MAKING HISTORY

- This season the Wings will begin their 2017 campaign with all five draft selections from this year's WNBA draft. The five picks are the first time in 17 years that a WNBA team will enter their season with five or more draftees. The last time this occurred was in 2000, when the Minnesota Lynx opened their campaign with six draft selections.
- Sunday's game will be the first of 20 WNBA games to be streamed live via Twitter. The afternoon matchup will mark as the first time a professional women's sport game will be streamed live on the social channel. Fans can watch the game wnba.twitter.com and via @WNBA.

MILESTONE WATCH

- Veteran Karima Christmas-Kelly is just 14 points shy of scoring her 1500th WNBA point. The star forward could make her mark in the books this Sunday in Phoenix. Last season, Christmas-Kelly averaged 12.4 points per game with 423 scored overall.
- Skylar Diggins-Smith is also close to scoring her 1500th WNBA point. She is 32 points shy of the mark, and will look to pass that in the first two games of the season. Last year Diggins-Smith registered a total of 353 points, averaging 13.1 per game.

PRESEASON REWIND

- In preseason action, the Wings went 1-1, with an 87-81 loss in San Antonio and an 80-75 victory over Indiana at home. Rookies Allisha Gray and Kaela Davis showed out leading the team in points. In San Antonio, Gray registered 15 points, shooting perfectly behind the line (8-for-8). Davis led the way against Indiana, recording 14 points. In both games she shot perfectly behind the line and ended the preseason with a perfect 1.000 percentage.

- On April 23 the Wings began their second training camp in the Dallas Fort-Worth area with nine returning players, five draft picks and three camp invitees.

- On April 13, 2017 the Wings selected five draft picks overall. Three of the picks were in the first round. The Wings draft class was forward Evenlyn Akhator (3rd pick), guard Allisha Gray (4th pick), guard Kaela Davis (10th pick), center Breanna Lewis (23rd) and guard Saniya Chong (26th)

- The month of February the Wings....

- Traded guard Odyssey Sims to the Los Angeles sparks acquiring two draft picks in the 2017 WNBA Draft (4th and 26th).
- Signed guard Tiffany Bias to a one-year contract. Bias initially joined the team in July of 2016.
- Signed new Assistant Coach Taj McWilliams-Franklin.

- Last season the Dallas Wings....

- Ended the 2016 season with an 11-23 record, finishing 5th in the Western Conference, and 11th overall in the league.
- Theresa Plaisance scored her first 20+ point game at Connecticut on 9/16.
- Skylar Diggins played her 100th game in her WNBA career on 9/11 against New York.
- Head Coach Fred Williams recorded his 100th win as a WNBA head coach against San Antonio on 9/9 with a 94-82 win.
- Glory Johnson became the first WNBA player to be part of the 20-20 club since 2013. Johnson scored 23 points and recorded 22 boards, leading the Wings to their third straight win over Phoenix, 77-74 on July 5.
- Skylar Diggins scored 29 points, the second highest in her career and most points scored by a Wings player in 2016 on 6/28

2017 DALLAS WINGS SEASON NOTES

TEAM QUICK STATS

- This year's draft class ranks as the third time in franchise history that the Wings have had five picks or more
- The Wings having three picks in the first round breaks a franchise record for more first round selections in any WNBA draft. The most picks the team previously has had is two (2000, 2005, 2006 and 2011).
- The five picks are the first five in league history to be solidified in an opening season roster since the 2000 Minnesota Lynx opened their roster with six draft selections.
- The Wings will return six players this season, four with four or more years and two with one to three years experience.
- Last season the team finished in the top five in the league in field goal percentage at 47.6
- Last season the Wings made at least seven or more 3-pointers in 10 games. In the month of June, the Wings went on a hot streak hitting 10 3-pointers or more in a game. The most recorded was 15 against the Liberty in New York. It was a season team high.
- On June 8, 2016, the Wings scored 117 points against the Phoenix Mercury, breaking a franchise record for points scored in a game.
- September of 2016 is definitely a month to remember, as the Wings snapped an 11-game winning streak to give Head Coach Fred Williams his 100th victory as a WNBA coach.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Rookies Allisha Gray and Kaela Davis saw double this preseason. Combined, they have scored a total of 50 points. In the first pre-season game, Gray finished with 15 points, while Davis scored 13. Davis came back a week later to close out the pre-season with 14 points and lead the team to a 80-75 victory.
- Assistant Coach Bridget Pettis was named the 2017 Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame back in December of 2016. Pettis will be honored in a special ceremony tonight for her accomplishments and attributes she has made in the game of basketball as a player and coach. Pettis enters her fourth season as an assistant coach under head coach Fred Williams and the Wings franchise.

After being named the seventh head coach in franchise history in Jan. 2014, Williams enters his fourth season at the helm of the Dallas Wings and his 14th season of coaching overall in the WNBA.

Williams, who also had a two-and-a-half year stint as head coach of the Utah Starzz and a one-and-a-half year run at the helm of the Atlanta Dream, has compiled a 101-118 regular season record as a WNBA head coach, including four seasons with a winning percentage at or above a .500. In 2016, Williams recorded his 100th victory as a WNBA head coach when the Wings defeated San Antonio 92-84 on Sept. 9. It was also in 2016 that Williams served as an on-court coach for the USA Basketball Women's National Team's February training camp in advance of the 2016 Rio Olympic Games.

In 2014, his first season in his current position, Williams led the then-Tulsa Shock to an 18-16 mark and the franchise's first playoff appearance and best season since the team moved from Detroit prior to the 2010 season.

Immediately prior to joining the Shock/Wings, Williams served with the Dream from 2009-13, first as an assistant to Marynell Meadors from 2009-12 and then as head coach and general manager after taking over for Marynell Meadors late in the 2012 season. During his six seasons with Atlanta, the team appeared in 11 playoff games and reached the WNBA Finals three times, twice with Williams in the role of assistant (2010 and 2011) and once with him at the helm (2013).

Also a successful coach at the collegiate level, Williams was instrumental in the development of several players who went on become Hall of Famers, including Cynthia Cooper, Pamela McGee, Cheryl Miller, Lisa Leslie and Tina Thompson, all of whom he tutored at the University of Southern California. Williams began his coaching career at USC, serving as an assistant for the women's basketball program during their back-to-back National Championships in 1983 and 1984. He later returned to USC as head coach from 1995-1997. In his final season, he took the Women of Troy to their 13th NCAA tournament appearance with a 20-9 overall record.

He would then return to USC, as head coach from 1995-1997. In his final season, he took the Women of Troy to their 13th NCAA tournament with a 20-9 overall record, where the team went 1-1 in the tournament.

In 1998, Williams began his WNBA stint as an assistant with Utah (now the San Antonio Stars) and was elevated to head coach five games into the following season and served in that capacity through 2001, amassing a 50-42 (.543) regular season record as head coach.

Williams graduated from Boise State University in 1979, where he played two seasons as a guard under head coach Bus Conner and was named to the All-Big Sky team.

Williams is a native of Inglewood, CA. Off the court, he is an avid musician who produces jazz music under the name "Freddy Bass Williams." He has released two jazz albums titled "Game Time" and "My Gift to You." He and his wife Bo, an Atlanta native and a Who's Who of Atlanta honoree for the past four years, reside in Irving, Tex. They have five children between them.
