SERIES NOTES

• Washington has won seven-straight home games versus Atlanta (June 1, 2019-present), the longest homewinning streak for the Mystics in series history.

• Washington's 109 points on 6/28/23 mark the third most points an opponent has scored against Atlanta this season. The Mystics 109 points also mark the most points the team has scored against the Dream in series history as well as tied for the third most points all-time in franchise history.

- Since the 2019 season (15 total games), Washington has scored 80 or more points 11 times.
- Guard Brittney Sykes' 10 assists on 6/28/23 marked a career best.

• Prior to the Mystics 94-89 loss on 6/30 at Atlanta, the Mystics had won seven consecutive games. Also, Washington has won seven-straight home games versus Atlanta (June 1, 2019-present).

• Delle Donne's 31 points on 6/30 vs. ATL, mark the most points she has scored in a game since 9/3/2019 and tied for the third most points by a player in series history.

Mystics 73, Dream 80

AP-- Allisha Gray tied her career high with 27 points, Nia Coffey had a season-high 16 points, nine rebounds, five assists and two blocks to help the Atlanta Dream beat the Washington Mystics 80-73 on Sunday. Gray made 8 of 11 from the field, 3 of 6 from 3-point range and 8 of 8 from the free-throw line. Rhyne Howard added 11 points, five rebounds, five steals and two blocks and Cheyenne Parker also scored 11 for Atlanta (14-11). Parker hit a mid-range jumper and Gray followed with a pull-up 3-pointer to make it 53-48 midway through the third quarter and the Dream led the rest of the way. Cyesha Goree made a jumper that trimmed Washington's deficit to 58-57 with 8:38 to play but Coffey answered with a 3-pointer 19 seconds later to spark a 10-4 spurt — including five points by Gray — to make it 68-61 with 4:57 remaining.

Brittney Sykes made a driving layup to pull the Mystics within three points with 25.1 seconds left but the Mystics were called for a take foul before the inbounds pass. Aari McDonald made the ensuing technical free throw and the Dream hit 4-of-4 foul shots thereon to seal the victory. Washington (12-13) has lost three games in a row and five of its last six. Regular starters Elena Delle Donne (ankle), Ariel Atkins (ankle) and Shakira Austin (hip) as well as reserve Kristi Toliver (plantar fasciitis) did not play for the Mystics. Sykes had 25 points and season-high six steals and Tianna Hawkins added 17 points and 10 rebounds — her second double-double this season — for the Mystics. The duo made 13 of 31 (42%) from the field while the rest of the team shot 24% (10 of 41).

Gray, who went into the game averaging a career-best 17.9 points per game, has scored 20-plus points eight times this season. The No. 4 overall selection out of South Carolina in the 2017 draft, Gray scored at least 20 points in a game 12 times during six seasons with the Dallas Wings

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the first time with Eric Thibault at the helm. Since Thibault joined the Mystics in 2013 (formerly Assistant Coach 2013-19, associate head coach 2019-22), the Mystics have reached the postseason in all but two seasons (2016, 2021).
- The Mystics are set to play 40 regular season games for the first time in league history. The 40-game season is an increase from the WNBA's 36-game season last year.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, ESPN, CBS, CBSSN, ION and NBA TV) 23 times this season.
- Washington has 11 afternoon games this season, with six of the 11 games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- The Mystics played their 850th regular season game on July 28, 2023, at Dallas. This date will also marks the Mystics' 900th regular or postseason game in franchise history.
- Washington will look to improve upon their franchise-high defensive rebounds per game set last season after the team averaged 26.9 per game.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the seventh-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted 22.5 three-pointers per game.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 20+ assists per game for the second-consecutive season and for the third time in franchise history (2022, 2019).
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the seventh time over the last eight seasons.
- The 2023 WNBA season marks the 26th season for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .900 from the free throw line for the eighth time in her career (at least 90 FTA).
- Delle Donne (2441) needs 114 points to pass Crystal Langhorne (2554) as the fourth all-time leading scorer in franchise history. She needs 403 points to become the third all-time leading scorer (Monique Curry, 2843).

