SERIES NOTES

• Washington is on an eight-game home win streak over Atlanta, the longest such streak in series history.

• The Mystics held the Dream to 50 points in their 70-50 win last season on May 24, 2022. This ranks as the lowest amount of points allowed by Washington against Atlanta in series history (previously 61, 6/20/08).

• The Mystics have won 11 of the last 12 games against the Dream.

• Ariel Atkins' 32 points scored against the Dream on June 17, 2021 are the most scored by a Mystics player against Atlanta in series history.

• The Mystics have claimed victory in four-consecutive season series against Atlanta (2019-2022), posting a 11-1 record during that time.

PREVIOUS MEETING

July 6, 2022 Mystics 85, Dream 66

AP-- Elena Delle Donne scored nine of her season-high 26 points in the fourth quarter and the Washington Mystics beat the Atlanta Dream 85-66 on Wednesday night.

Delle Donne was 10 of 17 from the field and had eight rebounds. Myisha Hines-Allen added 14 points, Natasha Cloud had 13, Shatori Walker-Kimbrough a season-high 12 and Ariel Atkins 10 for Washington (14-10).

Delle Donne scored 13 points in the first half, including a fadeaway from the right block and then stepped into a deep fast-break 3-pointer — which gave the Mystics the lead for good — to spark a 9-0 run that made it 41-36 at halftime.

Washington scored nine consecutive points to make it 67-56 with six minutes to play after Delle Donne hit a short turnaround jumper. The Dream trailed by at least seven the rest of the way.

Monique Billings, Cheyenne Parker, Tiffany Hayes and Rhyne Howard scored 10 points apiece for Atlanta (10-12).

Howard played just 8 1/2 first-half minutes after picking up her second personal foul late in the first quarter and never found offensive rhythm. The No. 1 overall selection in April's draft, Howard went 0 for 6 from 3-point range and goes into her first WNBA All-Star game having four of her last 29 3-point shots over the past five games.

The Dream, which has lost six in a row against Washington, went 0 for 13 from 3-point range.

COMMISSIONER'S CUP

The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its third season in 2023. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool and an additional pool of money for charitable and civic organizations in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, August 15.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2023 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 19 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, and the Las Vegas Aces took home the Cup last season, defeating the Chicago Sky 93-83 in the championship game.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the first time with Eric Thibault at the helm. Since Thibault joined the Mystics in 2013 (formerly Assistant Coach 2013-19, associate head coach 2019-22), the Mystics have reached the postseason in all but two seasons (2016, 2021).
- The Mystics are set to play 40 regular season games for the first time in league history. The 40-game season is an increase from the WNBA's 36-game season last year.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, ESPN, CBS, CBSSN, ION and NBA TV) 23 times this season.
- Washington has 11 afternoon games this season, with six of the 11 games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- The Mystics will play their 850th regular season game on July 28, 2023, at Dallas. This date will also mark the Mystics' 900th regular or postseason game in franchise history.
- Washington will look to improve upon their franchise-high defensive rebounds per game set last season after the team averaged 26.9 per game.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the seventh-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted 22.5 three-pointers per game.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 20+ assists per game for the second-consecutive season and for the third time in franchise history (2022, 2019).
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the seventh time over the last eight seasons.
- The 2023 WNBA season marks the 26th season for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .900 from the free throw line for the eighth time in her career (at least 90 FTA).
- Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season for the fourth time in her career.
- Delle Donne is six wins away from 150 career wins and 32 games away from 250 career games (both regular season).
- Delle Donne (2168) needs 123 points to pass Emma Meesseman (2290) as the fifth all-time leading scorer in franchise history. She needs 387 points to become the third all-time leading scorer (Crystal Langhorne, 2554).

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 7.0 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to extend her franchise record assists (1030) after passing 1,000 career assists last season.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Cloud is the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).
- Cloud looks to total 200 or more assists for the second consecutive season. Cloud's 239 assists in 2022 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and led the WNBA last season.
- Cloud looks to finish the season top five in the WNBA in assists per game for the fourth time since 2019 (did not play in 2020).
- Cloud looks to average one or more steals per game for the fourth consecutive season.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to top 500 total points in the season for the second time in her career and second consecutive season.
- Atkins looks to exceed her single-season career high in three-point field goals made after setting a new high last season (70).
- Atkins looks to continue to improve her rebounding numbers, after averaging career-bests with 2.3 defensive rebounds and 3.2 total rebounds per game.
- Atkins looks to notch 45+ steals for a third-straight season to join nine others in WNBA history to do so.
- Atkins looks to become one of 11 players in WNBA history to earn All-Defensive honors at least six times in her career.
- Atkins (221) needs 40 steals this season to pass Monique Currie (260) and become the second all-time steals leader in franchise history. She is currently tied third all-time with Chamique Holdsclaw.

