MATCHUP NOTES

The Los Angeles Sparks will take on the Chicago Sky in their second contest of the WNBA season Tuesday night in Bradenton, Florida, Home of the IMG Academy. The last time these teams went head to head was August 16, 2019 at the Wintrust Arena in Chicago, Illinois. The Sky took home an 91-81 victory against the Sparks where Allie Quigley scored 26 points to help the Chicago Sky beat Los Angeles. Despite entering the playoffs as a fifth seed and finishing the season with a 20-14 record, the Sky's season was cut short in round one of the playoffs against the Las Vegas Aces in a last-second finish when Dearica Hamby intercepted a pass near mid-court and banked a 38-foot shot placing the Aces in the lead by one.

The Sky enter the 2020 season with two rookie's on their roster, Ruthy Hebard and Stella Johnson. Hebard was drafted in the first-round by Chicago and Johnson was a third-round draft pick by the Phoenix Mercury but was released in late May and signed a free-agent contract with the Sky.

THE BIG THREE

Two-Time MVP (2008, 2013) Candace Parker, 2016 MVP Nneka Ogwumike (2016) and 2019 First Team All-WNBA guard Chelsea Gray look to lead the LA Sparks to their second championship with this nucleus and the franchise's fourth overall title.

In 2019, **Chelsea Gray** earned her third consecutive All-Star selection and topped it off with First Team All-WNBA honors. On July 8, 2019, Gray recorded the 8th triple-double in WNBA regular season history. Known for her clutch baskets and no-look passes, Gray, nicknamed Point Gawd, will look to lead the Sparks back to the Finals for the first time since 2017. Last season Gray averaged 14.9 points, 5.9 assists and 3.8 rebounds per game.

Nneka Ogwumike is not only a former MVP on the court, but has been called the current MVP of the league before the games even start. As WNBPA President, Ogwumike helped negotiate a new Collective Bargaining Agreement announced on January 14, 2020, which triples average player compensation and secured several benefits, including full maternity leave for players. Ogwumike was instrumental in coordinating the WNBA plan for a 22-game season at IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida. Now, Ogwumike takes the court looking to continue a career marked by elite consistency with career averages of 16.4 points and 7.8 rebounds per game, while shooting at a historically efficient rate of 55.1%.

Candace Parker is focused on earning her second WNBA title to go along with two titles won at the University of Tennessee (2007, 2008). The future Hall-of-Famer has also made an incredible mark off the court as a full-time NBA analyst with Turner Sports, appearing on TNT, NBATV and the Ledlow & Parker podcast. For her career, Parker has averaged 17 points, 8.5 rebounds, 3.9 assists, 1.6 blocks, and 1.3 steals per game.

RETURNERS

Riquna "Bay" Williams returns as the fourth Sparks player to average double-digit scoring last season when she scored 12.3 points per game while shooting 38.4% on 3-pointers. The Sparks also return defensive stalwart **Tierra Ruffin-Pratt** and combo guard **Sydney Wiese.**

NEWCOMERS

The legendary **Seimone Augustus** brings her talents to the Sparks after 14 seasons and four titles with the Minnesota Lynx. The savvy vet has averaged 15.9 points per game on 48% shooting for her career. Athletic wing **Brittney Sykes** also joins the Sparks after she was acquired, along with former Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year **Marie Gülich**, in an offseason trade with the Atlanta Dream. Other newcomers include rookie **Te'a Cooper**, coming off an impressive run at Baylor University, efficient rebounder **Reshanda Gray**, and **Kristine Anigwe**, a 2019 first-round pick.

LEADERSHIP

Head Coach Derek Fisher enters his second season with the Sparks coming off an impressive debut campaign, leading the Sparks to a 22-12 record and the WNBA Semifinals. Fisher accomplished this in his first season in the WNBA despite key players including Candace Parker, Alana Beard, Maria Vadeeva and Riquna Williams missing a combined 74 games.

President & COO Danita Johnson begins her second season overseeing all business operations. In her first year, the LA Sparks won the 2019 Business Franchise of the Year and took the top honors for Marketing Performance and Ticket Sales. Johnson brings 15 years of experience in the WNBA, NBA and NBA G League.

MISSING FROM ACTION

The Sparks will be without Chiney Ogwumike, Kristi Toliver and Maria Vadeeva in 2020.

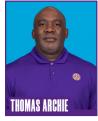

JULY 25 vs PHX - GAME STORY

The Los Angeles Sparks started their 2020 season off emphatically, defeating the Phoenix Mercury 99-76 on Saturday at IMG academy in Bradenton, Florida.

As the shortened 2020 WNBA season kicked off, the opening weekend of games commemorated the Black Lives Matter movement, where Breonna Taylor's name was seen across the court and on the backs of player's uniforms.

"Breonna Taylor was 26?" Chelsea Gray asked after the game. "She had so much life to live, and we're killing. That's the youth right there. I'm 27 years old. That could've been me last year."

"Coming into this, I think everybody knew why this was bigger than basketball, especially to the W," Nneka Ogwumike added. "We're not new to this fight. Our movement has found its moment. This is who we are."

On the court, the Sparks overwhelmed Phoenix in the third quarter after a highly contested first half, outscoring the Mercury 30-8 in the period. The Sparks defense forced 27 Phoenix turnovers, their most since 2016, and the Sparks scored 38 points off of them.

Nneka Ogwumike led the Sparks with 21 points on a perfect 8-for-8 from the field to go along with seven rebounds in 24 minutes. New-comer Brittney Sykes set the pace early with two highlights as she forcefully drove to the basket on a step-through move and followed it up by blocking the 6-foot-9 Brittney Griner.

Seimone Augustus was one of six Sparks in double-figures, shooting a perfect 6-for-6 from the floor and scoring 14 points to help extend the Sparks lead to 80-54 heading into the final quarter.

"This team has a very high basketball IQ," Augustus said. "But most importantly, they are workers, so I can play with anybody that works extremely hard because of a lot of the mistakes we'll have, we'll make up for it with the intensity and the passion that we play with."

Augustus and Ogwumike combined to make all 14 of their shots. Chelsea Gray and Candace Parker added 13 points apiece, and Brittney Sykes and rookie Te'a Cooper each scored 10.

The Sparks improved to 23-12 in the regular season under second-year head coach Derek Fisher.

Phoenix was led by future Hall-of-Famer Diana Taurasi, who missed all but six games last season with back and hamstring injuries. She scored 16 points, and newly acquired All-Star point guard Skylar Diggins-Smith added 14 points and six assists. The Phoenix roster saw a lot of change in the offseason, where they lost DeWanna Bonner and added Skylar Diggins-Smith and Bria Hartley.

The Sparks next game is against the Chicago Sky on Tuesday, July 28 at 9ET on Spectrum SportsNet and NBA TV.


