- Averaged a career-best 2.4 defensive rebounds and 3.1 total rebounds per game in 2023

- Finished sixth in the WNBA in 2023 in three-point percentage, shooting .426 percent from three
- Had a breakout season in 2023 with career-highs in points (7.7), rebounds (3.0), assists (2.0) and three-point attempts (3.4) per game

SHAKIRA AUSTIN

- Had a career-high number of double-doubles in a season after recording five double-doubles in the first seven games of the 2023 season
- Averaged 10.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game in 2023

SERIES NOTES

- The Mystics will face the Liberty at home on opening night for the second-straight season.
- The Mystics defeated the Liberty 80-64 on opening night in 2023 and closed the regular season with a 90-88 win in Brooklyn.
- New York scored the most points in series history last season on July 21, 2023 with 96 points.
- The Mystics have not won a season series since 2019, they have lost or tied the series after sweeping them in 2018 and 2019.
- The Mystics are 11-7 against the Liberty in the regular season spanning back to the start of the 2018 WNBA season.
- The Mystics' 101 points scored on May 21, 2021 in the team's 101-72 win over the Liberty is tied for the most points scored against New York in franchise history, also doing so on 8/25/19.

AP -- Breanna Stewart scored 27 points and the New York Liberty beat the Washington Mystics 90-85 in overtime on Tuesday night to advance to the semifinals of the WNBA playoffs for the first time in eight years. New York hadn't won a playoff series since 2015. "It means a lot. I don't know if we're thinking about it," Stewart said. "Today there were highs and lows. We knew it was going to be emotional. D.C. was going to go out swinging. We stayed the course. We didn't stop playing until the final buzzer." The Liberty will play either No. 3 Connecticut or sixth-seeded Minnesota. Those two teams will play the deciding game of their best-of-3 series on Wednesday night. The semifinals begin Sunday. The Liberty had to work to advance after blowing an 11-point halftime lead. New York built an 84-79 lead in overtime before Washington got within 86-85 with 38 seconds left. The Liberty worked the shot clock down, but Jonquel Jones turned it over. Brittney Sykes drove down the other end before turning it over herself with 14 seconds remaining. Stewart hit two free throws a few seconds later to give New York an 88-85 advantage. Washington had a chance to tie it, but Ariel Atkins missed a contested 3-pointer with 7 seconds remaining. Stewart hit two more free throws to seal the win to the delight of the sellout crowd that included Carmelo Anthony and Sue Bird. Jones finished with 19 points and 14 rebounds for New York. Natasha Cloud scored a career-high 33 points to lead Washington. "One of the best games of her career," Mystics coach Eric Thibault said. "Especially considering the way they were playing her and put the people on her. To do it on a stage like this was impressive." Both teams had chances in the final seconds of regulation after New York tied it at 76 on two free throws by Jones with 11 seconds left. Those came off an offensive rebound when Sabrina Ionescu missed two free throws. "You all saw it, we felt it, Jonquel's a phenomenal rebounder, she's really hard to keep off the glass," Mystics forward Elena Delle Donne said. "She's going to go at that point. We couldn't pinch her quite right. Those moments are certainly heartbreaking."

Team

- Washington looks to make the playoffs for the second time with Eric Thibault at the helm. Since Thibault joined the Mystics in 2013 (formerly assistant coach 2013-19, associate head coach 2019-22), the Mystics have reached the postseason in all but two seasons (2016, 2021).
- The Mystics are set to play 40 regular season games for the second-straight season. The 40-game season is an increase from the WNBA's 36-game season in 2022.
- Washington will appear on national TV (ESPN, CBS, ION) seven times this season.
- Washington has 10 afternoon games this season, with eight of the 10 games having a 3:00 p.m. tip-time and two games with a 2:00 p.m. tip time.
- The Mystics will play their 900th regular season game on Sunday, September 8, 2024, vs. Minnesota.
- Washington looks to average 80 or more points per game for the eighth time over the last nine seasons. The team averaged 80.5 points per game in 2023.
- The Mystics will look to dish out 20+ assists per game for the third time in franchise history (2022, 2019). The team averaged 19.2 assists per game in 2023.
- Washington will look to average at least 25 defensive rebounds per game after the team has averaged 25+ defensive rebounds per game in a season for the past three seasons.
- The Mystics look to attempt 20+ three-pointers per game for the eighth-consecutive season. Last season, Washington attempted 23.1 three-pointers per game and had a franchise-high 27.4 three-point attempts per game in 2021.
- A Mystics player has been named to the WNBA All-Defensive team for six-straight seasons, including five-time All-Defensive Ariel Atkins and four-time All-Defensive Brittney Sykes and look to earn more All-Defensive honors this season among other awards.
- The Mystics have had a player named to the WNBA All-Rookie team for back-to-back seasons (2022: Shakira Austin, 2023: Li Meng). The team currently has 5 rookies on the 2024 roster.
- The 2024 WNBA season marks the 27th season for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.

