#### PREVIOUS MEETING

June 3, 2022 Mystics 70, Liberty 74

AP-- Sabrina lonescu made 5 of 10 3-pointers and finished with 24 points, Natasha Howard added 17 points and the New York Liberty beat the Washington Mystics 74-70 on Friday night. New York (3-7) hit 11 3-pointers, made 17 of 18 free throws and committed a season-low 12 turnovers. The Liberty have won back-to-back games following a seven-game losing streak. Howard, who scored 10 points in the fourth quarter, finished with seven rebounds and three steals — the last of which came when she stole a pass from Natasha Cloud, was fouled and hit 1 of 2 from the foul line to make it 72-70 with 24.6 second to go. Rebecca Allen added 11 points — seven in the final 2-plus minutes — and Sami Whitcomb was 3 of 6 from 3-point range and finished with nine points. Cloud scored nine points in a 13-5 spurt that gave Washington (7-4) a one-point lead with three minutes to play and her pull-up jumper with 1:29 to play stretched the advantage to 68-65. Out a of timeout, Rebecca Allen tied it with a 3-pointer before Cloud set up a layup by Myisha Hines-Allen to give the Mystics a 70-68 lead with 1:11 remaining but Howard finished a layup through contact and made a free throw to give the Liberty the lead for good with 56.1 seconds to go. Cloud led Washington with 17 points and eight assists — her 13th consecutive game with at least five assists, a franchise record. Ariel Atkins and Elena Delle Donne each added 15 points. New York's Betnijah Laney, a 2021 All-Star, underwent surgery Wednesday to repair meniscus damage in her right knee and is slated to miss approximately eight weeks.

#### **COMMISSIONERS CUP**



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its second season in 2022. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the first half of the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool of half a million dollars in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, July 26.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2022 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 6 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, defeating the Connecticut Sun 79-57.

### WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

#### **Team**

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).
- Head Coach Mike Thibault (367) looks to reach 375 career wins. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 160 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.328) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

#### **Elena Delle Donne**

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (1,881) needs 25 points to become the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points.

#### **Natasha Cloud**

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and her 891 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

#### **Ariel Atkins**

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,724) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (195) looks to record her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so.
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in three-consecutive seasons (2019-21).

#### **Myisha Hines-Allen**

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (882) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (523) recorded her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so. [6/5 at CHI]

#### **Alysha Clark**

- Alysha Clark (1,997) looks to record her 2000th career point.
- Clark (967) needs 33 rebounds to record her 1000th career rebound.
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

#### **Tianna Hawkins**

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,207 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .466 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (638) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].



### **2022 NOTES**

#### Sharing the Ball

- Washington is averaging 20.8 assists per game, fourth most in the WNBA. The Mystics hold an assist percentage of 69.0% (fourth) and an assist ratio of 18.5, third best in the WNBA.
- The Mystics' 20.8 assists are the most the team has averaged since 2019 (21.9) and is currently the second most in franchise history.
- The Mystics have recorded 20+ assists 11 times this season, the most 20+ assists games by a team this season.
- Since the 2018 season, Washington has total 71 games of 20+ assists, the fifth most in that time span.

#### 9's Dishing Dimes

- Natasha Cloud recorded 10 assists on 6/14 vs. PHX, the 18th consecutive game dating back to 9/10/2021 she has dished five or more assists in a game, the longest active streak in the WNBA and the fifth longest streak in league history.
- Cloud recorded her ninth career 10+ assist on 6/14. Since the 2019 season, she has totaled seven 10+ assist games - the second most in the league.
- Cloud is averaging a career-best 7.1 assists per game, second most in the WNBA.

#### **HEAD COACH MIKE THIBAULT**

Mike Thibault was named the head coach/general manager of the team on December 18, 2012. Under his tutelage, Washington has made the playoffs all but twice (2016, 2021). The winningest coach in WNBA history, Thibault has led Washington to the playoffs to seven total postseason appearances and in four of the last five seasons.
