#### SERIES NOTES

- The Mystics lost the season series against Seattle last year for the first time since 2018.
- Seattle's +14 win margin over Washington earlier this season on June 23 (85-71) ranks as the Storm's sixth-largest win over the Mystics in series history.
- Elena Delle Donne's 37 points tallied on Sept. 1, 2017 against the storm are the most scored against Seattle in series history. Washington would win that game 110-106, which ranks as the highest scoring contest between the two teams in series history.

#### PREVIOUS MEETING

July 30, 2022 Mystics 77, Storm 82

AP-- Breanna Stewart made four free throws in the final 12 seconds and finished with 18 points, Tina Charles scored 16 points and grabbed nine rebounds and Seattle used a big second-half run to beat the Washington Mystics 82-77 Saturday and clinch a berth in the WNBA playoffs. Seattle (19-11), which had lost three of its previous four games, took sole possession of fourth in the league standings — a game ahead of the fifth-place Mystics and 1 1/2 games behind No. 3 Connecticut with about two weeks before the postseason begins. The Storm have won the first two games of their three-game regular season series with Washington, which wraps up when the teams meet again Sunday. Epiphanny Prince took two steals coast-to-coast for layups 18 seconds apart as the Storm score the first 13 points of the fourth quarter to cap a 16-0 spurt that made it 70-55 when Stefanie Talbot made a 3-pointer with 26.28 to play. Washington scored 14 of the next 18 points to trim its deficit to five points with 26.3 seconds remaining. After an inadvertent whistle by an official, Seattle called timeout and Talbot threw away the ensuing inbounds pass but Ezi Magbegor forced Washington's Elena Delle Donne into a tough shot with 14.9 seconds to go. Stewart grabbed the offensive rebound and the Storm held on. Washington (18-12) had won three games in a row and five of its last 6. Delle Donne led the Mystics with 22 points and Atkins scored 13. Shakira Austin added 10 points and 10 rebounds and Natasha Cloud had 10 points and 11 assists.

# WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

#### <u>Team</u>

• Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).

WASHINGTON MYSTICS GAME NOTES

- Head Coach Mike Thibault (375) recorded his 375 career win [7/28 at DAL]. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 169 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.328) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

#### Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (2,092) became the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points [at LAS, 7/17].

#### Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and her 987 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise
  history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

#### Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,920) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (214) recorded her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so. [6/21 at LAS]
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in threeconsecutive seasons (2019-21).

#### Myisha Hines-Allen

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (1,006) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (607) recorded her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so. [6/5 at CHI]

#### **Alysha Clark**

- Alysha Clark (2,082) recorded her 2000th career point [6/23 at Seattle]
- Clark (1029) recorded her 1000th career rebound [7/3 at CON]
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

#### **Tianna Hawkins**

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,233 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .466 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (649) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].



# **2022 NOTES**

#### Sharing the Ball

- Washington is averaging 20.1 assists per game, seventh most in the WNBA. The Mystics hold an assist percentage of 68.6% (fourth) and an assist ratio of 18.1, fifth best in the WNBA.
- The Mystics' 20.1 assists are the most the team has averaged since 2019 (21.9) and is currently the second most in franchise history.
- The Mystics have recorded 20+ assists 18 times this season, tied for the third most 20+ assists games by a team this season.
- Since the 2018 season, Washington has total 77 games of 20+ assists, the fifth most in that time span.

#### 9's Dishing Dimes

- Natasha Cloud's 23 five-plus assists game streak ended on 6/28, marking the third longest streak in league history.
- Cloud totaled her fifth 10+ assist game of the season and her 12th career 10+ assist game on 7/30 vs. SEA. Since the 2019 season, she has totaled 10 10+ assist games - the second most in the league.
- Cloud is averaging a career-best 7.2 assists per game, the most in the WNBA.