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 7.0 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to extend her franchise record assists (1778) after passing 1,000 career assists last season.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Cloud is the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).
- Cloud looks to total 200 or more assists for the second consecutive season. Cloud's 239 assists in 2022 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and led the WNBA last season.
- Cloud looks to finish the season top five in the WNBA in assists per game for the fourth time since 2019 (did not play in 2020).
- Cloud looks to average one or more steals per game for the fourth consecutive season.

Brittney Sykes

- Brittney Sykes looks to lead the WNBA in steals and steals per game for the third-straight year after recording 65 steals in 2022, the most in a single season of her career. She also totaled the most steals per game (2.0) of her career.
- Sykes looks to average 10+ points per game for the fifth time in her career. In 2022, she averaged 12.7 points per game, her highest mark since her rookie year (13.9) in 2017.
- Sykes looks to continue to improve upon her 3.7 assists per game (2022), the highest of her career.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to top 500 total points in the season for the second time in her career and second consecutive season.
- Atkins looks to exceed her single-season career high in three-point field goals made after setting a new high last season (70).
- Atkins looks to continue to improve her rebounding numbers, after averaging career-bests with 2.3 defensive rebounds and 3.2 total rebounds per game.
- Atkins looks to notch 45+ steals for a third-straight season to join nine others in WNBA history to do so.
- Atkins looks to become one of 11 players in WNBA history to earn All-Defensive honors at least six times in her career.
- Atkins (242) needs 18 more steals to pass Monique Currie (260) and become the second all-time steals leader in franchise history.

Kristi Toliver

- Kristi Toliver along with Diana Taurasi (18), Candace Parker(15), Epiphanny Prince (13), DeWanna Bonner (13), Jasmine Thomas (12) and Courtney Vandersloot (12) are the only active WNBA players to have played at least 12 seasons
- In her 13th season, Toliver looks to continue to move up the all-time three-point field goals made list, where she currently ranks seventh all-time (641).
- Currently ranked fifth in franchise history, Toliver looks to increase her total three-point field goals made (184) as a Mystic.
- Toliver (4434) needs 66 points to reach a new milestone of 4,500 points.

Shakira Austin

- Shakira Austin looks to build off of her rookie season as the sixth player in franchise history to be named to an All-Rookie Team
- Austin looks to shoot .540 or better from the field for the second-straight season. Her .547 field goal percentage last season ranked as the franchise's second highest by a Mystics rookie (Min. 25 GP), trailing only Crystal Langhorne in 2008 (.624).
- Austin looks to build upon her six double-figure rebound games, which was the most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history and led the team in 2022.
- Austin's four double-doubles last season tied Alessandra Santos de Oliveira (1998) for the second-most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history.

Clinched!

- On September 5 at Phoenix, the Mystics controlled their destiny and clinched a playoff berth for the second straight season. The team will be making their sixth playoff appearance over the last seven seasons.
- The Mystics had a historic shooting night in the game that marked just the third time in WNBA history a team has shot 55% or better from the field and 55% or better from three-point range, while making 100% of their free-throws. The last such instance came from the Atlanta Dream on August 23, 2015.
- The Mystics had strong individual performances on the night. Elena Delle led the team with 24 points on her birthday, shooting shooting 9-15 from the field (60.0 %), 2-2 from three and 4-4 from the free-throw line. Natasha Cloud had her second double-double of the season with 20 points and 10 assists, shooting 6-8 from the field. Shatori Walker-Kimbrough scored 17 points while shooting a perfect 7-7 from the field. Rookie Li Meng shot 4-6 from the field, including three made threes in her third game this season with 3+ threes.

Steals Leader

- Brittney Sykes is tied for the league lead with 80 total steals this season, the most steals in a season in franchise history and in her career
- She is second in the league in steals per game (2.1), behind Jordin Canada (2.2, LAS)
- If Sykes leads the league in steals this season, she'll join Tamika Catchings (7x) as the only players to lead the league in steals in more than three seasons. If Sykes leads the league again, she will be the first player to do so in three consecutive seasons.

