MATCHUP NOTES

The Sparks head into their seventh game of the 2020 season on Sunday against the Minnesota Lynx in Bradenton, Florida. Los Angeles is coming off a highly contested loss against the Las Vegas Aces (86-82). Against the Aces, Candace Parker recorded her fourth consecutive double-double, Chelsea Gray surpassed her 2,000-point career mark and Sydney Wiese achieved a season-high of 18 points.

The Sparks went undefeated against the Lynx in the 2019 season. Most recently, the Lynx beat the Indiana Fever, 87-80. Sylvia Fowles and Lexie Brown combined for 47 points, Brown achieving a career-high of 26 points. The Lynx are 5-1 on the season. Seimone Augustus will meet her former team for the first time since her departure, following 14 years with the franchise.

MONEY MONE

The Sparks signed **Seimone Augustus** this past offseason in a move that surprised the women's basketball world after the veteran had played all 14 seasons in a Minnesota Lynx jersey, winning four titles. After appearing in just 12 games in 2019 due to injuries, Augustus has come out of the gates shooting 55.6% from the field and 66.7% on 3-pointers, averaging 9.2 points in 17.4 minutes per game. Not only is Augustus scoring at an efficient clip, she's come up with multiple clutch scoring runs in the second half of her first five games. Seimone Augustus will meet her former team for the first time since her departure, following 14 years with the franchise.

DOUBLE DOUBLE PARKER

Candace Parker recorded four consecutive doubles in the wins against the Indiana Fever on August 5 (18 points and 11 rebounds), Connecticut Sun on July 30 (10 points and 11 rebounds) and the losses to Seattle on August 1 (19 points and 12 rebounds) and Las Vegas on August 7 (20 points and 12 rebounds). This is the first time Parker has had four double-doubles in a row since 2015 when she had a seven game streak, per CBS Sports. Through six games, Parker is averaging a double-double with 14.7 points and 10.3 rebounds while shooting 48.6% from the field.

ROOKIE BUZZ

After Kristi Toliver opted out of the 2020 season, the Sparks signed rookie **Te'a Cooper**, the No. 18 overall pick in the 2020 WNBA Draft who was waived by the Phoenix Mercury. Cooper has impressed early with tenacious, pressure defense and shown lighting quickness attacking the basket. She's averaging 6.0 points in 15.5 minutes per game and has worn out opposing point guards, keeping the Sparks competitive in all three games she's appeared.

ROUND UP

Riquna Williams scored 16 points in the Sparks 81-75 loss to the Storm on Aug. 1, eclipsing the 2,000 career point mark. Williams previously held the record for most points in a WNBA game, scoring 51 on 9/18/13 as a member of the Tulsa Shock, a record that was broken by Liz Cambage when she scored 53 points on 7/17/18 as a member of the Dallas Wings.

Nneka Ogwumike continues to be one of the most efficient players in league history, starting off the season shooting 60.5% from the field to go along with 13.2 points per game.

Chelsea Gray is averaging 5.7 assists per game, to go along with 12.7 points and is hoping to get her scoring going in this next stretch of the season.

Sparks center **Marie Gülich** played in her first contest of the season on August 5, contributing six points, three rebounds, and a strong defensive performance, recording both a steal and a block. Gülich made her first start with the Sparks on August 7.

LEADERSHIP

Head Coach Derek Fisher enters his second season with the Sparks coming off an impressive debut campaign, leading the Sparks to a 22-12 record and the WNBA Semifinals. Fisher accomplished this in his first season in the WNBA despite key players including Candace Parker, Alana Beard, Maria Vadeeva and Riguna Williams missing a combined 74 games.

President & COO Danita Johnson begins her second season overseeing all business operations. In her first year, the LA Sparks won the 2019 Business Franchise of the Year and took the top honors for Marketing Performance and Ticket Sales. Johnson brings 15 years of experience in the WNBA, NBA and NBA G League.

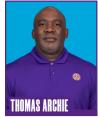

Aces Outlast Sparks Despite Parker's Double-Double

The LA Sparks fell short in a tight game against the Las Vegas Aces, 86-82. Candace Parker recorded her fourth consecutive double-double, scoring 20 points and snatching 12 rebounds, but it was not enough to overcome the Aces, led by A'ja Wilson's 26 points and 11 rebounds. Angel McCoughtry added 24 points, eight rebounds and five assists for Vegas and the Aces out-rebounded the Sparks 42-33.

The Sparks started off strong with an and-one from Sydney Wiese, who scored the first five points for the Sparks. But the Aces took control and after going up 22-19 at the end of the first quarter, started the second quarter on a 9-0 run to go up 31-19.

But Wiese, starting her second game of the season, continued her strong play, helping the Sparks go on a 10-1 run to close the gap to 32-29. Wiese scored 16 first-half points, the second-most points she's scored in a half in her career (she previously scored 19 points in a half on May 19, 2017). The Aces led 43-42 at halftime.

The Sparks worked hard in the third quarter getting solid contributions from Marie Gülich (7 points and 5 rebounds), starting her first game of the season, and Kristine Anigwe (8 points) and took a one-point lead into the fourth quarter, 63-62.

The fourth quarter went back and forth until Wilson, who went scoreless in the third quarter, took over with 12 points in the fourth. 2019 No. 1 pick Jackie Young also had an explosive fourth quarter, scoring critical baskets down the stretch for Las Vegas. She finished with 15 points.

"Yea, I'll take that one," Wiese said after the game. "That's who I was on in the last part of the fourth [quarter] and she was making great plays, what I was failing to do was cutting her off and making her go the other way. I was trying to get under the screen and I stopped short, so she had an angle to the basket and [she] made tough shots. They made plays down the stretch and Jackie was one of those players, and so I need to do a better job next time making sure that I take care of her any way that I can, just to make sure she doesn't score."

Chelsea Gray finished with 16 points and four assists and passed the 2,000 career points milestone. With the loss, the Sparks are now 3-3 and have a quick turnaround as they play Sunday, Aug. 9 against the Minnesota Lynx at Noon PT on ESPN.

"We still have high expectations," Head Coach Derek Fisher said after the game. "We still know that we are going to be where we need to be at the right time, but there are no short-cuts to becoming great. So we can't kid ourselves into thinking we can just show up and be great. It's going to take time, going to take adversity, and it is going to take us asking ourselves the hard questions and finding the answers and solutions to get us where we are trying to get to. There is no short-cut or way around that, it's hard work and a journey."

Los Angeles Highlights:

- Candace Parker recorded her fourth consecutive double-double (20 points and 12 rebounds)
- Chelsea Gray eclipsed 2,000-point career points, making her the 122nd player to reach that mark.
- Three Sparks players finished in double-figures: Candace Parker (20), Chelsea Gray (16), and Sydney Wiese (18). Wiese scored 16 of her points in the first half.
