The Los Angeles Sparks look forward to the next matchup against the Indiana Fever in their fifth game of the season on Wednesday night in Bradenton, Florida, Home of the IMG Academy. Indiana started the season with a reduced roster with Lauren Cox and Erica Wheeler out due to injury/medical protocols. Most recently, the guard play from Kelsey Mitchell alongside forwards Candice Dupree and Tiffany Mitchell lifted the Fever over the Atlanta Dream.

The Sparks have 5 players averaging double-figure scoring heading into Wednesday's matchup. In their last game against the Storm, Chelsea Gray reached yet another milestone grabbing her 500th career rebound along with Riguna Williams surpassing 2000 career points. Candace Parker recorded her second straight double-double and led the team in scoring with 19 points. Los Angeles went 3-0 against Indiana in 2019.

MONEY MONE

The Sparks signed **Seimone Augustus** this past offseason in a move that surprised the women's basketball world after the veteran had played all 14 seasons in a Minnesota Lynx jersey, winning four titles. After appearing in just 12 games in 2019 due to injuries, Augustus has come out of the gates shooting 54.5% from the field and 66.7% on 3-pointers, averaging 10.5 points in 18.5 minutes per game. Not only is Augustus scoring at an efficient clip, she's come up with multiple clutch scoring runs in the second half of these first four games.

DOUBLE DOUBLE PARKER

Candace Parker recorded back-to-back doubles in the win against the Connecticut Sun on July 30 (10 points and 11 rebounds) and the loss to Seattle on Aug. 1 (19 points and 12 rebounds). Through four games Parker is averaging 12.5 points and 9.8 rebounds while shooting 48.8% from the field.

ROOKIE BUZZ

After Kristi Toliver opted out of the 2020 season, the Sparks signed rookie **Te'a Cooper**, the No. 18 overall pick in the 2020 WNBA Draft who was waived by the Phoenix Mercury. Cooper has impressed early with tenacious, pressure defense and shown lighting quickness attacking the basket. She's averaging 7.3 points in 16.7 minutes per game and has worn out opposing point guards, keeping the Sparks competitive in all three games she's appeared.

ROUND UP

Riquna Williams scored 16 points in the Sparks 81-75 loss to the Storm on Aug. 1, eclipsing the 2,000 career point mark. Williams previously held the record for most points in a WNBA game, scoring 51 on 9/18/13 as a member of the Tulsa Shock, a record that was broken by Liz Cambage when she scored 53 points on 7/17/18 as a member of the Dallas Wings.

Nneka Ogwumike continues to be one of the most efficient players in league history, starting off the season shooting 62.5% from the field to go along with 15.5 points per game.

Chelsea Gray is averaging a career-high 6.3 assists per game, to go along with 11 points and is hoping to get her scoring going in this next stretch of the season.

The Sparks have been without newly acquired center **Marie Gülich** due to an ankle injury and hope to get her back in the next week.

LEADERSHIP

Head Coach Derek Fisher enters his second season with the Sparks coming off an impressive debut campaign, leading the Sparks to a 22-12 record and the WNBA Semifinals. Fisher accomplished this in his first season in the WNBA despite key players including Candace Parker, Alana Beard, Maria Vadeeva and Riguna Williams missing a combined 74 games.

President & COO Danita Johnson begins her second season overseeing all business operations. In her first year, the LA Sparks won the 2019 Business Franchise of the Year and took the top honors for Marketing Performance and Ticket Sales. Johnson brings 15 years of experience in the WNBA, NBA and NBA G League.





Sparks Comeback Falls Short Against Seattle

The Sparks battled back from a 17-point hole, but ultimately fell to the Seattle Storm, 81-75. Candace Parker led Los Angeles with her second consecutive double-double, scoring 19 points and grabbing 12 rebounds, but the team fell victim to a 17-4 early deficit which proved too much to overcome against the Associated Press' unanimous preseason title favorites. 2018 MVP Breanna Stewart led the way for Seattle, totaling 21 points, 9 rebounds, and 5 assists.

"I think the biggest thing to learn and understand for our group is, this is basketball," Head Coach Derek Fisher said after the game. "It really is, it's just a competition and the team that really competes harder for more minutes in a game typically either wins the game or definitely has a





The Sparks first basket was a three-pointer by Candace Parker that did not come until four minutes into the game. Candace Parker kept the Sparks within striking distance in the first by scoring six of the team's 16 first-quarter points. The Sparks continued to battle throughout the second quarter but weren't able to fully capitalize as they entered the second half down 45-29.

The Sparks got going in the third quarter, outsourcing Seattle 26-20 to cut the Storm lead to 10 heading into the fourth quarter. Riquna Williams had a stellar third-quarter performance scoring 11 of her 16 total points including three 3-pointers. The Sparks continued their hot shooting in the fourth quarter and got another lift from veteran Seimone Augustus who hit back-to-back tough 3-pointers to bring the Sparks to within one possession at 66-63 with 6:43 to go in the fourth.

But the Storm was able to pull away with some key plays from point guard Jordin Canada, who was starting in place of Sue Bird, who sat out to rest. Canada ended the game with 16 points and was able to get to the basket and draw fouls down the stretch to help the Storm hold off the Sparks.

"Our second unit coming in the Chicago game, this game, even the Connecticut game, is doing a good job getting us back," Parker said. "But then we exert all of our effort getting back into the game and I don't know if we have enough to get over the hump."

The Sparks had four players in double-figures: Parker (19), Ogwumike (14), Williams (16), and Augustus (12). After playing four games in eight days to start the season, the Sparks have three days off before facing the Indiana Fever next Wednesday, Aug. 5. The team is now 2-2 and in seventh place in the standings.