Players

- **Ariel Atkins** looks to increase her franchise record in career threes made and to exceed her single-season career high made after setting a season-high 70 made threes in 2022.
- Atkins looks to continue to improve her rebounding numbers, after averaging a career-best 2.4 defensive rebounds and 3.1 total rebounds per game in 2023, her second-straight season averaging at least three rebounds per game
- Atkins looks to notch 45+ steals for a fourth season in her career after achieving the feat in 2019, 2021, and 2022.

TEAM NOTES

Team

- Washington clinched a playoff berth for the first time with Eric Thibault at the helm. Since Thibault joined the Mystics in 2013 (formerly Assistant Coach 2013-19, associate head coach 2019-22), the Mystics have reached the postseason in all but two seasons (2016, 2021).
- The Mystics played 40 regular season games for the first time in league history, with the team finishing the year 19-21 to take the seventh seed in the WNBA standings.
- The Mystics averaged 80.5 points per game this season, their second-straight season averaging at least 80 points a game and for the seventh time over the last eight seasons.
- The Mystics had their fourth-highest assists per game in team history, dishing 19.2 per game.
- The Mystics had the highest free-throw percentage in the league shooting 82.3% from the line, the sixth time in team history shooting at least 80% on the season.
- Washington had the second-lowest turnovers in the league, averaging 13.2 turnovers per game.
- The Mystics forced the third-most opponent turnovers in the league, averaging 15.5 per game.
- The Mystics had the lowest opponent second chance points (8.7) in the league and were second-lowest in opponent points off turnovers (13.3), opponent fast-break points (8.3) and opponent points in the paint (33.2). No other team in the league ranked top two in multiple categories.
- Washington brought down an average 25.7 defensive rebounds per game, the third straight season with at least 25 and the third-highest mark in team history after setting a record-high last season with 26.9 per game.
- The team's pace (estimated possessions per 40 minutes) was the highest in franchise history, averaging 80.1.
- The 2023 WNBA season marks the 26th season for the Washington Mystics. Chartered in 1997, the Mystics are one of the first WNBA expansion franchises to be established and the longest tenured continuously operating women's professional sports team in Washington, D.C.

Player

- Brittney Sykes had a career year, averaging career-highs in points (15.9), rebounds (5.9), assists (3.8) and steals (2.1). Last season she averaged 12.7 points per game and her previous season-high was from her rookie year when she averaged 13.9 points per game.
- Sykes's 2.1 steals per game ranked second in the WNBA and she was one of two players in the league to average more than two steals per game.
- Sykes recorded six games with at least five steals this season, with no other players having more than two such games this year. Her 12 career games with 5+ steals ranks 9th in WNBA history.
- Sykes recorded at least one steal for 19 consecutive games spanning from May 19 to July 11, the longest such streak in the WNBA this season.
- Sykes greatly improved her three-point shot this year, averaging a career-high 1.4 makes per game, shooting a career-high 35.0% from three, improving upon her previous-high set her rookie season in 2017 (33.6%).
- Natasha Cloud ranked fifth in the WNBA this season with 6.2 assists per game, her third consecutive season with at least 6.0 assists per game. Cloud is the only player in franchise history to average six-plus assists in three or more seasons (min. 20 GP).
- Cloud finished top five in the WNBA in assists per game for the fourth time since 2019 (did not play in 2020).
- Cloud totaled more than 200 assists for the second-consecutive season with 229 assists this year, increasing her franchise-leading total assists (1259).
- Cloud broke the Mystics single-game assists record with her 15 assists on 9/8 vs. Atlanta.
- Cloud had 39 steals this season to move into fourth all-time in Mystics steals with 237.
- Cloud averaged a career-high 12.7 points per game, the second-consecutive season and second time in her career with 10+ points per game.
- Elena Delle Donne shot 93.8% from the free-throw line, the eighth time in her career shooting at least 90.0%.
- Delle Donne (2551) surpassed 2500 points with the Mystics with her 383 points scored in 23 games played this season.
- Delle Donne moved into 30th all-time in the WNBA in scoring this season with 4,706 career points.
- Ariel Atkins broke the franchise record in three pointers made with 318 total threes, passing Ivory Latta (308) on July 11.
- Atkins averaged 1.6 three's made per game. She has had at least 1.5 three's per game every season since entering the league in 2018.
- Atkins finished the year with her highest free-throw shooting percentage of her career, shooting 89.7%.
- Shakira Austin in her sophomore season had 5 double-doubles this year, all of them in the first seven games of the season, improving upon her four total double-doubles last season.
- Austin finished the season averaging 10.0 points per game and 7.0 rebounds per game, improving upon her marks set last season.
- Li Meng led all rookie's in threes made this season with 44 on the season, averaging 1.3 per game. She also had the fifth most points among rookies with 190 total points this year.
- Meng has the most games among rookies with multiple threes in Mystics history with 14 such games, passing Atkins who had 11 such games her rookie year.
- Tianna Hawkins finished the season with 8.2 points per game, her highest mark since 2020 and the third time in her career with at least 8.0 points per game.
- Hawkins finished the season with a career-high in rebounds (5.0) and assists (1.4) per game.

