#### SERIES NOTES

- New York claimed the season series 2-1 last year, the first time they have won the series since 2017.
- The Mystics are 8-3 against the Liberty spanning back to the start of the 2018 WNBA season.
- The Mystics' 101 points scored in last years 101-72 win over the Liberty is tied for the most points scored against New York in franchise history, also doing so on 8/25/19 vs. NY.

#### PREVIOUS MEETING

September 17, 2021 Mystics 80, Liberty 91

AP-- Natasha Howard scored 24 points, Sabrina lonescu added 22 and the New York Liberty keep alive their playoff hopes with a 91-80 victory over the Washington Mystics on Friday night. The Liberty (12-20) need Washington to lose to Minnesota on Sunday and have Los Angeles lose at Dallas that day as well. The Liberty, who snapped an eight-game losing skid, hold the tiebreaker by virtue of having a better record against the two other teams. Washington (12-19) would get the No. 8 seed with a win Sunday. Washington was missing coach Mike Thibault, who is in COVID-19 protocols. He'll also miss the team's final game Sunday against Minnesota. His son, Eric, coached the game in his absence. New York jumped out to a 26-15 after one quarter as Howard had 11 points, making all five of her shots. New York kept it up in the second quarter extending the advantage to 20 on Rebecca Allen's 3-pointer with 2:28 left in the half. That was New York's 317th of the season to set a WNBA record, passing Washington's mark set in 2019. The Liberty, who finished the season with 321 3s, connected on seven of their 11 3-point attempts in the first half and led 46-29 at the break. The lead expanded to 24 before Washington rallied to cut it to 79-74 with 5:03 left. New York scored eight of the next 10 points to put the game away. Ariel Atkins scored 29 points to lead Washington.

#### **COMMISSIONERS CUP**



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its second season in 2022. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the first half of the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool of half a million dollars in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, July 26.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2022 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 6 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, defeating the Connecticut Sun 79-57.

### WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

#### **Team**

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).
- Head Coach Mike Thibault (364) looks to reach 375 career wins. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 158 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.328) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

#### **Elena Delle Donne**

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (1,864) needs 136 points to become the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points.

#### **Natasha Cloud**

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded
  in a single season in franchise history and her 847 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise
  history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

#### **Ariel Atkins**

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,643) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (189) looks to record her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so.
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in three-consecutive seasons (2019-21).

#### **Myisha Hines-Allen**

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (814) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (495) looks to haul in her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so.

#### **Alysha Clark**

- Alysha Clark (1,917) looks to record her 2000th career point.
- Clark (944) needs 56 rebounds to record her 1000th career rebound.
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

#### **Tianna Hawkins**

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,172 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .466 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (623) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].



### **2022 NOTES**

#### No Soup for You

- On 5/31 at IND, Elizabeth Williams totaled 10 points, 15 rebounds and six blocks off the bench for the Mystics. Williams' six blocks ties a franchise high and she becomes the first player since Cheyenne Parker (8/27/2019) to total at least six blocks off the bench.
- Williams joins Sylvia Fowles (7/9/2014) as the only players to record at least 10 points, 15 rebounds and five blocks in a reserve role. She is also the only player in franchise history to total 10+ points and 15+ rebounds in a game off the bench.
- Williams is currently averaging 2.0 blocks per game, joining LaToya Sanders as the only Mystics players to average 2.0+ blocks per game.

#### Top of the East

- Washington holds a 7-3 record through 10 games, tied for the second best record in the WNBA and tied with CON for the best record in the Eastern Conference.
- The Mystics' 7-3 start is tied for the second best record through 10 games in franchise history and the best start since 2019.

#### Sharing the Ball

- Washington is averaging 21.1 assists per game, second most in the WNBA. The Mystics hold an assist percentage of 71.0% (third) and an assist ratio of 19.1, second best in the WNBA.
- The Mystics' 21.1 assists are the most the team has averaged since 2019 (21.9) and is currently the second most in franchise
- The Mystics have recorded 20+ assists eight times this season, the most 20+ assists games by a team this season.

#### 9's Dishing Dimes

- Natasha Cloud recorded nine assists on 5/31 at IND, the 12th consecutive game dating back to 9/10/2021 she has dished five or more assists in a game, the longest active streak in the WNBA and the longest streak in franchise history. Cloud is one of 12 players in the WNBA to hold a 10+ game streak.
- Cloud is averaging a career-best 7.0 assists per game, second most in the WNBA.

- Elena Delle Donne has started the season averaging 17.7 points (eighth most in WNBA), 6.6 rebounds and 2.3 assists on .484 shooting from the field and .371 shooting from three-point range. She joins Nneka Ogwumike (LAS) and Sylvia Fowles (MIN) as the only players to start the season averaging at least 17 points and five rebounds on .470 or better shooting.
- Delle Donne recorded her 68th 15+ point game with the Mystics on 5/31 at IND, tied for fifth in franchise 15+ point games.

Mike Thibault was named the head coach/general manager of the team on December 18, 2012. Under his tutelage, Washington has made the playoffs all but twice (2016, 2021). The winningest coach in WNBA history, Thibault has led Washington to the playoffs to seven total postseason appearances and in four of the last five seasons.
