SERIES NOTES

- The Mystics are currently on a six-game home win streak over Atlanta, the longest in series history.
- Washington has won nine of the last 10 matchups against Atlanta.
- Five of the last six matchups between these two teams have been determined by less than 10 points.
- Ariel Atkins' 32 points scored against the Dream last season (6/17/21) are the most scored by a Mystics player against Atlanta in series history.
- The Mystics have claimed victory in three-consecutive season series against Atlanta (2019-21), posting a 7-1 record during that time.

Mystics 78, Dream 73

AP-- Ariel Atkins scored 18 points, Natasha Cloud added 17 and the Washington Mystics erased a double-digit deficit in the second-half to beat the Atlanta Dream 78-73 on Friday night. There were two ties and three lead changes in the final 2 1/2 minutes, the last of which came when Tianna Hawkins made two free throws to give the Mystics a 74-73 lead with 41.5 seconds left. After Atlanta's Rhyne Howard missed a jumper, Cloud made two foul shots and Atkins stole a pass and added two more free throws to cap the scoring with 19 seconds remaining. Howard hit four 3-pointers and led Atlanta (4-2) with 21 points. The No. 1 selection in last month's draft, Howard is averaging 20.5 points while shooting 46.7% from behind the arc. Her 21 made 3s through six career games are second in WNBA history. Ruthie Bolton had 23 for the Sacramento Monarchs in 1997. Cheyenne Parker scored 13 points, Nia Coffey had 12 points and 10 rebounds, and Erica Wheeler added 11 points for the Dream. Hawkins added 11 points for Washington (5-1) and rookie Shakira Austin had 10 points, seven rebounds and three steals. Atlanta scored 10 consecutive points to take a 56-46 lead when Wheeler hit a 3-pointer midway through the third quarter. The Mystics responded with an 11-0 run soon after.

COMMISSIONERS CUP



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its second season in 2022. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the first half of the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool of half a million dollars in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, July 26.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2022 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 6 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, defeating the Connecticut Sun 79-57.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).
- Head Coach Mike Thibault (362) looks to reach 375 career wins. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 156 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.130) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (1,830) needs 170 points to become the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points.

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and her 815 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,592) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (186) looks to record her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so.
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in three-consecutive seasons (2019-21).

Myisha Hines-Allen

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (807) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (483) looks to haul in her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so.

Alysha Clark

- Alysha Clark (1,906) looks to record her 2000th career point.
- Clark (941) needs 59 rebounds to record her 1000th career rebound.
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

Tianna Hawkins

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,162 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .471 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (622) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].

Rookie Moves

- Shakira Austin has recorded 10+ points in four games this season, joining fellow rookies Rhyne Howard (ATL) and NaLyssa Smith (IND) to total at least four double-digit scoring games.
- Austin currently ranks second in the WNBA in field goal percentage (63.8%), trailing only Sylvia Fowles. Austin is one of seven players to have totaled 50+ total points this season while shooting 55.0% or better.
- On 5/17 at Dallas, Austin recorded 20 points and eight rebounds on .818 shooting. Austin is just the second rookie in franchise history to record 20/5 on .750 or better shooting [Temeka Johnson; 6/18/05].

- Austin recorded her first career-double (13 points and 10 rebounds) on 5/8 at MIN. Austin becomes just the second rookie in franchise history to record a double-double through only two career games played (Alessandra Santos de Oliveira (19 pts., 18 rebs, 6/13/98 at Utah).

- With Washington's 78-73 win over the Dream on 5/20, the team improved to 3-0 on the road this season. This marks the first time the team has started 3-0 in away games since the 2015 season.

On 5/22 vs. Chicago, Atkins passed Alana Beard for second in franchise three-point makes. Atkins is the youngest player in Mystics history to reach 200 three-point makes.

- Through seven games, Washington ranks third in offensive rating (103.6) and is averaging 81.7 points per game (fifth) on .453 shooting (third).
- Washington has an assists percentage of 70.1%, fourth best in the WNBA.
- The Mystics rank fourth in defensive rating (95.8) and are holding opponents to 75.6 points per game (third fewest).
- Washington is holding opponents to: 10.0 second chance points (third), to 31.1 points in the paint (third) and 8.3 fast break points (third).
