- Elena Delle Donne scored game-high 25 points in their last meeting, shooting 8-of-14 from the field and making 3 three-point shots.
- The Mystics are 9-5 against the Liberty spanning back to the start of the 2018 WNBA season.
- The Mystics' 101 points scored on May 21, 2021 in the team's 101-72 win over the Liberty is tied for the most points scored against New York in franchise history, also doing so on 8/25/19.
- The Mystics' 16 three-point makes on 5/21/21 mark the most three-point makes against the Liberty in series history.

#### Mystics 78, Liberty 69

AP-- Elena Delle Donne scored 25 points, Ariel Atkins added 16 points and the Washington Mystics beat New York 78-69 on Thursday to extend the Liberty's losing streak to five games. Leading by six late in the game, Atkins disrupted a pass along the 3-point line and Alysha Clark grabbled the loose ball and raced for a fast-break layup to extend Washington's lead to 77-69 with 36.7 seconds left. After a timeout, Sabrina lonescu missed a long 3-pointer and Clark secured the rebound before making 1 of 2 free throws at 24.1. Myisha Hines-Allen had 13 points and Clark finished with three points for Washington (17-11). The Mystics have a week off before playing at Dallas on July 28. Natasha Howard had 17 points and 10 rebounds for New York (9-17). Ionescu scored 15 points and Marine Johannes added 12. The Liberty were playing their third consecutive day game. Washington scored 12 unanswered points late in the first half until lonescu completed a three-point play with 3.5 seconds left to pull New York within 40-37 at the break. The Mystics added a 18-6 run in the third quarter and led 61-48 early in the fourth quarter until New York scored 10 straight to get back in it. New York scored the first 10 points of the game and also led 15-2.

### **COMMISSIONER'S CUP**



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its third season in 2023. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool and an additional pool of money for charitable and civic organizations in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, August 15.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2023 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 19 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, and the Las Vegas Aces took home the Cup last season, defeating the Chicago Sky 93-83 in the championship game.

### **WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023**

#### Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the first time with Eric Thibault at the helm. Since Thibault joined the Mystics in 2013 (formerly Assistant Coach 2013-19, associate head coach 2019-22), the Mystics have reached the postseason in all but two seasons (2016, 2021).
- The Mystics are set to play 40 regular season games for the first time in league history. The 40-game season is an increase from the WNBA's 36-game season last year.
- Washington will appear on Disney-owned networks (ABC, ESPN) four times this season, with other national TV appearances (CBS, CBSSN, ION and NBA TV) to be announced at a later date.
- Washington has 11 afternoon games this season, with six of the 11 games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- The Mystics will play their 850th regular season game on July 28, 2023, at Dallas. This date will also mark the Mystics' 900th regular or postseason game in franchise history.
- Washington will look to improve upon their franchise-high defensive rebounds per game set last season after the team averaged 26.9 per game.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the seventh-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted 22.5 three-pointers per game.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 20+ assists per game for the second-consecutive season and for the third time in franchise history (2022, 2019).
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the seventh time over the last eight seasons.
- The 2023 WNBA season marks the 26th season for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.

#### **Elena Delle Donne**

- Elena Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .900 from the free throw line for the eighth time in her career (at least 90 FTA).
- Delle Donne will look to total at least 500 points and 200 rebounds in a single season for the fourth time in her career.
- Delle Donne is six wins away from 150 career wins and 32 games away from 250 career games (both regular season).
- Delle Donne (2168) needs 123 points to pass Emma Meesseman (2290) as the fifth all-time leading scorer in franchise history. She needs 387 points to become the third all-time leading scorer (Crystal Langhorne, 2554).

#### **Natasha Cloud**

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 7.0 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to extend her franchise record assists (1030) after passing 1,000 career assists last season.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Cloud is the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).
- Cloud looks to total 200 or more assists for the second consecutive season. Cloud's 239 assists in 2022 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and led the WNBA last season.
- Cloud looks to finish the season top five in the WNBA in assists per game for the fourth time since 2019 (did not play in 2020).
- Cloud looks to average one or more steals per game for the fourth consecutive season.

### WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

#### **Ariel Atkins**

- Ariel Atkins looks to top 500 total points in the season for the second time in her career and second consecutive season.
- Atkins looks to exceed her single-season career high in three-point field goals made after setting a new high last season (70).
- Atkins looks to continue to improve her rebounding numbers, after averaging career-bests with 2.3 defensive rebounds and 3.2 total rebounds per game.
- Atkins looks to notch 45+ steals for a third-straight season to join nine others in WNBA history to do so.
- Atkins looks to become one of 11 players in WNBA history to earn All-Defensive honors at least six times in her career.
- Atkins (221) needs 40 steals this season to pass Monique Currie (260) and become the second all-time steals leader in franchise history. She is currently tied third all-time with Chamique Holdsclaw.

#### Kristi Toliver

- Kristi Toliver along with Diana Taurasi (18), Candace Parker(15), Epiphanny Prince (13), DeWanna Bonner (13), Jasmine Thomas (12) and Courtney Vandersloot (12) are the only active WNBA players to have played at least 12 seasons
- In her 13th season, Toliver looks to continue to move up the all-time three-point field goals made list, where she currently ranks seventh all-time (641).
- Currently ranked fifth in franchise history, Toliver looks to increase her total three-point field goals made (184) as a Mystic.
- Toliver is 31 games away from reaching 400 career regular season games played.
- Toliver (4434) needs 66 points to reach a new milestone of 4,500 points.

#### **Shakira Austin**

- Shakira Austin looks to build off of her rookie season as the sixth player in franchise history to be named to an All-Rookie Team
- Austin looks to shoot .540 or better from the field for the second-straight season. Her .547 field goal percentage last season ranked as the franchise's second highest by a Mystics rookie (Min. 25 GP), trailing only Crystal Langhorne in 2008 (.624).
- Austin looks to build upon her six double-figure rebound games, which was the most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history and led the team in 2022.
- Austin's four double-doubles last season tied Alessandra Santos de Oliveira (1998) for the second-most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history.

#### **Brittney Sykes**

- Brittney Sykes looks to lead the WNBA in steals and steals per game for the third-straight year after recording 65 steals in 2022, the most in a single season of her career. She also totaled the most steals per game
   (2.0) of her career.
- Sykes looks to average 10+ points per game for the fifth time in her career. In 2022, she averaged 12.7 points per game, her highest mark since her rookie year (13.9) in 2017.
- Sykes looks to continue to improve upon her 3.7 assists per game (2022), the highest of her career.
- Sykes is 18 games away from reaching 200 career games.

### **2022 NOTES**

#### Sharing the Ball

- Washington averaged 20.3 assists per game, seventh most in the WNBA.
   The Mystics held an assist percentage of 69.1% (fourth) and an assist ratio of 18.3, fifth best in the WNBA.
- The Mystics' 20.3 assists are the most the team has averaged since 2019 (21.9) and is the second most in franchise history.
- The Mystics recorded 20+ assists 22 times during the 2022 season. Since the 2018 season, Washington has total 82 games of 20+ assists, the fifth most in that time span.

#### 9's Dishing Dimes

- Natasha Cloud averaged 7.0 assists per game, the most in the WNBA.
   Cloud broke Courtney Vandersloot's four year streak of being the WNBA's assist leader
- Cloud totaled six 10+ assist games of the season. Since the 2019 season, she has totaled 11 10+ assist games - the second most in the league.
- Cloud recorded four point-assist double-doubles, tied for the most in the league this season (lonescu and Vandersloot).
- Natasha Cloud became one of four players in league history to average seven or more assists per game in a single season. Cloud is the only player in franchise history to average seven-plus assists per game.