TEAM NOTES

Clinched!

- On September 5 at Phoenix, the Mystics controlled their destiny and clinched a playoff berth for the second straight season. The team will be making their sixth playoff appearance over the last seven seasons.
- The Mystics had a historic shooting night in a game that marked just the third time in WNBA history a team has shot 55% or better from the field and 55% or better from three-point range, while making 100% of their free-throws. The last such instance came from the Atlanta Dream on August 23, 2015.
- The Mystics had strong individual performances that night. Elena Delle Donne led the team with 24 points on her birthday, shooting 9-15 from the field (60.0 %), 2-2 from three and 4-4 from the free-throw line. Natasha Cloud had her second double-double of the season with 20 points and 10 assists, shooting 6-8 from the field. Shatori Walker-Kimbrough scored 17 points while shooting a perfect 7-7 from the field. Rookie Li Meng shot 4-6 from the field, including three made threes in her third game this season with 3+ threes.

Steals, Steals and More Steals

- Brittney Sykes finished second in the league with 21 steals per game and 84 total steals this season, the most total steals in a season in franchise history and in her career.
- On 8/20 vs. Dallas, Sykes totaled 5+ steals for the sixth time this season. She has had 5+ steals 12 times since 2020, the most by any player in that time span.
- With her 12 career games with 5+ steals, Sykes is ninth all-time in WNBA history in games with at least five steals.
- Sykes has totaled at least one steal in all but four games she has played this season. Her 28-game steal streak (7/28/22-7/11/23) marked the fifth longest streak since the 2010 season. She also joined Tamika Catchings and Angel McCoughtry to hold numerous 20+ game streaks since 2010.
- From 7/26 to 8/4 (four games), Sykes totaled a combined 19 steals, the most by any player over a four-game span this season. It is also the most steals over four games in Mystics history, as she passed Alana Beard (18) for the franchise record.
- On 7/28 at Dallas, she recorded her 250th career steal.

Career Year

- Brittney Sykes is had a career year in 2023, averaging career-bests in points (15.9), rebounds (5.0), assists (3.8) and steals (2.1).
- Sykes also improved her three-point shot, setting a new career-high in threes made per game (1.4) and three-point shooting percentage (35.5%). 2023 was her third season shooting more than 30% from three.
- On 8/18, Sykes scored 30 points for a second-consecutive game, the first time she's scored 30+ points in back-to-back games. She is one of five players this season to score 30+ in back-to-back games and only the third player in Mystics history to do so.
- Sykes also made a career-high five three's on 8/18
- She has totaled eleven 20+ point games this season (last: 9/10 at NYL), which stands as the most 20+ point games in a single season in her career.
- Sykes has connected on 56 three-point makes, her most in a single season.
- She joined Thomas (CON), Sabally (DAL), Stewart (NYL) and Ionescu (NYL), as the only players this season to average at least 15.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and a steal per game.

Taking Down the Champs

- On 8/26, the Mystics defeated the Las Vegas Aces, 78-62, to hand the team their fifth loss of the season and their only home loss of the thus far.
- The Mystics held the Aces to their lowest team shooting percentage (30.8%) as well as their second-lowest point total (62) and second-lowest team three-point percentage (20.7%) of the season
- The Aces 30 points in the first half was their second lowest total in the first half this season, and their 32 points in the second half was their second lowest total in the second half all year.
- Elena Delle Donne stepped up in a big way, scoring 21 points with seven rebounds and a steal on 6-10 shooting from the field, 2-3 from three and 7-7 from the free-throw line. This was her seventh game this season scoring 20+ and her first since June 30 at Atlanta.