Kristi Toliver

- Kristi Toliver along with Diana Taurasi (18), Candace Parker(15), Epiphanny Prince (13), DeWanna Bonner (13), Jasmine Thomas (12) and Courtney Vandersloot (12) are the only active WNBA players to have played at least 12 seasons
- In her 13th season, Toliver looks to continue to move up the all-time three-point field goals made list, where she currently ranks seventh all-time (641).
- Currently ranked fifth in franchise history, Toliver looks to increase her total three-point field goals made (184) as a Mystic.
- Toliver is 31 games away from reaching 400 career regular season games played.
- Toliver (4434) needs 66 points to reach a new milestone of 4,500 points.

Shakira Austin

- Shakira Austin looks to build off of her rookie season as the sixth player in franchise history to be named to an All-Rookie Team
- Austin looks to shoot .540 or better from the field for the second-straight season. Her .547 field goal percentage last season ranked as the franchise's second highest by a Mystics rookie (Min. 25 GP), trailing only Crystal Langhorne in 2008 (.624).
- Austin looks to build upon her six double-figure rebound games, which was the most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history and led the team in 2022.
- Austin's four double-doubles last season tied Alessandra Santos de Oliveira (1998) for the second-most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history.

Brittney Sykes

- Brittney Sykes looks to lead the WNBA in steals and steals per game for the third-straight year after recording 65 steals in 2022, the most in a single season of her career. She also totaled the most steals per game (2.0) of her career.
- Sykes looks to average 10+ points per game for the fifth time in her career. In 2022, she averaged 12.7 points per game, her highest mark since her rookie year (13.9) in 2017.
- Sykes looks to continue to improve upon her 3.7 assists per game (2022), the highest of her career.
- Sykes is 18 games away from reaching 200 career games.

- On 5/23 vs. Connecticut, Elena Delle Donne's 27 points were the most points she has scored in the regular season since September 3, 2019. Her strong offensive performance builds off last season when she scored 25+ points three times.
- Two days prior on 5/21 at Connecticut, Delle Donne's 11 rebounds were her most boards since July 14, 2022, and tied her second-highest rebounding performance since the 2019 season.

Ariel's Career High

Sophomore Shakira Keeps Improving

 After having one of the best rookie seasons in Mystics history, Shakira Austin keeps getting better in 2023. On June 9, 2023, Austin secured her fifth double-double of the season with 15 points and 11 rebounds. With her fifth double-double through only seven games played, she improves upon her season-high four double-doubles set last year.

Seeking Seattle Sweep

- After defeating the Storm on 6/9 and 6/11 on the road, the Mystics have clinched the season series against Seattle for the first time since 2019
- Prior to the two wins, the Mystics had only defeated the Storm six times in regular season history.
- On 6/11 at SEA, the team put together a historic defensive effort in the first half, holding the Storm to just 21 points, tied for the fewest points the Mystics have ever allowed in a first half against the Storm. The team also allowed 21 points in the first half on July 6, 2013 (WAS 62 vs SEA 59).
- The Mystics will look to sweep the Storm in the regular season for the first time since 2005 when they face them at home on July 11.

- Through 12 games, the Mystics are allowing the fewest opponent points per game in the WNBA, averaging 72.5 points allowed. The next best team in that category are the Las Vegas Aces, averaging 76.3 opponent points per game.
- The Mystics have the best defensive rating in the league with 90.7
- The Mystics average the fourth-most steals per game in the league, led by Brittney Sykes, who leads the league with 21 steals per game.
- The Mystics allow the least opponent second-chance points (72) and opponent points in the paint (31.0) and allow the second-least opponent fast break points (8.1) in the WNBA.
- The Mystics have three players on the roster who have previously won all-defensive first team nods in Ariel Atkins, Natasha Cloud and Brittney Sykes.
