### TEAM STATS

- The Wings are now 1-1 for the 2017 season.
- The team will go on a two-game road trip to face the San Antonio Stars and the Phoenix Mercury
- On the road, the Wings are currently 1-0. Overall on the road, the team is 110-203.
- In road season openers the Wings are 7-12 overall and 2-0 since moving to the Dallas-Fort Worth area.
- May 14th's season opener win is the second straight season that the Wings have gotten the win to open up the season.
- The victory marks the first stretch of winning season-opening games in back-to-back years since the 2007-08 season, when the team was the Detroit Shock.
- The Wings continue to out rebound their opponent, 66-56.
- Against Phoenix, the Wings recorded the most boards for the season (41 to 17). It was also the most the team has ever out boarded their opponent on a season opener game.
- The Wings are shooting over 80% percent behind the line, which places them third in the league.
- This Wings began their 2017 campaign with all five draft selections from this year's WNBA draft. The five picks are the first time in 17 years that a WNBA team will enter their season with five or more draftees. The last time this occurred was in 2000, when the Minnesota Lynx opened their campaign with six draft selections.
- This year's draft class now has three college graduates. Top pick **Evelyn Akhator** graduated this month from Kentucky, **Breanna Lewis** received her degree at Kansas State on May 13, and **Saniya Chong** got her diploma from Connecticut.

### INDIVIDUAL STATS

- Rookie **Kaela Davis** opened the season with 20 points. She is the first rookie in franchise history to open the season with 20 points scored and the third rookie to lead the team in scoring on a season opening game. Davis currently ranks in the top five in eight categories amongst rookie leaders.... She currently ranks second in rookie leaders in scoring with 13.5 ppg.
- Fellow rookie **Allisha Gray** is averaging 13.0 and is third amongst rookie leaders in scoring average. She is ranked in the top five in seven categories under the rookie leaders.
- The Dynamic duo of Davis and Gray marked the first time that two rookies led the team in points in a season opening game.
- Glory Johnson** is 23 boards shy from recording her 1000th rebound in her WNBA career.... She is currently averaging 10.5 boards per game.



### MILESTONE WATCH

- Karima Christmas-Kelly** and **Skylar Diggins-Smith** are close to scoring their 1500th WNBA point. Christmas-Kelly is two points shy while Diggins-Smith is three. Against the Lynx, Diggins-Smith recorded 22 points, to pull her within the mark.
- Should the veteran duo hit their marks during today's contest it will be the second time in WNBA history when teammates reached the same multiple-of-500 career points milestone with more than 1000 career points.
- The last time this occurred was in August 9, 2011 (MIN at PHO) when MIN teammates Seimone Augustus and Lindsay Whalen both reached 3000 career point.
- It is also the first time in W history that two teammates with hyphenated last names reached the milestone in the same game.

## HEAD COACH FRED WILLIAMS • BOISE STATE • 7 YEARS HEAD COACHING EXPERIENCE

After being named the seventh head coach in franchise history in Jan. 2014, Fred Williams enters his fourth season at the helm of the Dallas Wings and his 14th season of coaching overall in the WNBA.

Williams, who also had a two-and-a-half year stint as head coach of the Utah Starzz and a one-and-a-half year run at the helm of the Atlanta Dream, has compiled a 101-118 regular season record as a WNBA head coach, including four seasons with a winning percentage at or above a .500. In 2016, Williams recorded his 100th victory as a WNBA head coach when the Wings defeated the Stars 92-84 on Sept. 9. It was also in 2016 that Williams served as an on-court coach for the USA Basketball Women's National Team's February training camp in advance of the 2016 Rio Olympic Games.

In 2015, his second season, Williams led the then-Tulsa Shock to an 18-16 mark and the franchise's first playoff appearance and best season since the team moved from Detroit prior to the 2010 season.

Immediately prior to joining the Shock/Wings, Williams served with the Dream from 2009-13, first as an assistant to Marynell Meadors from 2009-12 and then as head coach and general manager after taking over for Meadors late in the 2012 season. During his six seasons with Atlanta, the team appeared in 11 playoff games and reached the WNBA Finals three times, twice with Williams in the role of assistant (2010 and 2011) and once with him at the helm (2013).

Also a successful coach at the collegiate level, Williams was instrumental in the development of several players who went on become Hall of Famers, including Cynthia Cooper, Pamela McGee, Cheryl Miller, Lisa Leslie and Tina Thompson, all of whom he tutored at the University of Southern California.

Williams began his coaching career at USC, serving as an assistant for the women's basketball program during their back-to-back National Championships in 1983 and 1984. He later returned to USC as head coach from 1995-1997. In his final season, he took the Women of Troy to their 13th NCAA tournament appearance with a 20-9 overall record.

In 1998, Williams began his WNBA stint as an assistant with Utah (now the San Antonio Stars) and was elevated to head coach five games into the following season and served in that capacity through 2001, amassing a 50-42 (.543) regular season record as head coach.

Williams graduated from Boise State University in 1979, where he played two seasons as a guard under head coach Bus Conner and was named to the All-Big Sky team.

Williams is a native of Inglewood, CA. Off the court, he is an avid musician who produces jazz music under the name "Freddy Bass Williams." He has released two jazz albums titled "Game Time" and "My Gift to You." He and his wife Bo, an Atlanta native and a Who's Who of Atlanta honoree for the past four years, reside in Irving, Tex. They have five children between them.
