MATCHUP NOTES

The Los Angeles Sparks head into game four of the WNBA season against the Seattle Storm Saturday night in Bradenton, Florida, Home of the IMG Academy.

The teams last met in the second round of the 2019 playoffs. The Sparks defeated the 2018 champions 92-69, in the single elimination game. With the return of Sue Bird and Breanna Stewart to the roster, Seattle looks different in 2020. The Storm returns the 2019 defensive player of the year, Natasha Howard and All-Star Jewell Loyd. Most recently, Seattle fell to the reigning champion Washington Mystics 89-71.

The Sparks are coming off a great team win against the Connecticut Sun, four players scored in double digits including Candace Parker, Nneka Ogwumike, Chelsea Gray, and Seimone Augustus. Seattle and Los Angeles are both 2-1 on the season.

THE BIG THREE

Two-Time MVP (2008, 2013) Candace Parker, 2016 MVP Nneka Ogumike (2016) and 2019 First Team All-WNBA guard Chelsea Gray look to lead the LA Sparks to their second championship with this nucleus and the franchise's fourth overall title.

In 2019, **Chelsea Gray** earned her third consecutive All-Star selection and topped it off with First Team All-WNBA honors. On July 8, 2019, Gray recorded the 8th triple-double in WNBA regular season history. Known for her clutch baskets and no-look passes, Gray, nicknamed Point Gawd, will look to lead the Sparks back to the Finals for the first time since 2017. Last season Gray averaged 14.9 points, 5.9 assists and 3.8 rebounds per game.

Nneka Ogumike is not only a former MVP on the court, but has been called the current MVP of the league before the games even start. As WNBA President, Ogumike helped negotiate a new Collective Bargaining Agreement announced on January 14, 2020, which triples average player compensation and secured several benefits, including full maternity leave for players. Ogumike was instrumental in coordinating the WNBA plan for a 22-game season at IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida. Now, Ogumike takes the court looking to continue a career marked by elite consistency with career averages of 16.4 points and 7.8 rebounds per game, while shooting at a historically efficient rate of 55.1%.

Candace Parker is focused on earning her second WNBA title to go along with two titles won at the University of Tennessee (2007, 2008). The future Hall-of-Famer has also made an incredible mark off the court as a full-time NBA analyst with Turner Sports, appearing on TNT, NBA TV and the Ledlow & Parker podcast. For her career, Parker has averaged 17 points, 8.5 rebounds, 3.9 assists, 1.6 blocks, and 1.3 steals per game.

RETURNERS

Riquna "Bay" Williams returns as the fourth Sparks player to average double-digit scoring last season when she scored 12.3 points per game while shooting 38.4% on 3-pointers. The Sparks also return defensive stalwart **Tierra Ruffin-Pratt** and combo guard **Sydney Wiese**.

NEWCOMERS

The legendary **Seimone Augustus** brings her talents to the Sparks after 14 seasons and four titles with the Minnesota Lynx. The savvy vet has averaged 15.9 points per game on 48% shooting for her career. Athletic wing **Brittney Sykes** also joins the Sparks after she was acquired, along with former Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year **Marie Göllich**, in an offseason trade with the Atlanta Dream. Other newcomers include rookie **Te'a Cooper**, coming off an impressive run at Baylor University, efficient rebounder **Reshanda Gray**, and **Kristine Anigwe**, a 2019 first-round pick.

LEADERSHIP

Head Coach Derek Fisher enters his second season with the Sparks coming off an impressive debut campaign, leading the Sparks to a 22-12 record and the WNBA Semifinals. Fisher accomplished this in his first season in the WNBA despite key players including Candace Parker, Alana Beard, Maria Vadeeva and Riquna Williams missing a combined 74 games.

President & COO Danita Johnson begins her second season overseeing all business operations. In her first year, the LA Sparks won the 2019 Business Franchise of the Year and took the top honors for Marketing Performance and Ticket Sales. Johnson brings 15 years of experience in the WNBA, NBA and NBA G League.

MISSING FROM ACTION

The Sparks will be without **Chiney Ogumike**, **Kristi Toliver** and **Maria Vadeeva** in 2020.

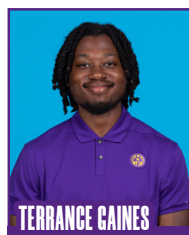

Augustus Leads Sparks Past Connecticut

The Los Angeles Sparks earned a tough win over the Connecticut Sun 81-76 to improve to 2-1 on the 2020 season. The Sparks got solid contributions from the full roster, including Candace Parker's first double-double of the season (10 points, 11 rebounds), 15 points and six assists from Chelsea Gray, and 13 points from Seimone Augustus, who scored nine in the third quarter to help the Sparks take control.



The Sun scored the game's first six points before Nneka Ogwumike put the Sparks on the board. The first quarter was a back-and-forth affair until a Candace Parker bucket pushed the Sparks ahead 19-18 at the end of the period. Chelsea Gray helped the Sparks gain control in the second quarter, reaching double-digit points before halftime. Riquna Williams added three 3-pointers in the second quarter alone to help the team take a 41-36 Sparks lead into the locker room.

The second half began with a Connecticut run led by DeWanna Bonner who erupted for 34 points and 14 rebounds on the night, turning a five-point halftime lead for the Sparks into a five-point deficit. But the Sparks got a huge boost from the bench when four-time champion Seimone Augustus scored nine third-quarter points and rookie Te'a Cooper stifled the Connecticut backcourt with pressure defense, helping limit All-Star point guard Jasmine Thomas to 3-of-12 shooting.

"As far as the third quarter, I just wanted to bring the spark any way that I could, just trying to find my spots to be effective on the court and get other players going, get CP going, get Chelsea going, get Nneka going," Augustus said. "But it allowed me to get myself going as well and try to bring some energy in the third quarter."

Their efforts helped the Sparks take a 63-57 lead into the fourth quarter.

"[Seimone] came up huge with her versatility," Gray said after the game. "Being able to switch on Bonner and Thomas setting those screens was key, as well as being able to defend one through four was huge."

The Sparks went up by a game-high 12 in the fourth quarter as Cooper showed flashes of her potential with spinning drives to the basket. She'd finish with eight points. Nneka Ogwumike chipped in with six fourth-quarter points of her own to finish with 14.

"We're a talented team, and as we get in better condition and better rhythm, I think our game will start to look better," Fisher said. "But right now, we just got to scrap and claw and squeeze out every win we can."

The Sparks face off against the Seattle Storm on Saturday, Aug. 1 at 5 p.m. PT on CBS Sports Network and Spectrum SportsNet.

Los Angeles Highlights:

- Candace Parker recorded her first double-double of the season with 10 points and 11 rebounds.
- Four Sparks players scored in double-digits including Seimone Augustus for the second time this season.
- Riquna Williams shot 60% from the three-point line, with all three makes in second quarter action
- Nneka Ogwumike and Seimone Augustus were the Sparks most efficient, shooting 6-10 and 6-12 from the field respectively.
