SERIES NOTES

- Washington has not claimed the season series over Phoenix since 2018.
- The Mystics' +19 margin of victory over the Mercury in their 88-69 win in their win on June 16, 2023 ranks as the third largest win over Phoenix in series history and is the largest since June 21, 2005 (+21).
- Washington has won two road games against the Mercury since 2010, with both wins in 2018, defeating Phoenix 103-98 on May 30, 2018 and 103-98 on August 7, 2018.
- Washington's overtime game on June 12, 2022 marked the first overtime game in the series since August 3, 2003 -- only the second overtime game in series history.

PREVIOUS MEETING

Mystics 84, Mercury 69

AP-- Natasha Cloud scored 23 points and had nine assists, Brittney Sykes also scored 23 points and the short-handed Washington Mystics beat Phoenix 84-69 Sunday, extending the Mercury's road losing streak to seven games. Shatori Walker-Kimbrough added 13 points for Washington (12-10).

Phoenix (6-16), which is 1-10 away from home this season, has the longest active road losing streak in the WNBA. The Mercury had won back-to-back games (for the first time this season) and three of their last four.

Two-time WNBA MVP Elena Delle Donne (left ankle sprain), Shakira Austin (left hip strain), Ariel Atkins (left ankle sprain) — all regular starters who combine to account for approximately 40% of Washington's scoring this season — and Kristi Tolliver (plantar fasciitis) did not play for the Mystics.

Sykes made a driving basket with 4:52 left in the first quarter that gave the Mystics the lead for good and sparked an 8-0 run, capped when Tianna Hawkins scored to make it 17-10. Sophie Cunningham hit a 3-pointer that trimmed the Mercury's deficit to 30-28 midway through the second quarter but Cloud and Walker-Kimbrough each scored five points in a 10-1 spurt over the next three minutes and the Mystics led by double figures the rest of the way.

Washington scored 22 points off 19 Mercury turnovers. Phoenix went into to the game averaging a league-high 17.3 turnovers per game this season - 1.8 more than any other team.

Cloud scored 19 of her points on 7-of-9 shooting in the first half as the Mystics took a 46-31 lead into the break

Cunningham hit five 3-pointers and finished with 17 points on 6-of-10 shooting for Phoenix. Brittney Griner and Megan Gustafson each scored 12 points and Moriah Jefferson 11. Diana Taurasi (quad/toe) missed her second consecutive game for Phoenix.

COMMISSIONER'S CUP



The WNBA Commissioner's Cup presented by Coinbase returns for its third season in 2023. The in-season tournament pits each team against their five conference rivals during the regular season as they compete for a spot in the Championship Game. The team from each conference with the top record in Cup games will compete for a prize pool and an additional pool of money for charitable and civic organizations in the Commissioner's Cup Championship Game on Tuesday, August 15.

For Washington, the first home and away game of the 2023 season against Atlanta, Chicago, Connecticut, Indiana and New York count towards the Cup Standings, which will take place between May 19 and July 7. The Seattle Storm took home the inaugural Commissioner's Cup in 2021, and the Las Vegas Aces took home the Cup last season, defeating the Chicago Sky 93-83 in the championship game.

The Mystics are playing for DC Safe Babies Safe Moms for the 2023 Commissioner's Cup.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the first time with Eric Thibault at the helm. Since Thibault joined the Mystics in 2013 (formerly Assistant Coach 2013-19, associate head coach 2019-22), the Mystics have reached the postseason in all but two seasons (2016, 2021).
- The Mystics are set to play 40 regular season games for the first time in league history. The 40-game season is an increase from the WNBA's 36-game season last year.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, ESPN, CBS, CBSSN, ION and NBA TV) 23 times this season.
- Washington has 11 afternoon games this season, with six of the 11 games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- The Mystics played their 850th regular season game on July 28, 2023, at Dallas. This date will also marks the Mystics' 900th regular or postseason game in franchise history.
- Washington will look to improve upon their franchise-high defensive rebounds per game set last season after the team averaged 26.9 per game.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the seventh-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted 22.5 three-pointers per game.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 20+ assists per game for the second-consecutive season and for the third time in franchise history (2022, 2019).
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the seventh time over the last eight seasons.
- The 2023 WNBA season marks the 26th season for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .900 from the free throw line for the eighth time in her career (at least 90 FTA).
- Delle Donne (2441) needs 114 points to pass Crystal Langhorne (2554) as the fourth all-time leading scorer in franchise history. She needs 403 points to become the third all-time leading scorer (Monique Curry, 2843).

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 7.0 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to extend her franchise record assists (1778) after passing 1,000 career assists last season.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Cloud is the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).
- Cloud looks to total 200 or more assists for the second consecutive season. Cloud's 239 assists in 2022 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and led the WNBA last season.
- Cloud looks to finish the season top five in the WNBA in assists per game for the fourth time since 2019 (did not play in 2020).
- Cloud looks to average one or more steals per game for the fourth consecutive season.

