The Los Angeles Sparks will take on the New York Liberty for the eighth contest of the season Tuesday night in Bradenton, Florida, Home of the IMG Academy.

New York heads into Tuesday with a 1-6 record after a close Sunday-night loss against the Las Vegas Aces. With rookie star Sabrina lonescu out with a sprained ankle, the Liberty have relied on steady contributions from Layshia Clarendon and Amanda Zahui B.

The Sparks roll into Tuesday after a big 97-81 win over the Minnesota Lynx. The team shot 65.5% from the field, the highest FG percentage in Sparks franchise history and third-best in WNBA regular reason history. Riquana Williams scored a season-high 21 points on a perfect 5-5 from three-point range.

MONEY MONE DELIVERS AGAINST LYNX

The Sparks signed **Seimone Augustus** this past offseason in a move that surprised the women's basketball world after the veteran had played all 14 seasons in a Minnesota Lynx jersey, winning four titles. After appearing in just 12 games in 2019 due to injuries, in 2020 Augustus is shooting 55.6% from the field and 61.5% on 3-pointers (second in the WNBA), averaging 9.8 points in 17.8 minutes per game. On Aug. 9, Augustus scored 13 points off the bench to help the Sparks defeat her former Lynx team 97-81. Augustus also passed Tina Charles on Aug. 9 for fifth all-time in WNBA history for field goals made with 2,426.

MVP PARKER

Candace Parker continues to be on a tear, increasing her streak of consecutive games with double-doubles to five. Last week, Parker averaged 16.3 points, 11 rebounds and 5.3 assists while shooting 50% from the field. Parker is also Top 3 in the league in rebounding, blocks and defensive win shares, per Basketball Reference. On Aug. 9 against the Lynx, Parker put up a stat line of 11 points, 10 rebounds and 9 assists, one assist shy of her second career triple-double.

SYD FROM THE SWEET SPOT

Sydney Wiese was inserted into the starting lineup last week and in three starts has scored 41 points. For the season, she's shooting 50.0% (tied for fifth in the WNBA) on 3-pointers and is averaging 7.7 points per game in 18.0 minutes.

RIQUNA RAINING THREES

After eclipsing 2,000 career points last week, **Riquna Williams** scored a season-high 21 points against the Lynx on Aug. 9 going 5-for-5 on 3-pointers. Williams has been coming off the bench the last three games and has increased her shooting percentages to 42% overall and 50% on 3-pointers (tied for fifth in the WNBA), while averaging 11.3 points per game in 24.1 minutes of action.

Chelsea Gray joined Riquna Williams last week, passing the 2,000 career points threshold. For the season, Gray is averaging 12.3 points and 5.6 assists per game, the assist mark good for Top 5 in the WNBA.

SPARKS SET FRANCHISE RECORD FOR FIELD GOAL PERCENTAGE

On Aug. 9, the Sparks shot 65.5% from the field, setting a franchise record for best single game field goal percentage in the regular season. The feat was the third best in WNBA history.

LEADERSHIP

Head Coach Derek Fisher enters his second season with the Sparks coming off an impressive debut campaign, leading the Sparks to a 22-12 record and the WNBA Semifinals. Fisher accomplished this in his first season in the WNBA despite key players including Candace Parker, Alana Beard, Maria Vadeeva and Riguna Williams missing a combined 74 games.

President & COO Danita Johnson begins her second season overseeing all business operations. In her first year, the LA Sparks won the 2019 Business Franchise of the Year and took the top honors for Marketing Performance and Ticket Sales. Johnson brings 15 years of experience in the WNBA, NBA and NBA G League.





Parker, Augustus Lead Sparks Over Rival Lynx

Candace Parker led the Los Angeles Sparks to a dominant 97-81 victory over the Minnesota Lynx with her fifth consecutive double-double (11 points, 10 rebounds, nine assists), ending the game one assist shy of her second career triple-double. Seimone Augustus, playing for the first time against her former team, scored 13 points on 5-for-9 shooting. Rookie Crystal Dangerfield led the Lynx with 29 points, who were without Sylvia Fowles (calf).

The Los Angeles Sparks came out of the gate hot, scoring a first-quarter season-high of 24 points followed by another 24 points in the second quarter. They shot 69% from the field in the first-half and 60% from the three-point line, the second-best first-half shooting percentage in the league since 2014.



"I think that myself, Chelsea, Nneka, we know that we're going to bring people," Candace Parker said after the game. "When we're able to get rid of [the ball], whether it's an assist directly or a hockey assist, we play really well when we're free and we're moving."

Once LA got going, they never slowed down with five players scoring in double-figures: Riquna Williams, who scored a season-high 21 points, Sydney Wiese with 15, Augustus with 13, Candace Parker with 11 and Chelsea Gray, who added 10 points and five assists.

The Sparks entered the game knowing they needed to improve on their rebounding, especially against a Minnesota team who is always strong in that area.

"We can't come back into the locker room at halftime and have a disparity in the rebounding that makes it hard for us to have a chance to win this game," said head coach Derek Fisher, before the game.

The Sparks finished the game out-rebounding Minnesota 30 to 20 behind the efforts of Candace Parker and Nneka Ogwumike along with a great showing from their bench led by Riquna Williams, helping the Sparks bench score a season-high of 53 points.

"[Players coming off the bench] deserve the credit for being able to perform at such a high level," Fisher said after the game. "The ball was moving, they looked out for each other on the defensive end. I think that's the difference for all great teams is being able to have players on your bench that teammates can trust and coaches can trust. And we had a lot of those contributions today".

The Minnesota Lynx did momentarily take a one-point lead in the third quarter, taking advantage of 20 Sparks turnovers and scoring 36 points off of them. But the Sparks did not cool down, setting multiple records in this game, including the highest field goal percentage in a regular season game in franchise history at 65.5% and the third highest in WNBA history. Individually, Augustus made her 2,426th career field goal passing Tina Charles for fifth all-time in WNBA history.

After the run, LA put their foot on the gas scoring a season-high 31 points in the fourth quarter to close out the game. The Sparks finished the game shooting a season-high 59.1% on 3-pointers (13-for-22), in addition to breaking the franchise record for FG% at 65.517%.

This was the first of four games in the next six days for the Sparks. Los Angeles, now 4-3, will look for their first winning streak when they face the New York Liberty on Tuesday, Aug. 11 at 7 p.m. PT on Spectrum SportsNet.

Los Angeles Highlights:

- Los Angeles shot 65.5% from the field, the highest field goal percentage in Sparks franchise history and third best in WNBA regular season history.
- Candace Parker recorded her fifth consecutive double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds, in addition to nine assists.
- Riquna Williams contributed double-digit scoring for the fourth consecutive game, shooting a perfect 5-5 from three en route to 21 points, her season-high.
- The Sparks 53 bench points is the third most in franchise history. The record sits at 61 bench points vs. the Utah Starzz on 6/28/1999.
- Seimone Augustus now has 2,426 career made FGs, passing Tina Charles (2,425) to enter the WNBA's top 5 all-time


