STORM

SERIES NOTES

- The Mystics lost the season series against Seattle last year for the first time since 2018.
- Washington's 41 total rebounds recorded last season on Aug. 22, 2021 are the most rebounds in series history since the 2009 season and the Mystics' 25 assists dished out that game are tied for the most assists in series his tory.
- Elena Delle Donne's 37 points tallied on Sept. 1, 2017 against the storm are the most scored against Seattle in series history. Washington would win that game 110-106, which ranks as the highest scoring contest between the two teams in series history.

PREVIOUS MEETING

September 7, 2021 Mystics 71, Storm 105

AP-- Jewell Loyd scored 20 points, Sue Bird added 14 points and seven assists and the Seattle Storm cruised to a 105-71 win over the Washington Mystics on Tuesday night. The Storm (20-10) moved into third place in the playoff race with two games to play. Seattle raced out to a 10-point lead in the first quarter, hitting eight 3-pointers. Bird made all four of her attempts from behind the arc in the quarter. Seattle kept it going and Katie Lou Samuelson was fouled as she hit a 3 in transition and converted the 4-point play to give Seattle a 67-45 lead with 6:28 left in the third quarter. Moments later Breanna Stewart gingerly walked to the locker room and did not return to action. The Storm played swarming defense throughout, regularly trapping Tina Charles — who went into the game averaging a WNBA-leading 24.8 points per game. Charles finished with four points on 1-of-6 shooting with three turnovers. Washington's Elena Delle Donne missed her fourth consecutive game (back). The two-time WNBA MVP returned from a nearly-two year absence on Aug. 22 — an 85-78 loss to Seattle — and played just three games. Shavonte Zellous hit four 3-pointers and finished with 17 points for Washington (10-18), which fell a half-game behind New York for the final playoff spot. Ezi Magbegor scored 15 points, Samuelson added 13 and Mercedes Russell 11 for Seattle. All 11 Storm players that entered the game scored at least two points. Seattle shot 59.1% from the field and made 14 3s, both season highs.

COMMISSIONERS CUP



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its second season in 2022. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the first half of the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool of half a million dollars in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, July 26.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2022 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 6 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, defeating the Connecticut Sun 79-57.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).
- Head Coach Mike Thibault (368) looks to reach 375 career wins. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 162 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.328) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (1,896) needs 104 points to become the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points.

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and her 911 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,769) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (200) recorded her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so. [6/21 at LAS]
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in three-consecutive seasons (2019-21).

Myisha Hines-Allen

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (902) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (535) recorded her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so. [6/5 at CHI]

Alysha Clark

- Alysha Clark (1,995) needs five points to record her 2000th career point.
- Clark (978) needs 31 rebounds to record her 1000th career rebound.
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

Tianna Hawkins

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,214 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .466 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (644) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].



2022 NOTES

Sharing the Ball

- Washington is averaging 20.5 assists per game, fifth most in the WNBA. The Mystics hold an assist percentage of 69.5% (fifth) and an assist ratio of 18.4, third best in the WNBA.
- The Mystics' 20.5 assists are the most the team has averaged since 2019 (21.9) and is currently the second most in franchise history.
- The Mystics have recorded 20+ assists 13 times this season, tied for the most 20+ assists games by a team this season.
- Since the 2018 season, Washington has total 72 games of 20+ assists, the fifth most in that time span.

 dished five or more assists in a game, the longest active streak
 in the WNBA and the third longest streak in league history.
- Cloud 13 assist are tied for the most by a Mystics player [Ivory Lotta, 2013] and it marks her 10th career 10+ assist game.
 Since the 2019 season, she has totaled eight 10+ assist games - the second most in the league.
- Cloud is averaging a career-best 7.4 assists per game, the most in the WNBA.