Brittney Sykes

- Brittney Sykes looks to lead the WNBA in steals and steals per game for the third-straight year after recording 65 steals in 2022, the most in a single season of her career. She also totaled the most steals per game
 (2.0) of her career.
- Sykes looks to average 10+ points per game for the fifth time in her career. In 2022, she averaged 12.7 points per game, her highest mark since her rookie year (13.9) in 2017.
- Sykes looks to continue to improve upon her 3.7 assists per game (2022), the highest of her career.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to top 500 total points in the season for the second time in her career and second consecutive season.
- Atkins looks to exceed her single-season career high in three-point field goals made after setting a new high last season (70).
- Atkins looks to continue to improve her rebounding numbers, after averaging career-bests with 2.3 defensive rebounds and 3.2 total rebounds per game.
- Atkins looks to notch 45+ steals for a third-straight season to join nine others in WNBA history to do so.
- Atkins looks to become one of 11 players in WNBA history to earn All-Defensive honors at least six times in her career.
- Atkins (221) needs 40 steals this season to pass Monique Currie (260) and become the second all-time steals leader in franchise history. She is currently tied third all-time with Chamique Holdsclaw.

Kristi Toliver

- Kristi Toliver along with Diana Taurasi (18), Candace Parker(15), Epiphanny Prince (13), DeWanna Bonner (13),
 Jasmine Thomas (12) and Courtney Vandersloot (12) are the only active WNBA players to have played at least
 12 seasons
- In her 13th season, Toliver looks to continue to move up the all-time three-point field goals made list, where she currently ranks seventh all-time (641).
- Currently ranked fifth in franchise history, Toliver looks to increase her total three-point field goals made (184) as a Mystic.
- Toliver (4434) needs 66 points to reach a new milestone of 4,500 points.

Shakira Austin

- Shakira Austin looks to build off of her rookie season as the sixth player in franchise history to be named to an All-Rookie Team
- Austin looks to shoot .540 or better from the field for the second-straight season. Her .547 field goal percentage last season ranked as the franchise's second highest by a Mystics rookie (Min. 25 GP), trailing only Crystal Langhorne in 2008 (.624).
- Austin looks to build upon her six double-figure rebound games, which was the most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history and led the team in 2022.
- Austin's four double-doubles last season tied Alessandra Santos de Oliveira (1998) for the second-most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history.



2023 NOTES

Steals Leader

- Brittney Sykes currently leads the league in the WNBA in steals per game (2.2), marking the third consecutive season she has led the league (2021, 2022).
- Sykes joins Tamika Catchings (7x) as the only players to lead the league in steals in more than three seasons. If Sykes leads the league again, she will be the first player to do so in three consecutive seasons
- She has totaled 60 steals on the season, the most in the WNBA
- Sykes leads the league in total steals over the last two seasons (125)

Steals, Steals and More Steals

- On 7/30 at Atlanta, Sykes totaled 5+ steals for the fourth time this season. She has had 4+ steals the 14 times since 2020, the most by a player in that time span.
- Sykes has totaled at least one steal in all but two games she has played this season. Her 28-game steal streak (7/28/22-7/11/23) marked the fifth longest streak since the 2010 season. She also joined Tamika Catchings and Angel McCoughtry to hold numerous 20+ game streaks since 2010.
- From 7/26 to 8/4 (four games), Sykes totaled a combined 19 steals, the most by any player over a four-game span this season. It is also the most steals over four games in Mystics history, as she passed Alana Beard (18) for the franchise record.
- On 7/28 at Dallas, she recorded her 250th career steal.

- Brittney Sykes is having a career year, averaging career-bests in points (14.3), rebounds (4.9), assists (3.8) and free throw attempts (4.4)
- She has totaled four 20+ point games this season, tied for the second most 20+ point games in a single season in her career.
- Sykes has connected on 28 three-point makes, her most in a single season since 2019.
- She joins Thomas (CON), Sabally (DAL), Stewart (NYL) and Gray (ATL), as the only players this season to average at least 12.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and a steal per game.

Dynamic Duo

- With injuries to key players, Mystics guards Natasha Cloud and Brittney Sykes stepped up their play. In a five-game stretch (7/9-7/28), they averaged a combined 36.8 points and 9.6 assists. They are one of three sets of teammates to have two players average at least 18.0 points each during this time span.
- Sykes' 18.0 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2.2 steals per game average during this five-game stretch mark the fifth time in her career she has averaged 18/5/2 in a five-game span.
- Coming out of the All-Star break, Cloud totaled 17 points and five assists in four straight games (streak broken on 7/28), the longest stretch of her career and the longest streak of 17/5 by a player this season
- Cloud averaged 22 steals per game in five games after the all-star break, recording 11 steals total, tied for the most in the league over that span.

On Cloud 9

- Natasha Cloud is averaging a career-best 12.4 points per game and is averaging a 6.0 assists per game, one of six players to average at least 12.0 points and 5.0 assists per game this season.
- In the month of July, Cloud averaged 14.6 points, 5.8 assists 3.3 rebounds and 1.8 steals per game.
