SERIES NOTES

- The Mystics have not won the series season against Connecticut since 2016, losing three series and splitting two since then.
- Washington was swept by Connecticut last season for the first time since the 2012 season.
- Natasha Cloud dished out a career-high 12 assists against the Sun last year (8/31/21). This represents the most assists by a Mystics player against Connecticut in franchise history.

AP-- Jonquel Jones scored 21 of her career-high tying 31 points in the first half and Connecticut beat the Washington Mystics 85-75 on Tuesday night for the Sun's ninth straight victory. It's the longest winning streak for Connecticut (21-6) since a 12-game run in 2006. Jones, who set a career-high for points in a half, also grabbed 13 rebounds to extend her league lead for double-doubles. Brionna Jones added 22 points and 10 rebounds for Connecticut. Jonquel Jones was 12 of 17 from the field, Brionna Jones went 10 for 14, and the Sun shot 49.3%. Washington was missing Elena Delle Donne (back) and Tina Charles (left gluteal). Connecticut outrebounded Washington 38-20, including a 16-3 edge on the offensive end. The Sun also had a 46-24 advantage for points in the paint and 19-0 in second-chance points. Shatori Walker-Kimbrough scored 17 points for Washington (10-16), which has lost all three games to the Sun this season. Myisha Hines-Allen and Ariel Atkins each added 16 points, and Natasha Cloud had 12 assists.

COMMISSIONERS CUP



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its second season in 2022. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the first half of the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool of half a million dollars in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, July 26.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2022 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 6 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, defeating the Connecticut Sun 79-57.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).
- Head Coach Mike Thibault (363) looks to reach 375 career wins. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 157 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.130) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (1,845) needs 155 points to become the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points.

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded
 in a single season in franchise history and her 832 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,602) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (186) looks to record her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so.
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in three-consecutive seasons (2019-21).

Myisha Hines-Allen

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (807) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (487) looks to haul in her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so.

Alysha Clark

- Alysha Clark (1,917) looks to record her 2000th career point.
- Clark (944) needs 56 rebounds to record her 1000th career rebound.
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

Tianna Hawkins

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,162 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .471 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (622) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].



2022 NOTES

Rookie Moves

- Shakira Austin has recorded 10+ points in four games this season, joining fellow rookies Rhyne Howard (ATL) and NaLyssa Smith (IND) to total at least four double-digit scoring games.
- Austin has recorded five-plus rebounds in six games, one of four rookies to have totaled at least five or more games of five-plus rebounds. Austin's six games are the fourth most by a Mystics rookie since 2010.
- Austin currently ranks second in the WNBA in field goal percentage (62.3%), trailing only Sylvia Fowles. Austin is the only rookie to have totaled 75+ points on 50.0% or better shooting.

All Hustle

- Washington is averaging 8.1 steals per game, the fifth most in the WNBA, the first time Mystics have averaged eight or more assists since the 2012 season (8.6).
- The Mystics forced the Dream into 25 turnovers on 5/24, one of three teams this season to force 25+ turnovers. Washington is ranked third in opponent turnovers, forcing 16.6 per game and is averaging 17.3 points off opponent turnovers (fifth in WNBA).

Triple A

 Ariel Atkins has connected on 18 three-point makes this season, seventh most in the WNBA. Atkins is currently averaging 2.3 three-pointers on .462 shooting from long distance. On 5/22 vs. Chicago, Atkins passed Alana Beard for second in franchise threepoint makes. Atkins is the youngest player in Mystics history to reach 200 three-point makes.

 On 5/24 Washington held Atlanta to an opponent season-low 50 points - marking the 17th time in franchise history the Mystics have held an opponent to 50 or fewer points. This also marked the fewest points an opponent has scored since 7/17/2015 (Indiana; 50).

 On 5/24 vs. Atlanta, Elena Delle Donne scored her 4000th career point, becoming the 40th player in the WNBA to reach 4000 points. Delle Donne is the second quickest to 4000 career points.

Elena Delle Donne has started the season averaging 17.7 points (ninth in WNBA), 6.5 rebounds and 2.2 assists on .487 shooting from the field and .379 shooting from three-point range. She joins Nneka Ogwumike (LAS) and Sylvia Fowles (MIN) as the only players to start the season averaging at least 17 points and five rebounds on .470 or better shooting.

9's Dishing Dimes

 Natasha Cloud recorded five assists on 5/24 vs. ATL, the 10th consecutive game dating back to 9/10/2021 she has dished five or more assists in a game, the longest five-plus game streak in franchise history. Cloud is averaging 6.8 assists per game, second most in the WNBA.

HEAD COACH MIKE THIBAULT

Mike Thibault was named the head coach/general manager of the team on December 18, 2012. Under his tutelage, Washington has made the playoffs all but twice (2016, 2021).