Steals, Steals and More Steals

- On 8/20 vs. Dallas, Sykes totaled 5+ steals for the sixth time this season. She has had 5+ steals 12 times since 2020, the most by any player in that time span.
- Sykes has totaled at least one steal in all but four games she has played this season. Her 28-game steal streak (7/28/22-7/11/23) marked the fifth longest streak since the 2010 season. She also joined Tamika Catchings and Angel McCoughtry to hold numerous 20+ game streaks since 2010.
- From 7/26 to 8/4 (four games), Sykes totaled a combined 19 steals, the most by any player over a four-game span this season. It is also the most steals over four games in Mystics history, as she passed Alana Beard (18) for the franchise record.
- On 7/28 at Dallas, she recorded her 250th career steal.

Career Year

- Brittney Sykes is having a career year, averaging career-bests in points (15.5), rebounds (4.9), assists (3.8), steals (2.1) and free throw attempts (3.9).
- On 8/18, Sykes scored 30 points for the second-straight game, the first time she's scored 30+ points in back-to-back games. She is just the fifth player this season to score 30+ in back-to-back games and only the third player in Mystics history to do so.
- Sykes also made a career-high five three's on 8/18
- She has totaled eight 20+ point games this season (last: 8/13 vs. CHI), which stands as the most 20+ point games in a single season in her career.
- Sykes has connected on 49 three-point makes, her most in a single season.
- She joins Thomas (CON), Sabally (DAL), Stewart (NYL) and Ionescu (NYL), as the only players this season to average at least 15.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and a steal per game.

Taking Down the Champs

- On 8/26, the Mystics defeated the Las Vegas Aces, 78-62, to hand the team their fifth loss of the season and their only home loss of the thus far.
- The Mystics held the Aces to their lowest team shooting percentage (30.8%) as well as their second-lowest point total (62) and secondlowest team three-point percentage (20.7%) of the season
- The Aces 30 points in the first half was their second lowest total in the first half this season, and their 32 points in the second half was their second lowest total in the second half all year.
- Elena Delle Donne stepped up in a big way, scoring 21 points with seven rebounds and a steal on 6-10 shooting from the field, 2-3 from three and 7-7 from the free-throw line. This was her seventh game this season scoring 20+ and her first since June 30 at Atlanta.

- Natasha Cloud is averaging 6.0 assists per game, sixth most in the WNBA.

- Natasha Cloud is averaging a career-best 12.7 points per game and is averaging 6.0 assists per game, one of five players to average at least 12.0 points and 5.0 assists per game this season.
- On 9/5, Cloud scored 20 points in Phoenix, marking the fifth time this season she has scored 20+ points in a game, which is a new career-high.

- With injuries to key players, Mystics guards Natasha Cloud and Brittney Sykes stepped up their play. In a five-game stretch (7/9-7/28), they averaged a combined 36.8 points and 9.6 assists. They are one of three sets of teammates to have two players average at least 18.0 points each during this time span.

- Hawkins was shooting 51.9% from the field this season, eighth best in the WNBA and averaging 9.1 points per game, the most points she has averaged since 2019 (9.5) when she was last in the starting lineup (8/13). She is currently averaging career-best in rebounds (5.1) and assists (1.5).

Return to the Starting Lineup

- On 8/18 at Indiana, Ariel Atkins (11 games missed, left ankle sprain) and Elena Delle Donne (14 games missed, left ankle sprain) made their returns to the Mystics starting lineup.

Powerful Pair Stepping Up

- On July 7, 2023 vs. Indiana, Ariel Atkins and Brittney Sykes filled up the stats sheet on a night when the Mystics faced a short bench with only eight active players.
- Ariel Atkins secured the first double-double of her career, with a season-best 26 points and career-high 10 rebounds.
- Brittney Sykes led the team in scoring with a season-high 29 points, the second-most points by a Mystics player this season behind only Elena Delle Donne who had 31 points on June 30. Sykes also tied her careerhigh in three-point shots made with four.
