#### SERIES NOTES

• With a win, the Mystics would sweep the Aces for the first time since the franchise relocated to Las Vegas in 2018.

• Washington currently leads the season series 2-0, claiming it for the first time over Las Vegas since the 2019 WNBA season.

- Five of the past six games between these teams have been decided by 10 or less points.
- Washington forward Myisha Hines-Allen dropped 32 points against the Aces last season in a 93-96 loss on June 5, 2021. This stands as the most points scored by a Mystics player against Las Vegas in series history.

## PREVIOUS MEETING

June 25, 2022 Mystics 87, Aces 86 OT

AP-- Alysha Clark scored 20 points, Elena Delle Donne added 19 and Natasha Cloud sank three free throws in the final 11.7 seconds of overtime to help the Washington Mystics hold on for an 87-86 victory over the Las Vegas Aces on Saturday night. Clark hit four 3-pointers for Washington (12-9), adding eight rebounds and four steals. Delle Donne, who had 15 of her points after halftime, blocked five shots and grabbed 10 rebounds for her first double-double of the season. Cloud scored 16 with 10 assists. Ariel Atkins totaled 15 points, five rebounds, four assists and three steals. Kelsey Plum and Jackie Young both scored 20 to pace Las Vegas (13-4), which had consecutive losses for the first time this season. Plum had six of the Aces' 17 steals. A'ja Wilson finished with 17 points, 14 rebounds and three blocks. Young sank a 3-pointer with 7.7 seconds remaining to send the game to overtime tied at 80. Cloud sank two foul shots and Atkins made a jumper to give the Mystics an 84-80 lead with 2:38 left in OT. Plum hit a 3-pointer at the 2:11 mark to pull the Aces within a point. Cloud made 3 of 4 free throws to put the Mystics up 87-83. Wilson sank a 3-pointer with less than a second left to cap the scoring.



# WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2022

#### <u>Team</u>

• Washington looks to make the playoffs for the ninth time under Head Coach Mike Thibault's tutelage. Since Thibault has been at the helm (2013), the Mystics have not reached the postseason only twice (2016, 2021).

WASHINGTON MYSTICS GAME NOTES

- Head Coach Mike Thibault (376) recorded his 375 career win [7/28 at DAL]. Thibault is the winningest coach in WNBA history and has totaled 170 wins with the franchise.
- The 2022 WNBA season marks the 25th Anniversary for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, CBSSN, ESPN2, ESPN3, NBATV) 18 times this season.
- Washington has nine afternoon games this season, with five of the nine games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- Washington looks to total at least 20 wins. Since 2018, Washington, Connecticut, Las Vegas and Seattle are the only teams to have multiple 20-plus win seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the sixth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted a franchise-high 27.4 three-pointers per game.
- Washington will look to build upon their three-pointers made per game (9.0) and three-point field goal percentage (.328) which both rank second in franchise history only behind the 2019 season.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 18+ assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Washington is one-of-five teams in the league who have compiled three-straight 18+ assist per game seasons.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the sixth time over the last seven seasons.

#### Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to finish top-five in points for the sixth time since the 2015 season. Delle Donne ranked second in points (19.5) during the 2019 season.
- Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .500 percent from the field and .400 percent from three-point range (min. 3 PTA per game) for the second time in her career after doing so during the 2019 campaign.
- For the fourth time in her career, Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season.
- Delle Donne (2,109) became the sixth player in franchise history to score 2,000 points [at LAS, 7/17].

#### Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 6.4 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to total 150 or more assists for the third consecutive season. Cloud's 189 assists in 2019 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and her 1002 career assists rank as the most in franchise history.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the third-consecutive season. Cloud could become the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).

#### Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to continue to improve her scoring average for the third consecutive season, after averaging a career-best 16.2 points per game.
- Atkins (1,943) could become the sixth player in franchise history to eclipse 2,000 career points with the franchise.
- Atkins (214) recorded her 200th career steal this season, becoming only the seventh player in franchise history to do so. [6/21 at LAS]
- Atkins looks to notch 40+ steals for a fourth-straight season. Atkins is the only player in the league to tally 40+ steals in threeconsecutive seasons (2019-21).

#### Myisha Hines-Allen

- Myisha Hines-Allen looks to average at least 12.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game for the third consecutive season. Hines-Allen is one-of-eight players in the WNBA to average 12+ points and 7+ rebounds since 2019.
- Hines-Allen (1,011) looking to eclipse 1,000 points for her career.
- Hines-Allen (610) recorded her 500th career rebound, becoming the 19th player in franchise history to do so. [6/5 at CHI]

#### **Alysha Clark**

- Alysha Clark (2,087) recorded her 2000th career point [6/23 at Seattle]
- Clark (1035) recorded her 1000th career rebound [7/3 at CON]
- Clark to build upon career-highs in field goal percentage (.558) and three-point percentage (.522) recorded during the 2020 season. Clark has finished with a FG% of .500-or-better four times in her nine-year career.

#### **Tianna Hawkins**

- Tianna Hawkins will look to climb the Mystics' all-time points scored leader board. Hawkins currently ranks 20th in franchise history with 1,233 points in a Mystics uniform.
- Hawkins will look to build on her .466 career field goal percentage with Washington which ranks as the sixth highest in franchise history.
- Hawkins (649) surpassed Kia Vaughn (614, 2013-16) for the 11th-most rebounds in Mystics history [on 5/17 at DAL].



# **2022 NOTES**

#### Sharing the Ball

- Washington is averaging 20.0 assists per game, seventh most in the WNBA. The Mystics hold an assist percentage of 68.4% (fourth) and an assist ratio of 18.1, sixth best in the WNBA.
- The Mystics' 20.0 assists are the most the team has averaged since 2019 (21.9) and is currently the second most in franchise history.
- The Mystics have recorded 20+ assists 18 times this season, tied for the fourth most 20+ assists games by a team this season.
- Since the 2018 season, Washington has total 77 games of 20+ assists, the fifth most in that time span.

9's Dishing Dimes

- Cloud totaled her sixth 10+ assist game of the season and her 13th career 10+ assist game on 7/31 vs. SEA. Since the 2019 season, she has totaled 11 10+ assist games the second most in the league.
- Cloud's has recorded four point-assist double-doubles, tied for the most in the league this season (Ionescu and Vandersloot).
- On 7/31 vs. SEA, Cloud became the first Mystic to record a point-assist double-double in consecutive games since Temeka Johnson on June 1st-3rd (2005). It also marked the first of Cloud's career
- Cloud is averaging a career-best 7.3 assists per game, the most in the WNBA.

• Cloud notched her 1,000th career assist on 7/31 vs. SEA. She is now the 32nd player in WNBA history to tally 1,000 assists in a career.

#### HEAD COACH MIKE THIBAULT

Mike Thibault was named the head coach/general manager of the team on December 18, 2012. Under his tutelage, Washington has made the playoffs all but twice (2016, 2021). The winningest coach in WNBA history, Thibault has led Washington to the playoffs to seven total postseason appearances and in four of the last five seasons.

#### Triple A
