SERIES NOTES

- The Mystics have won four of the last five season series against the Sky dating back to 2017. Washington and Chicago tied the season series 1-1 in 2020.
- Washington is 12-3 in their last 15 contests against Chicago dating back to the 2017 season.
- The Mystics won seven consecutive home meetings versus the Sky from 9/7/16 to 9/4/20, the longest such streak in series histroy.

September 10, 2021 Mystics 79, Sky 71

AP-- Tina Charles had 31 points, 10 rebounds and five assists to help the Washington Mystics beat the Chicago Sky 79-71 on Sunday. The Mystics (12-18) — who played without Elena Delle Donne (back), Ariel Atkins (personal reasons) and Myisha Hines-Allen (non-COVID illness) — have a one-game lead, with two games to play, over the Los Angeles Sparks and the New York Liberty for the final playoff spot. Charles scored 10 points and hit two of Washington's five 3-pointers during a 21-1 run that gave the Mystics the lead for good. Chicago went scoreless over the last four minutes of the first quarter as the Mystics ripped off 15 consecutive points. After a defensive 3-seconds technical foul, Allie Quigley made a free throw to snap a scoring drought of nearly seven minutes but Charles and Leilani Mitchell made back-to-back 3s to cap the spurt and made it 30-15 with 7:08 left in the first half. Chicago (15-15) needs to win one of its final two games to secure the No. 6 seed — and a first-round game at home — in the playoffs. Natasha Cloud had 16 points and eight assists and Shatori Walker-Kimbrough scored 14 points and had a career-high six steals for Washington. Azurá Stevens led the Sky with a season-high 18 points. Quigley added 15 points and Candace Parker had 12 points, 11 rebounds and five assists. Chicago made just 3 of 22 (13.6%) from 3-point range.

COMMISSIONERS CUP



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its second season in 2022. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the first half of the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool of half a million dollars in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, July 26.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2022 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 6 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, defeating the Connecticut Sun 79-57.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).
- Head Coach Mike Thibault (362) looks to reach 375 career wins. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 156 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.130) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (1,813) needs 187 points to become the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points.

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded
 in a single season in franchise history and her 815 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise
 history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,572) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (185) looks to record her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so.
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in three-consecutive seasons (2019-21).

Myisha Hines-Allen

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (807) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (482) looks to haul in her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so.

Alysha Clark

- Alysha Clark (1,906) looks to record her 2000th career point.
- Clark (941) needs 59 rebounds to record her 1000th career rebound.
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

Tianna Hawkins

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,160 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .472 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (620) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].



2022 NOTES

Rookie Moves

- Shakira Austin has recorded 10+ points in three games this season, joining fellow rookies Rhyne Howard (ATL) and NaLyssa Smith (IND) to total at least three double-digit scoring games.
- Austin recorded her first career-double (13 points and 10 rebounds) on 5/8 at MIN. Austin becomes just the second rookie in franchise history to record a double-double through only two career games played (Alessandra Santos de Oliveira (19 pts., 18 rebs, 6/13/98 at Utah).
- On 5/17 at Dallas, Austin recorded 20 points and eight rebounds on .818 shooting. Austin is just the second rookie in franchise history to record 20/5 on .750 or better shooting [Temeka Johnson; 6/18/05].

Starting The Season Right

- The Mystics hold a 5-1 record, the best record in the Eastern Conference. This also marks the team's best start to a season through six games since the 2018 season when the team also compiled a 5-1 record.
- With Washington's 78-73 win over the Dream on 5/20, the team improved to 3-0 on the road this season. This marks the first time the team has started 3-0 in away games since the 2015 season.
- Washington went 3-0 to start the season, marking only the fourth time since 2010.

- Through six games, Washington ranks second in offensive rating (105.3) and is averaging 83.2 points per game (third) on .467 shooting (second).
- Washington has an assists percentage of 69.4%, fourth best in the WNBA
- The Mystics rank third in defensive rating (94.5) and are holding opponents to 74.5 points per game (second fewest), on .413 shooting (second in the WNBA).
- Washington is holding opponents to: 10.0 second chance points (fourth), to 29.7 points in the paint (third) and 9.0 fast break points (t-third).

 Washington's bench is averaging 23.5 points per game on .514 shooting, first in the league. Washington's bench has totaled 20 or more points the past four consecutive games and outscored their opponents bench in four of the teams six games this season.

She's Back

 Elena Delle Donne has started the season averaging 18.5 points (seventh in WNBA), 6.5 rebounds and 2.8 assists on .490 shooting from the field and .350 shooting from three-point range. She joins Alyssa Thomas (CON) and Sylvia Fowles (MIN) as the only players to start the season averaging at least 18 points and five rebounds on .450 or better shooting.

Clouds Hot Start

- Natasha Cloud recorded five assists on 5/20 at ATL, the eighth consecutive game dating back to 9/10/2021 she has dished five or more assists in a game, marking the longest five-plus game streak in franchise history.
- Cloud has started the season scoring 10+ points in all four games she has played, marking the first time since the 2019 seasons she has recorded 10+ points in three or more consecutive games.

HEAD COACH MIKE THIBAULT

Mike Thibault was named the head coach/general manager of the team on December 18, 2012. Under his tutelage, Washington has made the playoffs all but twice (2016, 2021). The winningest coach in WNBA history, Thibault has led Washington to the playoffs to seven total postseason appearances and in four of the last five seasons.
