MATCHUP NOTES

The Los Angeles Sparks will take on the Connecticut Sun in their home opener and third contest of the WNBA season Thursday night in Bradenton, Florida, Home of the IMG Academy.

The teams haven't met since last year's semifinals where the Sun defeated the Sparks in a three game series. With All-Star Jonquel Jones sitting out for the season and the addition of DeWanna Bonner, Connecticut will look different from their last match up. The Sun are coming off two losses, most recently a tough loss against the defending champion Washington Mystics. DeWanna Bonner and Alyssa Thomas combined for 57 points.

The Sparks are coming off their first loss of the season against the Chicago Sky. Four players scored in double-digits including Nneka Ogwumike, Chelsea Gray, Riquna Williams, and Brittney Sykes. Chelsea Gray added 7 assists for her second straight game, surpassing 700 for her career.

MILESTONE WATCH

THE BIG THREE

Two-Time MVP (2008, 2013) Candace Parker, 2016 MVP Nneka Ogwumike (2016) and 2019 First Team All-WNBA guard Chelsea Gray look to lead the LA Sparks to their second championship with this nucleus and the franchise's fourth overall title.

In 2019, **Chelsea Gray** earned her third consecutive All-Star selection and topped it off with First Team All-WNBA honors. On July 8, 2019, Gray recorded the 8th triple-double in WNBA regular season history. Known for her clutch baskets and no-look passes, Gray, nicknamed Point Gawd, will look to lead the Sparks back to the Finals for the first time since 2017. Last season Gray averaged 14.9 points, 5.9 assists and 3.8 rebounds per game.

Nneka Ogwumike is not only a former MVP on the court, but has been called the current MVP of the league before the games even start. As WNBPA President, Ogwumike helped negotiate a new Collective Bargaining Agreement announced on January 14, 2020, which triples average player compensation and secured several benefits, including full maternity leave for players. Ogwumike was instrumental in coordinating the WNBA plan for a 22-game season at IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida. Now, Ogwumike takes the court looking to continue a career marked by elite consistency with career averages of 16.4 points and 7.8 rebounds per game, while shooting at a historically efficient rate of 55.1%.

Candace Parker is focused on earning her second WNBA title to go along with two titles won at the University of Tennessee (2007, 2008). The future Hall-of-Famer has also made an incredible mark off the court as a full-time NBA analyst with Turner Sports, appearing on TNT, NBATV and the Ledlow & Parker podcast. For her career, Parker has averaged 17 points, 8.5 rebounds, 3.9 assists, 1.6 blocks, and 1.3 steals per game.

RETURNERS

Riquna "Bay" Williams returns as the fourth Sparks player to average double-digit scoring last season when she scored 12.3 points per game while shooting 38.4% on 3-pointers. The Sparks also return defensive stalwart **Tierra Ruffin-Pratt** and combo guard **Sydney Wiese.**

NEWCOMERS

The legendary **Seimone Augustus** brings her talents to the Sparks after 14 seasons and four titles with the Minnesota Lynx. The savvy vet has averaged 15.9 points per game on 48% shooting for her career. Athletic wing **Brittney Sykes** also joins the Sparks after she was acquired, along with former Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year **Marie Gülich**, in an offseason trade with the Atlanta Dream. Other newcomers include rookie **Te'a Cooper**, coming off an impressive run at Baylor University, efficient rebounder **Reshanda Gray**, and **Kristine Anigwe**, a 2019 first-round pick.

LEADERSHIP

Head Coach Derek Fisher enters his second season with the Sparks coming off an impressive debut campaign, leading the Sparks to a 22-12 record and the WNBA Semifinals. Fisher accomplished this in his first season in the WNBA despite key players including Candace Parker, Alana Beard, Maria Vadeeva and Riquna Williams missing a combined 74 games.

President & COO Danita Johnson begins her second season overseeing all business operations. In her first year, the LA Sparks won the 2019 Business Franchise of the Year and took the top honors for Marketing Performance and Ticket Sales. Johnson brings 15 years of experience in the WNBA, NBA and NBA G League.

MISSING FROM ACTION

The Sparks will be without Chiney Ogwumike, Kristi Toliver and Maria Vadeeva in 2020.

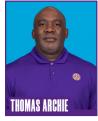

Sparks Fall to Chicago Sky in Second Game

The Los Angeles Sparks fell to the Chicago Sky 96-78 in their second game of the 2020 season at IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida.

Entering the game, Sparks Head Coach Derek Fisher touched on competing against Chicago's offense which is one of the fastest-paced in the league.

"Hanging our hat on the defensive end is something that we really want to do as a team more often than we did last season." Fisher said. "Great teams commit themselves on that end."

The Sky started the first quarter with both strong interior defense and an offense jolt from Kahleah Copper, starting in the place of Diamond DeShields, who came off the bench. Copper scored seven consecutive points early, helping the Sky jump out to a 13-point lead. Copper and Azura Stevens would end up leading all scorers with 21 points each.



Los Angeles started to climb back into the game towards the latter part of the first quarter when they found their rhythm offensively and were able to close the gap to five, trailing 19-14 after one. Brittney Sykes came off the bench scoring eight points and was 4-for-6 from the floor. She again scored in double-figures and led the Sparks with 16 points and five rebounds for the night.

The first half concluded with the Sky up 40-36, as they benefited from three Gabby Williams triples as she scored 11 first-half points. Nneka Ogwumike finished the half as the Sparks top scorer with eight points and three rebounds.

Chicago broke open the game early in the third quarter, going up by as much as 20 points.

"Chicago was ready to play and we weren't," Candace Parker said after the game. "They hit shots, they moved the ball, they played aggressive. I think we used everything we had to get back into the game, but Chicago played well tonight and we have to figure out ways to start the first quarter and the third quarter better."

The Sparks struggled to slow Chicago's offensive pace but did get a Spark from Sydney Wiese who hit two 3-pointers to help LA close the third quarter on a 9-0 run to cut the lead to 66-55 heading into the fourth quarter.

The Sky answered back right away in the fourth quarter, continuing to get to the basket and hit 3-pointers. All five starters for Chicago hit double-digit scoring and seven players scored at least nine points. The Sky were able to pull off this victory without starter Stefanie Dolson who missed the game due to an ankle injury. The Sparks were without Marie Gülich (ankle) and Te'a Cooper (illness).

Despite the loss, Nneka Ogwumike (13), Riquna Williams (12), Chelsea Gray (10), and Brittney Sykes (16) scored in double-figures. Chelsea Gray added seven assists for the second straight game.

"I just know every time I step on that court, I just got to be ready to play," Sykes said after the game. "I know that I'm an energy player, I know that I create possessions for my team, whether it's on the defensive end or the offensive end, so for me I just got to come in and do my job."

The Sparks next game is against the Connecticut Sun on Thursday, July 30 at 10ET on ESPN.
