shooting 12-for-14 from three in the last four games.

Vandersloot again moved up the all-time WNBA leaderboards for assists. She needed 11 and got

12, moving her to 17th all-time with 1,077, and passing Katie Douglas in the process.
•The other half of the Splash Sisters – Allie Quigley – did very well for herself as well. She finished with a team-high 26 points. She also made four three-pointers in the win and now has 69 for the season, which is a new Sky single-season franchise record. Stacey Dales previously held the record with 68 in the 2007 season. She also came away seven rebounds to tie her career-best for the third time, all oming this season. Her 17 field goals attempted and two steals also tied season-high marks.

Cappie Pondexter dished out four assists in the loss, surpassing both 1,500 for her career and 100 for the season. Her four dishes were her most since handing out nine on June 23. She also drained wo three-pointers for the second time this season, with the last coming on June 30.

Pondexter's 16 points from the bench is the highest such total this season.

Stefanie Dolson continued to play a well-rounded game. She picked up her third double-double o the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds. Her 18 points gave her a double-digit point total for the sixth-straight game and she has now done so in 15 of the last 17 games. She was two assists shy of c coveted triple-double, but her eight assists gave her a new career-best after dishing out six on three separate occasions. She also swatted away three blocks, giving her 37 on the season, which ties her season-best mark.

Kahleah Copper started her fourth-straight game, which is a new season-high in games started in just her sophomore campaign. She also came away with a block to tie her previous season-high of

Recently added Jordan Hooper had one of her best games this season in just her fourth game with the Sky. She set a new season-highs with 22 minutes played and one block. The lone block also tied er career-best performance. She also tied season-high totals with three rebounds and one assist.

Diana Taurasi scored 19 points to break the WNBA career scoring record in the Phoenix Mercury's 90-59 loss to the Los Angeles Sparks on June 18.

Taurasi finished with 7,494 points, passing Tina Thompson's mark of 7,488. Taurasi broke the record in the closing seconds of the first half, coming around a screen by Emma Cannon near the top of the key and knifing into the lane, past Nneka Ogwumike, for a layup.

The game was stopped and the crowd, which included former Lakers star Kobe Bryant, gave Taurasi a warm ovation. It only took the Mercury star 13 seasons to become the league's top scorer. Thompson needed 17 seasons to achieve her total. Earlier in the season, Taurasi set the career 3-pointer record, passing Katie Smith.

Ogwumike led the Sparks with 18 points and had seven rebounds, and Candace Parker added 17 points, eight rebounds and six assists.

The Sparks raced to a 15-0 lead, were up 22-2 and led 38-17 at the end of the first quarter. It was their highest-scoring quarter of the season and two points shy of the WNBA record for most points in a quarter.

Riquna Williams hit back-to-back 3-pointers to push the lead to 30 points early in the fourth and Odyssey Sims hit two free throws to make it 90-57, the biggest lead of the season for Los Angeles. Williams finished with a season-high 15 points.

The Mercury (6-5) had a season-high 19 turnovers, were held nearly 25 points below their season scoring average (83.7) and shot a season-low 32.8 percent from the field.

WNBA Head Coaching Record: 245-205 Los Angeles Sparks Head Coaching Record: 61-36 Seasons in the WNBA: 14th Season Seasons with the Sparks: 3rd Season

#### **HEAD COACH BRIAN AGLER**

On Jan. 5, 2015, Agler became the 12th head coach in Los Angeles Sparks history, bringing with him over 30 years of head-coaching experience, including 11 in the WNBA. In his first season with LA, Agler led the Sparks to a league-best 15th postseason appearance. Just one year later he led them to a 26-8 regular season mark and the 2016 WNBA championship, the third league title in the franchise's history.

Along the way, three Sparks players earned major WNBA awards in 2016 -- Nneka Ogwumike (league MVP); Candace (Finals MVP); and Jantel Lavender (Sixth Woman of the Year). The 2016 championship, when coupled with the one captured by his Seattle Storm in 2010, made Agler the first head coach in WNBA history to guide two different franchises to a title.

The all-time winningest coach in women's professional basketball history in the U.S. with 296 regular-season victories, Aglerenters the 2017 campaign with 224 wins as a WNBA head coach and 72 from his tenure in the ABL. On June 6, 2017, when the Sparks faced the Chicago Sky at the Staples Center, Head Coach Brian Agler notched his **300th regular season career win as a head coach**.

Immediately prior to joining the Sparks, Agler spent seven seasons (2008-14) at the helm of the Storm, guiding Seattle to the playoffs in each of his first six campaigns and compiling an overall regular-season record of 136-102 (.571) during his tenure there. In 2010, when Agler was recognized as the WNBA Coach of the Year, his Storm – led by league MVP Lauren Jackson and All-Star Sue Bird – captured the franchise's second WNBA title with an impressive regular 28-6 season record and a 7-0 run through the postseason.

Agler first joined the WNBA as Head Coach and GM of the expansion Minnesota Lynx from 1999-2002, where he compiled a 42-54 (.438) record. Following that, Agler was an assistant with the Phoenix Mercury in 2004 before spending 2005-07 as an assistant with the San Antonio Stars.

Agler's move to the WNBA's Lynx in 1999 followed three seasons as head coach of the ABL's Columbus Quest from 1996-1999, when his teams compiled a 72-18 regular-season record and a 10-4 mark in the postseason. Agler led the Quest to back-to-back ABL championships in 1997 and 1998 and was the ABL Coach of the Year for the 1996-97 campaign.

Agler spent 15 seasons coaching in the collegiate ranks, including 13 seasons as a head coach. He posted an impressive collegiate record of 248-135 (.648 winning percentage). From 1993-96 he served as the head women's basketball coach at Kansas State. In 1998, Agler took over as the head women's coach at the University of Missouri-Kansas City. In five seasons at UMKC, Agler was 85-54 and took the Kangaroos from a 9-16 record in 1988-89 to four straight winning seasons. Under his direction, UMKC led the NCAA in scoring defense three straight seasons (1990-93). In 1991, UMKC set an NCAA record, allowing just 51.8 points per game.

As the head women's basketball coach at Northeast Oklahoma A&M Junior College from 1984-88, Agler compiled a 124-42 record. In 1985-86, NEO A&M ranked second nationally at 30-2.

Agler attended Wittenberg University (Springfield, Oh.), where he starred on the basketball team, leading the Tigers to their only NCAA Division III basketball championship in basketball as a freshman. He started all 112 games during his career, leaving the school as the all-time assist leader (481). Agler was the MVP of the Ohio Athletic Conference and first-team All-America as a senior. In 1995, he was inducted into the Wittenberg Hall of Honor.