- Natasha Cloud averaged 6.2 assists per game, 5th most in the WNBA
- On 9/10 at New York, Cloud dished out 5 assists, marking the 29th time this season she dished 5+ assists . She dished 10+ assists three times (last 9/8, 15 ast).

- Natasha Cloud averaged a career-best 12.7 points per game and averaged 6.2 assists per game, one of four players to average at least 12.0 points and 6.0 assists per game in 2023.
- On 9/5, Cloud scored 20 points in Phoenix, marking the fifth time this season she scored 20+ points in a game, which is a new career-high. Prior to 2023, Cloud had scored 20+ points in five games of her career.
- In the month of July, Cloud averaged 14.6 points, 5.8 assists 3.3 rebounds and 1.8 steals per game.
- She totaled a season-high 24 points on 7/26 at MIN, the first time in her career she had recorded consecutive 20-point outings (7/23-7/26).

- Meng's 5.6 points per game currently ranked fifth among rookies
- Meng stepped up while several Mystics starters were out due to injury. Over 13 games from July 7 to August 11, Meng averaged 6.6 points per game (fifth among rookies over span), on 1.5 made threes per game (first among rookies over span), while playing 20.4 minutes per game (fourth among rookies over span).
- Meng recorded a career-high 14 points on 5-12 from the field and 4-9 from three on June 16 in a win over Phoenix. Her four threes are tied for the most made in a game by a rookie this season.

Step Right Up

- Mystics forward/center Tianna Hawkins and guard/forward Shatori Walker-Kimbrough both stepped up this season when inserted into the starting lineup.

- Hawkins started in 21 games this season, the most ever in her career, averaging career-bests in rebounds (5.0) and assists (1.4). She also averaged 8.2 points per game and shot 49.1% from the field this season, her highest mark since 2019.
- Walker-Kimbrough also started in the most games of her career with 15 starts, averaging career-bests in assists (1.7), rebounds (2.1) and free-throw percentage (93.6) this season. Walker-Kimbrough had a strong month of July, averaging 9.6 points, 2.6 rebounds and 2.5 assists while shooting 50.7% from the field and 47.8 from three-point range.

Shakira Keeps Improving

- After having one of the best rookie seasons in Mystics history, Shakira Austin kept getting better in 2023. On June 9, 2023, Austin secured her fifth double-double of the season with 15 points and 11 rebounds. With her fifth double-double, she improved upon her season-high four double-doubles set last year.
- Austin averaged higher marks this season in points per game (10.0) and rebounds per game (7.0).
- This season, this Mystics have played better defensively when Austin is on the court. The team's defensive rating this season is 89.3 when Austin is on the court, compared to 103.2 when she is off the court. Last season, the team's defensive rating was 96.8 when Austin was on the court compared to 91.0 when she was off.

All The Little Things

- Washington finished the season second in opponent points off turnovers (13.3), first in opponent second chance points (8.7), second in opponent fast break points (8.3) and second in opponent points in the paint (33.2). Washington is the only team to rank top-two in all four categories. No other teams rank top two in multiple categories.
- The Mystics forced opponents into 15.5 turnovers per game, which ranked third in the WNBA.
- Washington averaged 16.7 points off turnovers, fourth best in the WNBA.

- With injuries to key players, Mystics guards Natasha Cloud and Brittney Sykes stepped up their play. In a five-game stretch (7/9-7/28), they averaged a combined 36.8 points and 9.6 assists. They are one of three sets of teammates to have two players average at least 18.0 points each during this time span.
- Coming out of the All-Star break, Cloud totaled 17 points and five assists in four straight games (streak broken on 7/28), the longest stretch of her career and the longest streak of 17/5 by a player this season.
- Cloud averaged 2.2 steals per game in five games after the all-star break, recording 11 steals total, tied for the most in the league over that span.

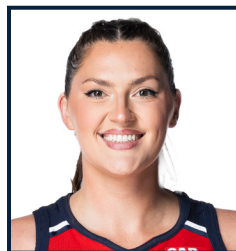

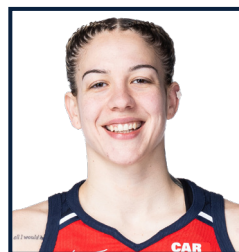
