• The Mystics' 101 points scored on May 21, 2021 in the team's 101-72 win over the Liberty is tied for the most points scored against New York in franchise history, also doing so on 8/25/19.

• The Mystics' 16 three-point makes on 5/21/21 mark the most three-point makes against the Liberty in series history.

PREVIOUS MEETING

July 21, 2023 Liberty 96, Mystics 87

AP-- Jonquel Jones scored 27 points and grabbed 11 rebounds, Breanna Stewart and Sabrina lonescu also had doubledoubles and the New York Liberty beat the short-handed Washington Mystics 96-87 on Friday night.

New York led 73-56 with 2:26 remaining in the third quarter before Washington scored the next 14 points to get within a single possession. Jones ended the Liberty's scoring drought with 8:15 left in the fourth. Stewart converted a three-point play, capping a 7-0 run, to extend New York's lead to 90-77. Jones made it 94-86 on a layup in traffic with 1:09 left. Stewart finished with 24 points and 10 rebounds and lonescu added 16 points, 11 rebounds and nine assists for New York (15-5). Courtney Vandersloot scored 12 points and Betnijah Laney had 10 as all five Liberty starters finished in double figures. Jones and lonescu combined for 25 of New York's 27 first-quarter points. Jones ended the first half with 19 points and seven rebounds to help New York lead 50-41. Stewart made New York's 10th 3-pointer with 5:05 left in the third for a 68-51 lead.

Brittney Sykes scored 29 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for Washington (11-10). Natasha Cloud added 17 points, Shatori Walker-Kimbrough had 15 and Tianna Hawkins added 14. Washington was without Elena Delle Donne (ankle), Ariel Atkins (ankle), Shakira Austin (hip) and Kristi Toliver (plantar fasciitis).

WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

Team

- Washington has clinched the playoffs for the first time with Eric Thibault at the helm. Since Thibault joined the Mystics in 2013 (formerly Assistant Coach 2013-19, associate head coach 2019-22), the Mystics have reached the postseason in all but two seasons (2016, 2021).
- The Mystics are set to play 40 regular season games for the first time in league history. The 40-game season is an increase from the WNBA's 36-game season last year.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ABC, ESPN, CBS, CBSSN, ION and NBA TV) 23 times this season.
- Washington has 11 afternoon games this season, with six of the 11 games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time.
- The Mystics played their 850th regular season game on July 28, 2023, at Dallas. This date will also marks the Mystics' 900th regular or postseason game in franchise history.
- Washington will look to improve upon their franchise-high defensive rebounds per game set last season after the team averaged 26.9 per game.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the seventh-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted 22.5 three-pointers per game.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 20+ assists per game for the second-consecutive season and for the third time in franchise history (2022, 2019).
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the seventh time over the last eight seasons.
- The 2023 WNBA season marks the 26th season for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.

Elena Delle Donne

- Elena Delle Donne looks to shoot at least .900 from the free throw line for the eighth time in her career (at least 90 FTA).
- Delle Donne (2441) needs 114 points to pass Crystal Langhorne (2554) as the fourth all-time leading scorer in franchise history. She needs 403 points to become the third all-time leading scorer (Monique Curry, 2843).

Natasha Cloud

- Natasha Cloud looks to build upon her career-best and franchise record 7.0 assists per game recorded last season.
- Cloud looks to extend her franchise record assists (1778) after passing 1,000 career assists last season.
- Cloud looks to average 5.0 assists per game for the fourth-consecutive season. Cloud is the only player in franchise history to average five-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).
- Cloud looks to total 200 or more assists for the second consecutive season. Cloud's 239 assists in 2022 were the most recorded in a single season in franchise history and led the WNBA last season.
- Cloud looks to finish the season top five in the WNBA in assists per game for the fourth time since 2019 (did not play in 2020).
- Cloud looks to average one or more steals per game for the fourth consecutive season.

Brittney Sykes

- Brittney Sykes looks to lead the WNBA in steals and steals per game for the third-straight year after recording 65 steals in 2022, the most in a single season of her career. She also totaled the most steals per game (2.0) of her career.
- Sykes looks to average 10+ points per game for the fifth time in her career. In 2022, she averaged 12.7 points per game, her highest mark since her rookie year (13.9) in 2017.
- Sykes looks to continue to improve upon her 3.7 assists per game (2022), the highest of her career.



WHAT TO WATCH FOR IN 2023

Ariel Atkins

- Ariel Atkins looks to top 500 total points in the season for the second time in her career and second consecutive season.
- Atkins looks to exceed her single-season career high in three-point field goals made after setting a new high last season (70).
- Atkins looks to continue to improve her rebounding numbers, after averaging career-bests with 2.3 defensive rebounds and 3.2 total rebounds per game.
- Atkins looks to notch 45+ steals for a third-straight season to join nine others in WNBA history to do so.
- Atkins looks to become one of 11 players in WNBA history to earn All-Defensive honors at least six times in her career.
- Atkins (242) needs 18 more steals to pass Monique Currie (260) and become the second all-time steals leader in franchise history.

Kristi Toliver

- Kristi Toliver along with Diana Taurasi (18), Candace Parker(15), Epiphanny Prince (13), DeWanna Bonner (13), Jasmine Thomas (12) and Courtney Vandersloot (12) are the only active WNBA players to have played at least 12 seasons
- In her 13th season, Toliver looks to continue to move up the all-time three-point field goals made list, where she currently ranks seventh all-time (641).
- Currently ranked fifth in franchise history, Toliver looks to increase her total three-point field goals made (184) as a Mystic.
- Toliver (4434) needs 66 points to reach a new milestone of 4,500 points.

Shakira Austin

- Shakira Austin looks to build off of her rookie season as the sixth player in franchise history to be named to an All-Rookie Team
- Austin looks to shoot .540 or better from the field for the second-straight season. Her .547 field goal percentage last season ranked as the franchise's second highest by a Mystics rookie (Min. 25 GP), trailing only Crystal Langhorne in 2008 (.624).
- Austin looks to build upon her six double-figure rebound games, which was the most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history and led the team in 2022.
- Austin's four double-doubles last season tied Alessandra Santos de Oliveira (1998) for the second-most by a Mystics rookie in franchise history.

Clinched!

- On September 5 at Phoenix, the Mystics controlled their destiny and clinched a playoff berth for the second straight season. The team will be making their sixth playoff appearance over the last seven seasons.
- The Mystics had a historic shooting night in the game that marked just the third time in WNBA history a team has shot 55% or better from the field and 55% or better from three-point range, while making 100% of their free-throws. The last such instance came from the Atlanta Dream on August 23, 2015.
- The Mystics had strong individual performances on the night. Elena Delle led the team with 24 points on her birthday, shooting shooting 9-15 from the field (60.0 %), 2-2 from three and 4-4 from the free-throw line. Natasha Cloud had her second double-double of the season with 20 points and 10 assists, shooting 6-8 from the field. Shatori Walker-Kimbrough scored 17 points while shooting a perfect 7-7 from the field. - On 8/26, the Mystics defeated the Las Vegas Aces, 78-62, to hand the team their fifth loss of the season and their only home loss of the thus far.
