- Myisha Hines-Allen's 35 points scored against Dallas on 8/21/20 are the most by any Mystics player against the Wings in franchise history.
- Washington last won the season series against Dallas in 2019, sweeping the Wings for the only time since the franchise's relocation to Dallas in 2016.

AP-- Natasha Cloud scored 21 points and Shavonte Zellous hit a pair of free throws with 4.7 seconds left to cap a second-half comeback in the Washington Mystics' 76-75 victory over the Dallas Wings on Saturday night. Washington was without Elena Delle Donne, who returned a week ago after missing 22 months following a pair or back surgeries. Delle Donne came out of Thursday's game after 12 minutes as a precaution and is considered day-to-day. The Mystics also were without Tina Charles because of a left glute strain. Dallas built a 17-9 lead after one quarter and a 35-19 advantage at intermission, but the Mystics scored 57 second-half points. Cloud, who scored all 21 points in the second half, hit three 3s and scored 15 points in the third quarter to help spark the rally. Zellous hit a 3 early in the fourth to give the Mystics their first lead, 54-53 and Cloud and buried a long 3 30-seconds later to extend the Washington lead to four, 57-53. Myisha Hines-Allen added 15 points and Theresa Plaisance had 11 for Washington (10-15). The Mystics had lost nine of their previous 11 games. Arike Ogunbowale scored 25 points to lead the Wings (11-15), hitting a pair of 3-pointers in the final 10 seconds, including a 28-footer as time expired to pull Dallas within one. Isabelle Harrison added 18 points for Dallas and Marina Mabrey had 17.

COMMISSIONERS CUP



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its second season in 2022. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the first half of the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool of half a million dollars in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, July 26.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2022 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 6 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, defeating the Connecticut Sun 79-57.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).
- Head Coach Mike Thibault (360) looks to reach 375 career wins. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 154 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.130) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (1,779) needs 221 points to become the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points.

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and her 790 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise
 history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,527) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (180) looks to record her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so.
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in three-consecutive seasons (2019-21).

Myisha Hines-Allen

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (794) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (470) looks to haul in her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so.

Alysha Clark

- Alysha Clark (1,891) looks to record her 2000th career point.
- Clark (928) needs 72 rebounds to record her 1000th career rebound.
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

Tianna Hawkins

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,143 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .470 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- With six rebounds, Hawkins (609) can surpass Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history.



2022 NOTES

Rookie Moves

- Rookie Shakira Austin recorded her first career-double of her career (13 points and 10 rebounds). Austin's 10 rebounds are the most by a WAS rookie in a single game since Myisha Hines-Allen hauled in 11 on 5/29/18 at SEA.
- Austin becomes just the second rookie in franchise history to record a double-double through only two career games played (Alessandra Santos de Oliveira (19 pts., 18 rebs, 6/13/98 at Utah).

All About Defense

- To start the season Washington ranks top five in both offensive (104.6; fourth) and defensive (88.3; third) rating. The Mystics have a net rating of +16.3, best in the league.
- The Mystics are holding opponents to 70.7 points per game, on .394 shooting (third in the WNBA).
- The team is forcing opponents into 17.0 turnovers per game, resulting in 19.7 points off turnovers per game
- Washington is holding opponents to only 5.0 fast break points per game.

Clouds Hot Start

- Natasha Cloud recorded 19 points and six assists on 5/8 at MIN, the sixth consecutive game dating back to 9/10/2021 she has dished five or more assists in a game. The longest five-plus game streak in franchise history is seven games (done three times).
- Cloud has started the season scoring 15+ points in both games this season, marking the first time in her career she has scored 15 or more points in consecutive games.

GAME RECAP (5/10 vs. LVA)

- Led by Elena Delle Donne's 19 points, five Mystics starters reached double-figures (Atkins, Hines-Allen, Benzan, Hawkins).
- For the third consecutive game, Ariel Atkins reached double-figures, her eighth straight game she has scored 10+ points [8/31/21-5/10/22]
- Myisha Hines-Allen tied a career-best with eight assists, also notching a season-high 15 points, eight rebounds. Hines-Allen becomes just the fifth player in Mystics history to total at least eight assists and zero turnovers in a game (and the first since 9/8/2020).
- The Mystics have now recorded 20 or more assists in all three games played this season (21 vs. LVA).
- Washington overcame a 15-point first half deficit to defeat Las Vegas, just the fourth time in franchise history the team has trailed by 15+ points to win by 10 or more (this marks the largest comeback win following a 15+ point deficit).
