- •Washington's +16 margin of victory at Dallas earlier this season on May 17 (86-62) ranks as the second-largest victory against the Wings in series history.
- Dallas has won the season series in back-to-back seasons (2020-20221).
- Washington last won the season series against Dallas in 2019, sweeping the Wings for the only time since the franchise's relocation to Dallas in 2016.
- Myisha Hines-Allen dropped a franchise record and career-high 35 points against Dallas on Aug. 21, 2020.

PREVIOUS MEETING

May 17, 2022 Mystics 84, Wings 68

AP-- Shakira Austin, the No. 3 overall pick in last month's draft, scored 12 of her career-high 20 points in the second half as the Washington Mystics pulled away for a 84-68 win over the Dallas Wings on Tuesday night. The 6-foot-5 Austin made 9 of 11 from the field, grabbed eight rebounds and blocked two shots. Elena Delle Donne added 14 points for Washington (4-1), Shatori Walker-Kimbrough scored 11 and Natasha Cloud and Kennedy Burke each had 10 points. The Wings (2-2) jumped to a 19-6 lead but then went scoreless for 4-plus minutes as Washington scored 13 consecutive points to tie it early in the second quarter and Austin made two free throws to give the Mystics their first lead with 3:34 left in the second quarter and followed with a layup 37 seconds later to make it 34-31. Marina Mabrey hit a 3-pointer for Dallas but Cloud answered with a 3 of her own to make it 37-34 at halftime and Washington led the rest of the way. Mabrey and Isabelle Harrison each scored 16 points for the Wings. Allisha Gray added 14 points and Kayla Thornton scored 13. Delle Donne made a driving layup, Ariel Atkins hit a 3-pointer and Delle Donne added another 3 in an 8-0 run that made it 58-43 midway through the third and the Wings trailed by double figures the rest of the way.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).
- Head Coach Mike Thibault (374) looks to reach 375 career wins. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 168 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.328) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (2,070) became the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points [at LAS, 7/17].

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and her 969 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,893) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (213) recorded her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so. [6/21 at LAS]
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in three-consecutive seasons (2019-21).

Myisha Hines-Allen

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (984) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (593) recorded her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so. [6/5 at CHI]

Alysha Clark

- Alysha Clark (2,064) recorded her 2000th career point [6/23 at Seattle]
- Clark (1024) recorded her 1000th career rebound [7/3 at CON]
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

Tianna Hawkins

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,226 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .466 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (648) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].



2022 NOTES

Sharing the Ball

- Washington is averaging 20.1 assists per game, seventh most in the WNBA. The Mystics hold an assist percentage of 68.9% (fourth) and an assist ratio of 18.2, fifth best in the WNBA.
- The Mystics' 20.1 assists are the most the team has averaged since 2019 (21.9) and is currently the second most in franchise history.
- The Mystics have recorded 20+ assists 17 times this season, the third most 20+ assists games by a team this season.
- Since the 2018 season, Washington has total 76 games of 20+ assists, the fifth most in that time span.

- Natasha Cloud's 23 five-plus assists game streak ended on 6/28, marking the third longest streak in league history. Cloud's three assists on 6/28 marked a season low.
- Cloud totaled her fourth 10+ assist game of the season and her 11th career 10+ assist game on 6/23. Since the 2019 season, she has totaled nine 10+ assist games - the second most in the league.
- Cloud is averaging a career-best 7.0 assists per game, the most in the WNBA.

Delle Donne totaled 21 points and 10 rebounds on 7/17 vs. MIN, marking the first time she has totaled consecutive double-doubles since the 2019. This marked Delle Donne's 30th career 20/10 game (11th most all-time).

HEAD COACH MIKE THIBAULT

Mike Thibault was named the head coach/general manager of the team on December 18, 2012. Under his tutelage, Washington has made the playoffs all but twice (2016, 2021).
